## LEADING OFF

- Virginia has been part of every ACC Tournament since its inception in 1973 and will make its 45th overall appearance.
- The Cavaliers own a 51-74 overall record in the ACC postseason and have captured tournament crowns in 1996, 2009 and 2011.
- Under head coach Brian O'Connor, the Cavaliers have a record of 26-20 overall mark in the ACC Tournament.
- NC State and Florida State are two of the three ACC teams Virginia did not play in 2018. The Cavaliers took two out of three against the Seminoles in Tallahassee in 2017 and the Cavaliers haven't squared off against the Wolfpack since 2016.

## SEASON AT A GLANCE

- Pitching has been the backbone of the 2018 club, highlighted by starting pitchers Derek Casey and Daniel Lynch. Back end relievers Andrew Abbott and Bennett Sousa have combined for 11 saves and eight total wins.
- As a staff, the Cavaliers rank second in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (10.5). Casey (97) and Lynch (98) are both closing in on a hundred strikeouts and would be the first Virginia duo to accomplish the feat since Danny Hultzen and Tyler Wilson in 2011.
- Six pitchers combined for a bizarre, 11-inning no-hitter in a 4-3 win against William & Mary on Feb. 28. The Cavaliers committed four errors and were down 3-2 with two outs in the bottom of the 11th. The Tribe made a throwing error that allowed two runs to score and Virginia to walk-off with the program's 6th no-hitter
- A total of 37 percent of Virginia's games have been decided by one run, the third highest percentage of any team in the country. The Cavaliers played six-straight one-run games from April 20-29, including three one-run losses at home to Clemson. Virginia is 10-9 in one-run games in 2018.
- In a knack for exciting baseball, Virginia has staged 12 come-from-behind wins in 2018, including six in walk-off fashion. Of the 12 total weekend series 10 were decided by the final game.
- The Cavaliers have been victims of the injury bug with All-American outfielder Jake McCarthy missing 37 games and 2017 All-ACC performer Cameron Simmons out for the year. Starting pitchers Noah Murdock, an ACC All-Freshman selection a year ago, and Sunday starter Evan Sperling have missed significant portions of the season. Senior catcher Caleb Knight, a Johnny Bench Award nominee, has missed 12 games and primarily seen action as a designated hitter since late March.

## ON THE OFFENSIVE

- In the final ACC series of the season, Virginia had its best offensive stretch of the year, scoring 30 runs and accumulating 41 hits in three games at Wake Forest. As a team, the Cavaliers batted .345 and hit 11 doubles and six home runs.
- In Friday's middle game, Virginia scored nine runs in the ninth inning en route to a season-high 15 runs. On Saturday, the Cavaliers out-hit the Demon Deacons 17-16 despite a 18-12 loss.

• Virginia went deep four times in Friday night's contest, the first time since 2014 when Robbie Coman, Joe McCarthy, Derek Fisher and Mike Papi all went yard against Richmond.

• Junior Jack Weiller homered twice in the nine-run ninth inning on Friday. He went on to homer in three-straight at bats after a pinch-hit, three-run shot in the series finale. His bid for four-straight homers fell short when he hit the right field wall in which he settled for a double. He became the third player in NCAA Division I Baseball this season to homer in the same inning.

• Of the 297 NCAA Division I teams, Virginia has the sixth-fewest strikeouts in the country with 297. Seven of the 12 ACC teams have struck out 400 or more times.

### ON THE MOUND

• Virginia comes into the weekend averaging 10.5 strikeouts per nine innings, the second highest total in the country.

• Three of the team's seven shutouts have come in ACC play. The staff's seven shutouts are tied for the fourth most in the country. Only 11 teams in the nation have seven or more shutouts in 2018.

• Thursday's starter Derek Casey has produced a team-best eight quality starts and has pitched into the seventh inning in eight of his last 10 starts.

• Daniel Lynch is two strikeouts shy of reaching 100 for the season. His 98 Ks are the seventh most in the league. Teammate Derek Casey's 97 strikeouts are the eighth most in the league.

• The last Virginia pitcher to record 100 strikeouts in a season was Connor Jones in 2015 with 113. The Cavaliers haven't had a pitching duo each strike out 100 batters each since Danny Hultzen (165) and Tyler Wilson (124) in 2011.

• As a pitching staff, Virginia owns a 2.73 strikeout to walk ratio, the second best in the ACC to Georgia Tech and 21st best in the country.

• The relief combination of Bennett Sousa and Andrew Abbott have combined for eight wins and 11 saves. Seven of the 11 saves have been multi-inning saves.

• Virginia starting pitchers have produced 19 quality starts (6 IP, 3 ER or less) this season, 13 have occurred in the 27 ACC games this season.

### PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

• Senior Justin Novak comes into the tournament as the team's hottest hitter over the past 10 games, batting .400 (12-for-30). He has four multi-hit performances in his last seven games, including two at Wake Forest over the Weekend.

• Junior Andy Weber, the team's lone First Team All-ACC selection, goes into the postseason with the league's fifth best batting average (.342). He ranks in the top-10 in the league in doubles (18-2nd) and RBI (48-10th). He's homered in back-to-back games coming into the tournament and has only been hitless in eight games this season.

• After missing the previous 37 games due to injury, junior Jake McCarthy returned to the lineup against Georgia Tech on May 14. In five games he's 9-for-22 (.409), with 3 runs and 6 RBI. He matched career-high with four hits in the season finale, exactly one year to the date of his last four-hit game. Despite missing significant time, he leads the team with eight stolen bases.

## DOWN BUT NEVER OUT

- The 2-1 series-clinching win over Louisville on 4/22 was the 12th come-from-behind win of 2018 for the Cavaliers.
- The late inning rally was the second time Virginia has mounted a comeback in the eighth inning or later to clinch a series. The Cavaliers scored four runs over its final two turns at the plate to defeat rival Virginia Tech on April 8 and scored two in the ninth to defeat Louisville the ensuing Sunday.
- Brendan Rivoli has been in the thick of three, late game rallies. He tied the game against Virginia Tech with a triple in the bottom of the ninth of an eventual 6-5 walk-off win, delivered a walk-off double down the right field line to top George Washington in the 12th inning on April 17 and put Virginia ahead 2-1 with a run-scoring single in the top of the ninth against Louisville.

## HOF COMPANY

- Daniel Lynch struck out 10 or more batters in four-straight starts from 3/17-4/6, including a career-best 12-strikeout performance at Pitt on March 31. The only other pitcher in Virginia history to go four-straight games with 10+ strikeouts is UVA baseball Hall of Famer, Danny Hultzen. He struck out 10 or more in his first five starts of the 2011 season.

Derek Casey struck out a career-high 12 batters in back-to-back starts, the first Cavalier pitcher to record 12 or more strikeouts in consecutive starts since UVA Baseball Hall of Famer Danny Hultzen in 2011.

- Casey went on to strike out 10 or more in three-straight starts, also a feat accomplished by Hultzen in 2011.

- Hultzen went on to become the second overall pick in the 2011 draft of the Seattle Mariners and was inducted into the Inaugural UVA Baseball Hall of Fame this past January.

## ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Derek Casey was named the ACC co-Pitcher of the Week on Monday (April 9) after tossing a complete game shutout against Virginia Tech last Friday (April 6.) He is the first Cavalier to be recognized by the league this season and the first Virginia pitcher to take home the award since Connor Jones did it twice in 2016.

- Casey did not walk a batter and only one Hokie baserunner reached second base. The right-hander fanned seven, upping his season total to 70.

- The nine-inning shutout was the first by a Virginia pitcher since Jones blanked Boston College on April 8, 2016.

## SEASON STREAKS

- Nate Eikhoff had his hit streak of 16 games snapped on 3/24 at Miami. He is one of nine players since 2001 to have put together hit streaks of 16 or more. Eikhoff reached base in his first 21 games of the season

- Shortly after earning the starting CF job, Cayman Richardson strung together a hit streak of 15-straight games. He batted .390 in that span.

- Andy Weber continued a hit streak of four games started in 2017 and ran it all the way to 12 by hitting safely in his first eight games of 2018. Weber topped that by hitting safely 13-straight games from March 10-31.

- Weber had his 32-game reached base streak come to an end on May 12 against Georgia Tech. It was the longest streak by a Cavalier this season and the longest since Adam Haseley finished the 2017 season by reaching safely in 40-straight games.

• He recorded his first collegiate hit, a single through the left side in a midweek game against Longwood on March 27.

• His comeback culminated in the final series of the 2018 season by hitting home runs in three-straight at bats including two in the same inning of the middle game against Wake Forest. He finished the weekend 4-for-5 with four runs scored, three home runs a double and 7 RBI.

## THREE RUNS, NO HITS, 12 INNINGS, WHAT?

• Six pitchers, Bobby Nicholson, Blake Rohm, Grant Donahue, Riley Wilson, Mack Meyer and Bennett Sousa combined to pitch the sixth no-hitter in program history on Feb. 28, 2018.

• Sousa was credited with the win after pitching the final 2.2 innings

• William & Mary scored three runs despite not recording a hit, one on a ground out in the top of the sixth and the game-tying run in the seventh. The Tribe took the lead after benefiting from three 11th inning Virginia errors.

• After scoring 35 runs in its two previous games, the Virginia offense was limited to eight hits and did not record an RBI in the contest.

## NO-HIT FACTS

• The no-hitter was the seventh this season in college baseball.

• Four of the six no-hitters in Virginia history have come in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present).

• The combined no-hitter is the first in Virginia history.

• 11 innings matched the longest no-hitter in NCAA Division I baseball since 2002, the other occurred on Feb. 28, 2015 when Lehigh blanked Iona, 2-0.

• Of the 294 MLB no-hitters, an opponent has never scored more than two runs.

## THE DISH

• The University of Virginia department of athletics and the Virginia Athletics Foundation announced on Feb. 20 that a generous commitment was made by an anonymous donor to rename the Virginia baseball stadium Davenport Field at Disharoon Park

• The name change was formally approved by the University of Virginia Board of Visitors on March 2, 2018.

• The stadium's namesake is to honor Leslie B. Disharoon and Ann Merriwether Disharoon, long time supporters of the Virginia baseball program.

## VIRGINIA BASEBALL TURNS 130

• Virginia will commence its 130th season of baseball in 2018.

• Going into the season, the program has accumulated 2,297 wins and owns an all-time winning percentage of .570.

## MCCARTHY PRESEASON ACCOLADES

• Junior Jake McCarthy is a unanimous preseason All-American and garnered first team honors from D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA. He was recognized by Baseball America, *Collegiate Baseball*, and Perfect Game as a second team honoree.

• In addition to All-America honors, Baseball America tabbed McCarthy as the "fastest runner" on its list of players across the country with the best tools.

• McCarthy was listed on the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list. He is one of eight ACC players on the initial 55-player list. Last year, Virginia's Adam Haseley was a finalist for the award annually bestowed on the nation's top amateur baseball

• Current LSU head coach Paul Mainieri, will serve as the manager for Team USA this summer.

• While working together, the Irish posted an overall record of 399-160-1, won six conference championships and made six trips to the NCAA Tournament.

• O'Connor's college coach at Creighton, Jim Hendry, will also be on staff as the bench coach. Hendry now works for the New York Yankees as a special assignment scout.

## **VIRGINIA INJURY UPDATES**

---

- It was announced shortly before the start of the 2018 season that outfielder Cameron Simmons will miss the year due to a left shoulder injury.
- A second team All-ACC selection as a sophomore, Simmons started all but three games for the Cavaliers in 2017. He was second on the team and fourth in the ACC with a .352 batting average. In conference play, he hit .374, tops on the team and the third highest average in the league.
- Junior preseason All-American Jake McCarthy was sidelined after sustaining a left wrist injury on March 6 vs. Davidson. He returned on May 14 against Georgia Tech after missing 37 games.
- Sophomore Evan Sperling was sidelined prior to the Miami series (March 23-25) with a forearm injury and made his first appearance in relief on May 15 against Richmond, working one inning. Prior to being sidelined, opponents had been hitting .152 off him in five starts.

## **MCMULLAN TABBED AS NATION'S TOP ASSISTANT**

---

- In a survey by Baseball America of more than 100 college coaches nationwide, assistant coach Kevin McMullan was named the country's top assistant coach.
- McMullan has garnered the No. 1 ranking in back-to-back years and was the 2009 Assistant Coach of the Year.
- Brian O'Connor was on the same list when he was an assistant at Notre Dame.

## **BACK-TO-BACK TOP-10 PICKS**

---

- In the 2017 MLB Draft, Virginia had six players selected, including two in the top-10 of the first round.
- Juniors Pavin Smith (Diamondbacks) and Adam Haseley (Phillies) went back-to-back, after being selected seventh and eighth overall, respectively.
- Smith and Haseley were the first set of position players from the same college to be selected in the top 10 of an MLB Draft since Oklahoma State's Monty Fariss and Robin Ventura in 1988.
- UVA is one of just two college programs to boast a first-round draft pick in each of the last four seasons.

## **HOOS IN THE WORLD SERIES**
