### FOR OPENERS

- UVA meets Middle Tennessee for the second time.
- The Cavaliers own a nation-leading 21-game winning streak in the month of November dating back to the 2015-16 season.
- UVA is 117-35 (.770) in non-conference action under Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers have captured championships in each of their last five Thanksgiving holiday tournaments (Emerald Coast Classic, Charleston Classic, Barclays Center Classic, Corpus Christi Challenge, NIT Season Tip-Off).

### ALL-TIME VS. THE BLUE RAIDERS

- UVA is 1-0 all-time against Middle Tennessee in a series that dates back to the 1988-89 season.
- No. 5 seed Virginia defeated No. 13 seed Middle Tennessee 104-88 in the second round of the 1989 NCAA Tournament in Nashville, Tenn.
- Richard Morgan had a game-high 33 points, while Bryant Stith added 26 points and John Crotty chipped in 25 in the win.
- UVA shot 54.7 percent from the floor and went 27 of 34 from the charity stripe.
- Randy Henry and Chris Rainey led Middle Tennessee with 23 points apiece.

### LAST TIME OUT

- De'Andre Hunter had a season-high 20 points and Mamadi Diakite added a career-high 18 points as No. 4 Virginia routed Coppin State 97-40 on Friday, Nov. 16.
- UVA's 97 points were its most under 10th-year head coach Tony Bennett and the 57-point win was the third largest in school history.
- Ty Jerome added 11 points and six assists and Kihei Clark sank a trio of 3-pointers in the lopsided win.
- UVA shot 60.3 percent from the field and went 15 of 25 from 3-point range.

### UVA VS. CONFERENCE USA

- UVA meets its first current C-USA opponent since losing to Old Dominion 63-61 on Dec. 22, 2012.
- Virginia is 20-7 all-time vs. current C-USA foes (9-5 vs. Old Dominion, 6-2 vs. Marshall, 2-0 vs. Rice, 1-0 vs. Middle Tennessee, 1-1 vs. UAB and 1-1 vs. Western Kentucky).

### GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its opponents to 46.3 points per game, including 40 vs. Coppin State and 42 vs. Towson.
- The Cavaliers are 78-2 when holding foes to fewer than 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- The Cavaliers limited opponents to 34.8 percent shooting from the floor and 28.6 percent from 3-point range.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 103-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 13-year coaching career.

### UVA RANKED NO. 4 IN AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked No. 4 in the AP poll for the second straight week.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons.
- The Cavaliers were unranked in the 2017-18 preseason polls, but became the fourth team in the Top 25 era (1990-present) to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.
- Dating back to last season, UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 19 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 15 polls.

### HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Virginia is led by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Jerome leads UVA with 17 points and 5.7 assists per game.
- Guy is averaging 11.7 points, while De'Andre Hunter is averaging 14.3 points and Salt is the lone senior on the team.
- Salt missed the Coppin State game with back stiffness, ending his 70-game starting streak.
- Transfer Braxton Key has averaged 6.3 points and 6.3 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 10 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark is averaging 5.0 points and 3.7 assists, and Jay Huff is averaging 6.7 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- Back-up guard Marco Anthony has averaged 12.7 minutes of action.
- Kody Stattmann, Austin Katstra and Jayden Nixon provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Redshirt freshman Francesco Badochi has taken an indefinite leave of absence from the team due to medical issues.
- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in three home games.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 222-86 (.721) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 291-118 (.712) career mark in 13 seasons overall.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record six straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best seven straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 117-35 (.769) in non-conference action, 105-51 (.673) in ACC play and 131-25 (.840) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .673, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

**TYING US TOGETHER**

- Point guard Ty Jerome is averaging a team-high 17 points, 5.7 assists and 4.3 rebounds.
- Jerome has reached double figures in each of UVA's three games, including back-to-back 20-point efforts in the first two contests.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylvan Landesburg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Ty Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.
- Jerome was an ACC Tournament second-team selection.
- Jerome ranked fourth in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.44) and seventh in steals (1.62).

**THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS**

- Kyle Guy is third on the team in scoring (11.7 ppg), highlighted by his seventh career 20-point effort vs. George Washington.
- Guy has shot 42.6 percent (140 of 329) from 3-point range during his career and has made five or more 3-pointers in seven games.
- Guy holds UVA's career 3-point percentage record, edging Keith Freel's (2000-01) mark of 42.1 percent.
- Guy has scored 20 or more points in seven career games (4 in 2017-18), including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy made at least one 3-pointer in UVA's first 28 games, which marked the fourth longest streak in UVA history.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.

**DRE'S WAY**

- De'Andre Hunter has reached double figures in every game, averaging 14.3 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- He recorded a season-high 20 points (4 of 4 3FGs) against Coppin State and tallied his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds in 2017-18.
- He shot 48.8 percent from the field, 38.2 percent from 3-point range and 75.5 percent from the free throw line.
- Hunter reached double figures in 16 games, including team highs against Monmouth (career-high 23), Georgia Tech (17), Virginia Tech (14), Syracuse (15), Miami (ACC-high 22) and Pitt (14, including career-high 10 rebounds).
- Hunter was named ACC Co-Rookie of the Week following his 22-point performance at Miami.
- He banked in the game-winning 3-pointer at Louisville (3/1/18).
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

**THREE CAVALIERS EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS**

- The Cavaliers' Kyle Guy joined preseason ACC Player of the Year Luke Maye (North Carolina), RJ Barrett (Duke), Tyus Battle (Syracuse) and Ky Bowman on the All-ACC first team.
- Virginia's De'Andre Hunter and Ty Jerome were joined on the second team by Zion Williamson (Duke), Justin Robinson (Virginia Tech) and Marquise Reed (Clemson).

**WATCH ME NOW**

- Ty Jerome (Bob Cousy Award), Kyle Guy (Jerry West Award) and De'Andre Hunter (Julius Erving Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award watch lists.
- Guy and Hunter are among 50 players to watch for the 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year honor and 20 players for the NABA Division I Player of the Year award.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 169-41 (.804), including a 3-0 mark in 2018-19, in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 16-1 at JPJ last season and is 131-25 (.840), including a 96-10 (.906) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 49-5 (.907) in league home games over the past six seasons. Duke is second at 48-6 (.889).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for nine straight seasons.

**HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia has held two opponents to fewer than 50 points and is 78-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era (2-0 in 2018-19).
- Bennett-coached teams are 103-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 22-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

## ABOUT THE 2018-19 SCHEDULE

- Five of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 poll (Duke, North Carolina, Virginia Tech, Florida State and Clemson), while four (Maryland, Syracuse, Miami and Notre Dame) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 12 games against 2018 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Marshall, Miami, Syracuse and Virginia Tech; road contests at Clemson, Duke, North Carolina, NC State, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA could meet NCAA Tournament teams Butler, Florida and Oklahoma in the Battle 4 Atlantis.
- Four opponents (Boston College, Middle Tennessee, Notre Dame and Louisville) participated in the 2018 National Invitation Tournament.

## THE ELECTRIC 70s, AWESOME 80s & DIVINE 90s

- Virginia scored over 70 points in each of its first three games and is 110-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett and 112-80 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.
- UVA scored 97 points against Coppin State and is 3-0 when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.
- UVA's lone loss under Bennett when scoring 80 or more was a 93-81 loss at UNC in 2012-13.
- UVA was the first ACC team to win seven straight conference games (Jan. 6-27, 2018) while scoring fewer than 70 points in any game.

## VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by Virginia, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pittsburgh.

## CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Los Angeles) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brogdon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17, is in his third season with the Bucks.
- Scott is in his seventh season (first with Los Angeles) and Harris is in his fifth NBA season (third with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his fourth season (first with Atlanta).
- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

- Virginia and Maine lead the nation with current players from five different continents. In addition to North America, UVA is represented by Africa (Mamadi Diakite), Europe (Francesco Badocchi), South America (Francisco Caffaro) and Australia (Kody Stattmann).
- New Zealander Jack Salt gives the Cavaliers five foreign players.

## UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 31-31 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 5-1 record in 2017-18.
- The Cavaliers are 146-327 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA's win over then-No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27 marked the Cavaliers first road win vs. a top-5 ranked foe since 1993 (77-69 over No. 3 Duke).
- UVA is 1-29 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

## RECORDS WATCH

- Kyle Guy is UVA's career 3-point percentage leader at 42.6 percent.
- Guy has drilled 140 of 329 career 3-point attempts and needs 22 3's to pass Devin Smith (161 3's) for 10th on UVA's all-time list.
- Ty Jerome needs two 3-pointers to reach 100 for his career, qualifying him for fifth on UVA's career list at 40.5 percent.

## 50-40-75 CLUB

- Virginia is 32-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 75 percent from the free throw line in the same game under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA is 1-0 this season after achieving the mark against Coppin State and was 5-0 last season when achieving the 50-40-75 mark (Austin Peay, VCU, Rhode Island, Davidson, NC State and Louisville).

## 2017-18 IN REVIEW

- Virginia claimed its eighth ACC regular-season title and third ACC Tournament title.
- The Cavaliers won a school-record 31 games and earned their first No. 1 ranking in the AP poll since 1982.
- UVA earned its school-record fifth consecutive NCAA Tournament bid, earning its first No. 1 overall seed and sixth No. 1 seed overall.
- The Cavaliers led the nation in scoring defense for the fourth time under head coach Tony Bennett at 54 points per game. UVA also ranked first in the nation in turnovers per game at 8.5 per game.
- Tony Bennett was named the NCAA Division I Coach of the Year by the AP, USBWA, NABC, Naismith, Basketball Times, USA Today and SI.
- Kyle Guy became Virginia's ninth All-America selection, earning third-team honors from the NABC and AP.

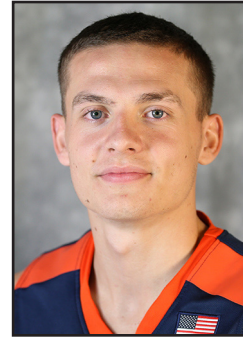

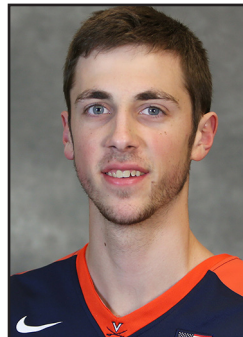
