LEADING OFF

- Virginia leads the all-time series against Virginia Tech, 99-85 and have won five of the last six games.
- Head Coach Brian O'Connor is 17-2 against the Hokies at Disharoon Park and 28-11 overall.
- The Cavaliers are in the midst of their second, 10-game home stand of the season. So far Virginia owns a 12-4 mark at The Dish.
- This ACC home series for Virginia is the first since March 16-18 against Boston College.
- Virginia is 5-2 against teams from the Commonwealth this season.
- After back-to-back ACC road series losses, the Cavaliers trail the Hokies by a game in the ACC Coastal Division standings.

COMMONWEALTH CLASH HISTORY

- After getting swept in Blacksburg by the Hokies in 2015, Virginia went on to win 32 of its next 51 games to win the 2015 National Championship. Prior to Miami this season, it had been the last time the Cavaliers had been swept on the road.
- Five of the last nine meetings have been decided by one run, including last year's 10-inning affair in Blacksburg. Adam Haseley hit the game-deciding, series clinching home run in the 10th inning of the middle game in Blacksburg.
- O'Connor won his first 11 games against the Hokies and 17 of the first 20 from 2004-2011.

MOUND NUMBERS

- Virginia pitchers come into the weekend ranked second in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (10.9). The Cavaliers have struck out 10 or more batters in 19 of the 29 games this season, including a school-record 21 against Duke on March 10.
- With 315 total strikeouts, Virginia is tied with Florida State for the league lead.
- Senior Derek Casey has already surpassed his career-high and ranks second in the ACC with 63 strikeouts.
- Friday game two starter, Daniel Lynch, has struck out 10 or more batters in his last three starts including a career-high 12 against Pitt last week.
- In ACC play this season Lynch is 2-1 with a 1.86 ERA. His 41 strikeouts are tied with Wake Forest's Griffin Roberts for the most in league play.

MIDWEEK RECAP

- Virginia used five pitchers in a five-hit shutout of Old Dominion on Tuesday (April 3). It was the first time this season Old Dominion had been held without a run.
- Bobby Nicholson earned his third midweek win of the season and has allowed just two earned runs in four midweek starts. He pitched five innings and struck out five batters.
- Freshman Alex Tappen delivered the big hit in a three-run first inning for the Cavaliers. After the first four batters reached in front of him, he delivered a two-run single to make the score 3-0.
- Despite being responsible for five hit by pitches, Virginia pitchers did not walk a batter in the contest for the second time this season.

ACC NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Virginia has struck out 159 times, the lowest total in the ACC by 28 strikeouts.
- Andy Weber is tied for second in the league with 44 this and is sporting a .368 batting average, third highest in the ACC. He also leads the Cavaliers in runs (23), doubles (9), triples (2), home runs (2), RBIs (26).
- Caleb Knight has been hit by 13 pitches this season, the second-most to Virginia Tech's Jack Owens in the ACC and tied for the fourth most in the country. He has reached base in 12-straight games and 26 of the 27 games he's appeared.
- The Cavaliers have totaled 29 sacrifice bunts, tied for fourth-highest total in the country.

PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

- Reliever Mack Meyer has pitched in seven of Virginia's last eight games. He leads the staff with 13 appearances
- Sophomore Cayman Richardson has four outfield assists in just 10 starts in center field.
- Weber has reached base safely in a career-high 15-straight games, the second longest streak of the season (Eikhoff – 21) by a Cavalier.

WEBER EMERGENCE

- Junior Andy Weber leads the team in batting average (.368), runs (23), hits (43), doubles (9), triples (2), RBI (26) and total bases (62).
- He had a career-high 13-game hitting streak come to a close in Sunday's loss at Pitt. It was his second hit streak of 12 or more after closing 2017 with four-straight games with a hit and starting the 2018 season hitting safely in the first eight games.
- Sunday proved to be just his third hitless game of 2018. He has reached base in all but two contest this season.
- In five games last week, Weber was 10-for-21 (.476) five doubles, a triple and seven RBI.
- His 19 hits and two triples in ACC play are the tied for the most amongst his ACC cohorts.

HIT STREAKS

- Nate Eikhoff had his hit streak of 16 games snapped on 3/24 at Miami. He is one of nine players since 2001 to have put together hit streaks of 16 or more.
- Andy Weber continued a hit streak of four games started in 2017 and ran it all the way to 12 by hitting safely in his first eight games of 2018. Weber topped that by hitting safely 13-straight games from March 10-31, a span of 13 games.

- The name change was formally approved by the University of Virginia Board of Visitors on March 2, 2018.
- The stadium's namesake is to honor Leslie B. Disharoon and Ann Merriwether Disharoon, long time supporters of the Virginia baseball program.

RECORD HOME OPENER

- Unveiling the newly expanded Davenport Field, a crowd of 3,709 turned out on Tuesday (Feb. 20), a new record for a UVA home opener.
- Temperature at game time hit 75 degrees, making it the warmest opener in the stadium's history.

VIRGINIA BASEBALL TURNS 130

- Virginia will commence its 130th season of baseball in 2018.
- Going into the season, the program has accumulated 2,297 wins and owns an all-time winning percentage of .570.

MCCARTHY PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Junior Jake McCarthy is a unanimous preseason All-American and garnered first team honors from D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA. He was recognized by Baseball America, *Collegiate Baseball*, and Perfect Game as a second team honoree.
- In addition to All-America honors, Baseball America tabbed McCarthy as the "fastest runner" on its list of players across the country with the best tools.
- McCarthy was listed on the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list. He is one of eight ACC players on the initial 55-player list. Last year, Virginia's Adam Haseley was a finalist for the award annually bestowed on the nation's top amateur baseball player.

2018 HOOS KEY FIGURES

- Virginia returns 23 letterwinners from a year ago, including three starting pitchers that made 10+ starts in 2017.
- The Cavaliers' projected lineup features five returners (McCarthy, Andy Weber, Caleb Knight, Nate Eikhoff and Justin Novak) that saw action in 40 or more games last season. Novak, Weber and Charlie Cody have each appeared in 80 or more games over the course of their careers. Novak is the team's active leader with 124 career games played.

- Current LSU head coach Paul Maineri, will serve as the manager for Team USA this summer.
- O'Connor spent nine seasons working as an assistant on Maineri's staff at Notre Dame from 1995-2003.
- While working together, the Irish posted an overall record of 399-160-1, won six conference championships and made six trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- O'Connor's college coach at Creighton, Jim Hendry, will also be on staff as the bench coach. Hendry now works for the New York Yankees as a special assignment scout.

VIRGINIA INJURY UPDATES

- It was announced shortly before the start of the 2018 season that outfielder Cameron Simmons will miss the year due to a left shoulder injury.
- A second team All-ACC selection as a sophomore, Simmons started all but three games for the Cavaliers in 2017. He was second on the team and fourth in the ACC with a .352 batting average. In conference play, he hit .374, tops on the team and the third highest average in the league.
- Junior preseason All-American Jake McCarthy was sidelined after sustaining a left wrist injury on March 6 vs. Davidson. He is expected to miss six weeks and make a full recovery.

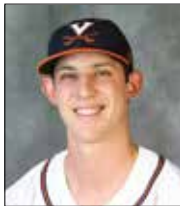
