COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoo-wah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

Adequate space is available for the visiting team needs. Arrangement for broadcasts must be validated in advance through the UVA Athletics Media Relations Office.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with coaches and players should be made through Vincent Briedis in the Athletics Media Relations Office. Postgame interviews are conducted at field level following the postgame handshake. Locker rooms are closed.

THE SERIES VS. NOTRE DAME

• The series tilts in favor of Notre Dame, 8-5. UVA has lost the last seven meetings.

• The teams had a three-year series that ended in 2003 and have met seven times since, the 2006 and 2012 NCAA Tournaments, as well as ACC play in 2014-18.

• Four of the meetings between UVA and Notre Dame have come in the NCAA Tournament (1993, 1994, 2006, 2012) and UVA holds a 3-1 record.

• The 2014 ACC matchup marked the first time the series had been played in Notre Dame. The first six games in the series were contested at UVA's Klöckner Stadium.

• Weather in South Bend forced the 2014 meeting inside at the Loftus Sports Center.

• The 2012 meeting came in the quarterfinal round of the 2012 NCAA Tournament at PPL Park in Chester, Pa. • Notre Dame's first victory was an 11-8 win in 2001 as the Fighting Irish advanced to Championship Weekend that season before falling to Syracuse in the semifinals.

• The Fighting Irish, ranked sixth at game time, became just the scond team ranked fifth or lower to defeat the Cavaliers at Klöckner.

• Notre Dame won the most recent NCAA meeting, a 12-10 triumph over UVA to advance to the 2012 Championship Weekend before falling to Loyola in the semifinals.

• The 2012 meeting was the final game in the illustrious career of UVA's Steele Stanwick. UVA's all-time point leader finished his career with seven points and five assists against Notre Dame.

• Virginia's 23-4 win in the 1994 Tournament represents its biggest win over a ranked team in program history (Notre Dame was ranked 14th at game time.) The margin of victory also marks UVA's greatest in NCAA Tournament action

• 2006 Tewaaraton Trophy winner Matt Ward led UVA with four goals in the 2006 meeting between UVA and Notre Dame, as the Cavaliers won 14-10 in the NCAA First Round on their way to the program's fourth NCAA title.

CAVALIERS, IRISH SHARE TIES

• UVA and Notre Dame share several ties which could be intriguing.

• Notre Dame head coach Kevin Corrigan is a graduate of UVA and played on three Cavalier squads that made the NCAA Tournament from 1979-81.

· Corrigan was an assistant coach on Jim Adams' staff at UVA in 1987 and 1988 before being named head coach at Notre Dame prior to the 1989 season.

 Corrigan's father, Gene Corrigan, served as athletics director at UVA from 1971-80, was the UVA lacrosse head coach from 1959-67, was the soccer coach from 1958-65 (among other positions).

 Gene Corrigan left UVA to become Notre Dame's athletics director in 1981 and left in 1987 to become the ACC's third-ever commissioner from 1987-1997.

 Notre Dame head coach Kevin Corrigan is first cousins with former UVA women's basketball head coaching legend Debbie Ryan.

 Kevin Corrigan also was a local Charlottesville high school coach for one season, serving as an assistant boy's lacrosse coach at Western Albemarle High School in 1982.

 Corrigan was in the same UVA men's lacrosse class as Steve Kraus, father of current UVA junior attackman Michael Kraus. Steve Kraus was a two-time All-American for the Cavaliers.

NO LUCK VS. IRISH IN OVERTIME

• Virginia lost the 2016 and 2017 regular season meetings with Notre Dame in overtime.

• Last year, despite Michael Kraus' five goals and two assists, UVA turned the ball over twice in overtime and never took a shot as the Fighting Irish won, 11-10.

• UVA's 2016 trip to Notre Dame, the Fighting Irish won the overtime faceoff and connected on their first overtime shot when Sergio Perkovic find nylon 29 seconds into the extra frame, giving ND the 8-7 win. Perkovic also scored with 23 seconds left in the fourth quarter to force overtime.

KRAUS STRONG AGAINST THE IRISH

Michael Kraus has had three strong games against Notre Dame in his career.

• Kraus has 12 career goals and three assists for 15 total points.

• As a freshman in 2017 Kraus had five goals and two assists in a rainsoaked game at Klöckner Stadium. He followed that game up with four goals at Notre Dame in 2018. Kraus had three goals and one assist in the ACC Championship game at Klöckner in 2018 before leaving early with an injury.

VIRGINIA AND OVERTIME IN 2019

• UVA is in the midst of a three-game stretch where the Cavaliers have played three overtime games in a row.

• It is only the third time in program history UVA has played three consecutive games that went to overtime. It is the first time in program history UVA has won all three games with wins at then-No. 19 Princeton (12-11), at then No. 14 Syracuse (15-14) and vs. Brown (14-13).

UVA last played three consecutive overtime games in 2017, going 1-2 with wins vs. Cornell and back-to-back losses to Notre Dame and Johns Hopkins. UVA also played three overtime games in a row in the 1980 NCAA Tournament, beating Cornell and North Carolina before falling to Johns Hopkins in double OT for the NCAA title.
UVA has never played four consecutive overtime games.

• UVA is 5-2 all-time in overtime under Lars Tiffany, including 2-1 at

TIFFANY DOES A RARE THING VS. BROWN

• UVA head coach Lars Tiffany has been the head coach at Stony Brook, Brown and now Virginia.

With UVA's win over Brown, Tiffany owns at least one career win over every program he has served as a head coach. Tiffany is 2-0 all-time against Stony Brook, winning once as the Brown head coach and once as the UVA head coach. Tiffany is 1-1 against Virginia, winning as the Brown head coach and losing as the Stony Brook head coach. He is 1-0 against Brown, winning at the Virginia head coach.
Only one other active coach that has had at least three DI head coaching jobs has career wins over each of the three programs he has coached. Tiffany joins Duke's John Danowski who coached C.W. Post when they were a DI program, as well as Hofstra and Duke. Danowski has beat all three of those DI programs as a DI head coach.

DOX AITKEN SETS ANOTHER UVA RECORD

• M Dox Aitken reached 100 career points (75-25-100) on Feb. 18 vs. High Point. He is the quickest midfielder in UVA history to the milestone, reaching so in 36 games.

• Aitken broke the previous record of 39 games by Pete Eldredge (1969-72).

UVA RECORDS BACK-TO-BACK ROAD RANKED WINS

• UVA won in overtime, 15-14, at then-No. 14 Syracuse on March 2. With a win at then-No. 19 Princeton (12-11, OT), UVA won back-toback road games against ranked opponents for the first time since 2012.

• In a seven-day span in 2012, UVA won at then-No. 9 Maryland (12-8) on March 31, followed by a win at then-No. 9 UNC (15-10) on April 7.

UVA HAS NO EASY OUTS TO BEGIN THE 2019 SEASON

• Of UVA's first 12 opponents of the 2019 season, 10 have been ranked so far this season.

• This week eight of those opponents are currently ranked. UVA's win over then-No. 19 Princeton knocked the Tigers from the polls. UVA also plays Richmond, who dropped out of the Top 20 this week.

• UVA's first five games of 2019 feature an opponent currently ranked, or previously ranked in the polls in 2019.

• Of UVA's first 12 games, only Brown and Utah have not been ranked at some point this season. Brown was receiving votes last week.

UVA ROCKING THE ASSISTS

• UVA has scored 74 goals through four games this year and has assisted 49 of them. That means UVA has recorded an assist on 66.2 percent of its goals in 2019.

DEFENDING THE CLEAR

• In six games this season, UVA is limiting its opponents to a 71.9 clearing percentage (92-of-128), which is 6.0 failed clears per game by UVA opponents.

• Contrast, UVA is clearing at an 79.6 percent rate (90-of-113), failing 3.8 clears per game.

AITKEN CLIMBS UVA MIDFIELDER SCORING LISTS

• Midfielder Dox Aitken (82) needs one goal to pass Greg Traynor (82) for sole possession of No. 6 all-time at UVA for career goals among midfielders.

• With 82 career goals, Aitken has reached the 80-goal mark quicker than any other midfielder in UVA history.

• Aitken needs one point to pass Jay Jalbert (107) and Andy Kraus (107) for sole possession of No. 6 in career midfielder points at UVA. Kraus is the uncle of current UVA attackman Michael Kraus.

 Aitken is only the second Cavalier midfielder to reach his 100th career point as a third year, joining Shamel Bratton.

• Bratton reached his 100th career point in career game No. 53, while Aitken is the quickest UVA midfielder to 100 points, doing so in 36 career games. Pete Eldredge (1969-72) was the previous record holder reaching 100 career points as a fourth year in career game 39.

TIFFANY CONNECTED TO UVA'S TITLE COACHES

• UVA head coach Lars Tiffany is connected in the lacrosse world to both Glenn Thiel and Dom Starsia, the two Virginia coaches who brought NCAA titles to Charlottesville.

• Tiffany played for Starsia at Brown and coached under Thiel at Penn State (2000-04).

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

• Virginia has been ranked in the top five of the USILA Coaches poll 281 weeks all-time.

- UVA has been ranked in the Top 10 in 422 polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

2019 CAPTAINS NAMED

• Midfielder Ryan Conrad, attackman Michael Kraus and midfielder Dave Smith have been selected by their peers as the captains of the 2019 men's lacrosse team.

• Conrad is the first back-to-back captain since Steele Stanwick in 2011 and 2012.

• Michael Kraus and Conrad in 2018 are the first two "third-years" named captain since Stanwick in 2011. Greg Coholan and Tanner Scales each were named captains as redshirt jurniors during their fourth year on Grounds.

FIRST-TIME OPPONENTS

• UVA has three first-time opponents on its schedule in 2019, hosting Lehigh (Feb. 16), Marist (April 20) and Utah (March 31).
• The last time UVA had at least three first-time opponents on its schedule was 2005 with regular season meetings with Manhattan and Mount St. Mary's, followed by an NCAA Tournament showdown with Albany.

DEFENSE FORCES TURNOVERS VS LEHIGH

• Lehigh had 22 turnovers against the Cavaliers on Feb. 15. UVA caused 12 of those turnovers.

• Of UVA's 12 turnovers, nine came from the starting defense: D Kyle Kology (3), D Cade Saustad (2), D Logan Greco (2) and LSM Jared Conners (2) led the way.

VIRGINIA DROPS OPENER AT LOYOLA

• For only the second time in 12 seasons, UVA has lost its season opener. Both times it game at the hands of the Loyola Greyhounds (2016 and 2019).

• In both of those losses, perennial Player of the Year candidate Pat Spencer recorded 11 combined points. In his collegiate debut against UVA in 2016 he scored two goals and two assists. In last week's Loyola win he led all players with five goals and two assists.

The No. 6 Virginia Cavaliers fell in the season opener against the No. 4 Loyola Greyhounds, 17-9, at the Ridley Athletic Complex.

The Greyhounds' goalie Jacob Stover was hot between the pipes, saving 18 shots by the Cavaliers. UVA opened the game with an extra-man goal by junior Dox Aitken 48 seconds into the game on a Michael Kraus helper. Loyola outscored UVA 8-3 the rest of the first half to take a four-point lead into the intermission, 8-4.

HOW IT HAPPENED

UVA was leading 1-0 when a 3-0 Loyola run gave the Greyhounds the lead for good, 3-1. Two goals by Loyola's Pat Spencer sparked a five-goal first quarter for LU.

After being outshot in the first quarter, 15-6, the Cavaliers managed 13 shots in the second quarter but only managed one goal as Stover made six saves in the second quarter.

Stover made seven saves in the third quarter as the Greyhounds started to pull away from UVA. Loyola picked up 11 ground balls in the fourth quarter and outscored UVA 5-2 in the final frame to solidify the win. Spencer and Kevin Lindley each scored five goals in the winning effort for Loyola, while Spencer also added two assists.

FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

"Fantastic overall effort from the entire Loyola team. It would be easy to focus on a Herculean effort by their goalie, Jacob Stover, and certainly look at potentially the nation's best player in Pat Spencer and what those two did, but that would take away from the entire team effort that we encountered. It was a heck of a team effort by Loyola on both sides of the field. We tried to hold our slides on defense and they made us pay for that. When we did slide and double the ball, they seemed to find openings. It was one of those frustrating days as defensive coordinator trying to figure out the magic formula and there wasn't one. It is easier to learn from the sting of a loss and we have the opportunity to learn from this loss. I love this team." - Lars Tiffany.

Game 2 Virginia 11, Lehigh 8 Feb. 15 • Charlottesville, Va.

The No. 11 Virginia Cavaliers used an 8-2 run to overcome an early deficit and dispose of the Lehigh Mountain Hawks, 11-8, at Klöckner Stadium. The game which was originally scheduled for Saturday was moved up a day due to a forecast for inclement weather in the Charlottesville area.

Cavalier goalie Alex Rode made three key saves in the third quarter, two of which came in man-down situations. The saves aided Virginia in holding Lehigh scoreless for 19:57 from the second quarter until the fourth quarter.

HOW IT HAPPENED

For the second week in a row UVA scored first, but then found itself in a hole. With a 2-0 lead over the Mountain Hawks, Lehigh responded by scoring five goals in a row to take a 5-2 lead at 7:42 in the second quarter.

Lehigh owned a two-goal lead, 6-4, at halftime. UVA, who handed Lehigh three extra-man goals in the first half on four penalties, settled in nicely. Dox Aitken scored a big goal to lead the third-quarter scoring. Michael Kraus scored back-to-back goals to give UVA the lead for good.

FROM THE LOCKER ROOM

"We had a couple man down stops in the third quarter and those two stops were big. Rode made a couple nice saves that could have been big momentum goals for Lehigh. From there we just got smarter about what we were doing physically. We're a physical team, we put some people on the ground after they take shots and we want to get after it in the ride. We take a lot of pride in our riding here and we had another good game in that phase. You have to put a lot of pressure on the ball and sometimes we do foul. Michael Kraus right here at the midline got that hold and I can't get upset with Michael because we're asking him to be relentless. We tell our attackmen that they are the defensive frontline of a football team, you got to get pressure. If we can get pressure with three or four rushing the passer then we don't have to implement a 10-man [ride] and we can cause turnovers, which we saw tonight. But it starts with our defensive line, they have to pressure. We tell them you don't have to make the sack, just force a bad pass or an interception because our safeties, our middies, they're ready to jump on errant passes." - Lars Tiffany
