THE CAVALIERS AT THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- UVA is making its 32nd straight appearance at the NCAA Championships.
- The Cavaliers' best finish in the NCAA Championships under head coach Steve Garland is 15th in the 2010 season and 2017 season.
- Senior Andrew Atkinson is making his fourth appearance at the NCAA Championships after competing in 2015, 2016 and 2017 at 157 pounds. He is the 10th Virginia wrestler to make four NCAA appearances.
- Making their second appearance are redshirt sophomore Sam Krivus (149) and sophomore Jack Mueller. Mueller earned All-America honors a year ago after advancing to the semifinals at 125 pounds. He finished sixth after an injury in his semifinal match.
- Three Cavaliers are making their first NCAA Championship appearance: Louie Hayes (125), Will Schany (174) and Tyler Love (285).

UVA AT THE 2017 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Virginia sent four wrestlers to the 2017 NCAA Championships in St. Louis: 10th-seeded Jack Mueller (125), sixth-seeded George DiCamillo (141), Sam Krivus (149) and Andrew Atkinson (157).
- DiCamillo earned All-America honors as he advanced to the finals, losing to top-seeded Dean Heil of Oklahoma State in a 6-3 decision. DiCamillo was the third NCAA finalist in UVA program history. He was the six seed in 2017.
- Mueller earned All-America honors after advancing to the semifinals where he lost to sixth-seeded Ethan Lizak of Minnesota in a 7-0 decision. Mueller, who had been injured in his 4-2 upset over second-seeded Joey Dance of Virginia Tech the previous round, finished sixth after having to medically forfeit the remainder of his matches following the semifinal with Lizak. Mueller was the 10 seed as a freshman.
- Krivus went 0-2 in 2017, falling to 15th-seeded Kenny Theobald of Rutgers and Cole Mendenhall of Wyoming in the wrestlebacks.
- Atkinson went 0-2 in 2017, falling to No. 10 seed Colin Heffernan of Central Michigan and Taleb Rahmani of Pitt in the wrestlebacks.

HAYES, MUELLER EARN SEEDS, CONTINUING TREND FOR UVA

- Louie Hayes (125) and Jack Mueller (133) both earned seeds for the 2017 NCAA Championships with Hayes seeded 12th and Mueller seeded 10th.
- It's the seventh consecutive year that Virginia has had at least two seeded wrestlers. The 2011 season was the last with only one seeded wrestler.
- The 2008 season was the last time Virginia did not have a seeded wrestler.

QUICK NOTES

- 2017 marks the 32nd consecutive season for UVA to compete at the NCAA Championships.
- The Cavaliers have six wrestlers in the field with Louie Hayes (125), Jack Mueller (133), Sam Krivus (149), Andrew Atkinson (165), Will Schany (174) and Tyler Love (HWT).
- Two UVA wrestlers are seeded in the event, with Hayes seeded No. 12 at 125 pounds and Mueller seeded No. 10 at 133 pounds.
- Hayes, Love and Schany make their first appearance, Krivus and Mueller make their second and Atkinson makes his fourth.

ATKINSON MAKES IT FOUR NCAA BERTHS

- Redshirt senior Andrew Atkinson became a four-time NCAA qualifier this season, qualifying at 165 pounds after qualifying at 157 pounds in 2015, 2016 and 2017.
- He is the 10th wrestler in Virginia program history to qualify for four NCAA Championships.
- George DiCamillo, a 2017 NCAA Finalist, was the most recent four-time qualifier for the Cavaliers when he qualified at 141 pounds last season.

LIGHTER WEIGHTS SET THE TONE FOR UVA

- It's no secret the lighter weights set the tone for the Hoos this season as Hayes and Mueller are both ranked.
- The duo have a combined record of 50-11 this season at 125 and 133 pounds.

CAVALIERS IN FIRST-ROUND MATCHUPS

- The first-round matchups for the Hoos present some interesting challenges as Cavaliers look to advance.
- Jack Mueller is one of two Virginia wrestlers facing off against an opponent from the regular season. Mueller and Sean Nickell (CSU-B) wrestled at the Southern Scuffle with Mueller taking a 10-0 major decision.
- Sam Krivus also faces an opponent from the regular season with a matchup against No. 6 seed Justin Oliver (CMU). They wrestled in the Cliff Keen Invitational with Oliver taking a 6-0 decision.
- Atkinson (165), Schany (174) and Love (HWT) all face tough matchups with seeded foes in their first-round matches.

HAYES VS. THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS FIELD

- Redshirt freshman Louie Hayes holds a 29-6 record and has wrestled 11 matches against NCAA qualifiers.
- Hayes holds a 7-4 record against wrestlers who advanced to this year's Championships.
- His four losses to NCAA qualifiers came against: No. 1 seed Darian Cruz (Lehigh), No. 4 seed Sean Fausz (NC State), No. 4 seed Nick Suriano (Rutgers) and No. 8 seed Ethan Lizak (Minnesota).

HAYES ON FIRE FOR THE HOOS

- Freshman Louie Hayes has picked up at 125 right were Jack Mueller left off after bumping up to 133 pounds for this season following his All-America debut.
- Hayes holds a 29-6 record on the year, including a 16-2 record in matches decided by bonus points.
- Of his last 15 wins, Hayes has posted 10 bonus-point wins, including six technical falls, four pins and a major decision. He is 17-3 in his last 20 matches.

HAYES PACED ACC IN DUAL SEASON

- Redshirt freshman Louie Hayes set the pace for the ACC when it comes to points amassed in the dual season.
- Hayes was one of seven wrestlers to post a perfect 5-0 record, but tallied the most dual points in those duals with 22 for the year.
- Hayes posted two wins by pin fall, a major decision and two decisions in his five dual matches in the ACC.

MUELLER VS. THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS FIELD

- Jack Mueller is 21-5 entering the NCAA Championship with 15 matches against NCAA qualifiers.
- Mueller is 11-4 in matches wrestled this year against the NCAA Championships field at 133 pounds.
- His four losses came to No. 9 seed Dennis Gustafson (VT), No. 12 seed Josh Terao (American), No. 15 seed Ali Naser (Arizona State) and Tariq Wilson (NC State).
- Included in his 11 wins vs. the field, Mueller has wins over: No. 7 seed Austin DeSanto (Drexel) three times, No. 8 seed John Erneste (Missouri), No. 11 seed Dom Forsys (Pitt) and No. 14 seed Korbin Myers (Edinboro).
- If the bracket advances as drawn, Mueller and DeSanto will face each other for the fourth time this season in the second round.

MUELLER LEADS HOOS AT SOUTHERN SCUFFLE

- Jack Mueller turned in one of his best performances of at the Southern Scuffle, going 4-0 to win the title.
- On the way to his title, Mueller posted three shutouts, including two major decisions. His fourth win was by injury default over No. 6 Austin DeSantos of Drexel.
- Two other Cavaliers placed at the Scuffle with Louie Hayes taking third at 125 pounds and Sam Krivus taking fourth at 149 pounds.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH STEVE GARLAND

- Head coach Steve Garland is in his 12th year at the helm of his alma mater.
- In his tenure Garland has posted an 148-79 dual record and is the second winningest coach in program history.
- His UVA wrestlers have won 10 All-America honors and 16 individual ACC titles.
- Garland guided UVA to six straight top-30 finishes at the NCAA Championships (2000-15), marking the first time UVA has recorded six straight NCAA top-30 finishes in program history.
- The 2010 ACC Coach of the Year, Garland led Virginia to an ACC championship and a 15th-place finish at NCAAs in 2010 (UVA's best NCAA finish since 1957) and again in 2017.
- He is an alum of the program and was the NCAA runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000 and the 1997 ACC champ at 126 pounds.

HAYES, MUELLER PLACE AT CLIFF KEEN INVITE

- Louie Hayes and Jack Mueller both led the way for UVA at the Cliff Keen Invitational as four wrestlers advanced to day two of the event.
- Mueller finished third in the event with a 6-1 record that included two shutout decisions over Austin DeSanto of Drexel and a win over No. 11 Korbin Myers of Edinboro. His lone loss came to then No. 13 Josh Terao of American.
- Mueller's second win over DeSanto, a 7-0 decision, included 6:23 of riding time for the UVA sophomore.
- Hayes took seventh with a 6-2 record. He posted a win over nationally-ranked Luke Welch of Purdue, while one of his two losses came to Minnesota's Ethan Lizak.
- Sam Krivus (149) and Will Schany (174) also advanced to day two of the Cliff Keen Invitational.

KRIVUS, SCHANY WRESTLED TOUGH SLATES

- Sam Krivus (149) and Will Schany (174) both also wrestled tough slates for the Cavaliers this season.
- Krivus faced 13 matches against NCAA qualifiers this season with nine of them against seeded wrestlers.
- Krivus posted wins over No. 9 seed Max Thomsen (UNI) and split with No. 14 seed Beau Donahue (NC State), most recently defeating Donahue in his last outing with an 8-1 decision at the ACC Championships.
- All but one of his losses to seeded wrestlers were by decision (the lone exception a pin by top-seed Zain Retherford of Penn State). Five of them were by three points or fewer.
- Schany also had 13 matches against NCAA qualifiers, with six of them coming against seeded wrestlers.

DON'T LET THE RECORD FOOL YOU

- It would be easy to dismiss UVA based off a 4-10 record in dual matches, but don't let the record fool you.
- Four of the duals were decided by three points or fewer.
- Duals with Kent State, No. 4 Missouri, Iowa State and Duke all were decided with one weight class or bonus points being the deciding factor.
- Add in duals with No. 12 Rutgers and No. 25 UNC, and six of the nine losses were still in play with two weight classes remaining.

ALL-AMERICA COACHING STAFF

- Virginia's coaching staff consists of three former All-Americans, including two NCAA finalists and an NCAA Champion.
- Head coach Steve Garland was the national runner-up at 125 pounds in 2000.
- Assistant coach Travis Paulson was a three-time All-American at Iowa State.
- Assistant coach Trent Paulson was a three-time All-American at Iowa State and 2007 NCAA Champion. Trent was also a World Team member in 2009.
