- Virginia leads the ACC in scoring defense and ranks seventh in the nation, allowing 53.4 points per game
- Virginia also ranks in the top-10 in the nation in two other defensive categories: opponent field goal shooting (34.5 percent, 10th in the NCAA) and opponent three-point shooting (26.0 percent, ninth in the NCAA). The Cavaliers rank second in the ACC in both statistics
- Freshman guard Jocelyn Willoughby was named this week's ACC Rookie of the Week. Willoughby scored 18 points in the victory over Virginia Tech and had 16 points on Sunday at Notre Dame
- It was the first ACC Player or Rookie of the Week honor for the Cavaliers since Faith Randolph was named the Player of the Week last season on Dec. 28
- Willoughby led the Cavaliers in scoring (18 pts) and rebounding (9 reb) against the Irish. It was the second time this season she had the team high points and rebounds after also doing so at Georgia
- Willoughby also had four assists and four steals at Notre Dame
- Thursday's game will feature the top-three freshman in the ACC in scoring with Georgia Tech's Francesca Pan leading the way at 10.4 ppg followed by Willoughby at 10.1 and Dominique Toussaint with 9.3. Willoughby is also second in rebounding at 6.3 per game. Willoughby and Toussaint are also second and third among first-years in steals per game at 1.62 and 1.50
- Junior guard J'Kyra Brown made her second start of the season at Notre Dame, scoring 11 points in the first half and 14 overall
- Brown also dished five assists in addition to scoring five baskets at UND. It was the fourth time this season she had five or more assists in a game. Brown also grabbed a season-high five steals
- Freshman center Felicia Aiyetotan is 6-of-8 from the field in the last four games. Aiyetotan is shooting 61.0 percent overall this season
- In the last two games, Aiyetotan has played a combined 26 minutes with 13 rebounds [an average of 6.5 rebounds in 13.0 minutes per game]
- Junior forward Lauren Moses scored 14 points at Notre Dame, just her second double-digit scoring effort in the last six games

TEAM NOTES

- Virginia leads the ACC in scoring defense and ranks seventh in the nation, allowing 53.4 points per game. The Virginia men's team leads the nation in scoring defense at 53.7 points per game
- Jocelyn Willoughby led the Cavaliers in scoring against Virginia Tech and Notre Dame. It was only the fourth time this season that a Cavalier led the team in scoring in back-to-back games
- In the five games before the Notre Dame game, six different Cavaliers led the team in scoring: Huland El at UNC; Mason vs BC; Moses and Tousseint at Clemson; Brown at Pitt; Willoughby at Virginia Tech
- Willoughby has led the team in rebounding in four of the last six games and 10 times overall this season
- Breyana Mason is 52 points shy of becoming the 32nd member of UVA's 1,000-career point club, and would join, among others, Chelsea Shine Wilson

QUICK LOOK AT THE NOTRE DAME GAME

- The Cavaliers trailed by eight at halftime, 44-36, and tied the game at 44-44 with 7:05 remaining in the third on a three from Willoughby
- Notre Dame built up an 11-point lead, 61-50, with 1:02 remaining in the 3rd, but the Cavaliers rallied to tie the game 63-63 on a three-pointer from Breyana Mason with 6:57 remaining in the gam. UVA missed eight straight field goals while the Irish scored the next nine points to again go up by nine.
- Virginia trailed by four, 75-71, with 41 seconds remaining, but the Irish went 7-of-8 from the line to close out the game
- Notre Dame's Arike Ogunbowale started the game by hitting three-straight three-pointers. The Irish made their first seven three-point attempts, not missing from long range until the 6:09 mark of the second quarter

NOTES ON THE VIRGINIA TECH GAME

- The 27 points scored by Virginia Tech were the fewest by a Cavalier opponent since UVA held Norfolk State to 23 points on Dec. 28, 2012. It was the third time this season UVA held an opponent to under 40 points, after limiting Clemson to 37 and UIC to 39
- Virginia Tech scored two points in the third quarter. It was the third time this season that UVA limited an opponent to two points in a quarter and the second time in an ACC game after holding Clemson to two points and no field goals in the fourth quarter of that contest
- The 49-point margin of victory against the Hokies matches the second-largest for the Cavaliers in an ACC game in program history, topped only by a 57-point victory over Wake Forest on Jan. 5, 1995
- The 49-point margin of victory was the largest ever for the Cavaliers when upsetting an opponent ranked higher than themselves
- UConn is the only team this year to have a larger margin of victory over a ranked opponent, a 66-point win against then No. 20 USF, 102-37
- The Cavaliers as a team shot 90 percent from the free throw line against Virginia Tech, making 18-of-20 attempts

GEORGIA TECH YELLOW JACKETS

- Virginia leads the all-time series 54-16 and is 45-14 in ACC games
- Georgia Tech has won three of the last four meetings, but the Cavaliers picked up a 78-67 victory last year in Atlanta
- Georgia Tech led 37-34 at halftime, but UVA outscored the Yellow Jackets 24-24 in the fourth quarter to pick up the victory. Breyana Mason scored a season-high 21 points, going 10-of-14 from the field, with four rebounds, four assists, two steals and a blocked shot
- The Yellow Jackets have dropped their last four games including an overtime loss at Wake Forest and a 62-61 game at Clemson on Sunday
- Georgia Tech has three players averaging double figures, led by Kaylan Pugh at 11.8 per game. Zaire O'Neil is averaging 11.6 while Francesca Pan scores 10.4 per game
- Pugh leads the defensive efforts with 5.6 rebounds per game

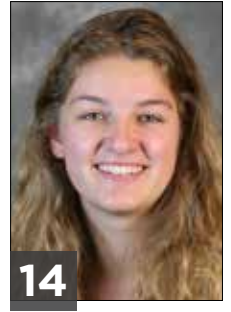
