BOSTON COLLEGE VS. VIRGINIA - ALL-TIME SERIES

- Today's game is the 23rd all-time meeting between the two teams.
- Boston College is 7-15 all-time against Virginia.
- In ACC play, BC is 7-12 against UVA.
- Virginia has won the last six and eight of the last nine matchups.
- Last year, BC dropped an 83-56 decision at home to the eventual national champions on Jan. 9, 2019.

BOSTON COLLEGE IN ACC PLAY

- Boston College is 84-157 in 13 seasons in the ACC.
- The Eagles started 2-0 in ACC play for the first time since 2010-11.
- BC downed Wake Forest, 77-70, in the season and ACC opener.
- On Dec. 7, the Eagles were victorious at Notre Dame, 73-72.
- The Eagles finished with a 5-13 record in ACC play in 2018-19.
- BC's 11th-place finish a year ago was its best finish since 2012-13.
- The Eagles were 7-11 in ACC play in 2017-18.
- BC's best ACC mark came in its inaugural season, going 11-5 in conference play in 2005-06 en route to a third place finish.
- BC also tied for third in 2006-07 (10-6) and finished fourth in 2010-11 (9-7).

NOW TRENDING: JAIRUS HAMILTON

- Jairus Hamilton is averaging 10.7 points over the last six games. BC is 4-2 during that stretch.
- He is also averaging 5.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists over the span.
- Hamilton poured in a career-high 18 points - including the go-ahead 3-pointer - in a comeback win vs. Cal.
- He was named the AI Attles Classic game MVP for his efforts in the win over the Bears in the City by the Bay.
- He was 5-of-10 from the floor (2-4 3FG) to go along with a season-best eight boards in 34 minutes.
- Hamilton missed five games from Nov. 10-23 due to injury. Since returning, he is scoring 10.0 points and 4.6 boards/game.

NOT THROWING AWAY HIS SHOT

- Over his last 11 games, Jared Hamilton has connected on 36-of-74 shots - just under a 50% shooting percentage.
- On Dec. 21 vs. California, he scored 10 of his 12 points in the first half in a 64-60 win at Chase Center.
- He scored a season-high 18 points on Dec. 15 vs. CCSU, making 6-of-9 shots (3-3 3FG).
- At Notre Dame, Hamilton made 6-of-8 shots from the floor (1-1 3FG), scoring a season-high 13 points.
- He has scored in double-digits in five of 14 games and ranks fifth on the team in scoring (8.4 ppg).
- His 41.4% shooting clip (12-29) from beyond the arc leads Boston College this season.
- The elder Hamilton is also averaging 2.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists, and 1.1 steals per game.

TODAY'S BOSTON COLLEGE NOTE(S) YOU CAN'T LIVE WITHOUT

- Boston College is 7-15 all-time when facing the defending NCAA champion.
- The Eagles have posted wins over CCNY (1/11/51), North Carolina (3/20/94; 1/25/06, 3/11/06; 2/20/10), Syracuse (3/11/04), and Connecticut (1/5/05).

ON THIS DATE: JANUARY 7

- Boston College is 12-10 all-time and 0-3 in ACC play in games played on January 7.
- January 7 marks the dual celebration of National Bobblehead Day and National Tempura Day.
- Several historic events occurred on January 7 - 1862: the Battle of Manassas Junction takes place; 1890: William Purvis receives a patent for the fountain pen; 1899: Walter Camp publishes his first All-American college football team; 1927: transatlantic telephone service begins between New York and London; 1927: the Harlem Globetrotters play their first game; 2007: Phil Jackson becomes the fastest to reach 900 wins in NBA history.
- Notable January 7 birthdays: Actors Jeremy Renner and Nicolas Cage; NFL MVP Lamar Jackson; singer Kenny Loggins; local baseball great Tony Conigliaro; and British runner Diane Leather - the first woman to run a sub-5 minute mile.

FELDER SCORES SEASON-BEST 13 POINTS AT DUKE

- CJ Felder scored a season-best 13 points (6-12; 1-2 3FG) at #2 Duke on New Year's Eve.
- He was the lone Eagle in double-digits in the scoring column. It was the second time he scored in double figures this season.
- Felder added six rebounds, two blocks, a steal, and an assist in 27 minutes.

HAMILTONS SHINE VS. CAL AT AL ATTLES CLASSIC

- For close to a seven-minute stretch, Jared and Jaius Hamilton combined to score 15 consecutive points for Boston College.
- This went from the 5:08 mark in the first half - a jumper from Jared - to the 18:22 mark of the second half
- Jaius scored a career-high 18 points, including the go-ahead 3-pointer, en route to earning game MVP honors.
- Jared added 12 points - 10 coming in the first half.

STEFFON MITCHELL HAD QUITE A WEEK

- Steffon Mitchell posted the most complete stat line among all Division I players from Dec. 9-15.
- During that week, he averaged 14.0 points, 12.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 5.5 steals per game in a 2-0 week for the Eagles.
- On Dec. 10 vs. Albany, Mitchell has his second double-double of the season, with 15 points, 13 rebounds to go with five steals.
- Against CCSU, he stuffed the stat sheet again, with 13 points, 12 boards, three assists, and a career-best six steals.
- Mitchell connected on just under 60% shooting from the floor (10-17), including 2-of-4 from the perimeter.
- In the 10 games prior to this past week, Mitchell was 3-of-13 from beyond the arc on the season.

To put this into perspective...since 1996...

- There have been six instances where an ACC player tallied at least 13 points, 12 rebounds, 5 steals and 2 assists in a single-game. Steffon Mitchell had two of those six performances that week alone.
- There have been three Division I players to total 28+ Points, 25+ Rebounds, 5+ Assists & 11+ Steals in a two-game span.

JAY DOT BUCKETS

- Entering the Dec. 10 game vs. Albany, Jay Heath ranked fourth nationally among freshman in 3FG% (21-42; 50.0%)
- Over his last four games, he has cooled off, connecting on 2-of-19 from beyond the arc.
- Earlier this season, Heath knocked down 5-of-7 from deep versus Eastern Washington.
- The last BC freshman to make five 3-pointers in a game: Ky Bowman (5) vs. Notre Dame on Feb. 14, 2017.
- Heath has scored in double figures in 10 of the 13 games in which he has appeared.
- The D.C. native scored 18 points in the season-opening win over Wake Forest.
- He ranks third among all ACC freshmen in scoring (12.0 ppg), 3FG% (.377), 3FG made (23), and is second in steals (19).

STEFFON MITCHELL DOES IT ALL

This season...

- Steffon Mitchell leads BC in rebounding (8.7), steals (2.4), and blocks (0.9) per game, while ranking second in assists (3.2).
- He is the only player nationally to log 8.7 rebounds, 3.2 assists, 2.4 steals, and 0.9 blocked shots per game.
- Mitchell has led the team in rebounding in 11 games, blocks on seven occasions, assists seven times, and steals eight times.
- He has posted three double-doubles this season, including in consecutive games vs. Albany and Central Connecticut.
- He set a new career-high with six steals on Dec. 15 against Central Connecticut.
- Against High Point, Mitchell logged his seventh career double-double, with 10 points and 10 rebounds.
- In the ACC, he leads the league in steals, ranks fourth in rebounding, and is 12th in assist/turnover ratio.

For his career...

- Mitchell has led BC in at least one statistical category (scoring, rebounds, assists, steals, blocks) in 69 of his 75 career games.
- The 6-7 forward is the ACC's active rebounding leader, averaging 8.2 rebounds per game for his 75-game career.
- Last year, he ranked fifth overall in the league (7.9 rpg). As a freshman, he ranked seventh in the conference (8.3 rpg).
- The Shakopee, Minn. native became the first true freshman in Boston College history to average better than 8.0 rpg.
- He has registered 10 or more rebounds in a game on 25 occasions.
- A skilled passer from the post, he is averaging 2.4 assists per game as well as a 2.07:1 assist/turnover ratio in his career.
- The point forward has dished out four or more assists on 21 occasions - including nine games with five or more assists

ALLOW ME TO RE-INTRODUCE MYSELF

- Graduate transfer Derryck Thornton has returned to the ACC to play his final season of eligibility.
- He is Boston College's leading scorer (13.3 ppg) and ranks 18th in the ACC in scoring.
- Thornton also ranks 14th in the ACC in assists, averaging 3.4 assists per contest, and 10th in steals (1.6 spg).
- His top two career scoring performances - 23 vs. Wake Forest and 22 at USF - came in the first two games of the season.
- Overall, three of Thornton's top four and six of his top 10 single-game scoring totals have come in a BC uniform.
- Thornton began his career at Duke in 2015-16, averaging 7.1 points, 1.8 rebounds, and 2.6 assists in 36 games (20 starts).
- The L.A. native played two seasons USC, averaging 6.0 points, 2.2 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and a 1.73:1 ATR in 57 games.
- His assist/turnover (2.22:1) ranked third and his assists average ranked sixth (4.3) in the Pac-12 in 2018-19.

SWISH-RAIN

- On Dec. 21 versus Cal, Julian Rishwain tallied 10 of his 12 points during a key second-half run.
- He connected on 2-of-4 from beyond the arc and 4-of-7 from the floor in the Dec. 21 win in San Francisco.
- His best shooting night of the season came in BC's home game versus DePaul, knocking down 4-of-7 from beyond the arc.
- The 6-5 freshman guard tallied a season-best 15 points vs. the Blue Demons, adding 3-of-4 from the foul line.
- For the season, the freshman guard has connected on 16 3-pointers, shooting just under 35% from the perimeter.

BACKCOURT EFFICIENCY AT NOTRE DAME

- Derryck Thornton and Jay Heath combined for 35 points, five rebounds, five assists, and three steals at Notre Dame.
- Thornton (9-12; 1-1 3FG) and Heath (6-12; 4-6 3FG) combined to shoot 15-24 from the floor, including 5-7 from the perimeter.
- Jared Hamilton (6-8 FG; 1-1 3FG) and Julian Rishwain (2-3; 2-3 3FG) combined to shoot 8-11 from the field (3-4 3FG).

FIRST FOUR, NEXT FIVE, FOUR-GAME WIN STREAK: COMPARE & CONTRAST

- Boston College averaged 21.0 points off turnovers per game through the first four contests of the season. BC was 3-1.
- Over the next five games, that figure dropped to 10.6 points. BC went 1-4 during that stretch.
- During its current four-game win streak, BC is averaging 21.8 points off turnovers.
- The Eagles scored an average of 37.0 points in the paint through the first four games.
- Over the next five, points scored in the painted area dipped to 20.4 per game.
- BC is scoring 25.0 points in the paint over its last four games - all wins.

HEATH ONE OF BC'S TOP FRESHMEN SCORERS

- Jay Heath is one of five BC freshmen since 1999 to have scored 100 points through his first eight games.
- Heath registered an even 100 points through his first eight collegiate contests.
- The others: Troy Bell (168), Craig Smith (152), Wynston Tabbs (119), Olivier Hanlan (101).

JAY HEATH ANNOUNCES PRESENCE WITH AUTHORITY

- Jay Heath scored 18 points, grabbed five rebounds, and logged four assists in his collegiate debut vs. Wake Forest.
- Heath was 7-of-11 from the floor, including 1-of-2 from beyond the arc, and was 3-of-5 from the charity stripe.
- After missing his first two FG attempts, he made 7-of-9 shots over the final 24:00 of play.
- The last BC freshman to tally that stat line in his first collegiate game - Jerome Robinson vs. St. Francis N.Y. on Nov. 14, 2015.
- Robinson - a 2018 lottery pick of the L.A. Clippers - had 19 points, six boards, and five dimes in his college debut.
- The last BC player to have a stat line of 18-5-4 was Ky Bowman - now of the Golden State Warriors.
- Bowman had 23 points, nine boards, and four assists against North Carolina on March 5, 2019.

THE DEFENSIVE HIGH POINT

- Boston College held High Point to the lowest scoring total by an opponent in Jim Christian's tenure - 33 points.
- The point total is the lowest by a BC opponent since holding NJIT to 32 points in Jan. 5, 2010.
- It ties as for the second-lowest points allowed since the 1946-47 season and is the second-lowest of the NCAA shot clock era.
- Among all ACC teams, the 33 points allowed ranks second, behind Virginia - which held Maine to 26 points.

LUCK OF THE EAGLES

- BC snapped several losing streaks on Dec. 7 at Notre Dame.
- The Eagles snapped their four-game slide dating back to the DePaul loss at home on Nov. 23.
- BC ended a 13-game slide vs. ND dating back to Feb. 8, 2005.
- The Eagles had been winless vs. the Irish in ACC play (0-12).
- Additionally, the win at Notre Dame ended a streak of losses at the Joyce Center that dated back to Jan. 11, 1997.

PROPER DEBUT FOR THE BOSTON COLLEGE BACKCOURT

- With a second half FT vs. Eastern Washington, Nik Popovic became the 45th member of Boston College's 1,000 point club.
- He is the fourth BC player in the last three years to score 1,000 points (Jerome Robinson, Ky Bowman, Jordan Chatman).
- Popovic reached the statistical milestone in his 98th career game.
- Standing at 6-11, Nik Popovic joins Jay Murphy '84 as the tallest members of Boston College's 1,000 point club.

AM I MY BROTHER'S KEEPER?

- Boston College is one of 15 Division I men's basketball programs to have a pair of brothers on its roster.
- The Hamiltons - Jared and Jairus - are entering their second season on the same squad.
- Jairus missed five games due to injury and was replaced in the starting lineup by his brother Jared.
- Last year, the Charlotte natives appeared in the starting lineup on two occasions - at Louisville and at Clemson.
- Jared and Jairus are combining to average close to 18.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 2.3 assists per game this season.

BASKETBALL LINEAGE

- Chris Herren Jr. and Kamari Williams are continuing the traditions of basketball excellence in their respective families.
- Herren Jr. is the son of Chris Herren Sr., who was a two-time All-WAC honoree at Fresno State and played two seasons in the NBA with the Denver Nuggets and Boston Celtics.
- He is now one of the nation's foremost public speakers on health, wellness and substance abuse.
- Williams is the son of Walt Williams, an All-American forward at Maryland who played 11 seasons in the NBA after being drafted seventh overall by the Sacramento Kings in 1992.
- Williams played with six different franchises - Sacramento, Houston, Toronto, Portland, Dallas, and Miami.

POINT OUT THE BOUNCE

- During summer vertical leap testing, Jared Hamilton reached the highest height on the Heights.
- The senior reached 35.5 inches on the Vertec machine on his standing test.
- Hamilton touched 44" on his running approach - besting his leap from last summer by two inches.
- Jay Heath and Chris Herren Jr. each touched 29" on their standing vertical attempts.
- Kamari Williams and Jairus Hamilton both measured 34.5" on their approach vertical leaps.
- Vertical jump is calculated by the standing/approach leap number, minus standing reach.

THE DEPARTED

- Three of BC's top four scorers are gone from a season ago. Including Ky Bowman, Jordan Chatman, and Wynston Tabbs.
- Bowman is with the Golden State Warriors, while Chatman is playing professionally in Romania.
- Bowman - who was first nationally in minutes percentage (KenPom.com) at 96.8% - ranked fourth in the ACC in scoring (19.0), 11th in rebounding (7.5), and eighth in assists (4.0). His 37.4% 3FG% ranked eighth in the league.
- Chatman's 13.2 points per game average ranked 25th in the ACC, while his 82% clip from the FT was third-best in the league.
- Tabbs will miss this season with a knee injury. The trio combined to make 154 of BC's 218 3-pointers from a season ago.
- The Eagles return 44% of its scoring, 65% of its rebounding, and 40% of its assists from a season ago.

FORMER ALL-AMERICAN TROY BELL TO HAVE JERSEY RETIRED ON JANUARY 25

- On January 25 game, Boston College Athletics will retire the jersey of former Eagles' All-American Troy Bell.
- A two-time consensus All-American in 2001 and 2003, Bell finished as the program's all-time leading scorer (2,632 points).
- During that span, from 1999-2003, Bell was the top scorer in all of college basketball, at 21.6 points per game.
- The Big East Rookie of the Year in 1999-2000, he is one of only six players to earn Big East Player of the Year honors twice.
- As a sophomore, Bell helped lead BC to a 27-5 overall record and the Big East regular season title.
- He also earned the Dave Gavitt Trophy as the Big East Tournament MVP, leading the Eagles to the 2001 championship.
- Bell still ranks at the top of the BC record book in career 3-pointers (300), FT made (810), and FT% (86.8%).

EAGLES SIGN TWO MASSACHUSETTS NATIVES TO NLI'S - DEMARR LANGFORD JR. AND JUSTIN VANDER BAAN

- DeMarr Langford Jr. and Justin Vander Baan - have signed their National Letters of Intent to continue their academic and athletic endeavors at Boston College.
- Head coach Jim Christian: *"We are excited to announce that DeMarr and Justin have signed their national letters of intent. We welcome them and their families into our Boston College men's basketball family. They are outstanding young men with bright futures on and off the court. BC is a perfect fit for them, especially being Massachusetts natives, and they are perfect fits for our program."*
- Both Langford Jr. and Vander Baan play for the Mass Rivals AAU and head coach Vin Pastore. They are the first two student-athletes to sign with the Eagles from the storied grassroots basketball program.
- Langford Jr. - a 6-5, 195 lb. guard - is a consensus top 100 rated recruit from Brewster Academy.
- Vander Baan - a 7-0, 225 lb. center - is a consensus three-star recruit from Whitinsville Christian.

JIM CHRISTIAN THE CLEMENT AND ELIZABETH IZZI FAMILY HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Jim Christian enters his sixth season on the Heights in 2019-20. Named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Boston College in April, 2014, Christian has helped inspire a turnaround in the Eagles program on and off the court.

This past season, Christian led BC to its highest finish in the ACC standings in six years. The injury-added Eagles were 11th in the league despite having starters miss 40% of the season. Ky Bowman - the nation's most dynamic guard - ranked among the conference leaders in points, rebounds, assists, and 3-point shooting as he earned All-ACC second team honors. Bowman became Christian's second NBA player in as many seasons, as he signed a deal with the Golden State Warriors.

In his six seasons at the helm of BC men's basketball, Jim Christian has recruited and developed five All-ACC honorees, the program's first-ever NBA Lottery Pick, and an Associated Press All-American.

In 2017-18, Christian helped guide BC to a 19-win season - the most victories since the 2010-11 season - and a return to the postseason. The Eagles' season was highlighted by a win over top-ranked Duke in December, a trip to the quarterfinals of the 2018 ACC Championship, and a bid to the National Invitation Tournament.

Under Christian's tutelage, Jerome Robinson became Boston College's fifth All-American and first-ever NBA Lottery Pick. Runner-up for 2017-18 ACC Player of the Year, Robinson was selected 13th overall in the first round by the Los Angeles Clippers. In his 13 seasons as a head coach, Christian has coached five All-Americans and 34 all-conference selections and has guided his teams to the postseason on nine occasions.

Christian and his staff developed one of the top scoring backcourts in the country in 2016-17. The duo of Jerome Robinson (17.4 ppg) and Ky Bowman (17.4) combined to average 34.8 points per game in ACC play which ranked fifth in the country among the major conferences. Robinson finished fourth in the conference in scoring (18.7) and earned All-ACC Honorable Mention accolades. Bowman was named to the All-ACC Freshman Team after averaging 14.3 points per game. He was also the only ACC freshman to rank in the top 10 in seven different categories in league play.

In his first season at Boston College, Christian guided guard Olivier Hanlan to First Team All-ACC and honorable mention All-America honors. Hanlan was the leading scorer in the ACC (19.5) which ranked 22nd in the country. He also led all major conference players in scoring average during league play (21.9). In addition, Hanlan led the ACC in 3-point percentage (.436). He was drafted by the Utah Jazz in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2015 NBA Draft.

Prior to moving to Chestnut Hill, Christian spent two seasons as head coach at Ohio, leading the Bobcats to a 49-22 record in that time. He is the Mid-American Conference's all-time leader in winning percentage (187-80, .700) and reached 20 wins in eight seasons as a head coach in the conference. His .731 winning percentage in league games (101-37) is second-best in MAC history. Christian also spent six seasons at Kent State from 2002-08.

In his first season at Ohio in 2012-13, the Bobcats went 24-10 and earned a bid to the NIT. Ohio captured the MAC regular season title - the school's first since 1994 - and tied the program record with 14 league wins and seven road victories. He was named the NABC District 14 Coach of the Year.

Ohio led the nation in assists per game (17.5) in 2012-13 and ranked seventh in the country in turnover margin (+4.7). Under Christian's guidance, guard D.J. Cooper ranked seventh in the nation in assists and was the first MAC Player of the Year from Ohio since 1995.

In 2013-14, the Bobcats went 25-12 and advanced to the quarterfinals of the College Insider Tournament. It was just the third time in school history that an Ohio team reached 25 wins.

Prior to his time at Ohio, Christian was the head coach at TCU from 2008-12. While in Fort Worth, he led the Horned Frogs to their first postseason appearance since 2005 when they played in the 2012 College Basketball Invitational.

He coached six All-Mountain West players while in Fort Worth, including guard Hank Thorns, Jr. - a first team All-MWC honoree who was the only player in the country to rank in the top 12 in both assists and assist/turnover ratio in 2010-11.

Christian began his head coaching career at Kent State where he compiled a record of 138-58 (.704). He led the Golden Flashes to five postseason appearances in his six seasons at the helm. He earned MAC Coach of the Year accolades in 2006 and 2008, both times leading Kent State to the conference title and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament. The Golden Flashes earned NIT berths in each of his first three seasons.

Kent State won at least 20 games every year with Christian at the helm. He guided the Golden Flashes to the program's first-ever top 25 ranking in both the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today polls. Kent was No. 23 on the Associated Press poll and 24 on the USA Today/Coaches poll, released on Feb. 25, 2008.

The 2007-08 season was one of the best in Kent State history. The Golden Flashes finished 28-7, including a school-record 25 regular season wins. Kent won both the MAC regular season and tournament championships and earned a program-best no. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

While at Kent, Christian mentored two All-Americans (Antonio Gates, DeAndre Haynes), two MAC Players of the Year (DeAndre Haynes, Al Fisher), three MAC Defensive Players of the Year (Demetric Shaw, John Edwards, Haminn Quaintance), one MAC Sixth Man of the Year (Kevin Warzynski) and a total of 19 All-MAC selections, including six first teamers. Gates signed with the San Diego Chargers of the National Football League and has put forth one of the finest careers as a tight end in pro football history.

Christian served as an assistant coach at Kent State in 2001-02, when the program advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight. Prior to Kent, Christian was an assistant at four different programs.

While at Pittsburgh from 1996-99, Christian guided the development of Vonteego Cummings, a two-time All-Big East player who went on to play for the Philadelphia 76ers and Golden State Warriors. During the 1995-96 season, Christian was part of the Miami (Ohio) program that posted a 21-8 overall record - including a 12-6 mark in MAC play - en route to a trip to the NIT.

He served two stints as an assistant at Western Kentucky, including the highly-successful 1994-95 season in which the Hilltoppers went 27-4, including a 17-1 record in the Sun Belt Conference, en route to a conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. The 27 wins were the fourth-most in program history.

Christian's first full-time assistant coaching position came at St. Francis (Pa.) from 1992-94.

From 1999-2001, Christian was a college basketball talent evaluator at Octagon Sports Marketing and Management.

A native of Bethpage, N.Y., Christian was an all-state guard at St. Dominic High School while playing under Ralph Willard. Christian was recruited by Hall of Fame head coach Rick Pitino to Boston University where he played two seasons. Christian played his final two campaigns under Tom Penders at Rhode Island where he helped the Rams reach the Sweet Sixteen in the 1988 NCAA Tournament.

The standout guard led the Rams to victories over Missouri and Syracuse before losing a 73-72 game to Duke for the right to advance to the Elite Eight. After graduation, Christian spent one season playing professionally in Australia for the Sydney City Comets.

Christian earned his bachelor's degree in consumer affairs from the University of Rhode Island in 1988. He and his wife, Patty, have three children, MacKenzie, Zach and Jay.
