### FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Saturday's road game t Loyola kicks off the 86th season of Virginia lacrosse.
- Virginia has won 13 of its last 14 season openers, losing only to Drexel on the UHall Turf Field in 2007.
- Eleven of those 13 wins came against Drexel and 2014 marked the first time since the 2001 (Towson) season the Cavaliers opened a season against someone other than the Dragons when UVa hosted Loyola.
- UVa and Loyola meet for the 18th time in program history in a series that was first played in 1938.
- UVa has visited the Ridley Athletic Complex before. The Cavaliers first visited the venue when they practiced there the afternoon before winning the 2011 NCAA title at Baltimore's M&T Bank Stadium.

### GAME OVERVIEW

Virginia opens up the 2015 men's lacrosse season on Saturday against the Loyola Greyhounds at the Ridley Athletic Complex in Baltimore, Md. Faceoff is set for 1 p.m. UVa owns a preseason ranking of No. 9 in the USILA coaches poll and the Cascade/Maverik media poll. Loyola, also opening its season, is ranked No. 7 in the preseason USILA coaches and Cascade/Maverik media polls.

### THE SERIES VS. GREYHOUNDS

Saturday marks the 18th all-time meeting between the Cavaliers and Greyhounds in a series that began in 1938. The series took a 23-year hiatus before being rekindled for the 2014 season. Saturday's game is the first meeting of the series to be played at the Ridley Athletic Complex, which didn't exist during the 1990 meeting, UVa's last to Baltimore to play Loyola.

Loyola head coach Charley Toomey is in his 10th season at the helm of his alma mater and returns 27 letterwinners from last year's 15-2 squad, a team that fell to Albany in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Widely regarded as one of the best teachers, motivators and tacticians in the game, Dom Starsia is in his 23rd season at the helm of the Virginia men's lacrosse program.

Under Starsia's guidance, his Cavalier squads have won four NCAA titles and reached the

final four 13 times. He has won more games than any coach in Atlantic Coast Conference and Virginia history, sporting a 257-90 (.741) record since coming to Charlottesville in 1993. In 22 seasons with Virginia, Starsia has coached 347 games, fittingly his 300th game at Virginia was the 2011 NCAA title game against Maryland at Baltimore's M&T Bank Stadium.

**HALL OF FAMER STARSIA TOPS NCAA DI WINS LIST**

- Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is one of the most accomplished coaches in the history of the college game coaching at Brown (1983-92) and Virginia (1993-present)
- He passed Jack Emmer for most career wins by a head coach while coaching at a NCAA Division I school with UVa's quarterfinal win over Cornell in 2011
- He becomes the second UVa head coach to hold the record as Jim Adams retired with 284 career victories after the 1992 season, giving way to Starsia to take the Cavalier program over in 1993 - Adams retired as the record holder
- He was inducted into the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in November 2008
- He has led UVa to four national championships ('99, '03, '06, '11)
- His teams have made 25 NCAA Tournament appearances, the most by any Division I coach in history
- His Cavalier squads have advanced to the final four 13 times
- One of four coaches in college lacrosse history to win 100+ games at two schools (along with Jack Emmer, Dave Urlick and John Danowski who joined the group in 2013)
- Only Division I coach to win 200+ games at one Division I school while winning 100+ at another Division I institution
- He is a three-time national coach of the year ('85, '91, '11)
- ACC Coach of the Year a record eight times

**COVERING THE CAVALIERS**

**UNIQUELY UVA**

The University of Virginia is an institution rich with history and tradition. Here is some of the terminology that contributes to UVa's culture.

**Grounds:** The term used by students, faculty and alumni to refer to the University dating as far back as Thomas Jefferson. "Campus" is never used.

**First Year, Second Year, Third Year, Fourth Year:** Instead of freshman, sophomore, junior, senior. Why you may ask? To be a "senior" implies that a person has reached the final phase of learning, a feat that Thomas Jefferson believed to be impossible, arguing instead that education is a life-long process.

**Commonwealth:** Virginia is one of four constituent states of the United States of America that officially uses the name "Commonwealth" instead of the word state in all references. The other three commonwealths are Kentucky, Massachusetts and Pennsylvania.

**CREDENTIALS**

Admission to the press box is by official credential only and is strictly limited to members of the working press, radio and television personnel. Please allow ample time for the mailing of credentials or they will be left at the Will Call window at Klöckner Stadium.

Special requests should be made in advance. Parking is always available on an unreserved basis at University Hall. Normal pregame and postgame information is supplied.

**PHOTOGRAPHERS**

Requests for photo passes must be made in advance through the Athletics Media Relations Office. Photographers must observe the field markings for lacrosse. No tri-pod equipment may be used on the field level, for the safety of the players and photographers.

**RADIO**

Broadcasts are made from the radio broadcast facilities in Klöckner Stadium. There is one courtesy line available for use by visiting radio crews. Adequate space is available for the visiting team needs. Arrangement for broadcasts must be validated in advance through the UVa Athletics Media Relations Office.

**INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with coaches and players should be made through Vincent Briedis in the Athletics Media Relations Office. Postgame interviews are conducted at field level following the postgame handshake. Locker rooms are closed.

When covering a game at Klöckner Stadium, please include the umlaut above the letter 'ö' in Klöckner. Mac users can do this by clicking Alt-u or Option-u and then typing the letter o. PC users should make sure their number lock is off and then type Alt 0246.

**THE SERIES VS. THE GREYHOUNDS**

- Virginia leads the all-time series with Loyola by an 12-5 margin.
- The series between these programs began in 1938, and only five current Division I programs have an all-time series with UVa that began earlier: Johns Hopkins (1926), Maryland (1926), Yale (1927), Navy (1928) and Penn (1929).
- Saturday marks the second year in a row these programs have met, making the first games in the series since 1991.
- UVa and Loyola started the 2014 season off with a bang as UVa escaped with a 14-13 overtime win at Klöckner Stadium. UVa was cruising with a 12-4 lead through three quarters. The fourth quarter started with UVa's Greg Danseglio serving a one-minute slashing penalty, which helped jump-start a nine-goal run by Loyola. The Greyhound took a 13-12 lead with 18 seconds remaining in regulation when Tyler Albrecht capped the run. Mick Parks won the ensuing faceoff and James Pannell found Ryan Tucker, who scored with one-tenth of a second to force overtime. UVa's Parks won the overtime faceoff and Pannell tallied the game-winning goal with 2:16 left in the overtime period in the instant classic. The game was dubbed nationally via social media as "the most watched game on Twitter."
- Prior to the 2014 meeting, the most recent meeting between UVa and Loyola was in 1991 at Scott Stadium in a matchup between the No. 2 Greyhounds and the No. 3 Cavaliers. Loyola started the game on a 6-1 run and it looked as if the Greyhounds would roll.
- After that lackluster first quarter, UVa jumped on the shoulders of sophomore attackman Kevin Pehlke for a 14-1 run and Virginia never looked back, winning 17-10. Pehlke scored seven goals and finished with 10 points.
- The win in 1991 snapped Loyola's three-game winning streak in the series, and coupled that week with a loss by No. 1 Syracuse, UVa ascended to the top of the polls. At the time it was the first time UVa had been No. 1 in the nation since the end of the 1980 regular season.
- Before Loyola's win in 1987, UVa had enjoyed a 10-game winning streak in the series that spanned from 1947-1986.
- UVa and Loyola played every season from 1982-1988.

**LOYOLA'S CHARLEY TOOMEY AND VIRGINIA**

- Charley Toomey never lost to the Cavaliers as a player, going 3-0. Last year's 14-13 overtime win by UVa was the first time Toomey has faced Virginia as a coach.
- The two-time All-American goalie made 13 saves for the Greyhounds in the 1990 meeting, a 14-8 Loyola win in Baltimore. Toomey did not play in the 1987 or 1988 meetings, but Loyola came away with wins during the Greyhounds' three-game win streak, the longest of the series for Loyola.
- Toomey served as the NCAA Charlottesville site rep during UVa's 2011 NCAA First Round game with Bucknell, a game that the Cavaliers won in overtime, 13-12, catapulting Virginia to its fifth NCAA title.

**VIRGINIA IN SEASON OPENERS**

- UVa is 48-32-1 (.599) all-time in season openers.
- The Cavaliers are 15-16 (.484) when the season opener is on the road.
- This is the sixth time in the last 16 seasons the Cavaliers have opened on the road.

**UVA'S DEFENSIVE YOUTH**

- The 2015 UVa defense may be the most inexperienced unit ever under head coach Dom Starsia.
- With a season-ending injury to All-American Tanner Scales, the Cavaliers are poised to start two true freshmen in Logan Greco and Scott Hooper at close defense. Also slated to start is senior walk-on Davi Sacco, who has played sparingly in nine career games over the past three seasons.
- At LSM is sophomore Michael Howard, who played in three games in 2014. Senior Tanner Ottenbreit brings 36 games of experience.
- At SSDM you have sophomore Will McNamara, who will make his collegiate debut at Loyola. Sophomore Jacob Dean played one game in 2014 and there is a bevy of youngsters that could see time at SSDM.
- Sophomore goalie Matt Barrett is the most seasoned player on the defensive end, having started all 16 games in 2014.

**VIRGINIA IS A GROUND BALL MACHINE**

- According to UVa head coach Dom Starsia - "If there's any single statistic that speaks to your effort overall, then it's that one (ground balls)."
- UVa has led the nation in ground balls three of the last five years.
- Since the NCAA started including ground balls per game in their national rankings in 2009, UVa has never finished a season lower than No. 3 in ground balls per game.
- UVa is the only school in the nation to finish in the Top-5 nationally in ground balls per game over the last six seasons.
- Duke is the closest team to UVa, finishing in the Top-5 three during the same span.

**CAN'T SCORE UNLESS YOU CLEAR THE BALL**

- Virginia registered a .918 percent success rate on clears in 2013, giving the Cavaliers four seasons in a row clearing the ball above .900 percent.
- No other team in the nation has ever been able to boast such a streak.
- UVa cleared at a .907 rate in 2012, a .900 rate in 2011 and a .922 rate in 2010.
- During that time UVa twice ranked No. 3 in the nation in scoring offense, scoring 13.44 goals per game in 2010 and 12.56 goals per game in 2011 UVa ranked No. 11 in 2012 with 11.5 goals per game.
- The streak snapped in 2014 when UVa only cleared at a .851 rate.
- According to research in collaboration with all NCAA DI men's lacrosse SIDs, only 17 teams have cleared at over .900 in a season, four times its been done by UVa, dating back to 1971 - the first year lacrosse was an NCAA Championship sport.
- UVa records on clearing date back to 1971 - some schools like Syracuse (1983), only go back to a certain year in regards to clearing stats. Below is the current list of all-time .900+ clearing schools in a season:

**VIRGINIA IN OVERTIME UNDER DOM STARSIA**

- UVa is 23-16 all-time in overtime under Dom Starsia. Seven of those losses came in NCAA Tournament action. UVa is 3-7 in OT games in the NCAA Tournament under Starsia.
- Since the start of the 2007 season, UVa is 13-4 in overtime games under Starsia.
- The four losses since 2007 came at Duke (2007), Syracuse in the NCAA semifinal in 2008, Johns Hopkins (2012) in a regular season matchup and last season at Syracuse (2013). The Hopkins game in 2012 was the only OT loss since 2007 at Klöckner Stadium.
- Virginia is 14-2 all-time in OT games at Klöckner Stadium, which doubles as the record under Starsia.
- The first loss was the 2000 meeting with Syracuse and the second was the 2012 Hopkins game.
- Starsia is 14-3 all-time at home in OT games while at UVa - the 1998 Syracuse game was played at the Field Hockey Turf Field, resulting in a loss.

**VIRGINIA ON THE GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER**

- Virginia owns a 118-25 (.8252) all-time record at Klöckner Stadium, including a 6-2 mark in 2014. UVa also is 11-2 all-time at Klöckner Stadium in the NCAA Tournament.
- Klöckner Stadium first hosted lacrosse in 1993, the first season Dom Starsia was the head coach of the Cavaliers.

**DOM (INATION) OF THE USILA POLLS**

- Since Dom Starsia took over as head coach of the Virginia program in 1993, there have been 241 USILA coaches polls, including this week's poll.
- Of those 241 polls, Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in 55 of them.
- Which means that over the past 22 seasons under Dom Starsia, Virginia has been ranked No. 1 in the nation 22.8 percent of the time.
- The two programs closest to UVa's dominance are Syracuse at 48 weeks and Johns Hopkins at 41 weeks.
- The USILA coaches poll is the oldest lacrosse poll and was established in 1973.
