- The Cavaliers shot 78.6 percent (11-of-14) in the third quarter, making seven-straight shots to close out the period. The team extended the hot shooting into the third when it made the first two attempts. The Cavaliers had struggled in the third period recently, shooting a combined 27.6 percent (21-of-76) in the first 10 minutes after halftime prior in the last five games
- The 78.6 percent shooting efficiency was the Cavaliers best in a quarter since going to the format last season and was just the second time that the team topped 70 percent shooting in a period after going 7-of-9 (77.8 percent) against UIC last season
- Dominique Toussaint scored a game-high 18 points against Maryland. Toussaint has stepped up in big games this season, scoring 17 points at Mississippi State and 18 against Georgia, leading the team in scoring in both of those games
- Lauren Moses took two charges in the first half against Maryland. She has taken five charges in the last three games
- Moses has led the team in rebounding in each of the last three games, averaging 9.0 boards per contest in that span
- The Cavaliers blocked 10 of Maryland's shots while the Terrapins only had two blocks. It was the most blocked shots by the Cavaliers since tallying 10 against Coppin State in the second game of the 2016-17 season. It was also the biggest shot-blocking differential (+8) since that same game
- Felicia Aiyetotan had six of the blocked shots, the third time in her career she had a half dozen in a game. Aiyetotan also scored 10 points (on 5-of-7 shooting) with six rebounds
- Maryland grabbed nine offensive rebounds in the first quarter, but only had five more the rest of the game. The Terrapins had been averaging 17.6 O-boards per game but only had 14 total against the Cavaliers and were limited to four second-chance points, the fewest scored by a UVA opponent this season
- Maryland shot 36.5 percent (23-63). The Cavaliers have held all eight opponents this season to under 40 percent shooting for the game

TEAM NOTES (CONTINUED)

- In Wednesday's game, Maryland led 34-25 at halftime and held a 12-point advantage midway through the third period, but the Cavaliers scored the final six points of the third quarter and the first five points of the fourth to take a 54-51 lead. After neither team scored for a three-minute span late in the fourth quarter, Maryland hit a jumper with 40 seconds remaining to take a 59-58 lead. The Cavaliers had the final possession of the game, trailing by one with 12.4 seconds remaining, but Maryland's defense held on to secure the 60-59 victory.
- The Cavaliers are closing in on the 900th win in program history coming into the game with an 899-446 record in the 45 years of Virginia women's basketball. Virginia will be the 25th team to hit 900 wins in NCAA history
- The Cavaliers played four games in a span of eight days, beginning with the Sunday, Nov. 19 contest at Dayton, followed by a Tuesday, Nov. 21 tilt against Hampton and then back-to-back games on Nov. 25 and 26 in the Cavalier Classic Tournament
- Virginia plays three games in a six-day stretch this week, taking on Maryland on Wednesday, Nov. 29 followed by a Saturday home contest against UNCG and then a road game on Monday, Dec. 4 at Rutgers
- Virginia will play two Big Ten opponents in a span of five days, facing Maryland in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Wednesday, Nov. 29 and Rutgers on Monday, Dec. 2
- The final day of classes for the fall semester is next Tuesday, Dec. 5
- Virginia will break for exams from Dec. 5-16 (12 days off)

COMEBACKS

- Virginia has made big comebacks in each of its last three games. On Wednesday against Maryland, erasing a 12-point second-half deficit to take a 54-51 lead with 7:40 remaining in the game, but Maryland came back to pick up the 60-59 victory
- Duquesne led by 12 points early in the fourth quarter, but the Cavaliers cut it to a four-point deficit, 67-63, in the final 40 seconds of the game after back-to-back threes from Huland El. UVA missed its final two shots of the game, two more three-point attempts from Huland El, while the Dukes made 7 free throws in the final 37 seconds to close out the game
- Virginia trailed by 9 points, 39-30, early in the fourth quarter against Harvard, but came back to win 50-48. Aliyah Huland El hit the game-tying three-pointer with 51 seconds remaining, with a pair of free throws giving UVA the deciding edge
- Earlier this season against Georgia, the Cavaliers trailed by 14 points early in the fourth quarter, but got the deficit down to one point, 62-61, with eight seconds remaining, but couldn't complete the comeback

UNCG SPARTANS

- Virginia is 3-0 all-time against UNCG, but this is the first meeting between the two since 2003. The two schools also met twice in the 1980's (1981-82)
- The Spartans are coming off back-to-back losses to Campbell and Radford. The Spartans opened their season with a 96-35 win over Division II Southern Wesleyan followed by an 82-34 victory over Division III Greensboro College. UNCG is 2-3 against Division I opponents this season
- They will also face Duke on Thursday, Dec. 7
- Sophomore Nadine Soliman leads the team with a 13.9 points per game average. Soliman finished the 2016-17 season as a Second Team All-SoCon selection after starting all 35 games. She averaged 16.2 points per game, ranking fourth in the league and was the nation's leading scorer among all freshman. She added 4.3 rebounds per game and was tied for the team-lead with 50 steals on the season
- The Spartans are picked to finish third in the Southern Conference after advancing to last season's WBI (Women's Basketball Invitational) championship game, the school's first postseason appearance since 2002
