THIS WEEK

- Virginia is making its 11th consecutive trip to the NCAA Round of 16
- The Cavaliers are looking to become the sixth school to win multiple NCAA Championships (USC, Stanford, UCLA, Georgia, William & Mary)
- UVA is one of four schools to have both the men and women in the round of 16 in each of the past four years (Cal, Georgia, UCLA)

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Cavaliers are the reigning NCAA Champions, winning their first title in 2013
- Virginia is making its 11th consecutive appearance and 16th overall
- UVA enters the round of 16 with a 43-14 all-time NCAA Tournament record
- The Cavaliers have a 41-9 record in the NCAA Tournament under Brian Boland
- Virginia has made at least the quarterfinals in each of the past nine years
- UVA reached the final the last three years and the semifinals in six of the last seven years (UVA is the only ACC team to ever reach a semifinal)
- The Cavaliers are 7-3 in NCAA Tournament matches in Athens, reaching at least the semifinals in the last three tournaments at Georgia (2007, 2010, 2012)
- Virginia's current senior class (Domijan, J.Shane) is 18-2 in the NCAA Tournament

VIRGINIA IS THE NO. 4 SEED

- Virginia is the No. 4 seed in this year's tournament
- It is the eighth straight year the Cavaliers have been a top four seed
- The Cavaliers' eight-year streak of being a top four seed is the longest current streak and the third longest streak in tournament history (14-Stanford, 1988-2001; 10-USC, 1979-1988)
- UVA is the only team to be a top-eight seed in each of the past 11 years

2014 Opponents in Bold

ACC CHAMPIONS

- Virginia won its eighth consecutive ACC Championship, its 10th in 11 years
- The Cavaliers won their 11th consecutive ACC regular season title this year

THE STREAK

- Virginia has won 121 consecutive matches against ACC opposition (regular season and tournaments)
- The Cavaliers' last loss to a conference foe was a 4-3 loss to Duke in the 2006 ACC Tournament final
- Earlier this year it became the longest streak in conference history in all sports (Duke women's tennis won 116 straight against ACC foes from 1989-2000)

DECADE OF DOMINANCE

- Virginia won its 11th consecutive ACC regular season title this season
- The Cavaliers have gone undefeated through the league in nine of those 11 years
- During the last 11 years, Virginia has gone 112-3 in ACC regular season matches
- The three losses came to UNC ('04), at UNC ('06) and against Miami ('06)

DOMIJAN NAMED ACC PLAYER OF THE YEAR

- Alex Domijan was named ACC Player of the Year
- He is the fourth Cavalier to win the award, joining Brian Vahaly (2000 & 2001), Somdev Devvarman (2008) and Jarmere Jenkins (2012)

ACC-OLADES

- Virginia led the conference with five All-ACC selections
- Mitchell Frank joined ACC Player of the Year Alex Domijan on the first team
- Ryan Shane was named to the second team
- Mac Styslinger and Thai-Son Kwiatkowski were third-team selections
- Alex Domijan was named the ACC Tournament MVP

NCAA SELECTIONS

- Virginia had three players selected to the NCAA Singles Championship (Mitchell Frank, Alex Domijan, Ryan Shane)
- UVa had two of the top eight seeds (No. 4 Frank, No. 6 Domijan) for the fourth consecutive year
- It is the seventh consecutive year Virginia has had at least three NCAA Singles Championship selections
- Domijan becomes fourth player in school history to be selected to four NCAA Singles Championships, joining Brian Vahaly (1998-01), Somdev Devvarman (2005-08) and Jarmere Jenkins (2010-13)

HOOS NO. 1

- Virginia opened the year ranked No. 1 nationally, as UVa has been ranked No. 1 at some point in seven of the past nine years
- Since 2006, Virginia has been No. 1 in 70 ITA polls, more than twice any other school
- The Cavaliers are the only ACC school to ever be ranked No. 1 in men's tennis

AGAIN AN ALL-AMERICAN

- As a seeded player in the NCAA Singles Championship, Alex Domijan will earn All-American honors in singles for the fourth time, becoming the first four-time ITA Singles All-American in school history
- He and Ray Sarmiento of USC will become the eighth and ninth players nationally to accomplish the feat since 2000

IN THE RANKINGS

- Virginia remained at No. 4 in the ITA computer rankings this week
- The Cavaliers lead the nation with seven singles players currently ranked (#4 Frank, #6 Domijan, #46 R.Shane, #81 Styslinger, #88 Daigle, #113 Kwiatkowski, #117 Corinteli) and also have four ranked doubles teams (#48 Domijan/J.Shane, #54 Corinteli/Styslinger, #67 Frank/Styslinger, #74 Domijan/Richmond)

DOMIJAN CLIMBS CAREER RECORD BOOK

- Alex Domijan has climbed up the UVa career record book during his senior year
- He enters the NCAA Round of 16 ranking fifth in career singles wins (127), 5th in career doubles wins (119) and sixth in career combined wins (246)
- Domijan is the first player in school history to post 100 career dual match singles victories (entering the round of 16 with 101 career dual match wins)
- He is one of nine Cavaliers to win at least 100 singles and 100 doubles matches during his career

FOUR CAVALIERS EARN ITA ATLANTIC REGION HONORS

- Alex Domijan was named ITA Atlantic Region Senior Player of the Year
- Thai-Son Kwiatkowski was named ITA Atlantic Region Rookie of the Year
- Ryan Shane was named ITA Atlantic Region Player to Watch, an award that both Shane brothers have won in their career (Justin won the award in 2012)
- Andres Pedrosa was named ITA Atlantic Region Assistant Coach of the Year for the second time in his career

NOTABLE

- The Round of 16 match with Notre Dame will mark the first time UVa has played an opponent four times in a season
- Virginia is 9-0 all-time against ACC opponents in the NCAA Tournament
- In Athens, Virginia is 5-1 on the Feild Stadium Courts, 1-1 on the McWhorter Courts and 1-1 on the Hopkins Indoor Courts
