The Virginia women's basketball team (5-3) hosts NJIT (2-4) on Saturday, Dec. 5 at 7 p.m. at John Paul Jones Arena in Charlottesville.

After jumping out to a 5-0 start, the best start to a season for the Cavaliers since 1997-98, Virginia has lost its last three games, falling to Rutgers, 60-48, and Tulane, 67-62, at the Paradise Jam, and Iowa, 85-73, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

Sophomore Mikayla Venson (Arlington, Va.) had two 25-point performances in a week span. Venson scored a then-career-high 25 points against Green Bay last Thursday (Nov. 26), only to top that with a 28-point game against lowa on Wednesday (Dec. 2). In the game against the Hawkeyes, Venson scored 15 points in the fourth quarter. Against the Phoenix, Venson scored 11 in the fourth quarter. In both games, Venson went 6-of-6 from the free throw line down the stretch.

Venson took 18 shots against the Hawkeyes, the second time in a week making that many attempts from the floor after also attempting 18 against Rutgers last Friday (11/27). Venson took 10 three-point shots against lowa, the third time in a week's span that she made at least eight attempts from long range.

The Cavaliers had a strong shooting night against lowa, making 50.0 percent of their shots (29-of-58), their second time this season shooting 50 percent or better, and were 40.0 percent (6-of-15) from three-point range, their second time shooting 40 percent or better from beyond the arc. Last season, the Cavaliers had seven games shooting 50 or better overall and 11 games of making at least 40 percent of their long-range attempts.

Iowa outrebounded UVA, 36-25, the second time this season Virginia had a rebounding deficit in double-digits.

#### **HOOS HOT**

- Mikayla Venson scored a career-high 28 points against lowa, going 9-of-18 from the field and 6-of-6 from the line
- In a seven day span (four games), Venson scored 68 points last week with eight assists
- Faith Randolph was 6-of-11 from the field against lowa, scoring
   12 points
- Randolph has made five or more field goals in six of eight games this season
- Randolph is second on the team in rebounding, averaging 4.5 per game
- Breyana Mason is averaging 9.5 points, 2.5 assists, 2.0 steals and 3.0 rebounds in the last two games
- Mason made two three-pointers in the first quarter against lowa, then did not attempt another long-range shot
- After a span of four games without making a three-point shot, Mason is 4-of-7 in the last two games
- Lauren Moses is averaging 13.0 points per game in the last three games
- Moses was 5-of-7 shooting against lowa. In the last three games, she is 17-of-29 (58.6 percent)
- Moses led the Cavaliers in rebounding against lowa, the fourth time in the last five games she has had the team-high rebounding total by herself
- Moses has led the team or been tied for the team lead in rebounding in all but two games this season

#### **FREE THROWS**

- Faith Randolph, who led the ACC in free throw percentage last season (90.7 percent) has made her last 14 free throw attempts
- Mikayla Venson has made her last 17 free throw attempts, including going 6-of-6 against Iowa and 8-of-8 against Green Bay

#### **BENCH POINTS**

- Virginia's non-starters are averaging 20.1 points per game
- Last season, the UVA bench averaged 11.1 points per game
- Aliyah Huland-El has two 20-point games coming off the bench this year

#### **HOMESTAND**

• Virginia is in the second game of a stretch of nine games in which only one, Dec. 21 at Ohio State, is away from John Paul Jones Arena

#### **RALLY TIME**

- Virginia erased a 14-point deficit to comeback to win against Green Bay in the opener of the Paradise Jam
- In the final game of the Paradise Jam, Virginia twice erased double-digit deficits against Tulane, 11 points in the first quarter and 10 points in the third, but ultimately fell 67-62



#### **NJIT HIGHLANDERS**

- NJIT (New Jersey Institute of Technology) has won two of its last three games, but fell 76-53 to Wagner on Wednesday. Wagner's Jasmine Nwajei had a triple double with 16 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. NJIT was led by Leah Horton's 16 points, including going 10-of-12 from the free throw line
- Horton leads the team in scoring and rebounding, averaging 11.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.
- Freshman Kelly Guarino was named the NJIT Female Athlete of the Week after 21 scoring points in last week's win over College of St. Joseph's (VT), going 7-for-8 from three point range.
- This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools

#### **CAREER HIGHS**

- The Virginia sophomores had a span of four-straight games in which they posted career-high points
- Aliyah Huland El had her first career 20-point game at Auburn (11/19), matching that career-best in the next game against Longwood (11/22)
- Mikayla Venson scored a career-high 25 points against Green Bay in the Paradise Jam (11/26)
- Lauren Moses scored a career-high 18 points the next night against Rutgers (11/27)
- Venson topped her 25-point performance by scoring 28 points against lowa (12/02), scoring 15 of those points in the fourth quarter

#### **BIG TEN/ACC CHALLENGE**

- The Cavaliers have a 5-4 record all-time in the Challenge after falling 85-73 to lowa this year
- The Hawkeyes broke open a tight game in the third quarter, outscoring the Cavaliers 23-10 in the period, taking a 20-point lead at the start of the fourth quarter. The Cavaliers mounted a 9-2 run midway through the fourth quarter, narrowing the gap to 11, 71-60, with 4:41 remaining, but lowa scored five-straight points to take back control of the game and hand Virginia its third-straight loss
- Mikayla Venson had her second 20-point game of the season, finishing with a career-high 28 points, including scoring 15 points in the fourth quarter.
- Faith Randolph finished the game with 12 points, going 6-of-11 from the field.
- Both teams had hot-shooting performances with the Hawkeyes shooting 52.7 percent (29-of-55) and the Cavaliers 50 percent (29-of-58). Iowa made 10 three-pointers, going 10-of-24 from long range. Venson and Breyana Mason combined to make six threes for the Cavaliers.
- The ACC won five games on Day II of the Challenge to rally for the second-straight tie. The ACC has never lost the Challenge

#### PARADISE JAM

- Virginia went 1-2 in the tournament in the Virgin Islands, tying for second place
- The Cavaliers won the opener against Green Bay, 68-59
- Virginia trailed by as many as 14 points in the game and was down 35-22 with 1:35 remaining in the first half, but a 25-point performance from Mikayla Venson and a huge third-quarter in which UVA outscored Green Bay 22-7 helped the Cavaliers open the tournament with a victory.
- Virginia fell 60-48 to Rutgers, the tournament champions
- The Cavaliers trailed by just two points, 29-27, at the half, and tied the game 33-33 on a three-pointer from Mikayla Venson with 6:34 remaining in the third quarter, but made just 5-of-26 shots in the remainder of the game (19.2 percent) to fall to the Scarlet Knights.
- Virginia dropped the final game to Tulane, 67-62
- For the second time in the tournament, the Cavaliers rallied to erase a double-digit deficit, trailing by as many as 11 points in the game and by 10, 40-30, with 4:35 remaining in the fourth quarter. Virginia closed out the third quarter on a 15-2 run, taking a 45-42 lead into the fourth. Tulane retook the lead, 50-47, on a three-pointer with 7:03 remaining in the game and never trailed again. The Green Wave outscored the Cavaliers 25-17 in the final period, making six of their final eight field goal attempts to close out their victory.
- Faith Randolph scored 19 points. Aliyah Huland El just missed her first career double-double with nine points and 10 rebounds

#### **ROAD WIN VS THE SEC**

- A big first-quarter by Mikayla Venson and a career-high 20 points from Aliyah Huland El helped the Cavaliers earn a 69-52 road victory at Auburn.
- Randolph finished the game with 15 points, with eight of those coming in the first quarter. Venson scored 14 points, including 10 in the second quarter. Huland El came off the bench to make 6-of-15 attempts from the field and 7-of-8 from the free throw line to tally her career-high 20 points
- The Tigers had a 43-39 edge in rebounding. Virginia shot 44.8 percent in the first half (13-of-29) but only made 9-of-34 (26.5 percent) in the final two quarters to shoot 34.9 percent for the game. Auburn shot 34.4 percent.

#### BALANCED SCORING IN THE FIRST TWO GAMES

- Virginia has had a very balanced approach to both scoring and rebounding in the first two games
- Six Cavaliers averaged 10 or more points a game through the first two contests
- In the 86-50 victory over Norfolk State, seven Cavaliers finished the game in double-digits, the first time in program history that seven players reached that benchmark in a single game
- In the opening 70-66 win at Middle Tennessee, five Cavaliers finished in double figures, a feat that the team accomplished just three times last season.
- The Virginia bench is averaged 32.5 points per game. Last year, the non-starters contributed 11.1 points per game



#### **DEBUTS**

- Three players made their Cavalier debuts in the season-opener at Middle Tennessee
- Freshman forward Moné Jones played 24 minutes, scoring six points with five rebounds
- Freshman center Debra Ferguson made her first career layup eight seconds after checking into the game for the first time
- Redshirt sophomore J'Kyra Brown scored 10 points, all in the third quarter
- Freshman Emily Battle made her collegiate debut against Norfolk State, scoring two points with a rebound

#### **SIGNING DAY**

- Head coach Joanne Boyle signed two five-star recruits and added a third with high-level international experience
- Jocelyn Willoughby is ranked the No. 8 wing in her class and No. 47 player overall by ESPN-W and No. 5 at her position and No. 28 overall by Prospects Nation. Willoughby is a standout at Newark Academy. She became the first player at her school to score 1,000 career points, doing so in her sophomore season. As a freshman and sophomore, she helped lead Newark to two-straight seasons with 21-or-more wins and back-to-back Prep B girls' basketball state titles.
- Dominique Toussaint, a 5-9 guard from Staten Island, N.Y., averaged 21.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 3.2 assists per game as a junior. She was named the 2015 Queens Player of the Year, CHSAA Sportsmanship Player of the Year and earned First Team honors after helping lead Christ the King to the CHSAA Class AA State Semi-Final as a junior. Toussaint also earned Tri-State Second Team and NYS All-Tournament Team honors as she was a member of the team that won the NYC High School Championship and finished second in the New York State Federation Champion in 2014-15. She is ESPN-W's No. 48 overall recruit and No. 12 at her position and ranked at No. 25 by Prospect Nation in the 2016 class.
- Lisa Jablonowski, a 6-3 forward from Luxembourg, brings international experience as she has competed in 46 games in international tournaments. In 2015, Jablonowski averaged 14.6 points per game, 8.6 rebounds per game and 3.4 assists per game in the U18 European Championship. She received the Best Sportswoman, the most prestigious award in Luxembourg, for her performance in the 2014-15 season. A three-time MVP of the U16 and U18 divisions, she helped her team win the Luxembourg Cup in 2014 and guided them to second place finishes in the U14, U16 and U18 championships.

#### PRESEASON ALL-ACC

- Senior guard Faith Randolph was named to the 10-player Blue Ribbon Panel and the ACC Head Coaches' Preseason All-ACC Teams.
- Randolph ranked sixth in the conference in scoring at 16.4 points per game. Randolph tallied 11 20-point games last season en route to scoring her 1,000th career point during the 2015 ACC Tournament.
- Randolph was first on the team in steals (1.4 per game), third in rebounds (3.9), and third in assists (2.2). Among ACC players, she ranked first in free-throw percentage (90.7).
- Randolph was the 2014 ACC Sixth Player of the Year and a 2015 All-ACC Second Team honoree.
- Ataira Franklin was the last Cavalier to earn conference preseason accolades, earning them both her junior and senior seasons (2012 and 2013).

#### **CAVALIERS EIGHTH IN ACC PRESEASON POLL**

- For the second time in the last three seasons, Virginia was picked to finish eighth in the preseason ACC polls.
- Last season, Virginia was tabbed to finish 10th in prognostications, going on to finish ninth with eight ACC teams making the NCAA Tournament. Virginia earned the conference's automatic qualifier into the WNIT.
- Six of the Cavaliers' top seven scorers from last season are back: Faith Randolph (16.4 ppg) Mikayla Venson (11.9 ppg), Breyana Mason (9.5 ppg), Lauren Moses (6.1 ppg), Aliyah Huland El (5.6 ppg) and Sydney Umeri (2.7 ppg).

- In June, senior guard Faith Randolph traveled to Giżycko, Poland, playing point guard for an Athletes in Action team.
- The United States' contingent stayed at Poland's Olympic Training Center, taking on teams from Poland, Latvia and France.
- Sophomore point guard Mikayla Venson traveled to Colorado Springs in May to compete in U.S. National Team Trials, vying for a pot on the U19 team.
- Venson had previously attended U16 Team trials in 2011.




