The Virginia women's basketball team (7-2) hosts Saint Mary's (7-2) on Friday, Dec. 19 at 7 p.m. at John Paul Jones Arena, the second game in a three-game week for the Cavaliers.

Virginia opened the week with a 91-49 victory over Longwood on Tuesday night. The Cavaliers had their best shooting performance of the season, going 38-of-68 (55.9 percent) from the field. UVa opened the second half making 10 of its first 11 shots, shooting 63.9 percent in the period, the second time this season the team shot over 60 percent in a half.

m The Cavaliers had six players finish the game scoring in doublem figures, the first time the squad has had that many double-digit m scorers in a game since a Feb. 6, 2007 game against North Florida. m Senior center Sarah Imovbioh (Abuja, Nigeria) led the squad m with 25 points, the second 25-point performance of the season by m a Cavalier. Imovbioh went 11-of-14 from the field, raising her season field goal shooting percentage to an ACC-best 64.0 percent. m Imovbioh also added 15 rebounds, her fifth double-double of the m season. m

The Cavaliers committed just six turnovers, the fifth time this season the team has turned the ball over fewer than 10 times. Virginia had a season-low five turnovers in the second game of the season against Radford, the only game this season with fewer miscues by UVa.

On the flip side, Virginia logged 15 steals, with freshman guard Aliyah Huland El (Randolph, N.J.) grabbing four, and forced 20 Longwood turnovers, scoring 25 points off those opportunities.

Virginia dominated Longwood in the paint, outscoring the Lancers 50-12 down low while also blocking a season-high eight shots. Freshman forward Lauren Moses (Mount Holly, N.J.) and sophomore guard Tiffany Suarez (Miami, Fla.) blocked three shots apiece.

HOOS HOT

• The Cavaliers have shot better than 50 percent in three of the last four games.

• In the last two games, the Cavaliers have shot 54.7 percent (76-of-139) while their opponents went 39-of-115 (33.9 percent)

• In the last four games, Mikayla Venson is 22-of-35 from the field, making 62.8 percent of her shots

- Venson was 8-of-12 from three-point range last week (66.7 %)
- Venson has scored in double digits in five of the last six games
- Breyana Mason went 6-of-6 from the free throw line against Longwood after making 5-of-5 against Delaware State.
- Mason has made her last 16 free throw attempts and has not missed from the stripe since the Radford game (Nov. 16)
- Lauren Moses went 4-of-5 shooting against Longwood, also blocking three shots and contributing three assists
- Sarah Imovbioh made 11 of 14 shots against Longwood (78.5 percent)
- Sarah Beth Barnette has 16 rebounds with six assists in the last two games

• Aliyah Huland El has scored in double digits each of the last two games, including scoring a season-high 11points with four assists and four steals against Longwood

SCOUTING THE GAELS

• The Gaels entered the week with an RPI of 46

• Saint Mary's split its Fresno State/Cal Poly roadtrip last week. Against Fresno State, the Gaels nearly pulled off the comeback of the ages. Once down 41-21, the Gaels went on an incredible 26-6 run to tie the game late in the second-half before eventually falling to the Bulldogs, 60-56.

• SMC overcame a game-tying buzzer beater by CP, to defeat the Mustangs in overtime 65-64.

• This will be the second ACC game of the year for the Gaels after falling to Boston College, 82-72, in the season-opener.

• Saint Mary's has a 64-58 upset win over Southern California

• As a team, Saint Mary's leads the West Coast Conference in rebounding margin at +12.4.

• Lauren Nicholson leads the WCC in scoring, averaging 18.8 points per game. Stella Beck leads the WCC in field goal percentage at 61.7 percent. Hayley Hendricksen leads the WCC in free-throw percentage at 92.6 percent while Shannon Mauldin is third in the league in steals with 2.4 per game.

• This is the first-ever meeting between the two teams.

• Sunday's game is at 6 pm instead of the usual Sunday afternoon matinee as the men's team is playing Harvard at noon.

• The players and staff will head home and return to practice on Friday, Dec. 26

• The Cavaliers return to game action on Sunday, Dec. 28 when they host the Cavalier Classic Presented by Holiday Inn University Area. Drexel and Miami (OH) open the tournament at 12 noon with Virginia taking on Davidson at 2:30 p.m.

• This year, the tournament will have set match-ups as opposed to a pure "classic" format, with Miami (OH) and Davidson playing at 4:30 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 29 followed by Virginia and Drexel at 7 p.m. An All-Tournament Team will still be announced, but there will not be a tournament champion.

DISHING IT OUT

• Breyana Mason had seven assists against Delaware State, the most assist by a UVa player in a game this season

- Mason is second in the ACC with 4.5 assists per game
- Mason is third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio at +2.8. She started the week ranked No. 26 nationally in that stat.
- Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high five assists againstDelaware State

• Ten out of Virginia's 11 players had at least one assist against Delaware State

THREE-POINT SHOOTING

• The Cavaliers were 7-of-10 from three-point range against Auburn, the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.

• Faith Randolph was 9-of-16 (56.3 percent) from three-point range through the first four games of the year

• Breyana Mason went 5-of-7 from three point range in the opener against Ohio State, but hadn't taken another three-point shot until going O-for-1 against Toledo

• Mikayla Venson matched that performance, making five of her seven three-point attempts against Delaware State

BLOCKED SHOTS

• Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 1.4 blocked shots per game, which ranked 337th nationally out of 343 teams

- This season, the Cavaliers are averaging 4.1 per game
- Freshman forward Lauren Moses has 13 blocked shots, ranking sixth in the ACC

• Sarah Imovbioh had four blocked shots last season. This year, she already has five.

LAST ROAD GAME OF 2014

• The Illinois game was Virginia's last road contest of the caeldnar year. The Cavaliers will not hit the road again until kicking off ACC play at Virginia Teach on Jan. 4, 2015 and will not leave the Commonwealth until playing at Syracuse on Jan. 11.

FORCING TURNOVERS

• The Cavaliers forced 25 turnovers against FIU, scoring 31 points off the miscues. Virginia only turned the ball over seven times in the game.

- The Cavaliers forced 20 Radford turnovers while only committing five.
- Both Mikayla Venson and Sarah Imovbioh had five steals agaisnt FIU.
- Seven different players had at least one steal against Radford.

100-POINT GAME

• Virginia defeated Delaware State, 100-62, before finals break

• After Delaware State tied the game, 11-11, on a pair of free throws seven minutes into the game, Virginia went on a 30-4 run, including a span in which UVa scored 18-straight points.

• The Cavaliers went into halftime with a 55-25 lead with three players already with double-digit points. Virginia outscored Delaware State, 45-37, in the second half.

• Freshman forward Jae'Lisa Allen scored a layup with 17 seconds remaining in the game, the first points of her career, to give UVa its first 100-point game since the Cavaliers scored 110 points in a Nov. 18, 2009 game against USC Upstate.

VIRGINIA 2014-15 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

• Virginia had five players finish the game scoring in double figures. Mikayla Venson had the first 20-point performance of her career, finishing with 22 points, going 8-of-10 from the field, including 5-of-7 from three-point range.

• Breyana Mason scored 16 points while also dishing seven assists with three rebounds and three steals.

• Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high 11 rebounds to lead the team while also scoring nine points with five assists a block and a steal.

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

• The Cavaliers now have a 5-3 record all-time in the Challenge after falling 86-63 at Illinois.

• For only the second time in ACC/Big Ten Challenge history, the challenge ended in a tie with each conference winning seven games

• The ACC moves to 6-0-2 all-time in the Challenge with a 54-39 record against the Big Ten in Challenge games.

• Virginia started the game in a 13-0 deficit after going 0-for-8 from the field while also committing five turnovers before making their first field goal 8:12 into the contest.

• The Illini, who led 38-22 at the break, started the second half on a 21-5 run to put the game out of reach.

• Junior guard Faith Randolph (Derwood, Md.) led the Cavaliers with 16 points. Freshman forward Lauren Moses (Mount Holly, N.J.) had a season-high 13 rebounds, scoring five points with two blocked shots.

• The Illini shot 50.0 percent, including making 17 of 28 shots (60.7 percent) in the second half. Virginia shot 37.5 percent in the game. The Cavaliers held a 42-29 rebounding edge. UVa committed 18 turnovers while the Illini turned the ball over 11 times.

FIU THANKSGIVING CLASSIC TOURNAMENT

• Faith Randolph was named to the All-Tournament team, scoring 21 points against Toledo and 16 against FIU

• The Cavaliers suffered their first defeat of the season, falling 64-62 in their opening-round game against Toledo. Virginia held a 10-point lead, 51-41, with 11 minutes remaining in the game, but Florida International chipped away at the deficit, coming back to tie and then take a 56-55 lead with 3:22 remaining. The final minute of play included three lead changes beginning with Toledo taking a 61-60 lead with 32 seconds remaining after Virginia committed an offensive foul. Mikayla Venson swung the score back in UVa's favor, pulling up for a free-throw-line jump shot with 13 seconds remaining. Zanoguera hit a three-pointer with five seconds left in the game to give the Rockets a 64-62 lead. Venson fired off a three-point attempt as the buzzer sounded, but it clanged off the rim.

• In the consolation final, Virginia earned a 74-61 victory over FIU.

• Virginia, which led the entire game, forced 25 FIU turnovers, scoring 31 points off the miscues.

• Virginia had four players finish the game with double-digit points, led by Sarah Imovbioh who logged her fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds while also matching a career high with five steals.

• Virginia went 7-of-7 from the field to start the game and 5-of-5 to start the second half.

RAINING THREES VS AUBURN

 Virginia won its fourth-straight game with a 66-51 victory

 The Cavaliers broke open a five-point game by going on a 19-3 run early in the second half, making 10 of their first 13 field goal attempts in the period while Auburn went 3-of-14 in the same span. The Tigers also committed five turnovers during that same span.

• Virginia's hot-shooting second-half performance propelled the Cavaliers to a 20-point advantage with 9:16 remaining in the second half. Virginia held a 21-point lead heading into the final two minutes of play, but Auburn capitalized on four late UVa turnovers to go on a 6-0 run to close out the game.

• The Cavaliers shot 70.0 percent from three-point range, making seven of 10 while Auburn was 8-of-20 for 40.0 percent. It was the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.

• Sarah Imovbioh had her third double-double of the season, reaching double figures in points and rebounds by halftime and finishing with 21 points and 13 rebounds. Faith Randolph scored 18 points on 6-of-13 shooting, including going 3-of-4 from threepoint range. Mikayla Venson scored 10 points.

ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (NOV. 17)

 Virginia senior center Sarah Imovbioh has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week

 Imovbioh set the Virginia single-game rebounding record with 24 boards against Ohio State, and accounted for almost half of Virginia's 51 total rebounds in the game.

 Against Radford, Imovbioh only played 20 minutes, but still nearly had another double-double with 14 points and 9 boards.

 Imovbioh averaged 16 points and 16.5 rebounds in UVa's two wins.

 Imovbioh is the first Cavalier to earn this honor since Chelsea Shine was named the ACC Player of the Week on Nov. 21, 2011 after Virginia upset No. 3 Tennessee, 69-64, in overtime.

ROAD WIN AT XAVIER

• Virginia led nearly the entire game, taking a 37-25 lead into halftime.

Xavier made just one three pointer on 11 attempts in the first half, but went 7-of-14 after the break, including Jada Byrd hitting a three-pointer as time expired, to cut the final deficit to single digits.

 The Cavaliers were 3-of-7 from three-point range and 10-of-12 from the free throw line, shooting 46.8 percent overall from the field. Virginia outrebounded Xavier, 44-33, with UVa scoring 17 second-chance

• Faith Randolph scored 26 points, matching her career high. Randolph went 8-of-8 from the free throw line, helping her to her second 25-point game of the season.

• Sarah Imovbioh finished with 18 points and 13 rebounds.
