## LEADING OFF

- At 293 games, North Carolina is Virginia's most played opponent in an all-time series that first began in 1891. The Tar Heels own a 181-108-4 advantage against the Cavaliers.
- Virginia has won seven of the last 10 games against North Carolina, despite dropping two out of three in Chapel Hill last season.
- North Carolina comes into the weekend series having won eight of its last nine games while Virginia has won four of its last five.
- The series will feature two of the ACC's top three hitters in North Carolina's Kyle Datres (.379) and Virginia's Andy Weber (.373).
- Ranked as high as No. 12 (Collegiate Baseball), North Carolina will be the first ranked opponent Virginia faces since the season opener against then-No. 22 UCF (Baseball America).
- The Cavaliers have won both of its ACC series this season at home and own a 15-5 overall mark at Disharoon Park.

## REIGNING PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Friday night's starting pitcher Derek Casey was named the ACC co-Pitcher of the Week on Monday (April 9) after tossing a complete game shutout against Virginia Tech last Friday (April 6.) He is the first Cavalier to be recognized by the league this season and the first Virginia pitcher to take home the award since Connor Jones did it twice in 2016.
- Casey did not walk a batter and only one Hokie baserunner reached second base. The right-hander fanned seven, upping his season total to 70.
- The nine-inning shutout was the first by a Virginia pitcher since Jones blanked Boston College on April 8, 2016.

## MOUND NUMBERS

- Virginia ranks second in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (10.8) and third in total strikeouts with 355.
- The Cavaliers' 3.03 strikeout to walk ratio is 13th-best in the country.
- Virginia is one of 16 teams in the nation with five or more shutouts. The five shutouts are the most since the Cavaliers posted eight in 2014.
- Virginia pitchers have struck out 10 or more batters in 22 of the 33 games this season and 12 of the 15 ACC games.
- The 1-2 punch of Derek Casey (70) and Daniel Lynch (68) rank second and third in the ACC in strikeouts respectively.
- Daniel Lynch has struck out 10 or more batters in each of his last four starts, including a career-best 12-strikeout performance at Pitt on March 31. The only other pitcher in Virginia history to go four-straight games with 10+ strikeouts is UVA baseball Hall of Famer, Danny Hultzen. He struck out 10 or more in his first five starts of the 2011 season.

### FIRST YEAR IMPACT

- Virginia first years, Tanner Morris, Brendan Rivoli and Alex Tappen were responsible for eight of the team's season-high 16 hits on Wednesday (April 11) vs. Radford.
- First years Kyle Whitten and Blake Rohm pitched the final two innings of the contest, yielding a combined one run on two hits.
- On Wednesday Morris became the third Cavalier this season to put forth a four-hit effort in 2018. He scored a game-high three runs and drove in 14th run of the season in the fourth inning.
- Tappen broke the game open in the bottom of the eighth with the team's first grand slam of 2018. He finished the night 2-for-5 with five RBIs.
- After hitting for the series cycle against Virginia Tech, Rivoli ignited a five-run second inning with a two-RBI single.

### ACC RANKINGS

- The Cavaliers have only struck out 174 times as a collective offensive unit, the least in the ACC. Virginia is the only team in the league that has not struck out more than 200 times.
- Andy Weber is tied for the league lead in hits (50), second in batting average (.374), second in doubles (12), sixth in RBI (31) and seventh in slugging percentage (.560).

### PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

- Andy Weber has reached base safely in 19-straight games, the second highest streak by a Cavalier this season (Eikhoff-21). He's been held hitless in just four games this year.
- In his last five games, Tanner Morris is batting .522 (12-for-23) with nine runs scored.
- Brendan Rivoli is 7-for-15 with two doubles, a triple, a home run and five RBIs in his last four games played.
- Cayman Richardson brings a career-high, eight-game hit streak into the series. He is batting .400 (12-for-36) with eight runs scored and five RBIs in that span.
- Nate Eikhoff, one of three Cavaliers to play and start in all 33 games, is six hits away from 100 for his career.
- Alex Tappen matched Andy Weber for the most RBIs in a single-game this season with five. Including the team's first grand slam of the season on Wednesday night against Radford, he has homered in back-to-back games.

### FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC

- Virginia clinched its second ACC series of the season on Sunday with a 6-5, walk-off win against Virginia Tech. It marked the third time for the Cavaliers in 2018 that a conference series has been decided on the last at bat.
- Nine of the team's 19 wins on the season have been in come-from-behind fashion, four in the seventh-inning or later.
- The Cavaliers have been involved in 12, one-run games in which they own a 7-5 record.

### SEASON STREAKS

- Nate Eikhoff had his hit streak of 16 games snapped on 3/24 at Miami. He is one of nine players since 2001 to have put together hit streaks of 16 or more. Eikhoff reached base in his first 21 games of the season
- Andy Weber continued a hit streak of four games started in 2017 and ran it all the way to 12 by hitting safely in his first eight games of 2018. Weber topped that by hitting safely 13-straight games from March 10-31, a span of 13 games.

- The name change was formally approved by the University of Virginia Board of Visitors on March 2, 2018.
- The stadium's namesake is to honor Leslie B. Disharoon and Ann Merriwether Disharoon, long time supporters of the Virginia baseball program.

## RECORD HOME OPENER

- Unveiling the newly expanded Davenport Field, a crowd of 3,709 turned out on Tuesday (Feb. 20), a new record for a UVA home opener.
- Temperature at game time hit 75 degrees, making it the warmest opener in the stadium's history.

## VIRGINIA BASEBALL TURNS 130

- Virginia will commence its 130th season of baseball in 2018.
- Going into the season, the program has accumulated 2,297 wins and owns an all-time winning percentage of .570.

## MCCARTHY PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Junior Jake McCarthy is a unanimous preseason All-American and garnered first team honors from D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA. He was recognized by Baseball America, *Collegiate Baseball*, and Perfect Game as a second team honoree.
- In addition to All-America honors, Baseball America tabbed McCarthy as the "fastest runner" on its list of players across the country with the best tools.
- McCarthy was listed on the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list. He is one of eight ACC players on the initial 55-player list. Last year, Virginia's Adam Haseley was a finalist for the award annually bestowed on the nation's top amateur baseball player.

## 2018 HOOS KEY FIGURES

- Virginia returns 23 letterwinners from a year ago, including three starting pitchers that made 10+ starts in 2017.
- The Cavaliers' projected lineup features five returners (McCarthy, Andy Weber, Caleb Knight, Nate Eikhoff and Justin Novak) that saw action in 40 or more games last season. Novak, Weber and Charlie Cody have each appeared in 80 or more games over the course of their careers. Novak is the team's active leader with 124 career games played.

- Current LSU head coach Paul Mainieri, will serve as the manager for Team USA this summer.
- O'Connor spent nine seasons working as an assistant on Mainieri's staff at Notre Dame from 1995-2003.
- While working together, the Irish posted an overall record of 399-160-1, won six conference championships and made six trips to the NCAA Tournament.
- O'Connor's college coach at Creighton, Jim Hendry, will also be on staff as the bench coach. Hendry now works for the New York Yankees as a special assignment scout.

## VIRGINIA INJURY UPDATES

- It was announced shortly before the start of the 2018 season that outfielder Cameron Simmons will miss the year due to a left shoulder injury.
- A second team All-ACC selection as a sophomore, Simmons started all but three games for the Cavaliers in 2017. He was second on the team and fourth in the ACC with a .352 batting average. In conference play, he hit .374, tops on the team and the third highest average in the league.
- Junior preseason All-American Jake McCarthy was sidelined after sustaining a left wrist injury on March 6 vs. Davidson. He is expected to miss six weeks and make a full recovery.
