NOTEWORTHY

- Stony Brook gave the Big East all it could handle on Saturday night, falling to Providence 82-78 at the Dunkin' Donuts Center in Rhode Island.
- The Seawolves rallied from a deficit as large as 14 to take the lead in the second half but were unable to keep the Friar's 3-point attack at bay.
- Junior Elijah Olaniyi led the way with 25 points, nine rebounds and four steals. Four different Stony Brook players were in double figures as the team combined to hit 11 threes.
- The squads were even on the rebounding front, each grabbing 39 while Stony Brook hauled in 12 offensive rebounds.
- The Seawolves enter Thursday's competition sixth in the country in opponent's 2-point field goal percentage, with teams shooting 39.6 percent from inside the arc against them.
- Stony Brook's two-game winning stretch game to an end on Tuesday night, as it lost the Battle of Long Island, 71-63, at the hands of its Nassau County foes Hofstra.
- Redshirt-junior **Andrew Garcia** had the team's first doubledouble of the year, totaling 18 points and 12 rebounds in the loss.
- A layup from **Elijah Olaniyi** cut Hofstra's lead to 62-61 with 4:41 to play, but the Seawolves were held scoreless outside of two free throws when the game was out of reach.
- The Seawolves extended its winning stretch to seven in its last eight after a controlling 79-63 victory over Brown on Saturday_night at Island Federal Arena.

THE OPPONENT

The Cavaliers are coming off an ACC victory in their last contest 10 days ago, taking down North Carolina 56-47 at John Paul Jones Arena.

Mamadi Diakite led the way with 12 points but fouled out of the contest, while Tomas Woldetensae had 11 points and Francisco Caffaro added 10 and seven boards.

On the year, Diakite leads the squad in scoring, putting in 13.2 per night. He's also third on the team in rebounding at a 6.6 per night clip. Braxton Key leads the Cavs on the board, hauling in 8.3 a game.

The hosts have committed the second-fewest fouls in the country and are first in FG% defense. Teams are shooting 3.1 percent from the field against them, translating to 44.2 points against per game.

THE SERIES

This is the first time the Seawolves and Cavaliers have met in each program's history. It is also the first time Stony Brook has played the defending champions and third Top 10 opponent in program history.

NEW ERA, NEW ATTITUDE: SEAWOLVES READY FOR 2019-20 CAMPAIGN

New head coach Geno Ford steps into his third head coaching role as the Seawolves get ready to tip off the new season on Tuesday night, playing host to Yale at 7 p.m. on SNY and ESPN+. Ford has coached previously at Kent State and Bradley before joining then-head coach Jeff Boals in Seawolves Country.

He now takes over a team with his own touch to it, bringing in junior college transfer **Mo Gueye** and having Chattanooga transfer **Makale Foreman** ready for service, this team is ready for the new season. With no seniors on the team, they will look to returning All-League juniors **Elijah Olaniyi**, **Foreman** and **Jeff Otchere** to lead a team that won 24 games a season ago.

ON THE BOARDS

The Seawolves have been very aggressive on the offensive glass as of late, grabbing over a third of their misses in three of five contests this season.

Against Providence, the visiting team grabbed exactly that, 33.3 percent, of its misses to create extra offensive opportunities. This allowed the team to pour in 78 points, its third-highest offensive output against D1 opposition this season.

COLD OUTSIDE, HOT (FROM) OUTSIDE

As the weather has gotten colder on Long Island, the Seawolves have begun to heat up from the outside. After making 11 threes on Saturday, Stony Brook is shooting just under 40 percent as a team from deep.

This includes a 14-for-25 output against Brown at home. The Seawolves also made half of their 3-point attempts in the second half, clawing back from double figures down to take multiple leads.

RANKED OPPONENTS

This will be the third-highest ranked opponent that Stony Brook has faced in its Division I history, facing the No. 2 team in the country twice in its history (Michigan State in 2017 and UConn in 2008).

Stony Brook owns one ranked win, a defeat of No. 13 Washington on December 28, 2014, in which the Seawolves defeated the Huskies 62-57 in Seattle.

TOUGH TWOS

The Seawolves defense has been tenacious inside of the arc this season, as teams have shot 39.4 percent from 2-point range. That mark places them fifth in the country, ahead of defenses like Kentucky, Maryland and Louisville.

Only one team has shot above 45 percent inside the arc in the last eight games. Opposition during that stretch is 110-for-297 (37.0 percent) from two.

CENTURY-MARK

Junior **Jeff Otchere** blocked his 100th career shot on Tuesday afternoon, becoming the fifth player in Seawolves history to the mark and the second in the Division I history of the program.

Doing so in his 44th game, he is the fastest to reach the milestone by 27 games. The Seawolves' career block leader, Jameel Warney, did so in 71 games.

BIG OPPORTUNITIES

The next two matchups for the Seawolves pose Power 5 opposition, the first time since the 2016-17 season that they played big-conference opposition in back to back contests.

After Saturday night's battle with Providence, they head to play the defending national champion Virginia on Wednesday night in Charlottesville, Va.

30-PIECE

Junior Elijah Olaniyi recorded the team's first 30-point output of the season, hitting 11 of 15 shots and six of nine from long range in the win. It bested his previous careerhigh of 28 that came against Hartford last season.

It is the first 30-point outing since Jaron Cornish went for that number against UMass Lowell on February 9 of last season.

NO FREE THROWS FOR YOU!

Defensively this season, Stony Brook has done a great job of keeping opposing teams off of the foul line, currently holding a free throw rate of 23.7 percent. That sits 38th nationally.

FT Rate divides the amount of free throw attempts by field goal attempts, helping figure out how effective teams are getting to the free throw line.

BLOCKED

Since the addition of junior Jeff Otchere (and this season, Mo Gueye), the Seawolves have made their presence felt inside the line, recording two of the highest block percentages in D1 history.

Last season, the team blocked 12.6 of opposing 2-point shots, which ranked 32nd in the country. This season, they are even more aggressive in the block department, swatting 14.5 percent of opposing twos.

HOME COOKING

The Seawolves have been able to score comfortably at home this season, tallying 76 points per game in their three times at Island Federal Arena. Four players are averaging in double figures, with Olaniyi leading the way at 21.5 per night.

Stony Brook is also dominating on the glass inside The Island, hauling in 45.5 rebounds per game. 14 of those have come on the offensive boards with a plus-10.7 margin.

THREES A CROWD

After only eclipsing the 30 percent mark once in the first four games, the Seawolves have done it five of the last seven games, including making 47.6 percent against UTRGV and 54.2 percent against Wagner.

As a team, the Seawolves are shooting 39.5 percent over the last five games from deep. Andrew Garcia leads the way by making them at a 40.9 percent clip.

OFFENDING DEFENSES

Stony Brook has been able to get going on the offensive glass, cracking double figures in four of the last six contests. Led by 17 against Delaware, the Seawolves have also grabbed 12 and 11 during the span, coming to an average of 10.8 per night.
