- Virginia is receiving votes in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls
- Virginia coming off a 64-61 loss to Georgia on Thursday night
- The Cavaliers trailed by 14 points early in the fourth quarter, but got the deficit down to one point, 62-61, with eight seconds remaining
- Virginia had three different players grab seven rebounds in the Georgia game including J'Kyra Brown, Aliyah Huland El and Felicia Aiyeotan
- The Virginia sophomores combined to score 43 points in the game, 70.5 percent of UVA's total output
- A sophomore has led the team in scoring in each of the first three games
- Sophomore guard Dominique Toussaint leads the team with a 17.3 points per game average, ranking eighth in the ACC. She scored 18 points against Georgia after contributing 17 in each of the first two games
- Against Georgia, Toussaint made six baskets and dishes five assists, having a hand in 11 of UVA's 21 field goals. Her five assists matched her career high
- Sophomore guard Jocelyn Willoughby is shooting 63.0 percent from the field this season (17-27), ranking fourth in the ACC. Willoughby scored 17 points against Georgia and is averaging 18.0 points in the last two games
- Senior guard Aliyah Huland El is 8-of-10 from the field in the last two games, including going 3-of-4 from three-point range
- The Cavaliers are averaging 32.7 points in the paint per game
- Virginia is looking for its first road win of the year. The Cavaliers were 6-8 in road games last season
- The Cavaliers are closing in on the 900th win in program history coming into the game with an 897-443 record in the 45 years of Virginia women's basketball

TEAM NOTES

- Sophomore forward/guard Jocelyn Willoughby was appointed as the non-voting, student-athlete member of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Oversight Committee. Willoughby is the lone student-athlete on the 15-member committee with her tenure running through June 2020. The goals of the committee are to advance the game and perception of women's basketball, improve the student-athlete experience and put an emphasis on the personal growth of student athletes. Along with the goals, it will also work to supervise qualifications and/or selection procedures for the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship and provide direction to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Rules Committee regarding playing rules.
- The Cavaliers have a very international flair. Joining Nigeria's Felicia Aiyetan and Luxembourg's Lisa Jablonowski, both of whom are now sophomores, is freshman guard Amandine Toi from Paris. Toi is a current member of the French U19 Junior National Team and competed this summer at the 2017 U19 FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup in Italy, finishing in fifth place.
- The Cavaliers took a foreign tour this summer, spending seven days in Costa Rica in August, taking on a Canadian team as well as the Costa Rican National Team. It allowed the squad time to practice as well as the experience of getting three exhibition games under their belt. While in Costa Rica, the team went zip lining through a jungle while others went on an ATV tour. Some of them took surfing lessons as well as seeing wildlife that included a river filled with crocodiles. Their favorite part of the trip, however, was a trip to an orphanage, an activity they enjoyed so much, the itinerary of the trip was altered to allow a return visit to see the kids.

DAYTON FLYERS

- Dayton defeated Morgan State, 88-52, on Friday night in the Flyers' home opener. Dayton hit nine consecutive field goals in the third starting with 7:54 and ending at 2:57 in the quarter, as the Flyers pulled away.
- Dayton opened the season by winning the title at the Maine Tip-Off Tournament, downing Harvard 72-66 and Tulane 71-65. The Flyers trailed the Green Wave by nine points at the half, but rallied to pick up the win and claim the tournament title
- JaVonna Layfield is this week's Atlantic 10 Co-Player of the Week after averaging 15.0 points and 16.0 rebounds per game in the tournament, recording a pair of double-doubles. She was named the tournament MVP
- In 2016-17, Dayton won the regular season and tournament titles in the Atlantic 10 Conference, and earned a berth in the NCAA Division I tournament. Head coach Shauna Green was named the 2016-17 WBCA National Rookie Coach of the Year
- Virginia is 1-0 against Dayton after picking up a 66-56 victory last season at John Paul Jones Arena in the finale of the Cavalier Classic tournament. Jocelyn Willoughby scored 16 points, going 12-of-14 from the freethrow line. Dominique Toussaint scored 17 points with five assists and four rebounds
