FOR OPENERS

- UVA meets JMU for the first time since opening the 2014-15 season with a 79-51 win in Harrisonburg.
- The Cavaliers have won 22 straight home-opening games.
- UVA is 21-3 in its last 24 games against teams from Virginia.
- UVA is 73-6 at home in nonconference action under Tony Bennett.

HOME OPENERS

- The Cavaliers have won 22 straight home-opening contests and are 10-0 in home openers under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia's last home-opening loss was against then-No. 12 Clemson, 62-52, on Dec. 7, 1996.

ALL-TIME VS. JMU

- UVA is 10-0 all-time against JMU in the series that dates back to the 1977-78 season.
- The Cavaliers are 6-0 against the Dukes in Charlottesville, including a 61-41 win at JPJ in 2013.
- Virginia head coach Tony Bennett is 2-0 all-time against JMU, including a 79-51 win over the Dukes to tip-off the 2014-15 season in Harrisonburg.

LAST TIME VS. THE DUKES

- Justin Anderson tallied a game-high 18 points to lead then-No. 9/8 Virginia to a 79-51 win at James Madison on Nov. 14, 2014.
- Anthony Gill added 15 points and Malcolm Brogdon had 14 points and a team-high four assists in the win.
- Devon Hall recorded five steals and Isaiah Wilkins had eight points, five rebounds, two steals and two blocks in their collegiate debuts.
- Virginia shot 58 percent from the floor, including a 69.2 percent (18-26) clip in the first half.
- The Cavaliers outscored the Dukes 36-8 in the paint and held a 38-27 edge in rebounds.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 1-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points in 2019-20.
- The Cavaliers are 88-2, including an 11-0 mark in 2018-19, when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 113-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA limited Syracuse to 34 points on Nov. 6 and is 24-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 181-42 (.812), including a 15-1 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last season and is 143-26 (.846), including a 108-11 (.908) mark the past seven seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 57-6 (.905) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 55-8 (.873).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.
- UVA has a 17-game nonconference home winning streak.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kihei Clark tallied 10 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists as No. 11 Virginia opened its season with a 48-34 road win at Syracuse on Nov 6
- UVA won its seventh straight season-opening game and 12th straight ACC opener (11-0 in ACC openers under Bennett).
- Jay Huff added 11 points and a career-high 12 rebounds for his first career double-double and Braxton Key added 10 rebounds as UVA had three players with 10 or more rebounds for the first time since
- Mamadi Diakite chipped in 12 points and six rebounds.
- UVA held its 24th opponent to fewer than 40 points in the Bennett era and are 24-0 in those contests.
- UVA out-rebounded Syracuse 47-28, but committed 16 turnovers.
- UVA shot 40.8 percent from the field and limited the Orange to 23.6 percent.

UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- UVA is 68-15 against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 21 of its last 24 games against teams from Virginia.
- UVA finished 4-0 against teams from the Commonwealth in 2018-19, posting wins against VCU (57-49), William & Mary (72-40) and Virginia Tech (81-59 & 64-58).

UVA RANKED NO. 11/9 IN PRESEASON RANKINGS

- Virginia is ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press preseason poll and No. 9 in the USA Today Coaches' preseason poll, respectively.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in seven of the past eight seasons.
- Dating back to 2017-18, UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 36 straight weeks and had been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 31 polls.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 255-89 (.741) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 324-122 (.726) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett has guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 133-36 (.787) in non-conference action, 122-53 (.697) in ACC play and 143-26 (.846) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .697, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff headline Virginia's top returnees from last season's NCAA championship and ACC regular-season title team.
- Diakite started 22 games and is UVA's top returning scorer at 7.4 points per game. Diakite averaged 10.5 points, 8.2 rebounds & 2.7 blocked shots in the 2019 NCAA Tournament.
- Clark started 22 games and averaged 4.5 points and 2.6 assists during his freshman campaign.
- Key is UVA's top returning rebounder (5.3 per game), while Huff (4.4 ppg, 2.1 rpg) showed promise during limited action in 2018-19.
- Kody Stattmann and newcomers Casey Morsell and Tomas Woldetensae will take the minutes left by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Stattmann averaged 4.1 minutes in 18 games as a freshman, while Morsell tallied 17 points per game as a high school senior and Woldetensae averaged 17.3 points at Indian Hills Community College.
- Freshman Justin McKoy provides frontcourt depth, while freshman walk-on Chase Coleman could earn minutes in the backcourt.
- Redshirt freshman Francisco Caffaro is out with a leg injury.
- Recruited walk-ons Austin Katstra and Javden Nixon provide depth.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is expected to redshirt this season, while
 Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA limited Syracuse to 34 points in its season-opener on Nov. 6, marking its fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points allowed tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA also limited the Orange to 23.6 percent field goal shooting (13-55), its lowest for an opponent since holding Grambling to 23.1 percent shooting (12-52) on Nov. 22, 2016.
- UVA captured its fifth NCAA scoring defense title in 2018-19, limiting opponents to 56.1 points per game.
- The Cavaliers have limited one opponent (Syracuse) to fewer than

50 points, 40 percent or less field goal shooting and 33 percent or less 3-point shooting.

- The Cavaliers forced one shot clock violation at Syacuse.
- UVA out-rebounded Syacuse 47-28.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked second and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE

- Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Louisville, North Carolina and Purdue), while four (Florida State, Notre Dame, Syracuse and NC State) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA will meet First Four NCAA Tournament teams Arizona State or St. John's in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 24.
- Two opponents (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.

DIAKITE EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- Mamadi Diakite was named the preseason All-ACC first team.
- Diakite was joined on the All-ACC first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Jordan Nwora (Louisville), Tre Jones (Duke), Cole Anthony (North Carolina) and John Mooney (Notre Dame).

WATCH ME NOW

- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Mamadi Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List.

2018-19 IN REVIEW

- Virginia claimed its first NCAA National Championship.
- The Cavaliers had a school-record 35 wins.
- UVA captured a share of its ninth ACC regular-season title.
- The Cavaliers earned their fifth No. 1 seed for the ACC Tournament.
- The Cavaliers advanced to their third NCAA Final Four (1981, 1984, 2019), seventh Elite Eight (first since 2016) and 10th Sweet 16.
- Virginia has 29 or more wins in five of the last six seasons.
- UVA is 64-6 in past two seasons (31-3 & 35-3) becoming second ACC program with no more than three losses in consecutive seasons (NC State 73-74).
- UVA won 25 or more games for the ninth time with five of the nine under 10th year head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA won 23 or more games for a school-best seventh straight year. • UVA won 16 or more ACC games for the fourth time (2014, 2015,
- 2018, 2019).
 The Cavaliers have won 11 or more ACC games for a school-record
- seven consecutive seasons.
- UVA has won 15 or more home games in six of the last seven years.
- UVA has captured an ACC-record five ranked road wins, tied for most all-time with UConn (1998-99).
- UVA set a school record with 11 wins vs. ranked opponents.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 42-34 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including an 11-3 mark in 2018-19.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins are a school record.
- The Cavaliers posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time in poll history since 1948-49.
