THIS WEEK

- Virginia is making its 12th consecutive trip to the NCAA Round of 16
- The Cavaliers are looking to become the sixth school to win multiple NCAA Championships (USC, Stanford, UCLA, Georgia, William & Mary)
- UVa is one of three schools to have both the men and women in the round of 16 in each of the past five years (Georgia, UCLA)

NCAA TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The Cavaliers won the NCAA Championship in 2013
- Virginia is making its 12th consecutive appearance and 17th overall
- UVa enters the Round of 16 with a 47-15 all-time NCAA Tournament record
- The Cavaliers have a 45-10 record in the NCAA Tournament under Brian Boland
- Virginia has made at least the quarterfinals in each of the past 10 years (longest active streak in the nation)
- UVa reached the semifinals in seven of the last eight years (UVa is the only ACC team to ever reach a semifinal)
- Virginia's senior class (Mitchell Frank) is 17-2 in the NCAA Tournament

WHAT'S IN A SEED?

- Virginia is the No. 3 seed in this year's tournament
- It is the ninth straight year the Cavaliers have been a top-four seed
- The Cavaliers' nine-year streak of being a top-four seed is the longest current streak and the third-longest streak in tournament history (14-Stanford, 1988-2001; 10-USC, 1979-1988)
- UVa is the only team to be a top-eight seed in each of the past 12 years

2015 Opponents in Bold
ACC CHAMPIONS

- Virginia won its ninth consecutive ACC Championship, its 11th in 12 years
- The Cavaliers won their 12th consecutive ACC regular season title this year

THE STREAK

- Virginia has won 139 consecutive matches against ACC opposition (regular season and tournaments)
- The Cavaliers' last loss to a conference foe was a 4-3 decision to Duke in the 2006 ACC Championship final
- The streak became the longest in conference history in all sports last year, passing Duke women's tennis' 116 straight wins against ACC foes from 1989-2000

DECADE OF DOMINANCE

- Virginia won its 12th consecutive ACC regular season title this season
- The Cavaliers have gone undefeated through the league in 10 of those 12 years
- During the last 12 years, Virginia has gone 124-3 (.976) in ACC regular season matches
- The three losses came to UNC ('04), at UNC ('06) and Miami ('06)

ITA ATLANTIC REGION HONORS

- Mitchell Frank was named the ITA Atlantic Region Senior Player of the Year and the region's nominee for the Arthur Ashe Sportsmanship and Leadership Award
- Collin Altamirano was named the ITA Atlantic Region Rookie of the Year, marking the sixth straight year a Cavalier has won the award
- Brian Boland was named ITA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year for the sixth time

IN THE RANKINGS

- Virginia has four nationally ranked singles players (No. 8 Ryan Shane, No. 19 Thai-Son Kwiatkowski, No. 20 Mitchell Frank and No. 77 Collin Altamirano)
- On Feb. 22, the Cavaliers had both the No. 1 and No. 2 ranked singles players (No. 1 Kwiatkowski, No. 2 Shane) in the nation for the second time in school history
- Luca Corinteli and Ryan Shane are currently ranked a career-high No. 2 in the ITA Doubles Rankings and are the highest-ranked Cavalier doubles team since Jarmere Jenkins and Mac Styslinger ended the 2013 season at No. 2

DOUBLES SUCCESS

• Virginia has won the doubles point in 25 of 28 matches this season (lost doubles point in both matches vs. Baylor & vs. Florida State in ACC Quarterfinals)

ACC-OLADES

- Virginia had four All-ACC selections
- Ryan Shane and Mitchell Frank were on the first team
- Thai-Son Kwiatkowski was named to the second team
- Collin Altamirano was a third-team selections
- J.C. Aragone was named the ACC Tournament MVP

NCAA SELECTIONS

- Virginia had three players selected to the NCAA Singles Championship (Mitchell Frank, Thai-Son Kwiatkowski, Ryan Shane)
- It is the eighth consecutive year Virginia has had at least three NCAA Singles Championship selections, the longest active streak in the nation
- Ryan Shane is the No. 8 seed in singles, the 10th consecutive year Virginia has had a seeded player, also the longest active streak in the nation
- Frank becomes fifth player in school history to be selected to four NCAA Singles Championships, joining Brian Vahaly (1998-01), Somdev Devvarman (2005-08, Jarmere Jenkins (2010-13) and Alex Domijan (2011-14)
- Shane and Luca Corinteli are the No. 3 seed in the NCAA Doubles Championship

HOME SWEET HOME

- After advancing to the Round of 16, Virginia has won 46 consecutive home matches, the longest active streak in the nation
- The Cavaliers' last loss at home came to Ohio State in the semifinals of the 2012 ITA National Team Indoor Championship at the Boar's Head Sports Club
- Virginia has won 62 consecutive outdoor home matches at the Snyder Tennis Center, dating back to a 4-3 loss to Miami in 2006
- Since 2004, Virginia has a 176-5 home record (76-3 at Snyder, 100-2 at BHSC)

NOTABLE

- The round of 16 matchup with Columbia will be the first meeting between the schools since 2000
- Virginia is 2-3 all-time in Waco (all matches against Baylor)
- The Cavaliers are 2-2 all-time in NCAA Tournament matches in Texas (reached quarterfinals in 2005 and 2009 at Texas A&M)
