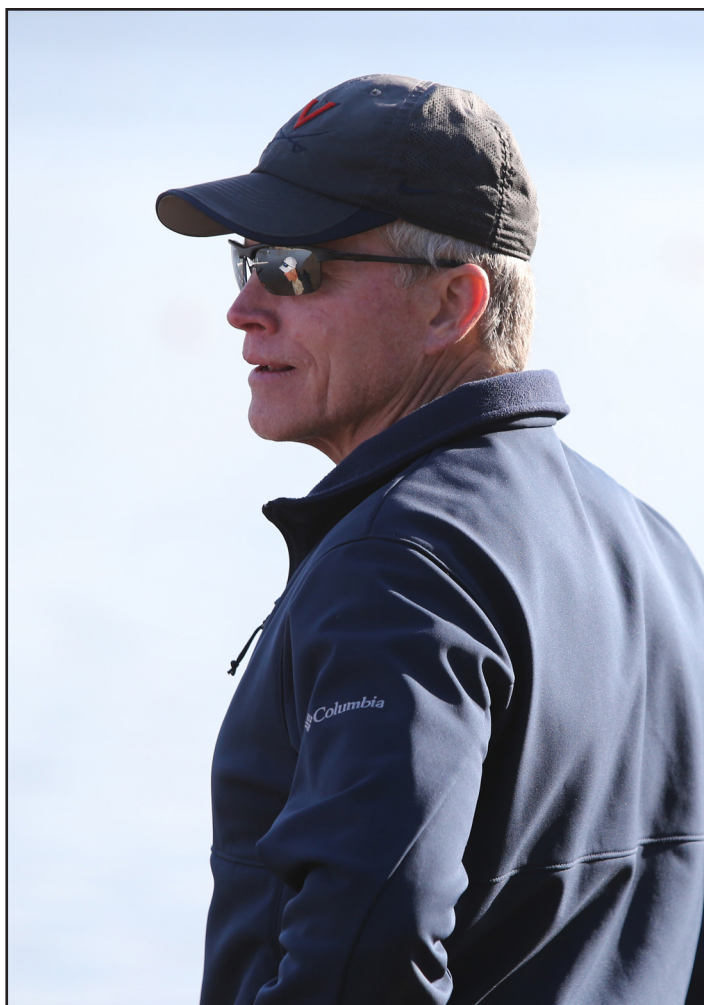

HEAD COACH KEVIN SAUER



2017-18 VIRGINIA ROWING



Kevin Sauer enters his 23rd season as the head coach of the varsity Virginia rowing program in 2017-18 and has led the Cavaliers to 11 top-four finishes in his career and 10 top-six finishes in the last 11 years at the NCAA Championships.

A two-time Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association (CRCA) National Coach of the Year (2010 and 2012), Sauer has elevated Virginia to the most elite level of rowing programs around the country and has guided the Cavaliers to a pair of NCAA Championships, in 2010 and 2012.

Cavalier boats have been crowned national champions nine times, including five times in the Varsity Four (2004, 2005, 2007, 2010 and 2015) and three times in the Second Varsity Eight (1998, 1999 and 2005). Sauer's program hit another high in 2012 as the UVA Varsity Eight won the NCAA title for the first time and clinched the team title in the process.

The Cavaliers' top crew, the Varsity Eight, has had a stellar record under Sauer, going 44-20 in 2017, 56-6 in 2016, 55-8 in 2015, 32-9 in 2014 and 54-5 in 2013. Overall, the V8 is 939-208 (.819 winning percentage) in the Sauer era.

Under Sauer's tutelage, 39 student-athletes have earned 53 CRCA All-America citations and he has had 81 All-ACC selections. Virginia has had multiple All-Americans 17 years in a row and had at least one member on the first team 19 consecutive seasons. Additionally, 17 Virginia rowers were named to the ACC's 50th Anniversary Rowing Team. In 2006, a league-high 16 Cavaliers were named to the inaugural Academic All-ACC Team.

The Cavaliers have also excelled in the ACC under Sauer, winning 17 of the 18 ACC regattas to be held, including the last eight years. Virginia has won 68 of the 75 events to be held at ACC regattas, had 14 crews be named ACC Crew of the Year and Sauer himself has been honored as the ACC Coach of the Year 11 times.

Sauer came to Charlottesville in the fall of 1988, when he was hired as the Virginia Rowing Club's second full-time professional coach. He oversaw the direction of both the men's and

women's club teams until the women's team was upgraded to varsity status and began competition in the fall of 1995. Both teams thrived under Sauer, including the women's Varsity Four winning the club national championship in 1995.

Once at varsity level, it did not take long for Sauer to build Virginia into a national powerhouse. The Cavaliers finished fourth at the inaugural NCAA regatta in 1997 and have finished as the runner-up on three occasions (1999, 2005 and 2007). Virginia is one of just seven schools to claim the NCAA Championship (Brown, California, Harvard, Ohio State, Stanford and Washington are the others) and one of four schools to compete in at least 17 NCAA Women's Rowing Championships. At each of those 17 appearances, the Cavaliers have not finished any lower than seventh.

In addition to NCAA success, the Cavaliers' Varsity Eight has been the top collegiate crew in the Championship Eights at the Head of the Charles four of the past six years and was the top overall crew at the 2012 regatta.

Sauer made his Olympic debut in 2016 in Rio, coaching former UVA two-sport athlete Meghan O'Leary and Ellen Tomek in the women's double sculls.

Sauer has helped coached several USRowing teams, including four times as the head coach of the US Under-23 National Team. Most recently, Sauer mentored the U.S. men's squad at the 2015 World Under-23 Championships. Under the guidance of Sauer at the national level, the American quad won gold at the 2007 World U-23 Championships, while Kelsie Chaudoin was in the American eight that captured gold in 2008. UVA standout Jennifer Cromwell was in the 2- in that same squad in 2007 and won gold with the eight in 2010.

Also in the summer of 2008, former UVA rowers tasted the ultimate success as Lindsay Shoop (Class of 2004) and Melanie Kok (Class of 2007) earned medals at the Olympics in Beijing, China. Shoop won gold with the U.S. women's eight, while Kok was a bronze medalist with the Canadian lightweight double.

Overall at Virginia, Sauer has coached 19 rowers that have competed at the World Championships and eight Olympians, including one at each of the last four Olympiads.

Before coaching at Virginia, Sauer served two stints as head coach at Purdue, his alma mater, from 1979 to 1982 and from 1986 to 1987. Under his direction, Purdue crews won the 1981-82 Midwest Championship and placed third in the 1986 Dad Vail. From 1983 to 1985, Sauer served as freshman coach at Yale, where his crews posted a 22-5 record.

A native of Indianapolis, Ind., Sauer received his bachelor's degree in marketing and finance from Purdue in 1976 and was a member of the U.S. National Rowing Team in 1975 and 1977. While at Purdue, he rowed for the United States in the 1975 Pan American Games. He also competed in the 1977 World Rowing Championships.

Sauer continued his involvement in international competition as the rowing, canoe and kayak course contractor for the 1984 Olympics, the 1987 Pan American Games, the 1990 Goodwill Games and the 1996 Olympics. He also coached the U.S. Rowing Development Camp in 1997 and served as a technical advisor for U.S. Rowing during the 1988 Olympic year before coming to Charlottesville that fall.

From 1997-2000, Sauer was a member of the High Performance Committee for U.S. Rowing, which makes plans for the coaching, selection and training of the national and Olympic rowing teams. In 2001, he was elected to serve as the South representative for the Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association, a position he held until 2008.

Sauer was inducted into the Pocock/Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association Hall of Fame on June 13, 2017.

Sauer and his wife, Barb, reside in Charlottesville. The Sauers have two children, Nick and Kelly, who also live in Charlottesville. Nick and wife, Lindsay, have two sons, Kevin and Nate, while Kelly and husband, Mark, have a daughter Colbie. Coach Sauer is the only one that does not have a University of Virginia degree.

EMILY FORD

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH
FIRST SEASON

Emily Ford joined the Virginia rowing program as an associate head coach in June of 2017 after serving 10 years as head coach of the Oregon State women's rowing team from 2006-16.

Oregon State ranked as high as No. 11 during Ford's tenure as six rowers earned Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association All-America honors and 159 individuals earned Pac-12 All-Academic recognition. In 2009, Ford earned Pac-10 Coach of the Year honors after the Beavers finished third at the Pac-10 Rowing Championships. Oregon State reached No. 11 in the rankings and finished 15th in the women's varsity eight at the NCAA Rowing Championships, marking the squad's first appearance at nationals since the 1999-2000 season.

Prior to her appointment at OSU, Ford spent 11 years at the University of Michigan helping build the program from the club level to a national power. After six years as an assistant coach, Ford was promoted to associate head coach in the fall of 2002. Ford was selected as the Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association's Central Region and National Assistant Coach of the Year in 2004.

Ford spent two years coaching at the University of California-San Diego from 1994-95. Ford was a three-year letterwinner, a two-time team captain and the only rower in school history to earn the prestigious Outstanding Senior Female Athlete Award at UCSD. She earned her undergraduate degree in psychology from UCSD in 1993.



FARRAH EDWARDS

ASSISTANT COACH
1ST SEASON

Farrah Edwards joined the Virginia rowing program as an assistant coach in the fall of 2017. Edwards arrived in Charlottesville after serving as an assistant coach at Rutgers from 2015-17.

While at Rutgers, Edwards coached the Varsity Four and Second Varsity Four in 2015, and Second Varsity Eight in 2016. She also served as the Scarlet Knights' recruiting coordinator and managed student-athlete development for the team.

Edwards spent three years (2012-15) as a club coach, serving as the rowing director and head coach of Dublin Crew in Columbus, Ohio. She was responsible for program development across four squads, producing training plans and hiring a part-time coaching staff.

As head coach of the Dublin Crew, Edwards guided the girls four and girls lightweight pair to top-four finishes at the Midwest Junior Championships. Edwards also coached the girls pair (11th), girls lightweight four (13th) and the girls four (17th) at the Youth Nationals.

A Cincinnati native and 2010 graduate of Ohio State, Edwards was a member of the Varsity Four that won a Big Ten championship and placed seventh at the NCAA championship. Edwards, who was a four-time OSU Scholar-Athlete, earned Big Ten Scholar-Athlete honors in 2008.



ERIN NEPPEL

ASSISTANT COACH
FIRST SEASON

Erin Neppel joined the Virginia rowing program as an assistant coach in July of 2017. Neppel arrived in Charlottesville after serving as the interim head coach at Canisius College in 2016-17.

In 2017, Neppel guided the Griffs to a third-place finish at the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference women's rowing championships, matching the program's best finish. Neppel served the previous three seasons as assistant coach at Canisius and was part of the College Rowing Coaches Associate Region 2 Staff of the Year in 2015-16.

Neppel was a three-time All-ACC rowing standout and CRCA Scholar-Athlete at North Carolina from 1998-2001. She garnered a pair of NCAA Central Region first-team honors and was a second-team All-America selection. Neppel spent the summer of 1998 in residence at the U.S. Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, California. She graduated from UNC in 2001 with a 3.88 GPA and recently earned her master's degree in sport administration from Canisius.

Prior to coming to Canisius, Neppel was on the coaching staff at Central Florida, and she has been instrumental in running the Nike Rowing Camps in Chapel Hill, N.C.

In addition to coaching at Canisius College, Neppel has coached the USRowing Development Camp at the West Side Rowing Club in Buffalo.



ROGER PAYNE

BOATMAN
14TH SEASON

Roger Payne enters his 14th season as boatman for UVa in 2015. Before coming to UVa, he worked as the boatman for Wisconsin for 14 years.

In 2012, Payne helped construct one of the Cavaliers' newest boat, the Craig K. Littlepage, dedicated in honor of Virginia's Director of Athletics. The boat was used by the Varsity Eight that won the NCAA Championship less than two months after its dedication.

A 1976 graduate of the University of Washington, Payne rowed lightweight crew for the Huskies and was a four-time Canadian Henley lightweight doubles champion. Payne was also the head women's rowing coach at Oregon State, and worked for Pocock Racing Shells and Owen Racing Shells.

In 1996, Payne was the boatman and assistant coach for the U.S. team at the Nation's Cup (U-23 World Championships). Payne served as boatman for the United States at the 1997 and 1998 Nations Cups. In 1999, Payne was the boatman for the U.S. team at the Pan Am Games. He also worked as the U.S. women's doubles coach at the Midwest Olympic Development Camps (1999-2003).

Payne is an active oarsman and competes in master's events. He and his wife, Kathie, have a son and daughter, Collin and Eva, who both rowed for Wisconsin.



DAVID HERRICK

**GRADUATE ASSISTANT COACH
SECOND SEASON**

David Herrick is in his first season as a graduate assistant coach and second season overall with the Virginia rowing program. Herrick was a volunteer assistant coach with the Cavaliers in 2016-17.

Herrick walked onto the men's rowing team at Washington State the fall of 2010 as a novice and proceeded to row for four years. He received All-PAC 12 honors in 2013 and 2014, while also serving as a member of the Student Officer Corps.

Herrick began coaching at WSU during the 2014-2015 season as an assistant and helped guide the Cougars to their best season in five years. WSU captured first in the Lightweight Men's 8+ and 4+, second in the Varsity 8+, bronze in the second Novice 8+ and Open 2x at the WIRA championship.

At ACRA's, the highlights included silver medals in the Lightweight Men's 4+ and Open 2x, and a fifth-place finish in the Novice 8+.

During the 2015-2016 season, Herrick served as a volunteer coach with the Syracuse men's team, coaching the Second Freshman 8+ in the fall, and the spare pair for the IRA National Championships.

In the summer of 2016, Herrick worked as a second assistant coach for the Penn AC junior program. At Club Nationals, PACRA placed fifth overall in the club standings.

Herrick is a Colorado native. He graduated from Washington State in 2014 with a bachelor's degree in psychology.



CORAL KASDEN

**VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH
SECOND SEASON**

Coral Kasden enters her second season as a volunteer assistant coach with the Virginia rowing program. Kasden works primarily with the coxswain's at UVA.
