- Virginia is trying to avoid its first 0-4 start to ACC play since dropping its first four conference contests in the 2002-03 season. The Cavaliers finished that year with a 9-7 mark in conference games (ranking third) and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament
- The Cavaliers are coming off a 67-58 loss at North Carolina last Sunday (Jan. 8). UVA trailed 34-28 at halftime, the first time this season the team was down at the break. The game featured eight lead changes and three ties. The Cavaliers took a 58-57 lead on a jumper from freshman Dominique Toussaint with 3:42 remaining, but the Tar Heels closed out the game on a 10-0 run to pick up the victory.
- Junior guard Aliyah Huland El has led the team in scoring in each of the last two games, averaging 18.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per game in that span. In UVA's three ACC games, Huland El is averaging a team-high 14.7 points per game and shooting 57.1 percent (16-of-28)
- Senior guard Breyana Mason is averaging 13.5 points per game in the last two games
- Mason is 5-of-10 from three-point range in the last three games
- Freshman guard Jocelyn Willoughby leads the team in rebounding at 6.3 per game, which ranks second among all ACC freshmen.
- Willoughby has had the team-high rebounds in three of the last four games and is averaging 7.7 rebounds per game in ACC contest
- The UVA first years are leading the team in several statistical categories. In addition to Willoughby leading the team in rebounding, center Felicia Aiyeotan leads the team in blocked shots (28) and field goal shooting percentage (61.4 percent). Guard Dominique Toussaint leads the team in assists (48). When it comes to three-point shooting, however, it is the upper classmen who dominate, with Breyana Mason, Aliyah Huland El and J'Kyra Brown accounting for 60 of the Cavaliers' 82 treys
- Freshman center Felicia Aiyeotan has scored in double-figures in two of the last three games
- It is Princess & Super Hero Day. The first 400 youth eighth-grade and under will receive a free Cavman cape

**INTERVIEW POLICY**

Please give a minimum of 24 hours notice for all interview requests.

**TEAM NOTES**

- The Cavaliers lead the ACC and are ranked ninth in the nation in scoring defense, holding opponents to 53.7 points per game
- Virginia also leads in the ACC in opponent field goal shooting percentage (33.9 percent), ranking 10th in the nation, and opponent three-point shooting percentage (26.0 percent)
- After outrebounding their opponents in seven straight games (Nov. 26-Dec. 28), the Cavaliers have been outrebounded by their opponent in each of the last four games including being -9 against both Syracuse and Louisville
- The Cavaliers have held their opponents to less than 60 points in all 11 victories this season
- The Cavaliers have held the lead at the half in every game this season except at UNC and have led by at least 10 points in all but two games (St. John's and North Carolina)
- The Cavaliers held UMBC to 10 points in the first half, the fewest since limiting Norfolk State to six first-half points in a Cavalier Classic game in 2012. The Cavaliers held UIC to 12 points in the second half of that 76-39 victory
- Virginia held Syracuse to 5 points in the first quarter, with the Orange going 1-of-24 from the field
- Virginia is fifth in the ACC in turnovers forced (19.6 per game) but also commits the second-most per game among conference teams (16.9)
- Virginia and Clemson are the only two teams still winless in league play this season
- Virginia is No. 83 in the latest RPI rankings; Boston College is No. 138

**BOSTON COLLEGE EAGLES**

- Virginia leads the all-time series, 14-5, including an 11-4 mark in regular-season ACC contests
- The Cavaliers have won seven of the last nine meetings between the two teams
- Senior guard Kelly Hughes is third amongst active ACC players in scoring with 1,430 career points
- Hughes comes into the game with 294 career three-pointers, nine shy of becoming just the fifth player in ACC history to make 300. With a career shooting efficiency of 40.5 percent from long range, she also ranks seventh in conference history in that statistic
- Hughes has faced the Cavaliers four times and is averaging 14.0 points per game in those contests, including her freshman season when she scored 23 points, including going 5-of-9 from three, in BC's 69-65 victory at BC on Feb. 6, 2014
- Sophomore center Mariella Fasoula leads the team and is ranked eighth in the ACC, averaging 15.6 points per game. Fasoula is 11th in the conference in rebounding, averaging 7.1 per game
- Last season, UVA picked up a 61-50 victory at BC. Lauren Moses had a double-double with 11 points and a career-high 15 rebounds.
- Virginia entered the final quarter with an 18-point lead (50-32) but the Eagles scored 11 unanswered points to close within 50-43 before Aliyah Huland EI converted a basket with 5:19 remaining to play. A three-point basket by BC's Kelly Hughes cut UVA's lead to six points but the Eagles could never get closer as Mikayla Venson responded with her own long-range jumper to put the Cavaliers ahead 52-43
- Boston College is coming off a 71-67 loss to Georgia Tech on Thursday. In a game of runs, BC rattled off a 12-2 run in the third quarter, outscoring the Yellowjackets 21-13 in the period. The Eagles held Tech to no field goals for the final 5:35. A Hughes layup cut the Yellow Jackets lead to 69-65 with 32 seconds left but Georgia Tech sealed it with four free throws to end the game. Mariella Fasoula scored 22 points to lead the Eagles.

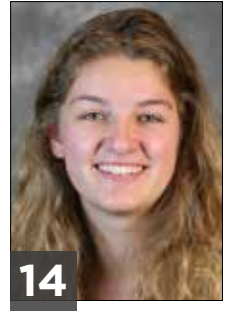
