FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Friday marks the 32nd all-time meeting between Virginia and Syracuse and the 12th meeting in Charlottesville.
- UVA head coach Dom Starsia and Syracuse head coach John Desko have a combined nine NCAA titles between them. Denver's Bill Tierney is the only other active coach to have won at least four NCAA titles.
- UVA attackman James Pannell had a career-high seven goals in the 2014 meeting as a sophomore, the last time the Orange came to Klöckner Stadium.
- Zed Williams' 10 ground balls against Loyola in the opening game are the second most in the nation this season by a non-FOGO in a game. Most is 11 by Brown's Alec Tulett vs. Stony Brook.
- Ryan Conrad's seven points through his first four collegiate games is the most points by a UVA freshman midfielder in the Dom Starsia era.

GAME OVERVIEW

Virginia (2-2) opens ACC play on Friday when the Syracuse Orange (3-0) come to Klöckner Stadium. Faceoff is set for 5:30 p.m. UVA is ranked No. 17 in the USILA coaches poll and No. 14 in the Cascade/Maverik media poll. Syracuse is ranked No. 3 in both polls.

THE SERIES VS. ORANGE

The Cavaliers and Orange are meeting for the 32nd time in series history, but are playing each other for only the third time as part of ACC play. Virginia has won 9 of the last 13 regular season meetings, but three of the four losses have come at the Carrier Dome (2011, 2013, 2015). UVA owns the narrow 16-15 margin in the all-time series between two programs that recently won four NCAA titles between 2006-11.

The Orange came away with a 15-9 win the last time these team got together in 2015 at the Carrier Dome. The last time UVA and Syracuse met at Klöckner Stadium James Pannell scored seven goals and the Cavaliers cruised to a 17-12 win.

Widely regarded as one of the best teachers, motivators and tacticians in the game, Dom Starsia is in his 24th season at the helm of the Virginia men's lacrosse program.

Under Starsia's guidance, his Cavalier squads have won four NCAA titles and reached the

final four 13 times. He has won more games than any coach in Atlantic Coast Conference and Virginia history, sporting a 269-97 (.735) record since coming to Charlottesville in 1993. In his 24th season with Virginia, Starsia has coached 366 games, fittingly his 300th game at Virginia was the 2011 NCAA title game against Maryland at Baltimore's M&T Bank Stadium.

HALL OF FAMER STARSIA TOPS NCAA DI WINS LIST

- Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is one of the most accomplished coaches in the history of the college game coaching at Brown (1983-92) and Virginia (1993-present)
- He passed Jack Emmer for most career wins by a head coach while coaching at a NCAA Division I school with UVA's quarterfinal win over Cornell in 2011
- He becomes the second UVA head coach to hold the record as Jim Adams retired with 284 career victories after the 1992 season, giving way to Starsia to take the Cavalier program over in 1993 - Adams retired as the record holder
- He was inducted into the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in November 2008
- He has led UVA to four national championships ('99, '03, '06, '11)
- His teams have made 26 NCAA Tournament appearances, the most by any Division I coach in history
- His Cavalier squads have advanced to the final four 13 times
- One of four coaches in college lacrosse history to win 100+ games at two schools (along with Jack Emmer, Dave Urlick and John Danowski who joined the group in 2013)
- Only Division I coach to win 200+ games at one Division I school while winning 100+ at another Division I institution
- He is a three-time national coach of the year ('85, '91, '11)
- ACC Coach of the Year a record eight times

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

CREDENTIALS

Admission to the press box is by official credential only and is strictly limited to members of the working press, radio and television personnel. Please allow ample time for the mailing of credentials or they will be left at the Will Call window at Klöckner Stadium.

Special requests should be made in advance. Parking is always available on an unreserved basis at University Hall. Normal pregame and postgame information is supplied.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

Requests for photo passes must be made in advance through the Athletics Media Relations Office. Photographers must observe the field markings for lacrosse. No tri-pod equipment may be used on the field level, for the safety of the players and photographers.

RADIO

Broadcasts are made from the radio broadcast facilities in Klöckner Stadium. There is one courtesy line available for use by visiting radio crews. Adequate space is available for the visiting team needs. Arrangement for broadcasts must be validated in advance through the UVA Athletics Media Relations Office.

INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with coaches and players should be made through Vincent Briedis in the Athletics Media Relations Office. Postgame interviews are conducted at field level following the postgame handshake. Locker rooms are closed.

THE SERIES VS. SYRACUSE

- UVA narrowly leads the series 16-15 which mimics the back-and-forth scoring characteristic of the games between the two teams.
- The two schools battled only three times between 1938-93, but have met at least once each season since 1994.
- The regular-season series began in 1995, Dom Starsia's third season at Virginia.
- The two schools have also met six times in the NCAA Tournament since 1995.
- Virginia has won nine of the last 13 meetings in the series, including six straight regular-season matchups until the 2011 setback at the Carrier Dome.
- The Cavaliers' success lately closely mirrors that of the Orange who won eight of nine games from 1997-2002.
- The Orange won in overtime, 9-8, in the 2003 at the Dome. It was the first time in the series that neither team scored in the double figures.
- Another heartbreaking UVA loss saw the Orange pull out a dramatic come-from-behind 12-11 double overtime win in the semifinals of the 2008 NCAA Tournament on the way to capturing the national championship.
- The 2008 Syracuse NCAA win ended Virginia's five-game series winning streak, the longest by either team in the series.
- Both teams are known for their high-scoring offenses, but it is interesting to note that since 1999 Syracuse has scored at least 15 goals only five times (2002-03-04-06-15) and Virginia four (03-06-06-14) in the series.
- Virginia's loss in 2011 snapped a three game win streak in the "Dome" over Syracuse, a feat boasted by no other opponent of the Orange.
- The last meeting at Klöckner Stadium between UVA and Syracuse in 2014, James Pannell scored a career-high seven goals in a 17-12 triumph.

TIGHT GAMES CHARACTERIZE SERIES

- The potential for a high-scoring game such as the classic 1997 match-up won by Syracuse 22-21 is one of the main reasons this game is so widely anticipated.
- However, since 1996 a three-goal win can be considered a "blow out"
- 16 of the last 24 games since then have been decided by just one or two goals.
- More than half the games between the two schools (18 of 31), have been decided by one or two goals, including both games in 2008, which went to overtime.
- In the history of the series, the biggest win by either team is a 13-4 Syracuse win in 1938 in the first meeting between the two squads.
- Virginia's biggest win is a 15-7 victory in the Carrier Dome in 1995.
- UVA's 14-10 win in 2012 was the largest winning-margin for the Cavaliers in the series since winning 17-10 in the 2006 Final Four.
- UVA's 2014 win was a five-goal margin, 17-12, at Klöckner Stadium.
- Syracuse's 2015 win was a six-goal margin, 15-9, at the Dome, its largest win in the series since winning 18-12 in Charlottesville in 2004.

A DIFFERENT FEEL TO THE 2016 MEETING BETWEEN UVA AND CUSE

- The 2016 meeting between Virginia and Syracuse marks the first time since 2007 that the Cavaliers do not enter the contest with the Orange with an undefeated record. In 10 seasons, UVA is only entering the Syracuse game with at least one loss for only the second time. UVA also entered the 2007 meeting with a loss.
- Historically the meeting is between two defeated teams over the past 10 seasons.
- In 2007, 2013 and 2014 Syracuse entered the game with at least one loss.
- Since the USILA coaches poll came out in 1973, there have been 19 meetings between UVA and Syracuse and 17 of them matched two Top-5 teams. This is only the third meeting since the USILA coaches poll came out where both teams are not ranked in the USILA coaches poll Top-5.

NO WONDER THE SERIES IS NEARLY 50/50

- Since Dom Starsia became head coach at Virginia in 1993, the two teams have met 28 times—with Syracuse winning 14 times and Virginia 14.
- 17 of those games have been decided by one or two goals, including a string of five meetings - both games in 2008 went to overtime - until UVA's four-goal win in 2012 in Charlottesville snapped the streak.

RYAN CONRAD POISED FOR A SPECIAL FRESHMAN SEASON

- Freshman midfielder Ryan Conrad has five goals and seven total points through his first four games of his Virginia career.
- The seven points are the most by a Dom Starsia freshman (1993-present) through a season's first four games, while playing strictly midfield in their first season.
- Ryan Tucker (2012) is the only freshman midfielder under Starsia to have more goals (six) than Conrad through the season's first four games.
- Conrad is already No. 11 all-time among Starsia freshman for a season playing strictly midfield.

VIRGINIA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

- Virginia owns a 123-30 (.8039) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 1-2 mark in 2016. UVA also is 11-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993, the first season Dom Starsia was the head coach of the Cavaliers.

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

- According to UVA head coach Dom Starsia - "If there's any single statistic that speaks to your effort overall, then it's that one (ground balls)."
- UVA has led the nation in ground balls three of the last five years.
- Since the NCAA started including ground balls per game in their national rankings in 2009, UVA has never finished a season lower than No. 3 in ground balls per game.
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the Top-5 nationally in ground balls per game over the last six seasons.
- Duke is the closest team to UVA, finishing in the Top-5 three during the same span.

CAN'T SCORE UNLESS YOU CLEAR THE BALL

- Virginia registered a .918 percent success rate on clears in 2013, giving the Cavaliers four seasons in a row clearing the ball above .900 percent.
- No other team in the nation has ever been able to boast such a streak.
- UVA cleared at a .907 rate in 2012, a .900 rate in 2011 and a .922 rate in 2010.
- During that time UVA twice ranked No. 3 in the nation in scoring offense, scoring 13.44 goals per game in 2010 and 12.56 goals per game in 2011
- UVA ranked No. 11 in 2012 with 11.5 goals per game.
- The streak snapped in 2014 when UVA only cleared at a .851 rate.
- According to research in collaboration with all NCAA DI men's lacrosse SIDs, only 21 teams have cleared at over .900 in a season, five times its been done by UVA, dating back to 1971 - the first year lacrosse was an NCAA Championship sport.
- UVA records on clearing date back to 1971 - some schools like Syracuse (1983), only go back to a certain year in regards to clearing stats. Below is the current list of all-time .900+ clearing schools in a season:

VIRGINIA IN OVERTIME UNDER DOM STARSIA

- UVA is 24-17 all-time in overtime under Dom Starsia. Seven of those losses came in NCAA Tournament action. UVA is 3-7 in OT games in the NCAA Tournament under Starsia.
- Since the start of the 2007 season, UVA is 14-5 in overtime games under Starsia.
- The five losses since 2007 came at Duke (2007), Syracuse in the NCAA semifinal in 2008, Johns Hopkins (2012) in a regular season matchup, at Syracuse (2013) and home against High Point (2016).
- Virginia is 14-3 all-time in OT games at Klöckner Stadium, which doubles as the record under Starsia at UVA's home edifice.
- The first loss was the 2000 meeting with Syracuse, the second was the 2012 Hopkins game and the third was the 2016 High Point game.
- Starsia is 14-4 all-time at home in OT games while at UVA - the 1998 Syracuse game was played at the Field Hockey Turf Field, resulting in a loss.

DOM (INATION) OF THE USILA POLLS

- Since Dom Starsia took over as head coach of the Virginia program in 1993, there have been 257 USILA coaches polls, including this week's poll.
- Of those 257 polls, Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in 55 of them.
- Which means that in 24 seasons under Dom Starsia, Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation 21.6 percent of the time.
- The two programs closest to UVA's dominance are Syracuse at 54 weeks and Johns Hopkins at 41 weeks.
- The USILA coaches poll is the oldest lacrosse poll and was established in 1973.

The No. 14 Loyola Greyhounds (1-0) used a 5-0 run to help jump-start an 11-4 triumph over the No. 8 home-standing Virginia Cavaliers (0-1) inside Klöckner Stadium.

Loyola used a 5-0 run and held UVA scoreless in the first quarter to take commanding control of the game. Brian Sherlock capped the run for the Greyhounds at the 5:39 mark in the second quarter. UVA's Greg Coholan put a stop to the Loyola streak with an unassisted goal at 4:22. Freshman Ryan Conrad scored his first collegiate goal for the Cavaliers at 1:20 on an assist from Mike D'Amario to finish the first half scoring for both teams.

The Greyhounds used a 3-1 run to start the third quarter, capped by a Zach Herreweyers goal on a Sherlock helper at 6:39, giving Loyola an 8-3 lead. Ryan Lukacovic scored for UVA on a James Pannell helper with 1:13 left in the third quarter to get something started for the Cavaliers. However, after winning the ensuing faceoff UVA turned the ball over and Loyola deposited another Herreweyers goal in transition with two seconds left in the period.

Virginia was shutout again in the fourth as Loyola added two more to close the scoring. The loss for Virginia snapped a nine-game winning streak in season openers. UVA last lost a season opener against Drexel in 2007 when the Cavaliers were ranked No. 1. That loss was at UVA's UHall Turf Field.

Virginia won the battle of shots (40-33), ground balls (39-32) and faceoffs (10-7), while Loyola had more saves (14-10) and turnovers (15-13).

UVA's Zed Williams led all players with 10 ground balls.
