FOR OPENERS

- No. 9 Virginia continues its five-game homestand with its 52nd meeting against South Carolina.
- The Cavaliers have held a Division I leading eight opponents to fewer than 50 points and three foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA has a 22-game home nonconference winning streak and is 140-37 (.791) in non-league play under Tony Bennett.

ALL-TIME VS. SOUTH CAROLINA

- No. 9 Virginia meets South Carolina for the second straight season after not meeting for 16 seasons.
- UVA is 26-24 all-time vs. the Gamecocks, including a 16-8 mark in Charlottesville.
- The Cavaliers posted a 14-20 mark from 1953-71 against South Carolina when the Gamecocks were members of the ACC.
- UVA is 3-2 against the Gamecocks since 1990.

LAST TIME VS. THE GAMECOCKS

- Ty Jerome scored 25 points and Kyle Guy added 18 to lead then-No. 5 Virginia to a 69-52 win at South Carolina on Dec. 19, 2018.
- Mamadi Diakite added 10 points on 5 of 6 shooting as the Cavaliers recorded their 11th consecutive true road win.
- Jerome went 9 of 15 from the field, including 3 of 8 from 3-point range. Guy added five 3-pointers as the duo combined for all eight UVA 3-pointers.
- UVA limited USC to 36.4 percent field goal shooting.
- The Cavaliers had their fifth game with five or fewer turnovers.

ALL-TIME VS. SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- The Cavaliers are 63-62 all-time vs. current SEC opponents (26-24 vs. South Carolina, 8-5 vs. Tennessee, 4-1 vs. Missouri, 4-3 vs. Arkansas, 4-4 vs. Auburn, 3-0 vs. LSU, 3-4 vs. Alabama, 3-4 vs. Georgia, 3-6 vs. Kentucky, 2-5 vs. Vanderbilt, 1-2 vs. Florida, 1-1 vs. Mississippi, 1-2 vs. Mississippi State and 0-1 vs. Texas A&M).
- UVA went 2-0 vs. the SEC last season, including wins over Auburn (63-62) and South Carolina (69-52).
- UVA is 5-4 all-time against current SEC opponents in the NCAA Tournament (2-1 vs. Tennessee, 1-0 vs. Auburn, 1-0 vs. LSU, 1-1 vs. Arkansas and 0-2 vs. Florida).

UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Dec. 20, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (44.2), field goal percentage defense (32.1) and personal fouls per game (11.5), fourth in fewest fouls (115) and 13th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.4).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 187-42 (.817), including a 6-0 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last season and is 149-26 (.851), including a 114-11 (.912) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 58-6 (.906) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 55-8 (.873).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kihei Clark tallied 14 points to lead a trio of Cavaliers in double figures in a 56-44 nonconference win over Stony Brook on Dec. 18.
- Mamadi Diakite added 13 points and Jay Huff chipped in 12 points and seven rebounds off the bench as UVA improved to 9-1 overall.
- UVA outrebounded Stony Brook 31-29 and limited the Seawolves to 37.8 percent shooting (17-45).
- Clark added six assists and five rebounds for the Cavaliers.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 8-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 95-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 120-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 3-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (26-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).

UVA RANKED NO. 9 IN LATEST AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 9 in the latest Associated Press poll for the second straight week and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 41 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in 37 of the last 38 polls.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 263-90 (.745) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 332-123 (.730) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett has guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 140-37 (.791) in non-conference action (78-6 at JPI), 123-53 (.699) in ACC play and 149-26 (.852) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .699, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.2 ppg) and is third in rebounding (6.5), while Clark is averaging 9.0 points, 4.6 rebounds and a team-high 5.1 assists.
- Key is averaging 8.9 points and a team-high 7.3 rebounds.
- Huff has tallied 9.5 points, 6.8 rebounds and team-high 13 blocks.
- Kody Stattmann and newcomers Casey Morsell and Tomas Wolde-tensae have absorbed the minutes left by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Morsell, who scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors, is averaging 4.9 points.
- Stattmann is averaging 5.3 points, including seven points in each of the past two contests.
- Wolde-tensae has started seven games and drilled a trio of 3-pointers against North Carolina.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Francisco Caffaro has appeared in six contests and had a great game off the bench with 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 6.0 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in four games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited eight opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.

- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA ranks first in the NCAA in scoring defense (44.2 ppg) after capturing its fifth NCAA scoring defense title in 2018-19 (56.1 ppg).
- The Cavaliers have limited four opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia and Maine) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held eight opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 10 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has out-rebounded seven opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

WATCH ME NOW

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List.

RECORDS WATCH

- Mamadi Diakite ranks fifth on UVA's career blocks list with 129.
- Diakite needs two blocks to pass Travis Watson (130 blocks from 2000-03) for fourth on the list.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's single-season list.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 43-34 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 1-0 mark in 2019-20.
- UVA went 11-3 vs. ranked foes and the 11 ranked wins marked a school record.
- The Cavaliers posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time in poll history since 1948-49.
- UVA posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents two times (Wisconsin and Maryland and Virginia Tech and Louisville) for the first time in the regular season since 1982.
- The Cavaliers are 157-329 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-30 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 poll (Louisville, Duke and Florida State), while three (North Carolina, Purdue and Virginia) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA defeated First Four NCAA Tournament team Arizona State in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament championship on Nov. 24.
- Two opponents (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

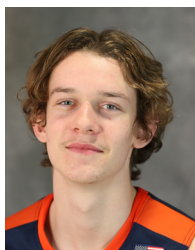
