FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets South Carolina for the 50th time in series history.
- UVA has started 9-0 for the first time since starting 19-0 in 2014-15 and 123-35 (.778) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett is three wins shy of 300 career wins.
- Virginia freshman guard Kihei Clark had successful surgery to repair a broken left wrist on Dec. 10. Clark injured the wrist against Morgan State and played with a cast in UVA's win over VCU on Dec. 9.

ALL-TIME VS. SOUTH CAROLINA

- Virginia meets South Carolina for the first time since a 74-67 loss in the first round of the NIT in the 2001-02 season.
- UVA is 25-24 all-time vs. the Gamecocks, including a 6-13 mark in Columbia.
- The Cavaliers posted a 14-20 mark from 1953-71 against South Carolina when the Gamecocks were members of the ACC.
- UVA and South Carolina have split four contests since 1990.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy had 15 points and Ty Jerome added 14 as then-No. 4 Virginia slid past in-state rival VCU 57-49 on Dec. 9.
- The Cavaliers shot a season-low 29.5 percent, but held the Rams to 29.5 percent shooting on 61 attempts.
- Kihei Clark sparked UVA's defense and scored nine points with a cast on his left wrist.
- The Cavaliers out-rebounded VCU 38-34 as Jerome matched a career high with eight rebounds.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

• As of Dec. 18, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (51.2 ppg), assist-to-turnover ratio (1.81), fewest turnovers (75) and winning percentage (100%), second in turnovers per game (8.3), seventh in fewest fouls (135), eighth in turnover margin (6.0) and scoring margin (21.6), 14th in personal fouls per game (15.0) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (27%), 24th in free throw percentage (76.2%), 32nd in 3-point field goal percentage (39.1%) and 33rd in field goal percentage defense (38.6%).

HUNTER, JEROME AND GUY AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Dec. 18, De'Andre Hunter ranks third in the ACC in field goal percentage (57.3%) and 14th in scoring (15.6).
- Ty Jerome ranks second in steals (2.2) and assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3), seventh in 3-pointers (2.4) and 3-point percentage (43.1%), 10th in assists (4.0) and 24th in scoring (13.4).
- Kyle Guy ranks seventh in 3-pointers (2.4) and 10th in minutes (33.2).

UVA RANKED NO. 5 IN AP POLL

- \bullet Virginia is ranked No. 5 in the AP poll, marking its seventh straight week in the top six this season.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 23 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 18 polls.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons.
- In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.

ALL-TIME VS. SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- Virginia meets its first SEC opponent since posting a 68-42 win over Vanderbilt in the 2017 NIT Season Tip-Off last season at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.
- The Cavaliers are 61-62 all-time vs. current SEC opponents (25-24 vs. South Carolina, 8-5 vs. Tennessee, 4-1 vs. Missouri, 4-3 vs. Arkansas, 3-0 vs. LSU, 3-4 vs. Alabama, 3-4 vs. Auburn, 3-4 vs. Georgia, 3-6 vs. Kentucky, 2-5 vs. Vanderbilt, 1-2 vs. Florida, 1-1 vs. Mississippi, 1-2 vs. Mississippi State and 0-1 vs. Texas A&M).

LAST TIME VS. THE GAMECOCKS

- Rolando Howell scored 24 points to lead four players in double figures as South Carolina topped Virginia 74-67 in the first round of the NIT on March 13, 2002.
- Travis Watson had a game-high 26 points and 13 points for the Cavaliers, who finished the 2001-02 campaign 17-12.
- UVA shot 59.3 percent en route to a 33-27 lead after 20 minutes.
- The Gamecocks shot 60.7 percent in the second half, outscoring the Cavaliers 47-34 to post the seven-point win.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 228-86 (.726) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 297-119 (.713) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 122-35 (.777) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 132-25 (.841) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 51.2 ppg.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Morgan State, Towson, Wisconsin, VCU).
- UVA has held six opponents to 40 percent or less shooting.
- UVA has out-rebounded seven opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.

HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia is led by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Hunter leads UVA in scoring (15.6) and rebounding (5.3).
- Jerome is averaging 13.7 points and team-high 4.0 assists.
- Guy is averaging 13.4 points, while Salt anchors UVA's stingy defense.
- Transfer Braxton Key has averaged 6.0 points and 5.1 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 5.9 points and 2.1 rebounds.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark, who has started the past four games, is
- averaging 5.8 points and 2.6 rebounds.

 Clark broke his left wrist against Morgan State, played in the VCU
- game with a cast and had successful surgery on Dec. 10.

 Marco Anthony, Jay Huff and Kody Stattmann provide depth and
- Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.

 Redshirt freshman Francesco Badocchi returned to the team last
- week after taking a leave of absence due to medical issues.

 Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in four home games.

TYING US TOGETHER

- Point guard Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 13.7 points, 4.0 assists and 3.7 rebounds.
- Jerome has reached double figures in seven games, including back-to-back 20-point efforts to start the season.
- Jerome is shooting a career-best 43.1 percent from 3-point range.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylven Landesberg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).

- Ty Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Kyle Guy is tied for the team with 22 3-pointers and is third on the team in scoring (13.4 ppg), highlighted by his seventh career 20-point effort vs. George Washington.
- Guy has shot 42.3 percent from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in eight games.
- Guy's 42.3 3-point percentage ranks first on UVA's career list, edging Keith Freel's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in seven career games (4 in 2017–18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.

DRE'S WAY

- De'Andre Hunter has reached double figures in eight games, averaging a team-leading 15.6 points and 5.3 rebounds.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds in the tournament.
- Hunter has three 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton and Wisconsin), matching a career-high 23 points against Dayton.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- \bullet Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- He is shooting 57.3 percent from the floor, 45.5 percent from 3-point range and 80 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including a career-high 23 against Monmouth and ACC-high 22 against Miami.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia has held five opponents (5-0) to fewer than 50 points and is 81-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 106-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 22-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s & DIVINE 90s

- Virginia has scored over 70 points in six games and is 113-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 115-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 97 points against Coppin State and is 3-0 when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.
- UVA is 28-1 when scoring 80 or more points under Bennett with its lone loss a 93-81 decision at North Carolina in 2012-13.
- UVA was the first ACC team to win seven straight conference games (Jan. 6-27, 2018) while scoring fewer than 70 points in any game.

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Los Angeles) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brodgon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17, is in his third season with the Bucks.

- Virginia is 171-41 (.805), including a 5-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 16-1 at JPJ last season and is 133-25 (.842), including a 98-10 (.907) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 49-5 (.907) in league home games over the past six seasons. Duke is second at 48-6 (.889).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.
- UVA has a 15-game nonconference home winning streak
- UVA is 70-6 at home in nonconference action under Bennett.
- The Cavaliers have a seven-game winning streak at JPJ.

RECORDS WATCH

- Kyle Guy ranks first on UVA's career 3-point percentage at 42.3 percent, while Ty Jerome is fifth at 39.4 percent.
- Guy has drilled 156 of 364 career 3-point attempts and needs six 3's to pass Devin Smith (161 3's) for 10th on UVA's all-time list.
- Ty Jerome reached 100 career 3-pointers with a pair against Dayton.

VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by UVA, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pitt.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 33-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 2-0 mark in 2018-19 and 5-1 record in 2017-18.
- UVA posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents (Wisconsin and Maryland) for the first in the regular season since 1982 (Georgetown and Houston).
- The Cavaliers are 148-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.

- UVA is 1-0 this season after achieving the mark against Coppin State and was 5-0 last season when achieving the 50-40-75 mark (Austin Peay, VCU, Rhode Island, Davidson, NC State and Louisville).

UVA INKS MORSELL AND SHEDRICK

- Guard Casey Morsell (Fort Washington, Md./St. John's College High School) and forward Kadin Shedrick (Raleigh, N.C./Holly Springs High School) signed NLI's with the Cavaliers.
- The 6-3, 190-pound Morsell averaged 14 points and 4.3 rebounds for St. John's College High School (Washington, D.C.) in 2017-18.
- The 6-11, 200-pound Shedrick averaged 16.2 points and 9.8 for Holly Springs in 2017-18.

UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- UVA is 1-0 against teams from the Commonwealth of Virginia, posting a 57-49 win over VCU.
- The Cavaliers play William & Mary & Virginia Tech (twice) this year.
- UVA has a 65-15 record against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 18 of its last 21 games against teams from Virginia.
- The Cavaliers went 3-1 vs. the Commonwealth last year.

PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should apply online at www.sportssystems.com/virginia-hoops. Credential requests should be submitted no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. Please request your parking pass during the online credential application process.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett, two Virginia student-athletes and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game, followed by two Virginia student-athletes or the visiting coach. Other Virginia players will be available upon request in the Courtside Club after the Virginia student-athletes press conference.

UVA SPORTS APP
