QUICK HITS

AROUND THE ACC

■ No. 4 Clemson and No. 20 NC State are two of the 11 remaining undefeated teams in FBS competition. Both teams have the week off prior to the Wolfpack's visit to Death Valley on Saturday, Oct. 20.

■ The Tigers are the only team in ACC history to start 6-0 in four consecutive seasons. Clemson has started 6-0 in six of the last eight seasons and has won 28 of its last 30 games against conference opponents. Last week, Clemson won its 10th-consecutive game over Wake Forest by a 63-3 score. The Tiger's 60-point margin of victory was the program's largest in conference play in school history.

■ NC State is 5-0 for the first time since 2002 and is ranked 20th in the AP Top 25 poll and 19th in the Coaches Poll. The Wolfpack's seven-game win streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. Only UCF (18 games), Ohio State (11) and Alabama (8) have a longer streak than the Pack. Clemson has won six in a row and Miami has won five straight.

■ Five teams in the Atlantic Division - Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Syracuse and Wake Forest - have the weekend off. The only game in the Atlantic this weekend is Louisville at Boston College on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. on RSN. Last year, BC running back AJ Dillon rushed for a career-high 272 yards on 39 carries as the Eagles snapped a four-game losing streak to the Cardinals.

■ All seven teams in the Coastal Division are in action this Saturday with Duke at Georgia Tech at 12:20 p.m. on Raycom Sports, Pitt at No. 5 Notre Dame at 2:30 p.m. on NBC, Virginia Tech at North Carolina at 7 p.m. on ESPNU and No. 16 Miami at Virginia at 7 p.m. on ESPN2.

THREE IN AP TOP 25

■ Led by No. 4 Clemson, three ACC teams are ranked in this week's Associated Press Top 25 football poll (Oct. 7). Miami is No. 16 after a win Saturday over Florida State, and NC State moved up to No. 20 after a 28-23 victory over Boston College.

■ Clemson has been ranked in 59 consecutive AP polls, including 56 in the top 10.

■ Last season, the Wolfpack was ranked 10 weeks during the season, reaching as high as No. 14 in late October. That marked the first time NC State was ranked in the AP poll since the final poll of the 2010 season.

WEEK SIX NOTABLE PERFORMANCES

■ Clemson's 63-3 win over Wake Forest was the largest margin of victory in a road conference game in ACC history, and the second-largest margin of victory in any road game in ACC history.

■ Georgia Tech's 66-31 win at Louisville tied for third-most points on the road in ACC history. It also tied for the second-most points on the road in league play in ACC history.

• Ten of 14 ACC Football teams earned a graduation success rate (GSR) at or above the FBS average of 76. That ties for first among Power 5 conferences, both in terms of percentage and in total number.

• The ACC remains the only Power 5 conference to have multiple teams score 90 or higher in GSR each year since 2005. Duke (96), Wake Forest (93) and Boston College (90) reached that plateau last year.

• In the 2018 U.S. News and World “Best Colleges” rankings, ACC member schools combine for an average rank of 54.7, marking the 12th straight year that the ACC has led all Power 5 conferences.

ATHLETICS

• The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men’s basketball, women’s basketball and baseball over the last four years.

• The ACC has won a combined four football and men’s basketball national titles over the last five years, twice as many as any other conference.

• The ACC has had a team in either the College Football Playoff or the BCS National Championship Game in each of the past five years.

• The ACC led all conferences with 10 bowl teams in 2017. Over the last two years, the ACC has had a nation’s best 21 teams in bowl games.

• The ACC has earned at least six bowl bids in 17 consecutive seasons. The league ranks second among all conferences with 116 total bowl appearances since 2005.

• Since 2013, the ACC is second among all conferences with 54 postseason appearances, has the second-best record of any conference in BCS, New Year’s Six and CFP games, and is tied for the most national championships (Florida State in 2013, Clemson in 2016).

• Over the last four years, the ACC is 13-3 in games against the SEC on rivalry week, which features Clemson-South Carolina, Florida State-Florida, Georgia Tech-Georgia and Louisville-Kentucky. The league was 3-1 in 2017, winning all three games on the road.

• Two of the last five national champions have come from the ACC, and the league has had a team in the national championship game in three of the last five years. Both are tied for the most from any conference.

• An ACC football player has won the Heisman Trophy or the Campbell Trophy – commonly referred to as the “Academic Heisman” – in four of the last five years, something no other league can claim.

■ Georgia Tech now has three of the four highest-scoring road games in ACC history.

■ Georgia Tech became the fourth team in ACC history to score 60-or-more points in back-to-back games. The Yellow Jackets beat Bowling Green 63-17 and Louisville 66-31.

■ Georgia Tech and Clemson had the two highest ACC rushing totals of the season in week six. The Yellow Jackets' 542 rushing yards were the second-highest total in a game between two ACC teams, ranking just behind the 582 yards rushing by Maryland over Virginia in 1975. Georgia Tech has the overall ACC record with 604 rushing yards vs. Kansas in 2011.

■ Georgia Tech rushed for 400 yards-or-more for the third time in six games this season, seventh time since the beginning of the 2017 season (17 games) and 24th time in 11 seasons under head coach Paul Johnson.

■ Eight ACC players rushed for 100-or-more yards in week six (Oct. 5-6), the most of any single-week this year.

■ Clemson RB Travis Etienne gained 167 yards on 10 carries with three rushing touchdowns, including two of Clemson's six touchdowns of 50-plus yards on the day. He became the first Clemson player to rush for three touchdowns in back-to-back games since Travis Zachery in 1999. Also became the first Clemson player with four-straight 100-yard rushing games since Woodrow Dantzler in 2000.

■ Florida State defensive end Brian Burns recorded three tackles for loss for 16 yards and two sacks for 11 yards against Miami. Burns also forced two fumbles (the first of which was recovered by linebacker DeCalon Brooks), was credited with a quarterback hurry and swatted away a pass. Burns ranks second nationally with three forced fumbles on the season, fifth with 7.0 sacks and 16th with 9.5 tackles for loss. Burns leads the league in forced fumbles and sacks.

■ Syracuse defensive end Alton Robinson turned in a dominant performance in the win at Pitt. He recorded a career-high eight tackles, including four behind the line of scrimmage, two sacks, two forced fumbles (both of which Syracuse recovered), and was credited with two quarterback hurries. The two turnovers Robinson caused led to 10 Orange points.

■ Pitt running back Qadree Ollison rushed for a season-high 192 yards with a touchdown on 24 carries (8.0 avg.) in the Panthers' 44-37 overtime victory over Syracuse. After Pitt fell behind 14-0 in the first-quarter, Ollison ripped off a 69-yard touchdown run. Ollison's 192

rushing yards are the third most by an ACC player this season.

IN THE NATIONAL STATS

■ Miami and Clemson are ranked second and third, respectively, in the nation in total defense. The Hurricanes are allowing just 237.3 yards per game, while the Tigers are close behind at 261.2 yards allowed. Miami is sixth in pass efficiency defense, and seventh in rushing defense.

■ Clemson, Miami and Syracuse are all tied for the national lead with 3.33 sacks per game. Florida State's DE Brian Burns leads the conference and is sixth nationally with 1.17 sacks per game. The Orange's Kendall Coleman and Alton Robinson are both tied at 10th with 1.0 per game.

■ Georgia Tech and Clemson rank first and fifth, respectively in rushing yards per game. The Yellow Jackets are averaging 373.0 yards on the ground, while the Tigers are posting 280.8 per contest.

■ Led by Clemson, four ACC teams are ranked in the top 25 in scoring defense. The Tigers are giving up only 14.5 points per game. NC State is allowing 16.8 to rank 14th, followed by No. 21 Duke (18.4), and No. 23 Miami (18.5).

■ Wake Forest's Greg Dortch is third in the country in receptions per game (8.0) and 11th in receiving yards (98.7).

■ Boston College's AJ Dillon and Clemson's Travis Etienne rank fifth and seventh, respectively in rushing yards per game. Dillon, who missed last week's game at NC State, is averaging 130.4 yards rushing, while Etienne is rushing at a 126.8 clip.

■ NC State quarterback Ryan Finley is fourth in the nation in completions per game, fifth in passing yards per game and eighth in total offense.
