FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- UVa's 24 shots at Drexel are the fewest in a UVa win during the Dom Starsia era.
- Steele Stanwick joins fellow Tewaaraton Award winners Mike Powell (Syracuse) and Matt Danowski (Duke) as former winners of the prestigious award to have remaining collegiate eligibility, returning to the NCAA game as the "reigning Tewaaraton winner".
- Stanwick needs three goals and eight assists to become the 7th player in ACC history with at least 100 career goals and 100 career assists.
- Virginia head coach Dom Starsia made a cameo as himself in the new lacrosse movie "Crooked Arrows" opening nationwide in April.
- Former UVa men's lacrosse player Jason Leneau plays the lacrosse double of the character "Dixon" in the CW's New 90210 show.

GAME OVERVIEW

No. 1 in the USILA coaches and Nike/Inside Lacrosse media polls, the Virginia Cavaliers (1-0) return home on Tuesday to host the VMI Keydets (0-2) at Klöckner Stadium. UVa has won four home openers in a row and is 14-5 all-time under Dom Starsia in home-opening games. Faceoff for the in-state rivalry is slated for 7 p.m.

THE SERIES VS. THE KEYDETS

The Cavaliers own an 18-0 all-time record against the Keydets and 2012 is the seventh-straight season the two programs have met in a series that started in 1949. Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is 11-0 all-time against VMI. The Cavaliers' average victory margin in the series is 17.5 goals.

VMI and second-year head coach Brian Anken brings a 0-2 Keydets team into Klöckner Stadium with setbacks to Navy and Army.

Chris Kitchen leads VMI with five goals, while Mike Deblasio has three goals and two assists. Both Kitchen and Deblasio lead VMI with five points. Kelly McMinn is saving 56.9 percent of shots, while posting a 14.00 goals against average inside the pipes.

THE SERIES VS. VMI

- UVA holds an 18-0 all-time record against the Keydets
- 2012 is the seventh-straight season the two programs have met in a series that started in 1949
- UVA's 11-10 win in the first game in 1949 is the closest of the series
- The teams met again in 1950 (a 14-4 UVA win) and then did not meet again until 1988
- Since Under Dom Starsia, Virginia is averaging 24.4 goals per game and has won by an average of 19.6 goals
- The Cavaliers have rarely trailed the Keydets
- Based on available records going back to 1988, the Cavaliers have only trailed in one game
- VMI scored the first two goals in 1994 (2:19 and 7:30 of the first quarter) and led for 5:33
- The Cavaliers quickly tied the score with 7:08 to go in the opening quarter and took the lead for good with 3:51 left in the period
- Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is 11-0 all-time against VMI and Tuesday marks the 12th time in the Starsia era VMI and UVA have met
- The Cavaliers' average victory margin in the series is 17.5 goals
- The 2009 meeting between these two teams was UVA's first in Lexington, Va., since 1997
- The 2009 meeting also marks the only time a Starsia coached UVA team failed to score at least 20 goals in a game against VMI

HALL OF FAMER STARSIA TOPS NCAA DI WINS LIST

- Virginia head coach Dom Starsia is one of the most accomplished coaches in the history of the college game coaching at Brown (1983-92) and Virginia (1993-present)
- He passed Jack Emmer for most career wins by a head coach while coaching at a NCAA Division I school with UVA's quarterfinal win over Cornell in 2011
- He becomes the second UVA head coach to hold the record as Jim Adams retired with 284 career victories after the 1992 season, giving way to Starsia to take the Cavalier program over in 1993 - Adams retired as the record holder
- He was inducted into the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in November 2008
- He has led UVA to four national championships ('99, '03, '06, '11)
- His teams have made 23 NCAA Tournament appearances, the most by any Division I coach in history
- His Cavalier squads have advanced to the final four 13 times
- One of three coaches in college lacrosse history to win 100+ games at two schools (along with Jack Emmer and Dave Urick)
- Only Division I coach to win 200+ games at one Division I school while winning 100+ at another Division I institution
- He is a three-time national coach of the year ('85, '91, '11)
- ACC Coach of the Year a record eight times
- Starsia is currently ranks in the top two on two different all-time coaching lists

CAVALIERS IN MIDWEEK GAMES

- Virginia has a 26-game winning streak going back to 2001 in regular-season midweek games
- Virginia has three midweek games scheduled in 2011
- The last time the Cavaliers lost a midweek contest was an 11-8 loss to Notre Dame on March 14, 2001 (a Wednesday)
- Under head coach Dom Starsia, Virginia is 46-2 (.958) in mid-week games since 1993
- After losing his first mid-week game (9-6 to Princeton in 1993), the Cavaliers rattled off 22 wins in a row before that loss to Notre Dame 10 years ago

STANWICK ON VERGE OF THE 100/100 CLUB

- Steele Stanwick currently has 97 career goals and 92 career assists, needing three goals and eight assists to become the third UVA player in program history to reach the 100/100 club - joining Kevin Pehlke (1990-93) and Danny Glading (2006-09)
- Stanwick will be the seventh player in ACC history to join the club, including Duke's Matt Danowski (2004-08), Tony Cullen (1978-80) and Steve Sachs (1966-69), NC State's Marc Resnick (1976-79) and UVA's Pehlke and Glading
- Stanwick and Cornell's Rob Pannell are in a race to become the 41st player in NCAA history to join the club - Pannell needs just four goals to reach the club
- Once Stanwick joins the club, UVA will tie Air Force and Duke for No. 2 among schools with most members in the 100/100 club - Syracuse leads all with six

STANWICK WAS QUICK TO 100 POINTS

- Steele Stanwick became the sixth-fastest Cavalier to 100 career points when he reached the mark in his 30th career game
- Kevin Pehlke (22), Jay Connor (25), Tom Duquette (25), Kris Snider (26) and Conor Gill (28) are the only Cavaliers to reach the mark in fewer games
- Stanwick currently sits No. 14 all-time at UVA with 189 career points

LOW SHOT TOTAL AT DREXEL

- Virginia attempted only 24 shots in its 9-8 triumph at No. 20 Drexel on Saturday
- The 24 shots are the fewest by the Cavaliers in a game since they attempted 21 total shots in a 17-2 road loss at Duke on April 16, 2005
- The 24 shots are the fewest in a UVA win during head coach Dom Starsia's tenure (1993-present)
- The 24 shots are the second-fewest in any UVA game during the Dom Starsia tenure - trailing the 2005 Duke game

STARSIA CLOSING IN ON 450TH CAREER GAME

- Tuesday's game against VMI will be the 449th game for Starsia as a head coach
- The Feb. 25 against Stony Brook will serve as the 450th career game of Starsia's head coaching career
- Starsia coached his 300th game as the head coach of Virginia on May 30, 2011 - the day UVA won the 2011 NCAA title

GREEN GRASS OF KLÖCKNER BODES WELL

- This year's senior class has compiled a 23-1 record at Klöckner Stadium during their careers
- Their only loss at Klöckner was to Duke in 2010
- Overall Virginia is 103-16 (.866) all-time at Klöckner (since 1993), including 10-1 in the NCAA Championship
- Two scheduled home games are not included in record for the 2012 seniors - 2010 Stony Brook game played at UHall Turf Field and 2011 Maryland game played at Scott Stadium

SENIOR CLASS BRINGING HOME THE WINS

- This year's senior class has amassed a 44-10 overall record for a .815 winning percentage
- This year's senior class is 24-2 at home, 10-5 on the road and 10-3 at neutral sites since the start of the 2009 season

INVINCIBLE UNDER THE KLÖCKNER LIGHTS

- Virginia has lost only two night games at Klöckner Stadium
- Overall UVa is 26-2 when playing under the lights at Klöckner Stadium
- Overall the Cavaliers had 21-consecutive night wins since moving to Klöckner in 1993
- UVa fell to Duke in 2008, the first night loss - a game that started at 6 p.m. in April daylight shadows
- Virginia dropped its second overall game under the Klöckner Stadium lights ironically also to Duke on April 17, 2010

VIRGINIA PRE-RANKED NO. 1 IN THE NATION

- Virginia is ranked the preseason No. 1 team in the nation by the USILA coaches poll for the second year in a row
- UVa is ranked the preseason No. 1 team in the nation by the Nike/Inside Lacrosse media poll for the first time since the 2009

- Stanwick and Briggs are first-team preseason All-Americans by Face-Off Yearbook
- Stanwick is a captain for the second year in a row and the first Cavalier to be voted captain in back-to-back seasons since Mike Timms (2008 & 2009)
- In its 83rd lacrosse season, Stanwick is the 23rd Cavalier to be named a captain in more than one season

FOLLOWING UP AN NCAA TITLE

- Virginia has won five NCAA titles and the Cavaliers are 2-2 all-time in their season-opening games after winning a title. The wins came following the 1972 and 2003 seasons. The losses came after the 1999 and 2006 titles. UVa is 1-1 when facing Drexel in a season-opening game in a year following a title
- Since the NCAA started holding a men's lacrosse tournament in 1971, only seven times has a school repeated as champions - three of those efforts were part of a three-peat
- UVa has never repeated as champions following an NCAA title season

Owen Van Arsdale scored his first two collegiate goals via passes from White and Briggs to give the Cavaliers a 7-5 lead with 5:31 left in the third quarter. Drexel, however, scored three-straight goals to retake the lead at 8-7, capped by a Nick Trizano goal with 10:08 left in the game.

UVa then took over behind the goals from Hill and the game-capper from Emery, the sophomore's second of the day.

Rob Fortunato was stellar between the pipes for UVa, saving 11 shots and picking up five ground balls. The game was the senior's second career start. Fortunato also started the season-opening win against Drexel in 2011 where he stopped a career-high 12 shots.
