## FOR OPENERS

- No. 18Virginia meets Syracuse for the second time in 2019-20. - UVA (3-1) is tied for third in the ACC, while Syracuse (1-3) is tied 10th.
- Virginia has a four-game winning streak vs. Syracuse.
- The Cavaliers have not lost back-to-back games since dropping a home game vs. Duke (65-55) and road game at North Carolina (6541) in the 2016-17 season.


## ALL-TIME VS. SYRACUSE

- UVA is 8 -5 all-time against Syracuse, including a $7-1$ mark in ACC action, in the series that dates back to 1983-84.
-Virginia owns a four-game winning streak in the series, including a 48 -34 win at Syracuse to open the 2019-20 campaign.
-The Cavaliers are 3-1 against the Orange at John Paul Jones Arena. - UVA has held the Orange to 68 or fewer points in each of the last nine meetings between the teams.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is $7-2$ all-time against Syracuse.


## LAST TIME VS. THE ORANGE

- Kihei Clark tallied 10 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists as thenNo. 11 UVA defeated Syracuse 48-34 in the season opener on Nov. 6. - UVA won its seventh straight season-opening game and 12th straight ACC opener (11-0 in ACC openers under Bennett).
- Jay Huff added 11 points and a career-high 12 rebounds for his first career double-double and Braxton Key added 10 rebounds as UVA had three players with 10 or more rebounds for the first time since 1993.
- Mamadi Diakite chipped in 12 points and six rebounds.
- UVA out-rebounded Syracuse 47-28, but committed 16 turnovers. - UVA shot 40.8 percent and limited the Orange to 23.6 percent.


## UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 10, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (47.6), field goal percentage defense (34.7), second in fewest fouls (174), third in personal fouls per game (12.4) and ninth in 3 -point field goal percentage defense (26.5).


## HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 9-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 96-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era. - Bennett-coached teams are 121-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points ( $25-1$ in three years at Washington State). - UVA is $4-0$ when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).


## LAST TIME OUT

- Jay Heath scored 17 points to lead Boston College (9-6, 3-1 ACC) to a $60-53$ win over Virginia on Tuesday, Jan. 7 in Chestnut Hill.
- Braxton Key had 16 points and eight rebounds, Kihei Clark chipped in 12 points and Kody Stattmann added a career-best 11 points, for the Cavaliers (11-3, 3-1 ACC).
- UVA trailed $30-26$ at the half, but used a $20-3$ run to gain a 50-45 second-half lead.
- Jared Hamilton's 3 -pointer with 38 seconds remaining proved to be the game-winner, giving the Eagles a $56-53$ lead.
- UVA shot a season-low 32.7 percent from the field (17 of 52) and was just 3 of 16 from 3-point range.
- Jared Hamilton (16), Steffon Mitchell (10) and Jairus Hamilton (10) also landed in double figures for Boston College.


## UVA RANKED NO. 18 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 18 in the latest Associated Press poll and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 44 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in 37 of the last 41 polls.


## OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited nine opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48 -point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
-The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
-The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
-The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3 -point shooting. - UVA has held 11 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 14 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has out-rebounded 11 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

-Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 265-92 (.742) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 334-125 (.728) career mark in 14 seasons.

- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times. - He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018). - Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett has guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013). - Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPJ), 124-54 (.697) in ACC play and 151-27 (.848) at home under Tony Bennett. - Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .697, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.


## H00 ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring ( 12.9 ppg ) and is second in rebounding (6.8), while Clark is averaging 9.9 points, 4.4 rebounds and a teamhigh 5.7 assists.
- Key is averaging 10.8 points and a team-high 7.4 rebounds.
- Huff has tallied 8.4 points and 5.8 rebounds and a team-high 18 blocks
- Kody Stattmann and newcomers Casey Morsell and Tomas Woldetensae have absorbed the minutes left by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Stattmann is averaging 5.9 points, including career highs in points (11) at Boston College and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Morsell, who scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors, is averaging 5.0 points.
- Woldetensae has started eight games and has made 12 of 41

3 -pointers, including three against North Carolina.

- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina. - Francisco Caffaro started two contests after contributing 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 6.0 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.


## WATCH ME NOW

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List.


## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 189-43 (.815), including an 8-1 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina recently ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak.

- Virginia is an ACC-leading 59-6 (.908) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 56-8 (.875).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.


## UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- UVA is 70-15 against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 23 of its last 26 games against teams from Virginia - UVA defeated JMU (65-34) and Virginia Tech (65-39) earlier this season and finished 4-0 against teams from the Commonwealth in 2018-19.


## RECORDS WATCH

- Mamadi Diakite ranks fourth on UVA's career blocks list with 134. - Diakite needs eight blocks to pass Isaiah Wilkins (141 blocks from 2015-18) for third on the list.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's singleseason list.


## UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 43-34 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 1-0 mark in 2019-20.
- UVA went 11-3 vs. ranked foes and the 11 ranked wins marked a school record.
- The Cavaliers posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time in poll history since 1948-49.
- UVA posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents two times (Wisconsin and Maryland and Virginia Tech and Louisville) for the first time in the regular season since 1982.
- The Cavaliers are 157-329 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.

## ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 poll (Duke, Florida State and Louisville), while Purdue received votes. - The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA defeated First Four NCAA Tournament team Arizona State in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament championship on Nov. 24. - Two opponents (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.


## VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll. - The Cavaliers, who were picked second and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

## 2018-19 IN REVIEW

- Virginia claimed its first NCAA National Championship.
- The Cavaliers had a school-record 35 wins.
- UVA captured a share of its ninth ACC regular-season title.
- The Cavaliers earned their fifth №. 1 seed for the ACC Tournament.
- The Cavaliers advanced to their third NCAA Final Four (1981, 1984, 2019), seventh Elite Eight (first since 2016) and 10th Sweet 16.
- Virginia has 29 or more wins in five of the last six seasons.

- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

-The 6-7, 205 -pound Abdur-Rahim averaged 16.7 points and 8.7 rebounds during his junior season at Blair Academy in 2018-19. Abdur-Rahim was named New Jersey Gatorade Player of the Year after leading Blair Academy to the Prep A state championship.
- Beekman, a 6-2, 165 -pound point guard, averaged 21.9 points, 10.2 rebounds and 10.2 assists as a junior for Scotlandville in 2018-19. He was named first-team all-state from USA Today and the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.
