**FOR OPENERS**

- Virginia and Boston College meet for the second time in 2019-20.
- The Eagles defeated the Cavaliers 60-53 in Chestnut Hill on Jan. 7.
- UVA (9-5) is fourth in the ACC, while Boston College (7-8) is tied for seventh.
- Mamadi Diakite was named ACC Player of the Week after averaging 17.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in a pair of wins last week.

**ALL-TIME AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE**

- Virginia is 15-8 all-time vs. Boston College, including an 11-8 ACC mark, in the series that dates back to 1971-72.
- The Eagles ended the Cavaliers' six-game winning streak in the series with its 60-53 win on Jan. 7, but UVA has won eight of the last 10 games in the series.
- UVA is 8-2 against Boston College in Charlottesville, including a five-game winning streak at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA has limited BC to 58 or fewer points in five of the last six meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-5 all-time against Boston College.

**LAST TIME VS. THE EAGLES**

- Jay Heath scored 17 points to lead Boston College to a 60-53 win over Virginia on Jan. 7 in Chestnut Hill.
- Braxton Key had 16 points and eight rebounds, Kihei Clark chipped in 12 points and Kody Stattmann added a career-best 11 points, for the Cavaliers
- UVA trailed 30-26 at the half, but used a 20-3 run to gain a 50-45 second-half lead.
- Jared Hamilton's 3-pointer with 38 seconds remaining proved to be the game-winner, giving the Eagles a 56-53 lead.
- UVA shot a season-low 32.7 percent from the field (17 of 52) and was just 3 of 16 from 3-point range.
- Jared Hamilton (16), Steffon Mitchell (10) and Jairus Hamilton (10) also landed in double figures for Boston College.

**CLARK, DIAKITE, HUFF AND KEY AMONG ACC LEADERS**

- Kihei Clark ranks first in the ACC in minutes (37.5), second in free throw percentage (84.7), third in assists (6.1) and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7).
- Braxton Key ranks seventh in defensive rebounds (5.5), ninth in steals (1.5) and 11th in rebounding (7.2).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks eighth in blocks (1.3), 13th in defensive rebounds (4.9), 14th in scoring (13.7) & 16th in rebounding (6.5).
- Jay Huff ranks fifth in blocks (1.7) and 18th in rebounding (6.2).

**LAST TIME OUT**

- Tomas Woldetensae buried a 3-pointer with 0.8 seconds remaining to lift Virginia (17-7, 9-5 ACC) to a 64-62 win at North Carolina on Feb. 15.
- Woldetensae drilled six 3-pointers to finish with a team-high 18 points.
- Mamadi Diakite added 15 points and Kihei Clark and Casey Morsell chipped in 10 points each as UVA won back-to-back road contests at North Carolina for the first time.
- UVA outscored UNC 17-0 in bench points, led by Morsell (10), Francisco Caffaro (4) and Kody Stattmann (3).
- Cole Anthony led the Tar Heels with a game-high 20 points and Amando Bacot had a game-high 16 rebounds.
- UVA shot 44.4 percent, including 42.9 percent from 3-point range (9 of 21).

**UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS**

- As of Feb. 17, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (52.0), second in field goal percentage defense (36.7), fourth in fewest fouls (326), fifth in personal fouls per game (13.6) and 18th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.1).

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 192-45 (.810), including an 11-3 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak, while Syracuse ended the Cavaliers' six-game home ACC winning streak.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last season and is 153-29 (.841), including a 119-14 (.895) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 62-8 (.886) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 61-9 (.871).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

**HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- UVA is 11-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 98-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 123-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 4-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 271-96 (.738) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 340-129 (.725) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 130-58 (.691) in ACC play, 154-29 (.842) at home and 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPI) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .691, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

**OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- UVA has limited 11 opponents to fewer than 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 18 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 19 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has outrebounded 18 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

**HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.7 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.5), while Clark is averaging 10.3 points, 4.3 rebounds and a team-high 6.1 assists.
- Diakite has 509 career rebounds at Virginia.
- Key is averaging 9.7 points and a team-high 7.2 rebounds.
- Key has totaled 1,008 career points (589 at Alabama and 420 at Virginia) and 683 career rebounds (331 at Alabama and 352 at Virginia).
- Huff has tallied 8.0 points and 6.2 rebounds and a team-high 41 blocks. Huff recorded career highs in points (17) and blocks (6) at Georgia Tech.
- Tomas Woldetsaie has started the past eight games and has made a team-high 44 3-pointers, including seven at Wake Forest

- and Louisville, and six at North Carolina.
- Woldetsaie is the 3rd Virginia player in the last 20 seasons to have multiple games with at least 7 made 3-pt FG, joining Curtis Staples (8 such games) and Kyle Guy (3).
- Casey Morsell scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament. Morsell added 10 points and three steals at UNC.
- Kody Stattmann is averaging 4.3 points, including career highs in points (11) at Boston College and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Francisco Caffaro contributed 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina, six points vs. NC State and four points and one block at North Carolina.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 5.1 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser is sitting out the season after transferring from Marquette.

**UVA RECEIVES VOTES IN NATIONAL POLLS**

- UVA received votes in the latest AP poll.
- UVA, which has been unranked in five straight polls, was unranked in the Jan. 13 AP poll for the first time since Nov. 20, 2017, ending its streak at 46 straight weeks in the national polls.

**WATCH ME NOW**

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50.

**DIAKITE EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS**

- Mamadi Diakite was named the preseason All-ACC first team.
- Diakite was joined on the All-ACC first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Jordan Nwora (Louisville), Tre Jones (Duke), Cole Anthony (North Carolina) and John Mooney (Notre Dame).

**RECORDS WATCH**

- Mamadi Diakite is tied for second with Chris Alexander (1993-96) on UVA's career blocks list with 148.
- Diakite ranks second among active ACC players in career blocked shots.
- Ralph Sampson is UVA's career blocked shots leader with 462.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's single-season list.
- Kihei Clark ranks 11th on UVA's season assist list with 146.
- Clark needs seven assists to pass Othell Wilson (1982-83) for 10th and eight assists to pass London Perrantes (2015-16) for ninth.
- Jay Huff ranks 11th on UVA's single-season blocks list with 41.
- Huff needs three blocks to pass Isaiah Wilkins (2016-17) for 10th.

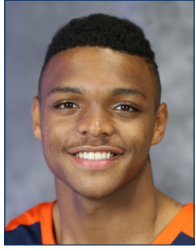

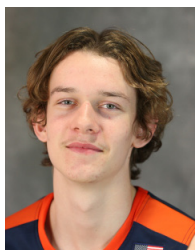
