### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia (12-2) is tied for first in the ACC, while Georgia Tech (4-11) is 12th.
- The Cavaliers have a four-game winning streak vs. Georgia Tech.

### FIGHT FOR LITERACY GAMES

- The UVA-Georgia Tech game is part of the Coaching for Literacy's Fight for Literacy Games initiative, which brings players, coaches and fans together to ensure America's children can read.
- The UVA and Georgia Tech coaching staffs will wear green ties, lapel pins and wrist bands to raise awareness about the issues connected to illiteracy.

### ALL-TIME AGAINST GEORGIA TECH

- Virginia is 41-40 all-time vs. Georgia Tech, including a 23-11 record in Charlottesville, in the series that dates back to 1947-48.
- The Cavaliers have a four-game winning streak in the series and a six-game winning streak against the Yellow Jackets in Charlottesville.
- UVA has held Georgia Tech to 54 points or less during the four-game winning streak in the series.
- Virginia is 11-2 in its last 13 games against Georgia Tech, all under head coach Tony Bennett.

### LAST TIME VS. THE YELLOW JACKETS

- Ty Jerome scored 18 points and dished out five assists as then-No. 1 Virginia held off depleted Georgia Tech 65-54 on Feb. 21, clinching the regular season title and top seed in the 2018 ACC Tournament.
- The Cavaliers, who also got nine points each from De'Andre Hunter and Mamadi Diakite, led just 31-30 at halftime.
- UVA had six turnovers and owned a 19-4 margin in bench points.
- Ben Lammers scored 22 points to lead the Yellow Jackets and Tadic Jackson added 15.

### GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense at 54.5 ppg.
- The Cavaliers have limited nine opponents to fewer than 50 points (Coppin State, Morgan State, Towson, Wisconsin, VCU, William & Mary, Clemson, Wake Forest and Miami).
- UVA has held 20 opponents to 40 percent or less field goal shooting and 23 opponents to 33 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- The Cavaliers have forced 23 shot clock violations.
- UVA has out-rebounded 21 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense five times and finished in the top-five nationally in nine of 12 seasons.

### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 178-42 (.809) in 13 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers are 12-1 at JPJ with their lone loss to then-No. 2 Duke.
- UVA is 140-26 (.843), including a 105-11 (.905) mark the past seven seasons, at home under Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 54-6 (.900) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 53-8 (.869).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.
- UVA has a 17-game nonconference home winning streak.

### UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Feb. 26, UVA ranks No. 1 in the KenPom.com overall ratings, No. 2 in adjusted defense and No. 4 in adjusted offense efficiency.
- UVA is shooting 47.3 percent (second best in Bennett era), 39.1 percent from 3-point range (second best in school history) and 75.5 percent from the free throw line.

### UVA IN THE NATIONAL STATISTICAL RANKINGS

- As of Feb. 26, UVA ranks first nationally in scoring defense (54.5 ppg), fewest turnovers (239), turnovers per game (9.2), 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.5%) and fewest fouls (377), fourth in scoring margin (17.0), field goal percentage defense (37.4%) and winning percentage (92.3%), sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.56), ninth in personal fouls per game (14.5), 11th in 3-point field goal percentage (39.1%), 25th in rebound margin (5.9) and 26th in free throw percentage (75.5).

### LAST TIME OUT

- De'Andre Hunter scored a career-high 26 points, including 19 in the second half, as then-No. 3 Virginia rallied for a 64-52 win at then-No. 18 Louisville on Feb. 23.
- Virginia trailed 37-27 at the half, before outscoring Louisville 37-17 for its eighth straight win against the Cardinals.
- Louisville was 10 of 16 from 3-point range in the first half, but was 2 of 17 in the second half from distance.
- Mamadi Diakite added 14 points, five rebounds and three blocked shots and Jay Huff chipped in 12 points as UVA owned a 26-15 advantage in bench points.
- UVA outscored Louisville 38-4 in the paint.

### FIVE CAVALIERS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Feb. 26, Kyle Guy ranks first in the ACC in 3-pointers (3.0), third in 3-point percentage (42.6%), eighth in minutes (34.4) and 13th in scoring (15.2).
- Ty Jerome ranks second in assists (5.1), third in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.0), fourth in 3-point percentage (40.3%) and 15th in minutes (32.9).
- De'Andre Hunter ranks third in the ACC in field goal percentage (54.3%), sixth in free throw percentage (79.3%) and 12th in scoring (15.2).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks ninth in blocked shots (1.54) and Braxton Key ranks 21st in rebounding (5.7).

### UVA RANKED NO. 2 IN AP POLL

- UVA is ranked a season-high No. 2 in the latest AP poll.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP top six in 26 consecutive polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP for 32 straight polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in each of the past 28 polls.
- UVA was ranked No. 5 in the preseason polls and has been ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in four of the past five seasons.
- In 2017-18, Virginia became the fourth team in the Top 25 era to earn a No. 1 ranking after being unranked in the preseason.
- UVA is 73-6 at home in nonconference action under Bennett.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Three-time National and ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 243-88 (.734) mark in 10 seasons at Virginia and 312-121 (.721) career mark in 13 seasons.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- In 2017-18, Bennett led Virginia to its eighth ACC regular-season title, third ACC Tournament championship, school-record 31 wins, ACC-record 17 league wins and ACC-record 9-0 mark on the road.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- Bennett also earned Division I National Coach of the Year honors from the AP, USA Today and NABC.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to five straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to a school-record seven straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in three of the last five seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a then-school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- UVA is 126-35 (.782) in non-conference action, 117-53 (.688) in ACC play and 140-26 (.843) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks sixth all-time in winning percentage at .688, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

**HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- We play defense, take good shots, share and take care of the basketball, rebound and play more defense.
- We are led by the quartet of Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, De'Andre Hunter and Jack Salt.
- Jerome, Guy or Hunter have led or tied for the UVA scoring lead in each of its 26 contests.
- Alabama transfer Braxton Key is averaging 6.3 points and a team-high 5.7 rebounds, while Mamadi Diakite has averaged 7.2 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.54 blocked shots.
- Newcomer Kihei Clark has started eight games and has chipped in 54 assists and 18 3-pointers. Clark broke his left wrist against Morgan State, but hasn't missed a game while playing with a cast.
- Jay Huff has averaged 4.9 points and 2.3 rebounds off the bench.
- Marco Anthony, Kody Statmann and Francesco Badocchi provide depth and Francisco Caffaro is redshirting the 2018-19 season.
- Manager Grant Kersey has appeared in eight games.

**SEASON ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

- Virginia has won 23 or more games for a school-record seven consecutive seasons.
- The Cavaliers have won 11 or more ACC games for a school-record seven consecutive seasons.
- UVA has captured an ACC-record five ranked road wins, tied for most all-time with UConn (1998-99).
- UVA has tied a school record with eight wins vs. ranked opponents.
- Head coach Tony Bennett captured his 300th career win.
- De'Andre Hunter earned MVP honors at the Battle 4 Atlantis as UVA captured its sixth consecutive Thanksgiving holiday tournament.
- Kyle Guy became the 48th member of the 1,000 point club at UVA.
- Virginia reached the 100-point mark for the first time under Bennett in its 100-64 win over Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Virginia won 11 or more home games for the 10th-straight season.

- Ty Jerome (Bob Cousy Award), Kyle Guy (Jerry West Award) and De'Andre Hunter (Julius Erving Award) were named to preseason and top-10 finalist award watch lists.
- Guy and Hunter were named to the John R. Wooden Award presented by Wendy's Men's Late Season Top 20 Watch List.
- Guy and Hunter are among 30 players on the midseason 2019 Citizen Naismith Trophy Men's Player of the Year watch list and 20 players for the NABA Division I Player of the Year award.
- Hunter was named to the midseason watch list for the USBWA Oscar Robertson Player of the Year award and is a semifinalist for the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year award.

**TYING US TOGETHER**

- UVA floor general Ty Jerome is averaging a career-high 12.8 points, 4.2 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 1.4 steals.
- Jerome has reached double figures in 17 games, including three 20-point efforts, highlighted by a season-high 25 at South Carolina.
- Jerome tallied 14 points and a career-high 12 assists against Virginia Tech for his first career double-double.
- Jerome added 15 points and 11 assists at North Carolina for his second career double-double.
- Jerome has handed out four or more assists in 19 games.
- Jerome is the first Cavalier to score 20 or more points in the first two games of a season since Sylvan Landesberg in 2008-09 (28 vs. VMI and 21 vs. USF).
- Jerome sank 10 of 14 3-pointers in UVA's first two games and is the first Cavalier to make 10 3-pointers in the first two games of a season since Curtis Staples (10 of 24) in 1997-98.
- Jerome was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament team.
- In 2017-18, Jerome earned All-ACC third-team honors after averaging 10.6 points and 3.9 assists.

**THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS**

- Returning All-American Kyle Guy is tied for the team lead in scoring (15.2 ppg) and is first in 3-pointers (78) and free throw accuracy (83.6 percent).
- The 6-2 sharpshooter was named ACC Player of the Week on Jan. 7 after averaging 25.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in wins against Marshall and then-No. 9 Florida State.
- Guy set a UVA school record with 11 consecutive 3-pointers over the two-game span.
- He has scored 20 or more points 12 times in his career, including a three-game 20-point streak from Feb. 11-18 (first UVA player since Malcolm Brogdon from Feb. 12-27, 2016).
- Guy has made five or more 3-pointers in 13 games.
- Guy ranks 42nd all-time in scoring at UVA with 1,131 career points.
- Guy ranks eighth all-time in the ACC and first at UVA with a 42.6 percent career 3-point shooting percentage.
- Guy ranks sixth all-time at UVA with 212 career 3-pointers.
- In 2017-18, Guy reached double figures in 28 games and led the Cavaliers in scoring in 15 contests.
- Guy averaged 16.7 points to earn ACC Tournament MVP honors.
- Guy owns the fourth and fifth longest 3-point field goal streaks in school history at 28 games (2017-18) and 25 games (2018-19), respectively.

**DRE'S WAY**

- De'Andre Hunter has led UVA in scoring in 13 games, averaging 15.2 points and 5.4 rebounds.
- Hunter tallied a career-high 26 points at Louisville for his ninth career 20-point game.
- He earned Battle 4 Atlantis MVP honors and ACC Player of the Week accolades after averaging 19.3 points and 7.7 rebounds.
- Hunter has seven 20-point games in 2018-19 (Coppin State, Dayton, Wisconsin, Virginia Tech, North Carolina, Notre Dame and Louisville).
- Hunter recorded his third career double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds vs. Notre Dame on Feb. 16.
- Hunter recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Towson.
- Hunter recorded a career-high nine assists vs. Middle Tennessee.
- He is shooting 54.3 percent from the floor, 47.4 percent from 3-point range and 79.3 percent from the charity stripe.
- Hunter averaged 9.2 points and 3.5 rebounds en route to ACC Sixth Man of the Year honors in 2017-18.
- Hunter fractured his left wrist during the ACC Tournament and missed the NCAA Tournament.

- UVA is 39-33 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including an 8-2 mark in 2018-19.
- UVA's eight ranked wins lead the nation.
- The Cavaliers have posted an ACC record five ranked wins on the road, which is also tied with UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time in poll history since 1948-49.
- UVA has posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents two times (Wisconsin and Maryland and Virginia Tech and Louisville) for the first time in the regular season since 1982 (Georgetown and Houston).
- The Cavaliers are 154-328 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.

- Virginia has scored 70 or more points in 12 games (11-2) and is 118-8 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett.
- UVA has scored 80 or more points in six games (6-0) and is 32-1 when scoring 80 or more points under Bennett with its lone loss a 93-81 decision at North Carolina in 2012-13.
- Bennett was 4-0 when scoring 80 or more points in three seasons as head coach at Washington State.
- UVA scored 100 points against Marshall for the first time under Tony Bennett and added 97 points against Coppin State.
- UVA is 4-0 all-time when scoring 90 or more points under Bennett.

- Guard Casey Morsell (Fort Washington, Md./St. John's College High School) and forward Kadin Shedrick (Raleigh, N.C./Holly Springs High School) signed NLI's with the Cavaliers.
- The 6-3, 190-pound Morsell averaged 14 points and 4.3 rebounds for St. John's College High School (Washington, D.C.) in 2017-18.

### HOOS GO STREAKING ON THE ROAD

- The Cavaliers' recent 12-game league road winning streak (2017-19) ended with the 72-70 loss at Duke on Jan. 19.
- The streak ranks fourth all-time in ACC history behind Duke's 24-game streak (1998-2001) and 14-game streak (1962-64) and NC State's 13-game streak (1972-74).

### CAVALIERS IN THE NBA

- Justin Anderson (Atlanta), Malcolm Brogdon (Milwaukee), Joe Harris (Brooklyn) and Mike Scott (Philadelphia) are former Cavaliers who are playing in the NBA this season.
- Brogdon, who earned NBA Rookie of the Year honors for Milwaukee in 2016-17, is in his third season with the Bucks.
- Scott is in his seventh season and Harris is in his fifth NBA season (third with Brooklyn), while Anderson is in his fourth season.
- Harris captured the 2019 NBA All-Star 3-point shooting title in Charlotte on Feb. 16, defeating Golden State's Stephen Curry 26-24 in the final round.
- Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

### VIRGINIA PICKED 2ND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish second in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked sixth and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by UVA, North Carolina, Syracuse, Virginia Tech, Clemson, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Miami, Louisville, Boston College, Georgia Tech, Wake Forest and Pitt.

### 50-40-75 CLUB

- Virginia is 34-0 when shooting at least 50 percent from the field, 40 percent from 3-point range and 75 percent from the free throw line in the same game under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA is 3-0 this season after achieving the mark against Coppin State, Marshall and Virginia Tech (58.5%, 54.2%, 100%).

### PRESS CREDENTIALS

Credential requests should be submitted no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

### PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. Please request your parking pass during the online credential application process.

### INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett, two Virginia student-athletes and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game, followed by two Virginia student-athletes or the visiting coach. Other Virginia players will be available upon request in the Courtside Club after the Virginia student-athletes press conference.

### RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table for visiting radio crews.

### GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Head coach and player quotes will be available after postgame interviews. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

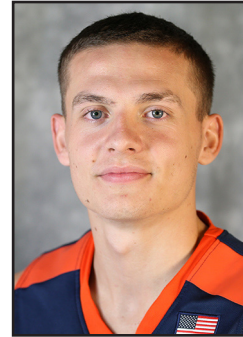
