LEADING OFF

- Like Louisville last week, Clemson comes into the weekend series on a five-game win streak.
- Virginia and Clemson split the four meetings last year, including a 10-2 Cavalier victory in the ACC Tournament. The Tigers won the final two games of the series at Doug Kingsmore Stadium in mid-March.
- The Cavaliers have won five of the last six games coming into the series, four of them have been one-run victories.
- Five of the six ACC series for Virginia this season have been decided on the final game of the weekend.
- Under Brian O'Connor, Virginia is 27-9 against Clemson and 13-2 against the Tigers at Disharoon Park since 2004.

ALL-TIME SERIES NOTES

- Virginia and Clemson first played on April 7, 1955.
- The series loss last year at Clemson was the first against the Tigers since 2005 and only the second in 10 total series with Brian O'Connor at the helm.
- Virginia avenged its worst loss in terms of run margin of the 2017 season, a 12-1 setback in Clemson on March 19, by scoring eight runs in the first inning in a 10-2 victory over the Tigers in last year's ACC Tournament.
- The Cavaliers are 5-1 in the ACC Tournament against Clemson and 22-8 overall in ACC play since 2004.

PROVIDING QUALITY

- Virginia starting pitchers have produced 16 quality starts (6 IP, 3 ER or less) this season, 10 have occurred in the 21 ACC games this season.
- Derek Casey and Daniel Lynch each have totaled six on the season to lead the staff. Casey has produced three-straight quality outings and four of his six have come against ACC foes.
- Lynch has pitched into the seventh inning in each of his last seven starts.

DOWN BUT NEVER OUT

- Sunday's 2-1 series-clinching win over Louisville was the 12th come-from-behind win of 2018 for the Cavaliers.
- The late inning rally was the second time in three weeks Virginia has mounted a comeback in the eighth inning or later to clinch a series. The Cavaliers scored four runs over its final two turns at the plate to defeat rival Virginia Tech on April 8 and scored two in the ninth to defeat Louisville last Sunday.
- Virginia has played in 16 one-run games this season and owns a 10-6 record in those contests.
- Brendan Rivoli has been in the thick of three, late game rallies. He tied the game against Virginia Tech with a triple in the bottom of the ninth of an eventual 6-5 walk-off win, delivered a walk-off double down the right field line to top George Washington in the 12th inning on April 17 and put Virginia ahead 2-1 with a run-scoring single in the top of the ninth against Louisville.

ACC/NATIONAL RANKINGS

- The Virginia pitching staff ranks fourth in the country in strikeouts per nine innings (10.5) and seventh in shutouts (6). Three of the six shutouts have come against ACC cohorts.
- Virginia has struck out 10 or more batters in 26 games and own a 16-10 record when fanning 10-plus batters.
- As a team, the Cavaliers rank fourth in the league in hits with 381 and fifth among ACC teams with a .271 team batting average.
- Andy Weber is the conference's third-best hitter with a batting average of .359. He ranks second in the league with 16 doubles, second in hits (60), fourth in total bases (89) and fifth in RBI (37).
- Derek Casey (82) and Daniel Lynch (78) are ranked second and fourth in the ACC in strikeouts.
- In ACC play this season, Cayman Richardson is batting .375, the third-highest average in the conference. Six of his seven multi-hit games have been in league play including a four-hit effort against Virginia Tech on April 6.
- As a team Virginia has struck out the least of any ACC team, 236 times. Only two others, Notre Dame and Louisville, have gone down on strikes less than 300 times.

PLAYER NOTES/TRENDS

- Bennett Sousa recorded the save in game two against Louisville and was credited with the win in the series finale. He pitched 3.2 innings of scoreless relief in the two contests and struck out six batters of the seven batters he faced in the middle game.
- Richardson had his 15-game hit streak come to a close in the finale against Louisville. He was the third Cavalier to run a streak past 10 games this season (Eikhoff-16, Weber-13, Novak-11).
- With a single in the top of the ninth to start the game-winning rally on Sunday, Weber extended his reached-base streak to 27 games.
- Richardson had three of the team's four outfield assists in last weekend's series against Louisville. He leads the team with seven in 24 outfield starts this season.
- Including Sunday's game-winning RBI, freshman Brendan Rivoli has 10 RBI in 16 games as the team's designated hitter, the most of any other Cavalier.

HOF COMPANY

- Daniel Lynch struck out 10 or more batters in four-straight starts from 3/17-4/6, including a career-best 12-strikeout performance at Pitt on March 31. The only other pitcher in Virginia history to go four-straight games with 10+ strikeouts is UVA baseball Hall of Famer, Danny Hultzen. He struck out 10 or more in his first five starts of the 2011 season. Derek Casey struck out a career-high 12 batters in back-to-back starts, the first Cavalier pitcher to record 12 or more strikeouts in consecutive starts since UVA Baseball Hall of Famer Danny Hultzen in 2011.
- Casey went on to strike out 10 or more in three-straight starts, also a feat accomplished by Hultzen in 2011.
- Hultzen went on to become the second overall pick in the 2011 draft of the Seattle Mariners and was inducted into the Inaugural UVA Baseball Hall of Fame this past January.

ACC PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Sousa was credited with the win after pitching the final 2.2 innings
- William & Mary scored three runs despite not recording a hit, one on a ground out in the top of the sixth and the game-tying run in the seventh. The Tribe took the lead after benefiting from three 11th inning Virginia errors.

NO-HIT FACTS

- The no-hitter was the seventh this season in college baseball.
- Four of the six no-hitters in Virginia history have come in the Brian O'Connor era (2004-present).

- 11 innings matched the longest no-hitter in NCAA Division I baseball since 2002, the other occurred on Feb. 28, 2015 when Lehigh blanked Iona, 2-0.
- Of the 294 MLB no-hitters, an opponent has never scored more than two runs.

VIRGINIA INJURY UPDATES

- It was announced shortly before the start of the 2018 season that outfielder Cameron Simmons will miss the year due to a left shoulder injury.
- A second team All-ACC selection as a sophomore, Simmons started all but three games for the Cavaliers in 2017. He was second on the team and fourth in the ACC with a .352 batting average. In conference play, he hit .374, tops on the team and the third highest average in the league.
- Junior preseason All-American Jake McCarthy was sidelined after sustaining a left wrist injury on March 6 vs. Davidson. He is expected to miss six weeks and make a full recovery.

- Brian O'Connor was on the same list when he was an assistant at Notre Dame.

BACK-TO-BACK TOP-10 PICKS

- In the 2017 MLB Draft, Virginia had six players selected, including two in the top-10 of the first round.
- Juniors Pavin Smith (Diamondbacks) and Adam Haseley (Phillies) went back-to-back, after being selected seventh and eighth overall, respectively.
- Smith and Haseley were the first set of position players from the same college to be selected in the top 10 of an MLB Draft since Oklahoma State's Monty Fariss and Robin Ventura in 1988.
- UVA is one of just two college programs to boast a first-round draft pick in each of the last four seasons.

HOOS IN THE WORLD SERIES

- Derek Fisher became the second Cavalier to win a World Series as a member of the Houston Astros. He scored the game-winning run in game five on a walk-off single by Alex Bregman.
- Chris Taylor was named co-MVP of the 2017 NLCS after batting .316 with two home runs, five runs scored and three RBIs.
