VIRGINIA POST-GAME NOTES

- Virginia advances to the College World Series for the third time in program history and for the third time in the past six seasons (2009, 2011)
- Two of UVa's College World Series-clinching berths came at Davenport Field in Game 3 of a Super Regional (UC Irvine – 2011).
- Virginia is now 38-30 all-time in the NCAA Tournament and 7-5 in the super regional round.
- UVa welcomed 15,003 fans through the turnstiles at Davenport Field during the 2014 Charlottesville Super Regional, a program record for a UVa-hosted super regional.
- UVa finishes its home slate at Davenport with a program-record 142,496 fans to watch baseball in Charlottesville in 2014.
- Every UVa starter reached base at least once. Eight of UVa's nine starters recorded at least one base hit.
- UVa's 4-9 hitters were 9-for-22 with six RBI.
- UVa hitters were 7-of-12 (.583) with runners in scoring position.
- Virginia scored three runs in the first inning. It was the second-most runs the Cavaliers have scored in the first inning of a game, trailing only the four they notched on VCU on May 13.
- Virginia hitters were hit by a pitch seven times against Maryland this super regional, bringing its 2014 NCAA Tournament total to 11.
- Virginia recorded at least one hit in 20-of-27 innings in the Charlottesville Super Regional.
- Virginia batters went down 1-2-3 in the second inning, breaking a streak of 12 straight innings of recording at least one hit.
- It also marked the first 1-2-3 inning for Virginia hitters since the second inning of Game 1.
- UVa's bullpen has gone 9.2 innings and has allowed only two earned runs, while striking out nine in the Charlottesville Super Regional.
- RHP Josh Sborz made his first start since May 10 vs. Georgia Tech.
- Sborz tied his career long for innings pitched with 7.0. He also went 7.0 at Miami on March 23.
- Sborz had nine strikeouts, the second-most in an outing in his career.
- Kenny Towns' two-run triple in the first inning was the first multiple-RBI hit for either team in the Charlottesville Super Regional.
- Towns drove in four runs, tying a Virginia NCAA Tournament record for RBIs in a game. He is the seventh Cavalier to accomplish the feat.
- Towns notched his third game with three hits and accomplished the feat for the second time in two days after going 3-for-5 on Sunday.
- Mike Papi extended his reached base streak to 17 games.

Maryland (40-23) vs. Virginia (49-14)

MARYLAND POST-GAME NOTES

- Maryland is 5-8 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
- Maryland is 1-2 all-time in the super regional round.
- Maryland concludes season with a program record 40 wins.
- Maryland pitching allowed only one leadoff baserunner to reach, Daniel Pinero in the third inning, which jumpstarted UVA's three-run third inning.
- Maryland left 22 runners on base in the super regional, 16 combined in the two losses.
- After starting the 2014 NCAA Tournament 4-0, the Terps lost two in a row to finish 4-2 in the 2014 postseason.
- Maryland was 1-of-5 with runners in scoring position, tallying its first RISP hit in a two-run eighth inning.
- RHP Bobby Ruse made his 31st appearance of the season, setting a new program record.
- Ruse went 2.1 innings, his shortest of his four starts on the season.
- Maryland's 6-9 hitters were 1-for-15 with five strikeouts.
- Tayler Stiles was efficient out of the bullpen making two appearances and going 5.2 innings in the Charlottesville Super Regional.
- Stiles allowed five hits, walked four and struck out three. He allowed three earned runs that were driven in after Kevin Mooney inherited his base runners.
- Charlie White finished the 2014 Charlottesville Super Regional 5-for-13 and only one extra base hit.
