THE SERIES VS. YALE

- Monday marks the eighth all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and the Bulldogs. Yale leads the series with a narrow 4-3 margin.
- UVA and Yale last met in 1991 when the Cavaliers won 13-6 in a game played at Scott Stadium in Charlottesville. Perry Frazer led UVA with four goals and three assists for seven points. Kevin Pehlke added three goals and two assists, while Andy Kraus, the uncle of current Cavalier Michael Kraus, added three goals.

#GOHOOS: BY THE NUMBERS

UVA is No. 1 in the nation in ground balls with 41.21 GBs per game. UVA led the nation in both 2017 & 2018. Tiffany's Brown team led the nation in 2016.

A win for UVA on Monday would give the Cavaliers their sixth NCAA title and first since 2011. UVA has won NCAA titles in 1972, 1999, 2003, 2006 & 2011.

Michael Kraus has at least one point in all 48 career games he has appeared in. The active streak is No. 5 in the nation.

COVERING THE CAVALIERS

UNIQUELY UVA

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVA's culture.

Grounds: The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year: Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

Commonwealth: Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

UNIVERSITY NICKNAMES

Virginia's athletics teams have been accompanied by a somewhat confusing array of nicknames. The most prominent and widely accepted of these monikers are "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos."

Although the terms "Cavaliers," "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are used almost interchangeably to refer to University teams and players, "Cavaliers" is more often used by the media, while "Wahoos" and "Hoos" are frequently used by Virginia students and fans.

Legend has it that Washington & Lee baseball fans dubbed the Virginia players "Wahoos" during the fiercely contested rivalry that existed between the two in-state schools in the 1890s. By 1940, "Wahoos" was in general use around Grounds to denote University students or events relating to them. The abbreviated "Hoos" sprang up later in student newspapers and has gained growing popularity in recent years.

THE CAVALIER MASCOT

The costumed Cavalier with a large character head debuted during Virginia's 1984 football season and has remained the official mascot of the University.

UNIVERSITY COLORS

Orange and blue were adopted as the University of Virginia's official athletic colors at a mass student meeting in 1888. UVA athletic teams had previously worn silver gray and cardinal red, but those colors did not stand out on muddy football fields, prompting a student movement to change them.

One of the students attending the mass meeting was Allen Potts, a star athlete who played on Virginia's first football team in 1888. Potts showed up at the meeting wearing a navy blue-and-orange scarf that he had acquired during a summer boating expedition at Oxford University. Orange and blue were chosen as the official athletic colors after one of Potts' fellow students pulled the scarf off Potts' neck and, waving it to the crowd, yelled, "How will this do?" UVA later served as the inspiration for schools like Auburn and Florida when they selected school colors.

WAH-HOO-WAH

The origin of "Wah-hoo-wah" is uncertain. The cheer was used to root on Virginia teams as early as 1890 and may have been borrowed from Dartmouth College, whose athletics teams were once known as the Indians.

Legend attributes the yell to Natalie Floyd Otey, who sang the ballad "Where'er You Are, There Shall My Love Be" at Charlottesville's Levy Opera House in 1893. The predominantly student audience noticed that Otey warbled the first three words of the song between each of the stanzas and decided to join in the refrain. By evening's end, goes the legend, the crowd had corrupted "Where'er You Are" into "Wah-hoowah."

The Levy Opera House stands at the corner of High Street and Park Street and has since been renovated into an office building.

CAVALIERS ADVANCE TO THE NCAA TITLE GAME

- UVA is making its 10th all-time appearance in the NCAA Finals and first since 2011 when the Virginia ended up winning it all.
- UVA has reached the finals in 1972, 1980, 1986, 1994, 1996, 1999, 2003, 2006, 2011 and 2019.
- UVA has won five NCAA title (1972, 1999, 2003, 2006 and 2011). UVA won its 2006 NCAA title and Philadelphia's Lincoln Financial Field.
- UVA went to 13 Championship Weekends from 1995-2011, but since the Cavaliers have made only two quarterfinal appearances and now their first final appearance in eight years.

VIRGINIA AS THE TOURNEY'S NO. 3 SEED

- Virginia is the No. 3 seed in the NCAA Championship for the seventh time in program history.
- This is the first time since 2002 that UVA has been the tournament's No. 3 seed.
- UVA is 12-5 all-time as the No. 3 seed, including winning the 1999 NCAA title.
- UVA has been the No. 3 seed in 2002, 1999, 1996, 1986, 1983 and 1982.

VIRGINIA VS. THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

- Virginia is 9-2 against teams in the 2019 NCAA Tournament field, which is the most among the tournament field.
- UVA owns wins over Duke, Johns Hopkins, Marist, Maryland, Notre Dame (2), Richmond, Robert Morris and Syracuse. UVA has lost to Duke and Lovola.

TIFFANY CONNECTED TO UVA'S TITLE COACHES

- UVA head coach Lars Tiffany is connected in the lacrosse world to both Glenn Thiel and Dom Starsia, the two Virginia coaches who brought NCAA titles to Charlottesville.
- Tiffany played for Starsia at Brown and coached under Thiel at Penn State (2000-04).

CHAMPIONSHIP WEEKEND NO STRANGER TO STAFF

- UVA head coach Lars Tiffany and assistants Kip Turner and Sean Kirwan are no strangers to Championship Weekend. The trip brought Brown to Championship Weekend in 2016.
- Turner won a championship in 2006 as the starting goalie of Virginia. That championship was won in Philadelphia.
- Kirwan won a DIII championship at Championship Weekend in 2010 as a player at Tufts and as a coach at Tufts in 2014.
- Volunteer assistant Coach Bo Lori also has Championship Weekend experience as a player. Lori played for Ohio State as the Buckeyes made Championship Weekend in 2017, losing in the title game to Maryland.

UVA IN CHAMPIONSHIP WEEKEND FOR 23RD TIME

- Virginia is making its 23rd appearance at Championship Weekend and its first since 2011 when the Cavaliers won their fifth NCAA title.
- UVA is No. 4 all-time in NCAA semifinal appearances, trailing only Johns Hopkins (29), Syracuse (26) and Marvland (26).
- UVA is 10-13 all-time in the NCAA semifinal round and 5-4 all-time in the final round.

MORE ON YALE SERIES

- In a series that began in 1927, UVA and Yale have only met in the NCAA Tournament one other time.
- UVA and Yale met in the first round of the 1988 NCAA Tournament in New Haven, Conn., in what is the only meeting in the series played at Yale.
- UVA won in double overtime, 10-9, over then-No. 7 national seeded Yale.
- This is the third time UVA has played in an NCAA title game against an Ivy League school. The Cavaliers dropped the 1994 and 1996 NCAA title games against Princeton.

TIFFANY AND HIS IVY LEAGUE CONNECTIONS

- UVA head coach Lars Tiffany is no stranger to Yale after facing them 11 times during his 10 seasons as the head coach at Brown (2007-16).
- Yale will be the sixth-different Ivy League school Tiffany's UVA program will face in three seasons. Counting Monday against Yale, Harvard is the only Ivy League team UVA has not faced since 2016.
- UVA faced Cornell and Penn in 2017. UVA faced Princeton and Dartmouth in 2018. UVA faced Brown, Princeton and now Yale in 2019.
- The last time Tiffany coached against Yale in 2016, his Brown team beat then-No. 1 Yale at home (14-12).

RODE TIES A CAREER HIGH

- GK Alex Rode tied his career high with 19 saves against Duke in the NCAA semifinal round on Saturday.
- Rode also had 19 saves earlier this season against Brown, a 14-13 overtime win.
- It was the most saves in an NCAA Tournament game for UVA since Tom Groeninger had 21 against Towson in the first round in 1991.

VIRGINIA COMING FROM BEHIND IN TOURNAMENT

- Virginia has won its last two games in the NCAA Tournament, despite leading for only a combined 9:43 during both games.
- UVA trailed five goals to Maryland in the quarterfinals in the fourth quarter with 10:38 left to play. Against Duke, UVA trailed by four in the third (8-4) and by two with as few as 47 seconds left.

KRAUS ON THE VERGE OF THE 100-100 CLUB

- Michael Kraus needs three assists to become only the fourth Cavalier to reach 100 career goals and 100 career assists.
- Kraus has 114 career goals and 97 career assists for 211 career points. His 211 career points ranks No. 9 all-time in the UVA record book.
- Steele Stanwick (126-143), Kevin Pehlke (138-101) and Danny Glading (119-104) are the other Cavaliers in the 100-100 club.

LAVIANO CLIMBS UVA'S SINGLE-SEASON GOAL LIST

CONRAD IS A SPECIAL KIND OF MIDFIELDER

- Ryan Conrad has 88 ground balls and 48 points (30-18) this season.
- Conrad is the only player in the nation with at least 70 ground balls and 12+ points. Yale's faceoff specialist TD Ierlan is the closest to Conrad, tallying 11 points to go with his nation-leading 282 ground balls.
- Conrad leads the nation's offensive players with 88 ground balls.
- Running on UVA's first midfield, Conrad has 30 goals and 18 assists.
- Conrad trails only FO specialist Petey LaSalla (97) for the UVA team lead in ground balls.
- UVA is No. 1 in the nation in ground balls per game with 41.21 per game. More on UVA and the ground ball on page 12.

VIRGINIA REACHES 16 WINS IN 2019

- Virginia has reached the 16-win plateau for the first time since 2010 when the Cavaliers finished 16-2.
- A win on Monday would tie a program record for most wins in a season, tying them with the 2006 team that went 17-0 and won the NCAA title in Philadelphia.
- Virginia has won 36 games dating back to 2017. It is the most threeyear span of wins since 2010-12 when the Cavaliers won 41 contests.
- UVA is playing game No. 20 on Monday against Yale. It will be a program high for games played in a season. UVA had never played more than 18 games in a season (2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2018) until 2019.

HERRING'S SHOOTING IS ON FIRE

- Mikey Herring is shooting 65.4 percent, which dating back to 1999 is tops among all Cavaliers with at least 10 goals.

UVA NCAA RECORDS SET/TIED VS. ROBERT MORRIS

- Mikey Herring's career-high six goals against Robert Morris in the first round of the NCAA Tournament tied a single-game program. Doug Knight, UVA's all-time career goal scorer, set the standard in 1995 against Brown.
- Justin Schwenk, who filled in for an ill Petey LaSalla, won 22 faceoffs against Robert Morris. It set a UVA single-game NCAA Tournament record. The previous mark was 21 by David Jenkins against Hofstra in 2001. Schwenk is the only Cavalier multiple career games with 20+ faceoff wins. He had 25 against Princeton and 20 at Stony Brook last season.

CAVALIERS SNAP NCAA LOSING STREAK

- Virginia snapped a four-game losing streak in the NCAA Tournament with its 19-10 win over Robert Morris in the first round. It was UVA's first in NCAA Tournament play since 2012 when UVA topped Princeton in the first round, 6-5.
- The four-game losing streak was a program worst in NCAA Tournament play. UVA had never gone seven years in NCAA Tournament play without a win.

VIRGINIA WINS THE 2019 ACC CHAMPIONSHIP

- Virginia won its 18th ACC title and seventh ACC Tournament crown on May 4 vs. then-No. 9 Notre Dame. It was UVA's first ACC championship since 2010 when the Cavaliers topped then-No. 5 Maryland (10-6).
- Ryan Conrad (MVP), Jared Conners, Dox Aitken and Matt Moore were named to the ACC All-Tournament team.
- Virginia won the ACC Tournament in: 1997, 1999, 2000, 2003, 2006, 2010 and 2019.
- Prior to the ACC establishing a tournament in 1989 to determine the league champion, Virginia won 11 ACC titles (1962, 1964, 1969, 1970, 1971, 1975, 1980, 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986).
- From 1989-2019, Virginia has won 14 regular-season titles (1990, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012 and 2019).

AITKEN SETS ANOTHER UVA RECORD

- In only three seasons Dox Aitken has broken two UVA career midfielder records.
- Aitken broke UVA's career record for goals by a midfielder against VMI on April 16. He broke the record in career game No. 46.
- The previous record of 94 goals was shared by Brian Carroll (70 games) and Pete Eldredge (47 games).
- With 101 career goals, Aitken has reached the 90-goal mark quicker than any other midfielder in UVA history.
- On April 27 at North Carolina for the ACC Tournament semifinal round, Aitken passed Shamel Bratton (129) for the all-time career points leader among UVA midfielders.
- Aitken reached 100 career points (75-25-100) on Feb. 18 vs. High Point. He is the quickest midfielder in UVA history to the milestone, reaching so in 36 games and breaking the previous record of 39 games by Pete Eldredge (1969-72).
- Aitken is only the second Cavalier midfielder to reach his 100th career point as a third year, joining Bratton.
- Bratton reached his 100th career point in career game No. 53, while Aitken is the quickest UVA midfielder to 100 points, doing so in 36 career games. Pete Eldredge (1969-72) was the previous record holder reaching 100 career points as a fourth year in career game 39.

UVA ATTACK GETTING IT DONE

- All three of UVA's starting attackmen rank in the Top-4 in the ACC in points per game. Michael Kraus is No. 1 (4.50), while Matt Moore is No. 2 in the ACC (4.42) and Ian Laviano is No. 4 (3.21.
- Kraus is No. 18, Moore is No. 21 in the nation and Laviano is No. 83.
- UVA is one of three schools in the nation (Cornell, Princeton) that has each member of its starting attack ranked in the Top 100 nationally in points per game.

VIRGINIA IN THE POLLS

- Virginia has been ranked in the top five of the USILA Coaches poll 285 weeks all-time.
- UVA has been ranked in the Top 10 in 430 polls all-time.
- The USILA Poll began in 1973.

VIRGINIA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER

- Virginia owns a 147-39 (.7903) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 10-1 mark in 2019. UVA also is 12-3 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- UVA is 20-7 all-time at Klöckner Stadium under head coach Lars Tiffany.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993.

VIRGINIA AND OVERTIME IN 2019

- UVA is 5-0 in overtime in 2019.
- It is the most times UVA has played overtime in a season since going to overtime five times in 2008, which ties a program record. UVA's five overtime wins in 2019 is a program best..
- UVA is 7-2 all-time in overtime under Lars Tiffany, including 2-1 at Klöckner Stadium.
- UVA had a three-game stretch where the Cavaliers played three overtime games in a row.
- It is only the third time in program history UVA played three consecutive games that went to overtime. It was the first time in program history UVA won all three games with wins at then-No. 19 Princeton (12-11), at then No. 14 Syracuse (15-14) and vs. Brown (14-13).
- UVA last played three consecutive overtime games in 2017, going 1-2 with wins vs. Cornell and back-to-back losses to Notre Dame and Johns Hopkins. UVA also played three overtime games in a row in the 1980 NCAA Tournament, beating Cornell and North Carolina before falling to Johns Hopkins in double OT for the NCAA title.
- UVA has never played four consecutive overtime games.

VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE

- Currently UVA is No. 1 in the nation with 41.21 ground balls per game.
- Entering 2019, UVA has led the nation in ground balls five of the last 10 years, including the last two seasons under Lars Tiffany.
- In 2018, UVA ranked No. 1 in the nation in ground balls (38.00).
- UVA is the only school in the nation to finish in the Top-5 nationally in ground balls per game nine times over the last 10 seasons.
- Duke is the closest team to UVA, finishing in the Top-5 four times during the same span.
- The only school in 2016 to finish with more ground balls per game was UVA head coach Lars Tiffany's 2016 Brown team.
