#### **FOR OPENERS**

- Virginia meets VCU for the 15th time in series history.
- UVA has started 8-0 for the second straight season and is 122-35 (.777) in non-conference action, including a 69-6 mark in non-league play at John Paul Jones Arena, under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett is four wins shy of 300 career wins.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. VCU**

- UVA sports a 12-2 all-time mark against VCU in a series that dates back to 1976-77.
- The Cavaliers are 5-1 vs. the Rams in Charlottesville, including a 59-56 loss in the last meeting at JPJ in 2013.
- UVA has a two-game winning streak against VCU and has won six of the last seven meetings.
- UVA head coach Tony Bennett is 2-1 all-time vs. the Rams.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE OPPONENTS**

- Virginia meets its third Atlantic 10 opponent of the season, defeating George Washington (76-57) and Dayton (66-59).
- The Cavaliers are 122-80 all-time against current Atlantic 10 members (13-4 vs. Davidson, 3-0 vs. Dayton, 0-3 vs. Fordham, 8-1 vs. George Mason, 27-24 vs. George Washington, 1-2 vs. LaSalle, 2-0 vs. UMass, 2-1 vs. Rhode Island, 52-36 vs. Richmond, 2-6 vs. Saint Joseph's, 0-1 vs. Saint Louis and 12-2 vs. VCU).
- Tony Bennett is 12-3 all-time vs. Atlantic 10 opponents at UVA.

#### **LAST TIME VS. THE RAMS**

- Kyle Guy scored a career-high 29 points to lift Virginia to a 76-67 win at VCU on Friday, Nov. 17.
- Guy drilled 11 of 20 shots, including five 3-pointers, and added a career-high four steals in UVA's second straight win against VCU.
- Ty Jerome added 13 points and seven assists.
- Isaac Vann led three VCU players in double figures with 19 points.
- UVA shot 50.8 percent (31-of-61) from the floor and 43.5 percent (10-23) from 3-point range.
   Isaiah Wilkins chipped in eight points, eight rebounds, two assists,
- one steal and took three charges.

  The Cavaliars committed a season low five turnovers and had 18
- The Cavaliers committed a season-low five turnovers and had 18 fast break points.
- UVA added 16 points off 12 VCU turnovers.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter each scored 15 points to lead No. 4 Virginia to an 83-45 win over Morgan State Dec. 3.
- $\bullet$  UVA started the game 7 of 7, including 4 of 4 from 3-point range.
- Ty Jerome added a career-high five steals and Braxton Key matched a season high with nine rebounds.
- UVA shot a season-high 65.2 percent (15 of 23) from the field in the first half and shot a season-high 91.3 percent (21 of 23) from the free throw line.
- UVA held Morgan State to 25.9 percent shooting, marking a season low for the Cavaliers.
- All 13 Cavaliers who played scored in the game.

#### **UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA**

- UVA plays its first of four games against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia (VCU, William & Mary & Virginia Tech).
- UVA has a 65-15 record against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 18 of its last 21 games against teams from Virginia.
- The Cavaliers went 3-1 vs. the Commonwealth last year.

#### **UVA RANKED NO. 4 IN AP POLL**

- Virginia is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll for the fourth straight week.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons.
- In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 21 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 16 polls.

#### **THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 170-41 (.804), including a 4-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 16-1 at JPJ last season and is 132-25 (.841), including a 97-10 (.906) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 49-5 (.907) in league home games over the past six seasons. Duke is second at 48-6 (.889).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.
- UVA has a 14-game nonconference home winning streak
- UVA is 69-6 at home in non-conference action under Bennett.

#### **VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 227-86 (.725) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 296-119 (.713) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 121-35 (.776) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 131-25 (.840) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

#### **UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS**

• As of Dec. 5, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (51.5 ppg), turnovers per game (7.9) and winning percentage (100%), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.02), fourth in fewest turnovers (63), sixth in turnover margin (7.1) and scoring margin (23.3), 10th in personal fouls per game (14.6) and 22nd in 3-point percentage (40.2%).

#### **HUNTER, JEROME AND GUY AMONG ACC LEADERS**

- As of Dec. 6, De'Andre Hunter ranks second in the ACC in field goal percentage (60.2%), 10th in scoring (16.4) and 23rd in rebounding (5.5).
- Ty Jerome ranks first in steals (2.3), third in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3), seventh in 3-pointers (2.4) and eighth in assists (4.1) and 3-point percentage (45.2%).
- Kyle Guy ranks fifth in 3-pointers (2.6) and 12th in minutes (32.8).
- Braxton Key ranks 10th in steals (1.8).

#### **GETTING DEFENSIVE**

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 51.5 ppg.
- The Cavaliers have limited four opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Morgan State, Towson, Wisconsin).
- UVA has held five opponents to 40 percent or less shooting.
- UVA has out-rebounded six of its eight opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.

#### **HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- Virginia is led by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Hunter leads UVA in scoring (16.4) and rebounding (5.5).
- Jerome is averaging 13.6 points and team-high 4.1 assists.
- Guy is averaging 13.3 points, while Salt anchors UVA's stingy defense.
- Transfer Braxton Key has averaged 6.4 points and 5.3 rebounds,

while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 5.9 points and 2.1 rebounds.

- Newcomer Kihei Clark, who has started the past three games, is averaging 5.4 points and 2.6 rebounds.
- Marco Anthony, Jay Huff and Kody Stattmann provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Redshirt freshman Francesco Badocchi returned to the team last week after taking a leave of absence due to medical issues.
- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in four home games.

#### **TYING US TOGETHER**

- Point guard Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 13.6 points, 4.1 assists and 3.1 rebounds.
- Jerome has reached double figures in six games, including back-to-back 20-point efforts to start the season.
- Jerome is shooting a career-best 45.2 percent from 3-point range.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylven Landesberg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Ty Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
   In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.

#### THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Kyle Guy leads the team with 21 3-pointers and is third on the team in scoring (13.3 ppg), highlighted by his seventh career 20-point effort vs. George Washington.
- Guy has shot 42.6 percent from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in eight games.
- Guy's 42.6 3-point percentage ranks first on UVA's career list, edging Keith Freel's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in seven career games (4 in 2017-18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.

#### DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has reached double figures in every game, averaging a team-leading 16.4 points and 5.5 rebounds.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the tour anneal.
- Hunter has three 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton and Wisconsin), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 58.7 percent from the floor, 44.4 percent from 3-point range and 76.9 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including a career-high 23 against Monmouth and ACC-high 22 against Miami.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

#### **HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia has held four opponents (4-0) to fewer than 50 points and is 80-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 104-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 22-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

#### THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s & DIVINE 90s

- Virginia has scored over 70 points in six games and is 113-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 114-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 97 points against Coppin State and is 3-0 when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.
- UVA is 28-1 when scoring 80 or more points under Bennett with its lone loss a 93-81 decision at North Carolina in 2012-13.
- UVA was the first ACC team to win seven straight conference games (Jan. 6-27, 2018) while scoring fewer than 70 points in any game.

#### THREE CAVALIERS EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- Kyle Guy joined preseason ACC Player of the Year Luke Maye (North Carolina), RJ Barrett (Duke), Tyus Battle (Syracuse) and Ky Bowman on the All-ACC first team.
- De'Andre Hunter and Ty Jerome were joined on the second team by Zion Williamson (Duke), Justin Robinson (Virginia Tech) and Marcquise Reed (Clemson).

#### **WATCH ME NOW**

- Ty Jerome (Bob Cousy Award), Kyle Guy (Jerry West Award) and De'Andre Hunter (Julius Erving Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award watch lists.
- Guy and Hunter are among 50 players to watch for the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year honor and 20 players for the NABA Division I Player of the Year award.

#### **CAVALIERS IN THE NBA**

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Los Angeles) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17. is in his third season with the Bucks.
- Scott is in his seventh season and Harris is in his fifth NBA season (third with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his fourth season.
- Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

#### **RECORDS WATCH**

- Kyle Guy ranks first on UVA's career 3-point percentage at 42.6 percent, while Ty Jerome is fifth at 39.6 percent.
- Guy has drilled 155 of 364 career 3-point attempts and needs seven 3's to pass Devin Smith (161 3's) for 10th on UVA's all-time list.
- Ty Jerome reached 100 career 3-pointers with a pair against Dayton.

#### **VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by UVA, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pitt.

#### **WORLD WIDE CAVALIERS**

- Virginia and Maine lead the nation with current players from five different continents. In addition to North America, UVA is represented by Africa (Mamadi Diakite), Europe (Francesco Badocchi), South America (Francisco Caffaro) and Australia (Kody Stattmann).
- New Zealander Jack Salt gives the Cavaliers five foreign players.

#### **UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- UVA is 33-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 2-0 mark in 2018-19 and 5-1 record in 2017-18.
- UVA' posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents (Wisconsin and Maryland) for the first in the regular season since 1982 (Georgetown and Houston).
- The Cavaliers are 148-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA's win over then-No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27 marked the Cavaliers first road win vs. a top-5 ranked foe since 1993 (77-69 over No. 3 Duke).
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

#### 50-40-75 CLUB

- Virginia is 32-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 75 percent from the free throw line in the same game under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA is 1-0 this season after achieving the mark against Coppin State and was 5-0 last season when achieving the 50-40-75 mark (Austin Peay, VCU, Rhode Island, Davidson, NC State and Louisville).

#### **UVA INKS MORSELL AND SHEDRICK**

- Guard Casey Morsell (Fort Washington, Md./St. John's College High School) and forward Kadin Shedrick (Raleigh, N.C./Holly Springs High School) signed NLI's with the Cavaliers.
- The 6-3, 190-pound Morsell averaged 14 points and 4.3 rebounds for St. John's College High School (Washington, D.C.) in 2017-18.
- The 6-11, 200-pound Shedrick averaged 16.2 points and 9.8 for Holly Springs in 2017-18.

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.
