QUICK HITS

AROUND THE ACC

■ Two of the remaining eight undefeated FBS teams are from the ACC – No. 3 Clemson and No. 16 NC State. In fact, Clemson and NC State are two of just four undefeated Power 5 teams left in the country. Alabama and Ohio State are the others. Clemson and NC State will face each other this weekend in Clemson at 3:30 p.m. in a nationally-televisioned game on ESPN. Each of the last two meetings have been decided by a touchdown in the Tigers' favor.

■ The Clemson-NC State game is the fifth all-time ACC matchup between undefeated teams with at least five wins. It is the first since No. 5 Florida State won at No. 3 Clemson in 2013, 51-14.

■ The Tigers are the only team in ACC history to start 6-0 in four consecutive seasons. Clemson has started 6-0 in six of the last eight seasons and has won 28 of its last 30 games against conference opponents. In Clemson's most recent outing, the Tigers beat Wake Forest by a 63-3 score. The Tiger's 60-point margin of victory was the program's largest in conference play in school history.

■ NC State is 5-0 for the first time since 2002 and is ranked 16th in the AP Top 25 poll and 15th in the Coaches Poll. The Wolfpack's seven-game win streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the nation. Only UCF (18 games), Ohio State (11) and Alabama (8) have a longer streak than the Pack. Clemson has won six in a row and Miami has won five straight.

■ Four teams in the Coastal Division - Georgia Tech, Miami, Pitt and Virginia Tech - and two in the Atlantic Division - Boston College and Louisville - have the weekend off. Virginia, fresh off a 16-13 win over No. 16 Miami, plays at Duke at 12:30 p.m. on RSN, and North Carolina visits Syracuse at 12:20 p.m. on Raycom. In addition to the NC State at Clemson game, the Atlantic also features Wake Forest at Florida State at 3:30 p.m. on ESPN2.

AP TOP 25

■ Two ACC teams are ranked in this week's Associated Press Top 25 football poll (Oct. 14). Clemson is No. 3 and NC State is No. 16. Miami, Duke and Virginia are also receiving votes.

■ Clemson has been ranked in 60 consecutive AP polls, including 57 in the top 10.

■ Last season, the Wolfpack was ranked 10 weeks during the season, reaching as high as No. 14 in late October. That marked the first time NC State was ranked in the AP poll since the final poll of the 2010 season.

NON-CONFERENCE NOTES

■ The ACC's seven road non-conference wins are the most of any conference.

BRING YOUR A GAME**ACADEMICS**

- Ten of 14 ACC Football teams earned a graduation success rate (GSR) at or above the FBS average of 76. That ties for first among Power 5 conferences, both in terms of percentage and in total number.
- The ACC remains the only Power 5 conference to have multiple teams score 90 or higher in GSR each year since 2005. Duke (96), Wake Forest (93) and Boston College (90) reached that plateau last year.
- In the 2018 U.S. News and World "Best Colleges" rankings, ACC member schools combine for an average rank of 54.7, marking the 12th straight year that the ACC has led all Power 5 conferences.

ATHLETICS

- The ACC is the only conference to win national championships in football, men's basketball, women's basketball and baseball over the last four years.
- The ACC has won a combined four football and men's basketball national titles over the last five years, twice as many as any other conference.
- The ACC has had a team in either the College Football Playoff or the BCS National Championship Game in each of the past five years.
- The ACC led all conferences with 10 bowl teams in 2017. Over the last two years, the ACC has had a nation's best 21 teams in bowl games.
- The ACC has earned at least six bowl bids in 17 consecutive seasons. The league ranks second among all conferences with 116 total bowl appearances since 2005.
- Since 2013, the ACC is second among all conferences with 54 postseason appearances, has the second-best record of any conference in BCS, New Year's Six and CFP games, and is tied for the most national championships (Florida State in 2013, Clemson in 2016).
- Over the last four years, the ACC is 13-3 in games against the SEC on rivalry week, which features Clemson-South Carolina, Florida State-Florida, Georgia Tech-Georgia and Louisville-Kentucky. The league was 3-1 in 2017, winning all three games on the road.
- Two of the last five national champions have come from the ACC, and the league has had a team in the national championship game in three of the last five years. Both are tied for the most from any conference.
- An ACC football player has won the Heisman Trophy or the Campbell Trophy – commonly referred to as the "Academic Heisman" – in four of the last five years, something no other league can claim.

■ The ACC's three road Power 5 non-conference wins are tied for the most of any conference.

■ The ACC has the second-most non-conference wins of any conference.

■ The ACC has the third-best non-conference winning percentage of any conference.

ROAD WINS

- There are four Power 5 conference teams with three true road wins and three of those are from the ACC - Clemson, Duke, and Virginia Tech. Florida is the other.
- Clemson road wins – at Texas A&M, at Georgia Tech, at Wake Forest
- Duke road wins – at Northwestern, at Baylor, at Georgia Tech
- Virginia Tech road wins – at Florida State, at Duke, at North Carolina

UPCOMING MILESTONES

■ Virginia's Olamide Zaccheaus (193) is closing in on 200 career receptions. Duke's T.J. Rahming (202) became the 22nd player in ACC history to reach the 200-reception mark last weekend in a win over Georgia Tech.

■ Georgia Tech's TaQuon Marshall and Syracuse's Eric Dungey have each rushed for 27 career touchdowns, which ranks seventh all-time among ACC quarterbacks. Louisville's Lamar Jackson (2015-17) owns the conference career mark with 50 and Georgia Tech's Tevin Washington (2009-12) is second with 38.

■ Syracuse's Eric Dungey and NC State's Ryan Finley are in position to top 10,000 total yards of offense for their careers. Dungey has 9,354 career yards and is currently averaging 273.8 yards per game. Finley has 8,517 career yards and is leading the conference with 330.4 yards per game. At their current pace, both players would top 10,000 career yards of total offense later this season. Only seven players in ACC history have reached this milestone. An ACC player has reached 10,000 yards in each of the last three seasons - Louisville's Lamar Jackson in 2017, Clemson's DeShaun Watson in 2016 and North Carolina's Marquise Williams in 2015.

■ Boston College's Michael Walker has 2,284 career kickoff return yards, which ranks sixth all-time in the ACC. North Carolina's Eric Blount (1988-91) is fifth at 2,313 and Florida State's Kermit Whitfield (2013-16) is fourth at 2,369.

IN THE NATIONAL STATS

■ Miami and Clemson are ranked first and third, respectively, in the nation in total defense. The Hurricanes are allowing just 236.4 yards per game, while the Tigers are close behind at 261.2 yards allowed. Miami is also first in third-down conversion defense and tackles for loss.

■ Georgia Tech and Clemson rank first and fourth, respectively in rushing yards per game. The Yellow Jackets are averaging 352.4 yards on the ground, which is nearly 40 yards more than second-place Army. The Tigers are posting 280.8 per contest. Georgia Tech (1st) Clemson (4th) and Wisconsin (6th) are the only Power 5 conference teams in the top 10 nationally in rushing.

■ NC State quarterback Ryan Finley is sixth in the nation in passing yards per game and eighth in total offense. He leads a Wolfpack offense that is sixth nationally in passing at 335.4 yards per game.

■ Boston College (4th), Miami (5th), Syracuse (T7th),

Clemson (T7th) and Florida State (13th) rank among the top 20 in sacks per game. BC's Wyatt Ray is third in the country with 1.42 sacks per contest, followed by Florida State's Brian Burns, who is fifth nationally. The Orange's Kendall Coleman and Alton Robinson are both tied at 10th with 1.0 per game. Clemson's Clelin Ferrell is also 10th.

■ Led by Clemson, three ACC teams are ranked in the top 20 in scoring defense. The Tigers are giving up only 14.5 points per game, which ranks sixth. NC State is allowing 16.8 to rank 16th, followed by No. 20 Duke at 17.7 per game.

■ Wake Forest's Greg Dortch is second in the country in receptions per game (8.0) and 12th in receiving yards (98.7).

■ Clemson's Travis Etienne ranks fifth nationally with 126.8 rushing yards per game. BC's AJ Dillon, who has missed the last two weeks, is averaging 130.4 yards rushing, but does not qualify for the national rankings.

■ Pitt's Maurice Ffrench is tied for the national lead in kickoff return TDs with two. The two-time ACC Specialist of the Week also leads the ACC and ranks second in the country with a 33.8-yard kickoff return average.

VIRGINIA'S THORNHILL IS WALTER CAMP DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Virginia safety Juan Thornhill has been named the Walter Camp Football Foundation National Defensive Player of the Week, for games played through Oct. 13. Thornhill made six tackles and intercepted two passes to help lead UVA to a 16-13 victory over No. 16 Miami on Saturday night. It was UVA's first win over a ranked opponent since beating then-No. 21 Louisville at Scott Stadium in 2014. Thornhill recorded 86 return yards on his two interceptions, including a career-long 62-yard return that set up UVA's lone touchdown in the second quarter.
