FOR OPENERS

- Virginia and Pitt meet for the lone time in 2019-20.
- UVA (10-5) is fourth in the ACC, while Pitt (6-10) is tied for 12th.
- UVA has won 10 or more ACC games for a school-record eight straight seasons.
- UVA posted season highs in points (78), field goal (57.8%) and 3-point (58.8%) percentage in its win vs. Boston College.
- UVA is averaging 64 points during its three-game winning streak.
- Reigning ACC Player of the Week Mamadi Diakite blocked two shots vs. Boston College to rank second all-time at UVA with 150.
- Tomas Woldetensae is shooting 50 percent from 3-point range over his last four games (18 of 36).

ALL-TIME AGAINST PITT

- UVA is 15-4 all-time vs. Pitt in the series that dates back to 1957-58.
- UVA has won four straight contests vs. the Panthers, including a 73-49 tilt last season at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Panthers 66-37 in their last visit to Petersen Events Center in 2017-18.
- Virginia has won 11 of the last 12 meetings and is 6-3 in Pittsburgh.
- UVA is 8-1 against Pitt since 2013-14 when the Panthers joined the ACC.
- Tony Bennett is 8-2 all-time vs. Pitt, including an 8-1 mark at UVA.

LAST TIME VS. THE PANTHERS

- Kyle Guy scored 17 points to lead then-No. 2 Virginia to a 73-49 win over Pitt on March 2, 2019.
- Ty Jerome added 13 points and De'Andre Hunter chipped in 12 points and five assists as Virginia improved to 26-2, 14-2 ACC.
- The Cavaliers used a 16-0 run to gain a 39-19 halftime lead.
- UVA shot 58.5 percent from the floor and went 9 of 16 from 3-point range in its sixth consecutive win.
- Pitt (12-17, 2-14 ACC) was led by Jared Wilson-Frame's 15 points.

CLARK, DIAKITE, HUFF AND KEY AMONG ACC LEADERS

- Kihei Clark ranks first in the ACC in minutes (37.2), second in free throw percentage (85.5), third in assists (6.2) and seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.8).
- Braxton Key ranks eighth in defensive rebounds (5.5) and 11th in steals (1.4) and rebounding (7.2).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks seventh in blocks (1.3), 12th in defensive rebounds (5.0), 14th in scoring (13.5) & 16th in rebounding (6.6).
- Jay Huff ranks fourth in blocks (1.8) and 20th in rebounding (6.2).

ON THE ROAD

- Virginia is 4-4 in true road games in 2019-20, defeating Syracuse (48-34), Georgia Tech (63-58), Wake Forest (65-63 OT) and North Carolina (64-62).
- The Cavaliers are 6-4 away from home, including a pair of neutral site wins at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament.
- UVA went 8-1 in ACC road action last season and 10-1 overall.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kihei Clark and Braxton Key each tallied 17 points to lead Virginia to a 78-65 win over Boston College on Feb. 19.
- Tomas Woldetensae and Jay Huff each had 14 points and Mamadi Diakite added 10 as five UVA players landed in double figures for the first time since at Notre Dame on Jan. 26, 2019.
- UVA (18-7, 10-5 ACC) shot a season-high 58.8 percent, including a blistering 68.4 percent (13 of 19) in the second half.
- Clark dished out a game-high eight assists and Key added a career-high four blocks as the Cavaliers tied a season high with nine rejections.
- Nik Popovic had a game-high 22 points and Jay Heath added 18 for the Eagles (13-14, 7-9 ACC).
- The 78 points and 58.8 percent 3-point shooting (10 of 17) were also season bests for the Cavaliers.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Feb. 20, Virginia ranks second in the nation in scoring defense (52.6), third in field goal percentage defense (37.1) and fewest fouls (337), fourth in personal fouls per game (13.5) and 25th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.4).

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 11-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 98-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 123-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 4-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).

UVA RECEIVES VOTES IN NATIONAL POLLS

- UVA received votes in the latest AP and USA Today Coaches' poll.
- UVA, which has been unranked in six straight polls, was unranked in the Jan. 13 AP poll for the first time since Nov. 20, 2017, ending its streak at 46 straight weeks in the national polls.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 272-96 (.739) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 341-129 (.726) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 131-58 (.693) in ACC play, 155-29 (.842) at home and 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .693, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited 11 opponents to fewer than 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 18 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 20 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has outrebounded 18 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.5 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.6), while Clark is averaging 10.6 points, 4.2 rebounds and a team-high 6.2 assists.
- Diakite has 516 career rebounds at Virginia.
- Key is averaging 10 points and a team-high 7.2 rebounds.
- Key has totaled 1,025 career points (589 at Alabama and 437 at Virginia) and 689 career rebounds (331 at Alabama and 358 at Virginia).
- Huff has tallied 8.2 points and 6.2 rebounds and a team-high 44 blocks. Huff recorded career highs in points (17) and blocks (6) at Georgia Tech.
- Tomas Woldetensae has started the past nine games and has made a team-high 48 3-pointers, including seven at Wake Forest and

- Louisville, and six at North Carolina.
- Woldetensae is the 3rd Virginia player in the last 20 seasons to have multiple games with at least 7 made 3-pt FG, joining Curtis Staples (8 such games) and Kyle Guy (3).
- Casey Morsell scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament. Morsell added 10 points and three steals at UNC.
- Kody Stattmann is averaging 4.0 points, including career highs in points (11) at Boston College and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Francisco Caffaro contributed 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina, six points vs. NC State and four points and one block at North Carolina.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 5.1 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser is sitting out the season after transferring from Marquette.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 193-45 (.811), including a 12-3 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak, while Syracuse ended the Cavaliers' six-game home ACC winning streak.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last season and is 154-29 (.842), including a 120-14 (.896) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 63-8 (.887) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 61-9 (.871).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

WATCH ME NOW

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50.

DIAKITE EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- Mamadi Diakite was named the preseason All-ACC first team.
- Diakite was joined on the All-ACC first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Jordan Nwora (Louisville), Tre Jones (Duke), Cole Anthony (North Carolina) and John Mooney (Notre Dame).

RECORDS WATCH

- Mamadi Diakite is second on UVA's career blocks list with 150.
- Diakite ranks second among active ACC players in career blocked shots.
- Ralph Sampson is UVA's career blocked shots leader with 462.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's single-season list.

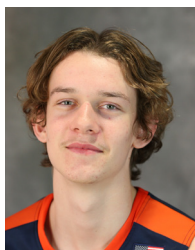
