### **FOR OPENERS**

- UVA meets Purdue for the second time in the B1G/ACC Challenge. • The Cavaliers are 2-1 all-time vs. the Boilermakers, including an overtime win in the 2019 NCAA Elite Eight.
- The Cavaliers have started 7-0 for the fourth straight season and increased their nation-leading November winning streak to 32 games dating back to 2015-16.
- UVA has a 21-game home nonconference winning streak and is 139-36 (.794) in non-league play under Tony Bennett.
- UVA has a seven-game road winning streak dating back to 2018-19.

#### **UVA ALL-TIME IN THE B1G/ACC CHALLENGE**

- The Cavaliers have a 13-6 record, including a 6-4 road mark, in the B1G/ACC Challenge.
- Virginia has a five-game winning streak in the Challenge, defeating Maryland (2014 and 2019), Ohio State (2015 and 2016) and Wisconsin (2018).
- UVA defeated Maryland 76-71 in last year's Challenge.
- Since its inception, the ACC is 12-5-3 in the Challenge and 127-98 in Challenge games.
- The ACC has not lost the Challenge since 2015 (won the event in 2016 and 2017, and tied in 2018).
- The ACC won 10 straight challenges from 1999-2008.

### **UVA RANKED NO. 5 IN LATEST AP POLL**

- UVA is ranked No. 5 in the latest Associated Press poll and No. 2 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 39 straight weeks and had been ranked in the top 10 in 35 of the last 36 polls.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Mamadi Diakite scored 15 points and Jay Huff added 13 as then-No. 7 Virginia defeated Maine 46-26 in nonconference action on Nov. 27.
- Diakite had a game-high seven rebounds along with two steals.
- UVA forced 21 turnovers and outscored Maine 20-6 in the paint.
- Maine shot 18.6 percent (8-43), second lowest all-time for a Cavalier opponent.
- The 26 points allowed matched the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- The 46 points are the fewest scored by an AP-ranked team in a
- 20-point victory in poll history (since 1948-49).

### **LAST TIME AGAINST THE BOILERMAKERS**

- Kyle Guy scored 25 points and Ty Jerome added 24 as then-No. 1 seed Virginia topped then-No. 3 seed Purdue 80-75 in overtime in the 2019 NCAA Elite Eight on March 30.
- Mamadi Diakite's jump shot at the end of regulation sent the game to overtime as UVA overcame Carsen Edwards' game-high 42 points.
- Kihei Clark delivered the game-tying assist to Diakite in regulation and the Cavaliers outscored the Boilermakers 10-5 in the extra
- Guy added 10 rebounds for his first career double-double and Diakite chipped in 14 points, seven rebounds and four blocked shots.
- Edwards drilled 10 of 19 3-point attempts in his 42-point outburst.
- UVA went 17 of 20 from the charity stripe and outrebounded Purdue 39-31.

### **UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS**

• As of Dec. 2, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (40.3), field goal percentage defense (28.8), personal fouls per game (10.7) and winning percentage (100.0), fourth in fewest fouls (75) and eighth in 3-point field goal percentage defense (24.7).

### **HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- UVA is 6-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 93-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 118-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 3-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (26-0 all-time under Bennett).

### VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 261-89 (.746) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 330-122 (.730) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett has guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 139-36 (.794) in non-conference action (77-6 at JPJ), 122-53 (.697) in ACC play and 147-26 (.850) at home under Tony Bennett.
   Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .697, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

### **HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.9 ppg) and is third in rebounding (7.3), while Clark is averaging 9.6 points, 4.7 rebounds and a teamhigh 5.0 assists.
- Key is averaging 10.3 points and a team-high 8.3 rebounds, and Huff has tallied 10.3 points, 7.4 rebounds and team-high 11 blocks.
- Kody Stattmann and newcomers Casey Morsell and Tomas Woldetensae have absorbed the minutes left by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Morsell, who scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors, is averaging 5.0 points.
- Stattmann is averaging 5.3 points, but has missed the last four games due to an illness.
- Woldetensae has started six games and had six rebounds in wins over Columbia and Vermont.
- Justin McKoy brings frontcourt depth, while walk-on Chase Coleman backs up point quard Kihei Clark.
- Francisco Caffaro has appeared in three contests.
- Walk-ons Austin Katstra and Jayden Nixon provide additional depth.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is expected to redshirt this season, while Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.

### **OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- UVA limited six of its first seven opponents to fewer than 50 points.
   The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA ranks first in the NCAA in scoring defense (40.3 ppg) after capturing its fifth NCAA scoring defense title in 2018-19 (56.1 ppg).
- The Cavaliers have limited four opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia and Maine) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held all seven opponents below 41 percent from the field.

- UVA has out-rebounded six opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

### **ABDUR-RAHIM, BEEKMAN AND MCCORKLE SIGN NLIS**

- Virginia announced the signings of guards Jabri Abdur-Rahim (Short Hills, N.J./Blair Academy), Reece Beekman (Baton Rouge, La./ Scotlandville High School) and Carson McCorkle (Greensboro, N.C./ Greensboro Day School) on Nov. 14.
- The 6-7, 205-pound Abdur-Rahim averaged 16.7 points and 8.7 rebounds during his junior season at Blair Academy in 2018-19. Abdur-Rahim was named New Jersey Gatorade Player of the Year after leading Blair Academy to the Prep A state championship.
- Beekman, a 6-2, 165-pound point guard, averaged 21.9 points, 10.2 rebounds and 10.2 assists as a junior for Scotlandville in 2018-19. He was named first-team all-state from USA Today and the Louisiana Sports Writers Association.
- The 6-3, 173-pound McCorkle tallied 15.9 points per game en route to AP and NCISAA 4A All-State honors at Greensboro Day School.

- Four of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 poll (Louisville, North Carolina, Duke and Florida State), while two (Purdue and Notre Dame) received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech
- UVA defeated First Four NCAA Tournament team Arizona State in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament championship on Nov. 24.
- Two opponents (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.

### **VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked second and finished first last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

### **DIAKITE EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS**
