FOR OPENERS

- UVA has a six-game winning streak vs. NC State.
- UVA is 5-1 in true road games and 4-1 vs. ranked opponents. - The Cavaliers are 13-1 in ACC road action over the past two seasons. - Jay Huff (Durham) and Braxton Key (Charlotte) are North Carolina natives.


## ALL-TIME VS. NC STATE

- Virginia is 65-82 all-time vs. NC State in the series that dates back to 1912-13.
- The Cavaliers are 11-0 in their last 10 regular-season games against NC State and 11-2 in their last 13 games including a pair of losses in the ACC Tournament.
- UVA posted a 68-51 win against NC State in Charlottesville last season and has limited the Wolfpack to 55 or fewer points in each game during its six-game winning streak in the series.
- UVA has a five-game winning streak against NC State at PNC Arena. - Tony Bennett is 11-2 vs. NC State as head coach at Virginia.


## CAVALIERS AT PNC ARENA

-Virginia sports an 11-7 all-time record at PNC Arena in Raleigh. - The Cavaliers are 7-7 against NC State at PNC Arena and 4-0 in NCAA tournament action in 2014 and 2016.

- UVA has a nine-game winning streak at PNC Arena (45-0 vs. NC State and 4-0 NCAA Tournament) dating back to Jan. 9, 2010.


## LAST TIME VS. THE WOLEPACK

- Devon Hall scored a career-best 25 points and then-No. 3 UVA posted a 68-51 victory over NC State on Jan. 14, 2018.
- Kyle Guy added 17 points for the Cavaliers, who have won 11 straight regular-season meetings against the Wolfpack.
- Torin Dorn scored 16 points to lead N.C. State, which arrived with a 3-0 record against ranked teams.
- N.C. State scoring leader Allerik Freeman (15.2 points per game) did not score in 29 minutes, missing all five of his shots from the field.
- Virginia led 30-20 at the break and quickly built its margin to 37-20 in the opening minutes after halftime. The lead grew as high as 21.


## UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 28, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (52.6 ppg ), turnovers per game (8.4), fewest turnovers (159) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (24.9\%), second in scoring margin (21.5), third in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.72), fourth in field goal percentage defense ( $37.3 \%$ ) and winning percentage ( $94.7 \%$ ), ninth in fewest fouls (284), 10th in free throw percentage (76.8\%), 11th in personal fouls per game (14.9), 13th in 3-point field goal percentage (39.6\%), 25th in rebound margin (6.4), 27th in turnover margin (3.6) and 33rd in field goal percentage (48.1\%).

## UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Jan. 28, UVA ranks №. 1 in the KenPom.com overall ratings, No. 2 in adjusted offense efficiency and No. 3 in adjusted defense efficiency.
- UVA is shooting 48.1 percent (second best in Bennett era), 39.6 percent from 3-point range (second best in school history) and 76.8 percent from the free throw line (best in school history).


## CAVALIER QUARTET AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Jan. 28, Kyle Guy ranks first in the ACC in 3-pointers (3.0), third in 3-point percentage (46\%), 10th in field goal percentage (47.6\%), 11th in minutes (33.1) and 12th in scoring (15.0).
- Ty Jerome ranks third in assists (4.9) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3), sixth in 3-point percentage (40.2\%) and 18th in minutes (31.2).
- De'Andre Hunter ranks fourth in field goal percentage (53.5\%) and 15th in scoring (14.7).
- Braxton Key ranks 23rd in rebounding (5.7).


## UVA RANKED NO. 3 IN AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 3 for the second straight week in the AP poll. -The Cavaliers have been ranked in the AP top six in 21 consecutive polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP for 28 straight polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 24 polls.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons. - In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.


## LAST TIME OUT

- De'Andre Hunter scored 19 points to lead five players in double figures as No. 3 Virginia routed Notre Dame 82-55 on Jan. 26 at Purcell Pavilion.
- Kyle Guy (15), Ty Jerome (13), Kihei Clark (12) and Mamadi Diaite (10) also reached double figures as UVA improved to 5-1 in true road contests.
- The Hoos jumped to a 12-0 lead and never trailed in the ACC win.
- Diakite matched career highs in blocked shots (4) and rebounds (7). - The Cavaliers tied a school record with two turnovers and shot 52.2 percent from the field.


## HOOS GO STREAKING ON THE ROAD

- The Cavaliers' recent 12-game league road winning streak (201719) ended with the $72-70$ loss at Duke on Jan. 19. -The streak ranks fourth all-time in ACC history behind Duke's 24-game streak (1998-2001) and 14-game streak (1962-64) and NC State's 13-game streak (1972-74).

## VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

-Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 237-87 (.732) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 306-120 (.718) career mark in 13 seasons.

- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018). - Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons and a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons. - Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, edipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013). - In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (20142015) for the first time in school history.

UVA is 126-35 (.782) in non-conference action, 111-52 (.681) in ACC play and 138-25 (.847) at home under Tony Bennett.

- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .681, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.


## GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 52.6 ppg .
- The Cavaliers have limited eight opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Morgan State, Towson, Wisconsin, VCU, William \& Mary, Clemson and Wake Forest).
- UVA has held 14 opponents to 40 percent or less shooting from the field and 17 opponents to 33 percent or less shooting from 3-point range.
-The Cavaliers have forced 17 shot clock violations.
- UVA has out-rebounded 15 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.


## H00 ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- We play defense, take good shots, share and take care of the basketball, rebound and play more defense.
- We are led by the quartet of Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Jerome, Guy and Hunter have started all 19 games, while Salt has started 16 and anchors UVA's defense.
- Jerome, Guy or Hunter have led or tied for the UVA scoring lead in each of its 19 contests, accounting for 57.7 percent of the Cavaliers' scoring.
- Alabama transfer Braxton Key is averaging 7.2 points and a teamhigh 5.7 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 6.8 points and 3.7 rebounds.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark has started four games and has chipped in 40 assists and 143 -pointers. Clark broke his left wrist against Morgan
State, but hasn't missed a game while playing with a cast.
- Jay Huff has averaged 5.2 points and 2.4 rebounds in 9.4 minutes per game off the bench.
- Marco Anthony, Kody Stattmann and Francesco Badocchi provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in eight games.


## TYING US TOGETHER

- UVA floor general Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 13.1 points, 4.3 rebounds, 4.9 assists and 1.6 steals.
- Jerome has reached double figures in 13 games, including three

20-points efforts, highlighted by a season-high 25 at South Carolina.

- Jerome had a career-high 12 assists against Virginia Tech and has handed out four or more assists in 13 games.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylven Landesberg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.


## THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- All-American Kyle Guy leads the team in scoring (15.0 ppg), 3-point shooting ( 46 percent), free throw accuracy ( 86.5 percent) and 3-pointers (57),
- Guy was named ACC Player of the Week on Jan. 7 after averaging 25.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in wins against Marshall and №. 9 Florida State.
-The 6-2 sharpshooter set a UVA school record with 11 consecutive 3-pointers over the two-game span.
- Guy has shot 51.9 percent from 3-point range (28 of 54) over the past seven games.
- Guy has a 13 -game double figure scoring streak.
- He has scored 20 or more points nine times in his career, including 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) last season.
- Guy has made five or more 3-pointers in 11 games
- Guy ranks 46th all-time in scoring at UVA with 1,022 career points.
- Guy ranks third all-time in the ACC and first at UVA with a 43.5 percent career 3-point shooting percentage.
- Guy ranks eighth all-time at UVA with 191 career 3-pointers.
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.


## DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has led UVA in scoring in 10 games, averaging 14.7 points and 5.4 rebounds
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the tournament.
- Hunter has four 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton, Wisconsin, Virginia Tech), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee. - Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 53.5 percent from the floor, 41.5 percent from 3 -point range and 78.5 percent from the charity stripe
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds en route to ACC Sixth Man of the Year honors in 2017-18.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.


## HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia has held eight opponents (8-0) to fewer than 50 points and is $84-2$ when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era. - Bennett-coached teams are 109-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points ( $25-1$ in three years at Washington State)
- UVA is 23-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

## VIRGINIA MEDIA RELATIONS OFFICE

The UVA athletics media relations office is located in John Paul Jones Arena. Regular business hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

## PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should apply online at www.sportssystems.com/virginiahoops. Credential requests should be submitted no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

## PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

## PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. Please request your parking pass during the online credential application process.

## INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

## POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett, two Virginia student-athletes and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game, followed by two Virginia student-athletes or the visiting coach. Other Virginia players will be available upon request in the Courtside Club after the Virginia student-athletes press conference.

## RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table for visiting radio crews.

## GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-byplay sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Head coach and player quotes will be available after postgame interviews. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.
