The Virginia women's basketball team (11-3, 1-0 ACC) hosts Wake Forest (9-6, 0-1 ACC) on Thursday, Jan, 8 at 7 p.m. at John Paul Jones Arena.

Virginia is looking to start conference play with a 2-0 mark for the first time since the 2007-08 season when the squad also defeated Wake and Virginia Tech in its first two ACC games.

Virginia has won six of its last seven contests including a 62-47 victory over Virginia Tech in the ACC-opener on Sunday. During that seven-game stretch, the Cavaliers are outscoring opponents by an average of 17.9 points per game. In that same span, Virginia has been making 44.8 percent of its shots while limiting opponents to 35.6 percent shooting. The Cavaliers also are +4.7 in turnover margin and outrebounding teams by 4.0 per game.

Senior center Sarah Imovbioh (Abuja, Nigeria) had 11 boards in Sunday's victory, the eighth time this season she has pulled in double-digits rebounds. Imovbioh currently leads the nation in offensive rebounds per game, averaging 6.0 per game. Imovbioh continues to lead the ACC in rebounding, averaging 11.7 per game, ranking ninth nationally in that stat.

Sophomore guard Breyana Mason (Woodbridge, Va.) led the team with 16 points against the Hokies, the first time in Mason's career that she paced the squad in scoring. In the three games since coming back from the holidays, Mason is 11 of 21 (52.3 percent) shooting, including going 3-of-6 from three-point range), with six assists.

Freshman guard Mikavla Venson (Arlington, Va.) scored 13 points against the Hokies, the eighth time in the last nine games that she contributed double-digit points. After going 0-of-4 from three point range against Davidson, Venson combined to go 6-of-13 from three-point range against Drexel and Virginia Tech.

HOOS HOT

• Sarah Imovbioh scored 40 points with 28 rebounds in the Cavalier Classic.

• After an O-for-8 shooting performance in the first game of the Cavalier Classic, Mikayla Venson rebounded by scoring 16 points against Drexel, her second-highest scoring game of the year, while grabbing a season-high seven rebounds. She added 13 points on Sunday against Virginia Tech

• Breyana Mason was 3-of-4 shooting, scoring 11 points with four rebounds, three assists with two blocked shots against Drexel. She was 6-of-10, including 2-of-4 from three, scoring 16 points at Virginia Tech

• Aliyah Huland El had one of her best shooting games of the year at Virginia Tech, going 4-of-9 and 2-of-4 from three-point range, finishing with 10 points (her third double-digit scoring effort of the year)

• Sarah Beth Barnette scored 11 points in the Cavalier Classic, going 4-of-5 from the field, grabbing four rebounds with two assists

• Faith Randolph scored nine points (with five rebounds, four assists and two steals) against Virginia Tech, which snapped a streak of 13-straight games scoring in double-digits.

SCOUTING WAKE FOREST

• Wake Forest dropped its ACC opener to Duke, 70-63

• Wake Forest started the game on fire, opening up a 10-0 run through the first four and a half minutes of play. Wake Forest controlled the paint early, scoring eight of the first 10 points down low.

• Duke went on a 12-2 run in the first half and started the second half with another 12-1 run.

• Duke led by as many as 15 in the second half, 53-38, with 12:44 remaining.

• Dearica Hamby ranks third in the ACC in scoring, averaging 20.3 points per game. Hamby is also third in rebounding at 10.4 per game.

• Wake has a -1.0 turnover margin. Virginia's is +4.1

• Wake Forest head coach Jen Hoover spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Virginia (2004-07) under Debbie Ryan and also spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Cal, working on Joanne Boyle's staff from 2009-11.

CAVALIERS VS WAKE FOREST

• Virginia is 64-5 all-time against Wake Forest, including holding a 29-3 home record and a 56-4 advantage in ACC contests

• In their last trip to John Paul Jones Arena in 2013, the Deacons earned a 73-68 victory, the first time the team had won in Charlottesville since 1978

• Virginia held off a late Deacon rally last season to garner a 64-59 victory in Winston-Salem

• The Demon Deacons whittled a 17-point deficit down to one point, 58-57, on a three-pointer from Dearica Hamby with 29 seconds remaining, but strong defense and six-made free throws by the Cavaliers in the final 23 seconds of the game secured the Virginia victory.

• Virginia returns home next Thursday, Jan. 15, hosting Boston College at 7 p.m.

ACC LEADERS

• Sarah Imovbioh leads the ACC in rebounding (11.7 per game) and in offensive rebounds per game (6.0)

• Imovbioh leads the nation in offensive rebounds per game and is ninth in total rebounds per game

• Imovbioh is second in the ACC in field goal percentage (64.7) and fifth in the nation. Imovbioh finished her freshman season as the ACC leader in field goal shooting percentage.

• Imovbioh is 11th in the ACC points per game (15.5)

• Imovbioh's 24 rebounds against Ohio State is still the highest single-game total by an ACC player this season

• Faith Randolph ranks fifth in ACC in points per game (17.4)

• Randolph is third in free throw percentage (88.9) and fourth in three-point percentage (37.8).

- Randolph is eighth in made-threes per game (2.0)

• Breyana Mason is second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.32) and seventh in assists per game (3.6)

• Virginia leads the ACC, averaging fewer turnovers per game (12.6) than any other conference team

CAVALIERS OPEN ACC PLAY

• Virginia's 62-47 victory over Virginia Tech in the ACC opener was the first time since 2008-09 that the Cavaliers won the first conference game of the season.

• Virginia hasn't started the season 2-0 in conference play since 2007-08

• The victory over the Hokies was the 17th-consecutive win in the series for the Cavaliers.

• The Cavaliers hit eight three-pointers, including making five in the first half.

• Breyana Mason was one of three Cavaliers to finish the game scoring in double digits, putting up 16 points, including making a pair of three-pointers.

- Mikayla Venson scored 13 points, going 5-of-11 from the field overall and 3-of-7 from three-point range.
- Sarah Imovbioh had 11 rebounds while also scoring nine points.

• Virginia Tech's Rachel Camp scored 23 points, including making one of VT's three three-pointers.

HOT SHOOTING

• Sarah Imovbioh was 9-of-11 (81.8 percent) from the field against Howard, topping her previous-best shooting, a 7-of-9 night against Auburn. She was also 7-of-9 in the final non-conference game against Drexel.

• Mikayla Venson was 6-of-8 from the field against Radford and 3-of-4 against Auburn. All four of her shots against Auburn were from beyond the arc.

- Venson was 5-of-7 from the field against FIU
- Breyana Masons was 4-of-6 (66.7 percent) shooting against Auburn
- Aliyah Huland El went 2-of-3 from 3-point range against FIU
- Sydney Umeri was 4-of-7 at Illinois and 3-of-4 against DSU

DISHING IT OUT

• Breyana Mason had seven assists against Delaware State, the most assist by a UVa player in a game this season

Mason is second in the ACC with 4.5 assists per game

• Mason is third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio at +2.8. She started the week ranked No. 26 nationally in that stat.

• Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high five assists against Delaware State

• Ten out of Virginia's 11 players had at least one assist against Delaware State

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

• The Cavaliers were 7-of-10 from three-point range against Auburn, the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.

• Faith Randolph was 9-of-16 (56.3 percent) from three-point range through the first four games of the year

• Breyana Mason went 5-of-7 from three point range in the opener against Ohio State, but hadn't taken another three-point shot until going 0-for-1 against Toledo

• Mikayla Venson matched that performance, making five of her seven three-point attempts against Delaware State

BLOCKED SHOTS

• Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 1.4 blocked shots per game, which ranked 337th nationally out of 343 teams

• This season, the Cavaliers have 55 blocked shots, already passing last season's final tally of 42

FORCING TURNOVERS

• The Cavaliers forced 25 turnovers against FIU, scoring 31 points off the miscues. Virginia only turned the ball over seven times in the game.

- The Cavaliers forced 20 Radford turnovers while only committing five.
- Both Mikayla Venson and Sarah Imovbioh had five steals against FIU.
- Seven different players had at least one steal against Radford.

CAVALIER CLASSIC TOURNAMENT

• For the first time, the Cavalier Classic, which dates back to 1976, had pre-determined match-ups as opposed to a true "classic" format.

• All four teams finished with 1-1 records.

• Virginia fell 67-57 against Davidson, bouncing back with a 72-66 victory over Drexel

• Sarah Imovbioh and Faith Randolph were named to the six-player All-Tournament team

• Imovbioh scored 40 points with 28 rebounds, four assists and five steals

• Randolph scored 27 points with four rebounds, three assists, a block and two steals

• The Cavaliers had their worst-shooting game of the year, going 31.3 percent from the field against Davidson. Imovbioh went 9-of-11 from the field, with the rest of the team combining to go 12-of-51 (23.5 percent)

• Virginia had four players finish in double-digits against the Dragons. The Cavaliers made their last 14 free throws in the game, including going 6-of-6 from the line in the final 32 seconds.

ACTING HEAD COACH

• Associate head coach Kim McNeill served as the acting head coach for three games (Longwood, Saint Mary's, Howard), while Joanne Boyle was finalizing an adoption. McNeill went 3-0 in those games. The wins will still be reflected in Boyle's career record.

100-POINT GAME

• Virginia defeated Delaware State, 100-62, before finals break

• After Delaware State tied the game, 11-11, on a pair of free throws seven minutes into the game, Virginia went on a 30-4 run, including a span in which UVa scored 18-straight points.

• The Cavaliers went into halftime with a 55-25 lead with three players already with double-digit points. Virginia outscored Delaware State, 45-37, in the second half.

• Freshman forward Jae'Lisa Allen scored a lay-up with 17 seconds remaining in the game, the first points of her career, to give UVa its first 100-point game since the Cavaliers scored 110 points in a Nov. 18, 2009 game against USC Upstate.

• Virginia had five players finish the game scoring in double figures. Mikayla Venson had the first 20-point performance of her career, finishing with 22 points, going 8-of-10 from the field, including 5-of-7 from three-point range.

• Breyana Mason scored 16 points while also dishing seven assists with three rebounds and three steals.

• Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high 11 rebounds to lead the team while also scoring nine points with five assists a block and a steal.

LAST ROAD GAME OF 2014

• The Illinois game was Virginia's last road contest of the calendar year. The Cavaliers will not hit the road again until kicking off ACC play at Virginia Teach on Jan. 4, 2015 and will not leave the Commonwealth until playing at Syracuse on Jan. 11.

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

• The Cavaliers now have a 5-3 record all-time in the Challenge after falling 86-63 at Illinois.

• For only the second time in ACC/Big Ten Challenge history, the challenge ended in a tie with each conference winning seven games

• The ACC moves to 6-0-2 all-time in the Challenge with a 54-39 record against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

• Virginia started the game in a 13-0 deficit after going 0-for-8 from the field while also committing five turnovers before making their first field goal 8:12 into the contest.

• The Illini, who led 38-22 at the break, started the second half on a 21-5 run to put the game out of reach.

• Junior guard Faith Randolph (Derwood, Md.) led the Cavaliers with 16 points. Freshman forward Lauren Moses (Mount Holly, N.J.) had a season-high 13 rebounds, scoring five points with two blocked shots.

• The Illini shot 50.0 percent, including making 17 of 28 shots (60.7 percent) in the second half. Virginia shot 37.5 percent in the game. The Cavaliers held a 42-29 rebounding edge. UVa committed 18 turnovers while the Illini turned the ball over 11 times.

FIU THANKSGIVING CLASSIC TOURNAMENT

• Faith Randolph was named to the All-Tournament team, scoring 21 points against Toledo and 16 against FIU

The Cavaliers suffered their first defeat of the • season, falling 64-62 in their opening-round game against Toledo. Virginia held a 10-point lead, 51-41, with 11 minutes remaining in the game, but Florida International chipped away at the deficit, coming back to tie and then take a 56-55 lead with 3:22 remaining. The final minute of play included three lead changes beginning with Toledo taking a 61-60 lead with 32 seconds remaining after Virginia committed an offensive foul. Mikayla Venson swung the score back in UVa's favor, pulling up for a free-throw-line jump shot with 13 seconds remaining. Zanoguera hit a three-pointer with five seconds left in the game to give the Rockets a 64-62 lead. Venson fired off a three-point attempt as the buzzer sounded, but it clanged off the rim.

• In the consolation final, Virginia earned a 74-61 victory over FIU.

• Virginia, which led the entire game, forced 25 FIU turnovers, scoring 31 points off the miscues.

• Virginia had four players finish the game with double-digit points, led by Sarah Imovbioh who logged her fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds while also matching a career high with five steals.

• Virginia went 7-of-7 from the field to start the game and 5-of-5 to start the second half.

RAINING THREES VS AUBURN

• Virginia won its fourth-straight game with a 66-51 victory

• The Cavaliers broke open a five-point game by going on a 19-3 run early in the second half, making 10 of their first 13 field goal attempts in the period while Auburn went 3-of-14 in the same span. The Tigers also committed five turnovers during that same span.

• Virginia's hot-shooting second-half performance propelled the Cavaliers to a 20-point advantage with 9:16 remaining in the second half. Virginia held a 21-point lead heading into the final two minutes of play, but Auburn capitalized on four late UVa turnovers to go on a 6-0 run to close out the game.

• The Cavaliers shot 70.0 percent from three-point range, making seven of 10 while Auburn was 8-of-20 for 40.0 percent. It was the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.

• Sarah Imovbioh had her third double-double of the season, reaching double figures in points and rebounds by halftime and finishing with 21 points and 13 rebounds. Faith Randolph scored 18 points on 6-of-13 shooting, including going 3-of-4 from threepoint range. Mikayla Venson scored 10 points.

ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (NOV. 17)

• Virginia senior center Sarah Imovbioh has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week

• Imovbioh set the Virginia single-game rebounding record with 24 boards against Ohio State, and accounted for almost half of Virginia's 51 total rebounds in the game.

• Against Radford, Imovbioh only played 20 minutes, but still nearly had another double-double with 14 points and 9 boards.

• Imovbioh averaged 16 points and 16.5 rebounds in UVa's two wins.

• Imovbioh is the first Cavalier to earn this honor since Chelsea Shine was named the ACC Player of the Week on Nov. 21, 2011 after Virginia upset No. 3 Tennessee, 69-64, in overtime.

ROAD WIN AT XAVIER

• Virginia led nearly the entire game, taking a 37-25 lead into halftime.

• Xavier made just one three pointer on 11 attempts in the first half, but went 7-of-14 after the break, including Jada Byrd hitting a three-pointer as time expired, to cut the final deficit to single digits.

• The Cavaliers were 3-of-7 from three-point range and 10-of-12 from the free throw line, shooting 46.8 percent overall from the field. Virginia outrebounded Xavier, 44-33, with UVa scoring 17 second-chance points.

• Faith Randolph scored 26 points, matching her career high. Randolph went 8-of-8 from the free throw line, helping her to her second 25-point game of the season.

• Sarah Imovbioh finished with 18 points and 13 rebounds.

• Breyana Mason (6) and Mikayla Venson (5) accounted for 11 of Virginia's 14 assists.

ROUTING RADFORD

• Virginia closed out the opening homestand with a 75-47 victory over Radford.

• UVa had four players end the game in double-figures. Mikayla Venson (12 points on 6-of-8 shooting), Sarah Imovbioh (14 points with nine rebounds in 20 minutes on the court), Breyana Mason (11 points, five assists.) and Faith Randolph (11).

• Virginia never trailed in the game, holding a 31-21 advantage at halftime and outscored the Highlanders 44-26 after the break.

• Virginia forced 20 turnovers, with seven different Cavaliers getting at least one steal, scoring 21 points off the miscues. Radford outrebounded Virginia 43-38, scoring 23 second-chance points to Virginia's 13.
