V TODD DESORBO HEAD COACH



Todd DeSorbo was hired as the head men's and women's swimming and diving coach in August 2017. He joins the UVA staff after serving on the staff at NC State the past six seasons as the associate head coach.

At NC State, DeSorbo worked primarily with the Wolfpack sprinters and was a developmental specialist. He oversaw the programs' recruiting, training and day-to-day operations.

During his tenure at NC State, DeSorbo coached American Olympic gold medalist Ryan Held (2016 Rio 4x100 free relay), USA Swimming national champion Justin Ress and NCAA Champions in the 4x100 free relay (2016) and 4x200 free relay (2017). The NC State men won the last three ACC titles and the Wolfpack women captured the 2017 ACC title. Both NC State programs produced their highest finishes at the NCAA Championships this past season. The Wolfpack men placed fourth overall while the women's team finished seventh.

In 2017, his athletes earned seven individual ACC titles and garnered 14 All-ACC honors, helping to lead both programs to sweep their respective ACC Championships meets. Additionally, DeSorbo coached 13 athletes to the 2017 NCAA Championships where they collected over 30 All-America honors on the way to the teams highest NCAA finishes in program history.

On the men's side, he led sprint standout Held to three top-eight individual performances at NCAAs, highlighted by a runner-up title in the 50 freestyle in a time of 18.60. Andreas Vaziaos also tabbed three top-eight finishes, his highest being fifth in the 200 butterfly with a conference record and school record of 1:40.80.

DeSorbo helped the women's team clinch its first conference title since 1980. Under his leadership, Ky-lee Perry had an outstanding rookie season in which she was crowned champion in the 50 freestyle in school record pace of 21.88 and qualified for NCAAs in the 50 and 100 freestyle. Perry was named ACC Female Freshman of the Year.

In the summer of 2016, DeSorbo coached three athletes to the Rio Olympic Games, as Held qualified for the U.S.A.'s 4x100m freestyle relay, Soeren Dahl qualified for Denmark's a 4x200m freestyle relay and Simona Bilis qualified the 50m and 100m freestyle. Held made history as he helped the United States win a gold medal in

the relay. He posted a split of 47.73 alongside teammates Caleb Dressel, Michael Phelps and Nathan Adrian to notch a time of 3:12.38.

During the 2015-16 season, DeSorbo helped Bilis finish his career as the most decorated All-American in the NCAA era with 19 honors during the 2015-16 season. At the 2016 NCAA Championship Bilis earned top-three finishes in the 50,100 and 200 freestyle, marking the fourth person in NCAA history to do so. DeSorbo also guided the men's 400 free relay of Held, Bilis, Andreas Schiellerup and Dahl to the program and conference's first NCAA title in a relay event.

He additionally helped the men's squad win four of five relay events at the conference championship and the team's second-straight conference title, as well as earn All-America honors in all five swims at the national meet. Prior to working at NC State, DeSorbo spent five seasons as the assistant coach at UNC Wilmington. At UNCW, DeSorbo assisted with all facets of the Seahawk program, including recruiting, student-athlete development and practice. During DeSorbo's tenure in Wilmington, the Seahawk men won five of 10 straight CAA titles and the women finished in the top-three of the conference every year.

Student-athletes directly under his tutelage set 35 school records, earned 100 all-conference honors, won 32 individual and relay conference championships, and collected 80 top-three conference finishes.

Prior to joining the UNCW staff full-time, DeSorbo served as the head swim coach for the Cape Fear Aquatic Club from 2005-07, and was a graduate assistant at UNCW from 1999-2000.

DeSorbo began his collegiate swimming career at Kentucky before transferring to UNCW in 1998-99. As a senior at UNCW, DeSorbo was named CAA Championships Swimmer of the Meet in 1999 after winning titles in the 200 backstroke, and both the 200 and 400 individual medley. He set school records in both the 200 and 400 individual medley, and made the All-ECAC team in 1999 by winning the 400 individual at the Eastern Championships.

DeSorbo holds two accounting degrees from UNCW, earning a bachelor's degree in 1999 and a master's degree in 2000. A native of Salisbury, N.C., DeSorbo is married to Lauren Suggs. They have one son, Jack, and one daughter, Cate.

TYLER FENWICK ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Fenwick joined the UVA coaching staff in August 2017 as the men's and women's associate head coach.

Fenwick joins the Cavalier programs with eight years of coaching experience with three unique gold medal clubs and seven years coaching a top-25 NCAA division I program.

Fenwick joins the program after serving as the associate head coach for Tennessee for five seasons (2012-2017). Fenwick helped coach four Olympians, in addition to developing training programs for Pan American Games, World Championships and World University Games medalist. Since 2012, Fenwick has had his student-athletes tally over 200 All-America swims, while breaking 36 Tennessee School records.

During Fenwick's tenure, the Volunteer women's program maintained a GPA of 3.4 or higher.

Prior to Tennessee, Fenwick coached the men's national team at the Mission Viejo Nadadores in Mission Viejo, Calif., as a senior coach. Fenwick coached the program from 2009-12, earning a men's team championships at the 2012 U.S. Open Water Nationals. He saw two athletes earn 2012 FINA World Junior Championships honors, in addition to one U.S. national champion and one U.S. junior national champion. Fenwick had at least one athlete compete in each event at the U.S. Junior Nationals.

From 2007-09, Fenwick worked as an assistant coach at the University of Tennessee Aquatics. Fenwick oversaw the training of Christine Magnusson and Davis Tarwater, pre-

paring the athletes for the world Championships in 2009. His additionally worked to maintain Olympic standards of a 2008 Olympic silver medalist and American record holder.

Fenwick started his coaching career at Germantown Academy Aquatic Club in Fort Washington, Pa. He coached the 2005 Women's national high school champions. Under Fenwick's guidance, the team notched 30 high school all-Americans. He additionally sent swimmers to the Pan Pacific, Pan American, World Championships and Olympics.

Additionally, Fenwick was the U.S. head coach for the 2015 and 2017 World University Games and the 2017 UANA Pan American Championships. Fenwick served on the U.S. national team coaches list in 2012-13, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18.

As an athlete, Fenwick was named Kit Award for Outstanding performance at the 1999 Eastern Inter-scholastic Swimming Championships. He was a three-year letterwinner for William & Mary. Fenwick additionally was team captain of the Germantown Academy water polo team.

Fenwick holds a bachelor's degree in English from William and Mary and a master of science degree in sports management from Tennessee.

JASON GLORIUS HEAD DIVING COACH



Jason Glorius, who has guided four different Cavalier divers to the NCAA Championships, completed his third season as the Cavaliers' head diving coach in 2015-16.

2015-16 was another record year for the Cavalier diving corps, which saw three divers qualify for the NCAA Championships, the most in a single year in school history. Becca Corbett became the first UVA female diver to qualify for two national meets, while Corey Johnson and Kylie Towbin qualified for the first time. Corbett also earned All-ACC honors on 3-meter.

In 2014-15, the Cavaliers had two divers qualify for the NCAA Championships for the first time in school history, with JB Kolod qualifying for the third straight year and Becca Corbett becoming the first woman in program history to qualify for the national meet. Kolod earned honorable mention All-America honors on 3-meter. Five of the six school records fell in Glorius' second season.

Under Glorius' tutelage in 2013-14, the Cavaliers advanced six divers to the NCAA Zone Diving Championships, while JB Kolod qualified for the NCAA Championships. Kolod became the first Cavalier to make a championship final at the NCAA meet, placing seventh on 3-meter. Kolod also was the first diver from UVa to score on two different boards, finishing 10th on platform. Overall, three school records fell in Glorius' first season.

Before Charlottesville, Glorius came to UVa after four seasons at Denison University, where he was named the 2013 NCAA Division III Men's Diving Coach of the Year.

Glorius helped elevate the Big Red's diving program to new levels over his four years in Granville, Ohio, aiding Denison's men to the first two national championship teams in program history (2011, 2012).

In 2013, Glorius mentored Ben Lewis to the NCAA Division III Championship on the 1-meter boards and Gabe Dixon to a second-place finish on the 3-meter.

In four years at Denison, Glorius guided the Big Red to 17 All-America diving performances and was named the North Coast Athletic Conference Diving Coach of the Year six times, including three on the women's side (2010, 2011 and 2013) and three on the men's side (2011-13).

Glorius came to Denison after spending all of 2008 and part of 2009 as the head coach and director of the Thunderbird Diving Club in Cincinnati. In addition to running the Thunderbird club team, Glorius also coached the diving teams at Cincinnati Moeller, Indian Hill, Mariemont and Madeira high schools.

Prior to starting the Thunderbird Diving Club, Glorius was a part of the Tri State club in Cincinnati, Ohio where he worked with elite international divers who represented the United States at meets in both China and England.

Glorius graduated from Miami University in 1997 with a degree in anthropology. He dove for both Illinois and then Miami University, where he helped MU win the 1997 Mid-American Conference Championship. Glorius has four children, Bella, 7, Nika, 5, and two-year old twins, Roland and Ruby.



BLAIRE BACHMAN ASSISTANT COACH



Blaire Bachman joined the UVA coaching staff in August 2017 as an assistant coach.

Bachman has had seven years of coaching experience at the club and college level. She helped coach the 2017 Big Ten Conference Champions, Indiana, with both programs earning top-10 finishes with the men being named the No. 7 NCAA program and the women No. 8.

In 2013-14 Bachman was named the NAIA Swimming and Diving Women's Coach of the Year, while earning the Appalachian Swimming Conference Women's Coach of the Year in 2012-13-14. Bachman was a four-time American Swimming Coaches Association Coach of Excellence honoree (2011-12-13-14). In 2010-11, she was named the youngest head coach in the nation.

Bachman joins the Cavalier programs after serving as the assistant swimming coach and women's recruiting coordinator for Indiana 2016-17. Her primary responsibility was to oversee the middle distance and distance training groups. With the Hoosiers, Bachman assisted with the coaching of 2016 Olympic gold medalists Lilly King, Cody Miller and Blake Pieroni, as well as aiding the program's 2017 World Championship and World University Games qualifiers.

Prior to Indiana, Bachman spent a year as the assistant swimming coach and women's recruiting coordinator for Dartmouth. In addition to coaching, Bachman helped behind the scenes with fundraising efforts and recruiting visits in addition to implementing and planning training plans.

From 2010-15, Bachman was the head swim coach and aquatics director for Brenau. She helped the program fundraise over \$25,000 for a timing system. During this time, Bachman administered year-round training.

Bachman started her coaching career as a camp counselor and coach for the Georgia Bulldogs Swim Club (2012-2016).

Bachman received a bachelor of arts degree in mass communication from Georgia College and State University.



Wes Foltz was named a Virginia swimming assistant coach in August 2017.

Foltz served as an assistant coach at NC State in 2016-17, helping the program achieve one of its best performances in recent history. Both programs finished in the top-10 at the NCAA Championships with the men earning a fourth-place finish while the women tabbed seventh. Additionally, the programs both won the 2017 ACC title with the men capturing the championship for the third year in a row and the women earning the conference trophy for the first time since 1980. The coaching staff was named the 2017 ACC Men's and 2017 ACC Women's Staff of the Year.

During his time with the Wolfpack, Foltz helped coach 34 male and 25 female All-American performances. Additionally, he had a hand in the Pro Group Wolfpack Elite's success over the last year including a World Championship title by Simonas Bilis and a third-place finish for Cullen Jones at the 2017 U.S. World Championship Trials.

Prior to NC State, Foltz worked at Southern California (2014-16) as an assistant coach, helping the program record 64 All-American performances. During this time, the women's program captured the 2016 Pac-12 conference championship and a sixth-place finish at the NCAAs. The men's team recorded the conference title in 2015 in addition to finishing fourth at the NCAAs. The coaching staff earned Pac-12 Staff of the Year honors in 2015 for the men's program and 2016 for the women's program.

From 2012-15, Foltz was a volunteer assistant coach for NC State in addition to working with the Marlins of Raleigh swim team (2012-14) as an assistant coach.

Foltz has an extensive background operating meets helping to run the 2015 Special Olympic Games the 2015-16 Los Angeles Invitational and all of the Southern California home meets.

He has a bachelor's degree in business management from Towson. While at Towson, Foltz was awarded the most valuable swimmer for the university. He was awarded the Unsung Hero Award for Towson Swimming in 2010 in addition to being named the Rookie of the Year in 2009.
