The Virginia women's basketball team (9-3) finishes off the 2014 non-conference schedule by hosting the Cavalier Classic Tournament, presented by Holiday Inn University Area. On Monday, Miami (OH) and Davidson will play at 4:30 p.m. followed by Virginia and Drexel at 7 p.m. An All-Tournament Team will still be announced, but there will not be a tournament champion.

Virginia is coming off its lowest scoring game of the season, a 67-57 loss to Davidson in which the Cavaliers failed to score at least 60 points for the first time since a 90-55 loss at Duke in January of last season. Virginia also had a season-low 31.3 field goal shoot percentage, the second time in the last three games UVa made less than 40 percent of their shots.

Senior center Sarah Imovbioh (Abuja, Nigeria) had her seventh double-double of the season, scoring 21 points with 19 rebounds, including 12 offensive boards. Imovbioh leads the ACC in total rebounds (15.8) and O-boards (5.9) per game, ranking 10th in the nation in total rebounds and second in O-boards. For the third time in the last four games, Imovbioh, who is ranked second in the ACC and sixth in the nation in field goal shooting percentage, shot better than 60 percent from the field. Imovbioh went 8-of-13 against Davidson after posting a season-best 81.8 percent efficiency against Howard when she was 9-of-11 from the field. The rest of the team combined to shoot 23.5 percent (12 of 51) against the Wildcats.

Junior guard Faith Randolph (Derwood, Md.) scored 15 points against Davidson, keeping alive her season-long streak of double-digit scoring performances. Randolph is fourth in the ACC in points per game, averaging 18.6 and is also fourth in three-point shooting efficiency at 39.7 percent.

#### **HOOS HOT**

- Breyana Mason went 6-of-6 from the free throw line against Longwood after making 5-of-5 against Delaware State.
- Mason snapped a streak of 18-straight made free throws with a miss against Howard
- Sarah Imovbioh made 11 of 14 shots against Longwood (78.5 percent) and 9-of-11 against Howard (81.8 percent)
- Faith Randolph has scored in double-digits each game this season. Last season, she had one seven-game stretch of scoring in double-digits in consecutive games (Dec. 29-Jan. 23)
- Randolph had her second 8-of-8 free throw shooting game of the season against Saint Marys. All eight of her attempts came in the final 69 seconds of the game. Randolph was 13-of-14 from the line in the three games last week.

#### **SCOUTING THE TOURNAMENT TEAMS**

- Virginia is 1-0 against Davidson and 1-0 against Drexel. The Cavaliers defeated the Wildcats, 83-68 in 2007 and UVa downed the Dragons. 63-54 in 2010.
- Davidson (3-8) has lost its last six games, including falling 82-66 to NC State earlier this month. Hannah Early leads the team, averaging 14.7 points per game. Mackenzie Latt, the Wildcats' other player averaging double-figures this season (12.0 ppg) leads the team in rebounding at 8.1 per game.
- Drexel (5-4) is coming off a 67-58 victory over Penn. This will also be their second game of the year against an ACC school, with the Dragons falling 72-53 to Pitt on Dec. 14. Sarah Curran leads the team, averaging 13.7 points per game.

### **ACTING HEAD COACH**

 Associate head coach Kim McNeill served as the acting head coach for three games (Longwood, Saint Mary's, Howard), while Joanne Boyle was finalizing an adoption. McNeill went 3-0 in those games. The wins will still be reflected in Boyle's career record.

#### **ON DECK**

- This will be the final non-conference game for the Cavaliers before heading into Atlantic Coast Conference competition. Virginia will play at Virginia Tech on Sunday, Jan. 4 at 2 p.m.
- The Cavaliers will be back at home on Thursday, Jan. 8 when they host Wake Forest at 7 p.m.



#### **ACC LEADERS**

- Sarah Imovbioh leads the ACC in rebounding 12.0 per game) and in offensive rebounds per game (5.9)
- Imovbioh moved up to ranking second in the nation in offensive rebounds per game and 10th in total rebounds per game
- Imovbioh is second in the ACC in field goal percentage (63.9) and sixth in the nation. Imovbioh finished her freshman season as the ACC leader in field goal percentage.
- Imovbioh is 10th in the ACC points per game (15.6)
- Imovbioh's 24 rebounds against Ohio State is still the highest single-game total by an ACC player this season
- Faith Randolph ranks fourth in ACC in points per game (18.9)
- Randolph is third in free throw percentage (89.4) and 11th in steals per game (1.83)
- Lauren Moses is eighth in blocked shots (1.42 per game)
- Breyana Mason is fifth in assists per game (3.9) and is second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.47)
- The Cavaliers are fourth in the ACC in field goal percentage (449) and fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.07)
- Virginia leads the ACC, averaging fewer turnovers per game (12.4) than any other conference team

#### **HOT SHOOTING**

- Sarah Imovbioh was 9-of-11 (81.8 percent) from the field against Howard, topping her previous-best shooting, a 7-of-9 night against Auburn
- Mikayla Venson was 6-of-8 from the field against Radford and 3-of-4 against Auburn. All four of her shots against Auburn were from beyond the arc.
- Venson was 5-of-7 from the field against FIU
- Breyana Masons was 4-of-6 (66.7 percent) shooting against Auburn
- Aliyah Huland El went 2-of-3 from 3-point range against FIU
- Sydney Umeri was 4-of-7 at Illinois and 3-of-4 against DSU

### **DISHING IT OUT**

- Breyana Mason had seven assists against Delaware State, the most assist by a UVa player in a game this season
- Mason is second in the ACC with 4.5 assists per game
- Mason is third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio at +2.8. She started the week ranked No. 26 nationally in that stat.
- Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high five assists against-Delaware State
- Ten out of Virginia's 11 players had at least one assist against Delaware State

### **THREE-POINT SHOOTING**

- The Cavaliers were 7-of-10 from three-point range against Auburn, the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.
- Faith Randolph was 9-of-16 (56.3 percent) from three-point range through the first four games of the year
- Breyana Mason went 5-of-7 from three point range in the opener against Ohio State, but hadn't taken another three-point shot until going 0-for-1 against Toledo
- Mikayla Venson matched that performance, making five of her seven three-point attempts against Delaware State

#### **BLOCKED SHOTS**

- Last season, the Cavaliers averaged 1.4 blocked shots per game, which ranked 337th nationally out of 343 teams
- This season, the Cavaliers are averaging 4.2 per game, ranking 86th

#### **LAST ROAD GAME OF 2014**

• The Illinois game was Virginia's last road contest of the calendar year. The Cavaliers will not hit the road again until kicking off ACC play at Virginia Teach on Jan. 4, 2015 and will not leave the Commonwealth until playing at Syracuse on Jan. 11.

#### **FORCING TURNOVERS**

- The Cavaliers forced 25 turnovers against FIU, scoring 31 points off the miscues. Virginia only turned the ball over seven times in the game.
- The Cavaliers forced 20 Radford turnovers while only committing five.
- Both Mikayla Venson and Sarah Imovbioh had five steals agaisnt FIU.
- Seven different players had at least one steal against Radford.

#### **100-POINT GAME**

- Virginia defeated Delaware State, 100-62, before finals break
- After Delaware State tied the game, 11-11, on a pair of free throws seven minutes into the game, Virginia went on a 30-4 run, including a span in which UVa scored 18-straight points.
- The Cavaliers went into halftime with a 55-25 lead with three players already with double-digit points. Virginia outscored Delaware State, 45-37, in the second half.
- Freshman forward Jae'Lisa Allen scored a layup with 17 seconds remaining in the game, the first points of her career, to give UVa its first 100-point game since the Cavaliers scored 110 points in a Nov. 18, 2009 game against USC Upstate.
- Virginia had five players finish the game scoring in double figures. Mikayla Venson had the first 20-point performance of her career, finishing with 22 points, going 8-of-10 from the field, including 5-of-7 from three-point range.
- Breyana Mason scored 16 points while also dishing seven assists with three rebounds and three steals.
- Sarah Beth Barnette had a career-high 11 rebounds to lead the team while also scoring nine points with five assists a block and a steal.

#### ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- The Cavaliers now have a 5-3 record all-time in the Challenge after falling 86-63 at Illinois.
- For only the second time in ACC/Big Ten Challenge history, the challenge ended in a tie with each conference winning seven games
- The ACC moves to 6-0-2 all-time in the Challenge with a 54-39 record against the Big Ten in Challenge games.
- Virginia started the game in a 13-0 deficit after going 0-for-8 from the field while also committing five turnovers before making their first field goal 8:12 into the contest.
- The Illini, who led 38-22 at the break, started the second half on a 21-5 run to put the game out of reach.
- Junior guard Faith Randolph (Derwood, Md.) led the Cavaliers with 16 points. Freshman forward Lauren Moses (Mount Holly, N.J.) had a seasonhigh 13 rebounds, scoring five points with two blocked shots.
- The Illini shot 50.0 percent, including making 17 of 28 shots (60.7 percent) in the second half. Virginia shot 37.5 percent in the game. The Cavaliers held a 42-29 rebounding edge. UVa committed 18 turnovers while the Illini turned the ball over 11 times.



### FIU THANKSGIVING CLASSIC TOURNAMENT

- Faith Randolph was named to the All-Tournament team, scoring 21 points against Toledo and 16 against FIU
- The Cavaliers suffered their first defeat of the season, falling 64-62 in their opening-round game against Toledo. Virginia held a 10-point lead, 51-41, with 11 minutes remaining in the game, but Florida International chipped away at the deficit, coming back to tie and then take a 56-55 lead with 3:22 remaining. The final minute of play included three lead changes beginning with Toledo taking a 61-60 lead with 32 seconds remaining after Virginia committed an offensive foul. Mikayla Venson swung the score back in UVa's favor, pulling up for a free-throw-line jump shot with 13 seconds remaining. Zanoguera hit a three-pointer with five seconds left in the game to give the Rockets a 64-62 lead. Venson fired off a three-point attempt as the buzzer sounded, but it clanged off the rim.
- In the consolation final, Virginia earned a 74-61 victory over FIU.
- Virginia, which led the entire game, forced 25 FIU turnovers, scoring 31 points off the miscues.
- Virginia had four players finish the game with double-digit points, led by Sarah Imovbioh who logged her fourth double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds while also matching a career high with five steals.
- Virginia went 7-of-7 from the field to start the game and 5-of-5 to start the second half.

#### **RAINING THREES VS AUBURN**

- Virginia won its fourth-straight game with a 66-51 victory
- The Cavaliers broke open a five-point game by going on a 19-3 run early in the second half, making 10 of their first 13 field goal attempts in the period while Auburn went 3-of-14 in the same span. The Tigers also committed five turnovers during that same span.
- Virginia's hot-shooting second-half performance propelled the Cavaliers to a 20-point advantage with 9:16 remaining in the second half. Virginia held a 21-point lead heading into the final two minutes of play, but Auburn capitalized on four late UVa turnovers to go on a 6-0 run to close out the game.
- The Cavaliers shot 70.0 percent from three-point range, making seven of 10 while Auburn was 8-of-20 for 40.0 percent. It was the first time Virginia had a 70 percent or better three-point efficiency since making 5-of-7 (71.4 percent) against UCSB in an NCAA Tournament game in 2008.
- Sarah Imovbioh had her third double-double of the season, reaching double figures in points and rebounds by halftime and finishing with 21 points and 13 rebounds. Faith Randolph scored 18 points on 6-of-13 shooting, including going 3-of-4 from three-point range. Mikayla Venson scored 10 points.

### **ACC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (NOV. 17)**

- Virginia senior center Sarah Imovbioh has been named the Atlantic Coast Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Week
- Imovbioh set the Virginia single-game rebounding record with 24 boards against Ohio State, and accounted for almost half of Virginia's 51 total rebounds in the game.
- Against Radford, Imovbioh only played 20 minutes, but still nearly had another double-double with 14 points and 9 boards.
- Imovbioh averaged 16 points and 16.5 rebounds in UVa's two wins.
- Imovbioh is the first Cavalier to earn this honor since Chelsea Shine was named the ACC Player of the Week on Nov. 21, 2011 after Virginia upset No. 3 Tennessee, 69-64, in overtime.

### **ROAD WIN AT XAVIER**

- Virginia led nearly the entire game, taking a 37-25 lead into halftime.
- Xavier made just one three pointer on 11 attempts in the first half, but went 7-of-14 after the break, including Jada Byrd hitting a three-pointer as time expired, to cut the final deficit to single digits.
- The Cavaliers were 3-of-7 from three-point range and 10-of-12 from the free throw line, shooting 46.8 percent overall from the field. Virginia outrebounded Xavier, 44-33, with UVa scoring 17 second-chance points.
- Faith Randolph scored 26 points, matching her career high. Randolph went 8-of-8 from the free throw line, helping her to her second 25-point game of the season.
- Sarah Imovbioh finished with 18 points and 13 rebounds.
- Breyana Mason (6) and Mikayla Venson (5) accounted for 11 of Virginia's 14 assists.

#### **ROUTING RADFORD**

- Virginia closed out the opening homestand with a 75-47 victory over Radford.
- UVa had four players end the game in double-figures. Mikayla Venson (12 points on 6-of-8 shooting), Sarah Imovbioh (14 points with nine rebounds in 20 minutes on the court), Breyana Mason (11 points, five assists.) and Faith Randolph (11).
- Virginia never trailed in the game, holding a 31-21 advantage at halftime and outscored the Highlanders 44-26 after the break.
- Virginia forced 20 turnovers, with seven different Cavaliers getting at least one steal, scoring 21 points off the miscues. Radford outrebounded Virginia 43-38, scoring 23 second-chance points to Virginia's 13.

#### **OHIO STATE OPENER**

- Virginia topped Ohio State, 87-82 in the seasonopener
- Sarah Imovbioh pulled in a school-record 24 rebounds while also scoring 18 points for her 16th career double-double.
- The game, which featured 18 lead changes and six ties, was knotted 79-79 with a minute remaining. Randolph drove through the Ohio State zone, converting a layup with 51 seconds left on the clock to give UVa an 81-79 advantage. After Ohio State missed a three-pointer on the opposite end, Lauren Moses came up with the rebound, her seventh of the game. The Cavaliers went 6-for-6 from the free throw line in the final 36 seconds of the game to secure the season-opening victory.
- Breyana Mason scored a career-high 22 points, going 8-of-11 from the field including making five of seven three-point attempts, with six assists.
- Faith Randolph led the Cavaliers with a 25-point performance.
- Virginia has won nine of its last ten season-openers and has never lost a home opener at John Paul Jones Arena, winning its first home game in each of the last 15 seasons.



#### **2015-16 RECRUITING CLASS**

- The Cavaliers signed three post players (two forwards and a center) to join the team in 2015-16

- Jones is ESPN-W's No. 61 overall recruit and ranked No. 11 at her position.
- Jones earned PAC 6 All-Conference honors in 2012, 2013, and 2014 in both basketball and volleyball.
- Jones participated in the 2014 USA Basketball Women's U18 National Team Trials last May.
- Shakyna Payne, a 6-3 forward from Acworth, Ga.
