## FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Morgan State for the fourth time in series history. - The Cavaliers extended their nation-leading November winning streak to 25 games with an ACC/B1G Challenge win at No. 24 Maryland on Nov. 28.
- UVA has started 7-0 for the third straight season and is 121-35
(.776) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett is five wins shy of 300 career wins.


## ALL-TIME VS. MORGAN STATE

- UVA sports a 3-0 all-time mark, including a 3-0 mark in Charlottesville, against Morgan State in the series that dates back to 2006-07.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Bears 85-66 at University Hall on Nov. 19, 2006.
- UVA posted a 75-57 win over Morgan State at John Paul Jones Arena in the last meeting between the teams on Dec. 19, 2012.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Bears 86-48 in season-opening action in the 2015-16 season.
- UVA has averaged 82 points vs. Morgan State, while limiting the Bears to 57 points per game for a 25 -point margin of victory in the series.


## ALL-TIME VS. MEAC OPPONENTS

- UVA meets its second Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference opponent (Coppin State) in 2018-19.
- Virginia is 20-0 all-time vs. current Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference foes (4-0 vs. Howard and Norfolk State, 3-0 vs. Morgan State, 2-0 vs. Coppin State, Maryland Eastern Shore and South Carolina State, 1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, North Carolina A\&T and Savannah State). - Tony Bennett is 12-0 all-time vs. the MEAC as head coach at UVA.


## LAST TIME VS. THE BEARS

- Mike Tobey had a game-high 15 points as then-No. 6 Virginia rolled to an 86-48 win over Morgan State in season-opening action on Friday, Nov. 13, 2015.
- Devon Hall added 13 points and Darius Thompson chipped in 12 points, six rebounds, four assists and three steals for UVA.
-Virginia out-rebounded Morgan State 50-21 and limited the Bears to 34 percent (17-50) shooting from the field.
- The Cavaliers had 50 rebounds for the first time since Jan. 15, 2009 vs. North Carolina.

## LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy had a game-high 18 points to lead No. 4 Virginia to a $76-71$ win at No .24 Maryland in an $\mathrm{ACC} / \mathrm{B} 1 \mathrm{G}$ Challenge game on Nov. 28.
-Ty Jerome added 17 points and De'Andre Hunter chipped in 15 points, five rebounds and four assists.
- Jack Salt had a career-high 12 points and season-high seven rebounds.
- Guy sank a season-high five 3-pointers as UVA built a 39-30 halftime lead.
- UVA built a 17-point lead, but Maryland sliced the margin down to four before a Jerome 3-pointer with 2:50 left halted the comeback.
-The Cavaliers sank 10 of 223 -pointers and tied a school record with two turnovers.
- UVA has a five-game winning streak in the ACC/B1G Challenge and is 13-6 overall in the Challenge.


## UVA RANKED NO. 4 IN AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked №. 4 in the AP poll for the third straight week. - UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons. - In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason. - UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 20 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 16 polls.


## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 169-41 (.804), including a 3-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 16-1 at JPJ last season and is 131-25 (.840), including a 96-10 (.906) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 49-5 (.907) in league home games over the past six seasons. Duke is second at 48-6 (.889).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.
- The Cavaliers have a five-game home winning streak dating back to last season.
- UVA is 68-6 at home in non-conference action under Bennett.
- The Cavaliers have a five-game winning streak at JPJ.


## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 225-86 (.724) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 295-119 (.713) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road. - Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20 -win seasons. - Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013). - In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title. - Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (20142015) for the first time in school history.
-UVA is 121-35 (.776) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 131-25 (.840) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673 , among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.


## UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- As of Nov. 29, UVA ranks first nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.20), turnovers per game (7.1) and winning percentage (100\%), third in scoring defense ( 52.4 ppg ) and fewest turnovers ( 50 ), sixth in turnover margin (7.6), ninth in fouls per game (14.6), 14th in scoring margin (21.1) and 29th in 3-point percentage (40.8\%).


## GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA ranks third nationally in scoring defense at 52.4 ppg .
- The Cavaliers have limited three opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Towson and Wisconsin).
- UVA has held four opponents to 40 percent or less shooting.
- UVA has out-rebounded five of its seven opponents.
-The Cavaliers are $79-2$ when holding foes to fewer than 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons. - Bennett-coached teams are 104-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 13 -year coaching career.


## HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia is led by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Hunter leads UVA in scoring (16.6) and rebounding (6.1).
- Jerome is averaging 14 points and team-high 4.0 assists.
- Guy is averaging 13 points, while Salt anchors UVA's stingy defense. - Transfer Braxton Key has averaged 6.4 points and 4.7 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 6.3 points and 2.0 rebounds. - Newcomer Kihei Clark, who has started the past two games, is averaging 5.7 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- Marco Anthony, Jay Huff and Kody Stattmann provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Redshirt freshman Francesco Badocchi has taken an indefinite leave

- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in three home games.


## TYING US TOGETHER

- Point guard Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 14 points, 4.0 assists and 3.1 rebounds.
- Jerome has reached double figures in six games, including back-toback 20-point efforts to start the season.
- Jerome is shooting a career-best 45.9 percent from 3 -point range.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylven Landesburg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Ty Jerome sank 10 of 143 -pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 103 -pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.


## THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Kyle Guy is third on the team in scoring ( 13 ppg ), highlighted by his seventh career 20-point effort vs. George Washington.
- Guy has shot 42.3 percent from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3 -pointers in eight games.
- Guy ranks first on UVA's career 3-point percentage list at 42.3 percent, edging Keith Freel's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in seven career games ( 4 in 2017-
18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the

Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.

- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.


## DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has reached double figures in every game, averaging a team-leading 16.6 points and 6.1 rebounds.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the touranment.
- Hunter has three 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton and Wisconsin), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 58.7 percent from the floor, 44.4 percent from 3 -point range and 76.9 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including a career-high 23 against Monmouth and ACC-high 22 against Miami.
- Hunter was named ACC Co-Rookie of the Week following his

22-point performance at Miami.

- Virginia has held three opponents (3-0) to fewer than 50 points and is 79-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 104-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points ( $25-1$ in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 22-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.


## THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s \& DIVINE 90s

- Virginia has scored over 70 points in five games and is 112-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 114-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 97 points against Coppin State and is 3-0 when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.
- UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 9381 loss at UNC in 2012-13.

- De'Andre Hunter and Ty Jerome were joined on the second team by Zion Williamson (Duke), Justin Robinson (Virginia Tech) and Marcquise Reed (Clemson).


## WATCH ME NOW

- Ty Jerome (Bob Cousy Award), Kyle Guy (Jerry West Award) and De'Andre Hunter (Julius Erving Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award watch lists. - Guy and Hunter are among 50 players to watch for the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year honor and 20 players for the NABA Division I Player of the Year award.


## CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Los Angeles) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17, is in his third season with the Bucks.
- Scott is in his seventh season and Harris is in his fifth NBA season (third with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his fourth season.
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.


## VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll. -The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia, North Carolina,

Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pittsburgh.

## RECORDS WATCH

- Kyle Guy ranks first on UVA's career 3-point percentage at 42.3 percent, while Ty Jerome is fifth at 39.5 percent.
- Guy has drilled 152 of 359 career 3-point attempts and needs 10 3's to pass Devin Smith ( 161 3's ) for 10th on UVA's all-time list.
- Ty Jerome reached 100 career 3-pointers with a pair against Dayton.


## WORLD WIDE CAVALIERS

- Virginia and Maine lead the nation with current players from five different continents. In addition to North America, UVA is represented by Africa (Mamadi Diakite), Europe (Francesco Badocchi), South America (Francisco Caffaro) and Australia (Kody Stattmann). - New Zealander Jack Salt gives the Cavaliers five foreign players.


## UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 33-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 2-0 mark in 2018-19 and 5-1 record in 2017-18.
- UVA' posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents (Wisconsin and Maryland) for the first in the regular season since 1982 (Georgetown and Houston).
- The Cavaliers are 148-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA's win over then-No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27 marked the Cavaliers first road win vs. a top-5 ranked foe since 1993 (77-69 over No. 3 Duke).
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).


## 50-40-75 CLUB

- Virginia is 32-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 75 percent from the free throw line in the same game under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA is 1-0 this season after achieving the mark against Coppin State and was 5-0 last season when achieving the 50-40-75 mark (Austin Peay, VCU, Rhode Island, Davidson, NC State and Louisville).


## UVA INKS MORSELL AND SHEDRICK

- Guard Casey Morsell (Fort Washington, Md./St. John's College High School) and forward Kadin Shedrick (Raleigh, N.C./Holly Springs High School) signed NLI's with the Cavaliers.
- The 6-3, 190-pound Morsell averaged 14 points and 4.3 rebounds for St. John's College High School (Washington, D.C.) in 2017-18.
- The 6-11, 200-pound Shedrick averaged 16.2 points and 9.8 for Holly Springs in 2017-18.
