#7 SEED NOTRE DAME (19-12) OR #10 SEED BOSTON COLLEGE (13-18)

FOR OPENERS

- No. 2 seed Virginia plays the winner of No. 9 seed Notre Dame (19-12) and No. 10 seed Boston College (13-18) in the quarterfinals of the 67th annual ACC Tournament on Thursday, March 12 at 7 p.m.
- Virginia went 1-0 vs. Notre Dame and 1-1 vs. Boston College in 2019-20.
- No. 2 seed Virginia (15-5 ACC) was predicted to finish fourth in the ACC regular season, has finished at or higher than its predicted finish in 11 of the last 12 seasons.
- Mamadi Diakite (All-ACC Second Team & All-ACC Defensive Team) and Kihei Clark (All-ACC Third Team) earned ACC postseason honors on March 9, while Braxton Key earned All-ACC honorable mention.
- Diakite earned his second ACC player of the week honor on March 9.

UVA ALL-TIME IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT

- Virginia will be the No. 2 seed for the ACC Tournament for the fifth time in school history and second under head coach Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers are 42-63 all-time in the ACC Tournament and 17-24 mark in Greensboro including the 2014 tournament title.
- UVA has posted a 6-4 mark as the No. 2 seed in the ACC Tournament (2-1 in 1982, 2-1 in 1983, 0-1 in 2007 and 2-1 in 2016).
- UVA captured ACC Tournament titles as the No. 6 seed in 1976, No. 1 seed in 2014 and No. 1 seed in 2018.
- UVA has advanced to the ACC Tournament semifinals in five of the last six seasons.
- UVA went 1-1 in last year's ACC Tournament, defeating No. 8 seed NC State (76-56) and losing to No. 4 seed Florida State (69-59).
- Bennett is 11-8 all-time in the ACC Tournament.

A WIN VS. NOTRE DAME OR BOSTON COLLEGE WOULD:

- Send UVA to the ACC semifinals for the sixth time in seven years.
- Give UVA 24 or more wins for the 11th time in school history.
- Give UVA a nine-game winning streak.
- Give UVA a five-game winning streak vs. Notre Dame or two-game winning streak vs. Boston College.
- Give UVA a program-best one win in each of the last seven ACC tournaments.
- Give UVA its 26th win in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals.

UVA RANKED NO. 17 IN LATEST AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 17 in the latest AP poll and No. 18 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- The No. 17 ranking is UVA's highest ranking since a No. 16 ranking on Dec. 23, 2019.
- UVA was ranked 46 straight weeks from Nov. 20, 2017 through Jan. 6, 2017.
- The Cavaliers are 12-4 as a ranked team in 2019-20.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of March 10, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (52.4), second in field goal percentage defense (36.9), fewest fouls (397) and personal fouls per game (13.2), 17th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.3), 20th in blocks per game (4.9) and 26th in total blocks (147).

FIVE CAVALIERS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- Kihei Clark ranks first in the ACC in minutes (37.1), second in free throw percentage (87.6), third in assists (5.9) and ninth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7).
- Braxton Key ranks sixth in defensive rebounds (5.7) and 11th in rebounding (7.4).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks eighth in blocks (1.3), 11th in defensive rebounds (5.2), 13th in scoring (13.7) and 15th in free throw percentage (75.4) and rebounding (6.8).
- Jay Huff ranks fourth in blocks (2.0) and Tomas Woldetensae ranks 15th in 3-pointers (1.8).

LAST TIME OUT

- Mamadi Diakite had 17 points and eight rebounds to lead then-No. 22 Virginia to a 57-54 win over then-No. 10 Louisville on March 7.
- Kihei Clark added 18 points, five rebounds and five assists as UVA earned its 15th league win and No. 2 seed in the ACC Tournament.
- Virginia led 31-24 at the half, but needed a Clark 3-pointer with 28 seconds left and a pair of free throws from Diakite with three seconds left to seal the win.
- Jordan Nwora led the Cardinals (24-7, 15-5) with 18 points.

AWAY FROM JPY

- The Cavaliers are 9-4 away from home, including a pair of neutral site wins at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament.
- Virginia was 7-4 in true road games in 2019-20, defeating Syracuse (48-34), Georgia Tech (63-58), Wake Forest (65-63 OT), North Carolina (64-62), Pitt (59-56), Virginia Tech (56-53) and Miami (46-44).
- UVA has won seven or more road contests in four straight seasons.
- UVA went 8-1 in ACC road action last season and 10-1 overall.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH FINISHES SECOND IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll and finished tied for second.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 12 of the last 13 seasons.
- Duke was the preseason favorite, followed by UNC, Louisville, UVA, FSU, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 277-96 (.743) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 346-129 (.728) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record eight straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).
- Bennett has led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances and seven consecutive NCAA tournaments.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 136-58 (.701) in ACC play (77-20 at home & 59-38 away), 157-29 (.844) at home and 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPI) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .701, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

ALL-TIME AGAINST NOTRE DAME

- Virginia is 14-2 all-time vs. Notre Dame, including a 9-0 ACC regular-season record, in the series that dates back to 1980-81.
- UVA is 0-1 against the Fighting Irish in the ACC Tournament, dropping a 71-58 decision in the ACC quarterfinals in 2017.
- The Cavaliers posted a 50-49 win against Notre Dame this season.
- UVA has limited Notre Dame to 58 or fewer points in eight of the last 10 meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 10-1 all-time against Notre Dame, including a 61-41 win over the Fighting Irish as head coach at Washington State in the 2008 NCAA Tournament in Denver, Colo.

LAST TIME VS. THE FIGHTING IRISH

- Mamadi Diakite scored a game-high 20 points to lead Virginia to a 50-49 overtime win against Notre Dame on Tuesday, Feb. 11.
- Diakite buried a game-tying jump shot with 25.3 seconds to tie the game at 47-47, and UVA outscored Notre Dame 3-2 in overtime to gain its fourth win when scoring 50 or fewer points.
- Jay Huff chipped in eight points and nine rebounds, and Kihei Clark scored nine points.
- Braxton Key snared a career-high 13 rebounds.
- Prentiss Hubb led three Fighting Irish in double figures with 12 points.
- UVA shot 37.3 percent from the field, outrebounded the Irish 42-34 and scored 24 of its 50 points in the paint.

ALL-TIME AGAINST BOSTON COLLEGE

- Virginia is 16-8 all-time vs. Boston College, including an 11-8 ACC mark, in the series that dates back to 1971-72.
- The Cavaliers are 1-1 against the Eagles in the ACC Tournament, posting a first-round win in Greensboro (2010) and first-round loss in Atlanta (2009)
- UVA went 1-1 against the Eagles in 2019-20, losing 60-53 in Chestnut Hill before winning 78-65 in Charlottesville.
- UVA has limited BC to 58 or fewer points in five of the last seven meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 10-5 all-time against Boston College.

LAST TIME VS. THE EAGLES

- Kihei Clark and Braxton Key each tallied 17 points to lead Virginia to a 78-65 win over Boston College on Feb. 19.
- Tomas Woldetensae and Jay Huff each had 14 points and Mamadi Diakite added 10 as five UVA players landed in double figures for the

- first time since at Notre Dame on Jan. 26, 2019.
- UVA shot a season-high 58.8 percent, including a blistering 68.4 percent (13 of 19) in the second half.
- Clark dished out a game-high eight assists and Key added a career-high four blocks as the Cavaliers tied a season high with nine rejections.
- Nik Popovic tallied 22 points and Jay Heath had 18 for the Eagles.
- The 78 points and 58.8 percent 3-point shooting (10 of 17) were also season bests for the Cavaliers.

THIS DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited 12 opponents to fewer than 50 points, one opponent (Duke) to 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 23 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 27 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has outrebounded 22 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 4-2 against ranked opponents in 2019-20 (1-2 vs top-5 foes and all six are top-10 foes).
- UVA is 46-36 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia's 61-56 win over No. 5 Florida State marked its first top-five win since a 65-63 win at then-No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27, 2018
- The top-5 win was also UVA's first as an unranked team since a 73-68 win over then-No. 3 Duke on Feb. 28, 2013.
- The Cavaliers posted a 52-50 win over then-No. 7 Duke on Feb. 29 and 56-47 win over then-No. 7 North Carolina on Dec. 8 and 57-54 win over then-No. 10 Louisville on March 7.
- UVA dropped a 54-50 decision at then-No. 9 Florida State Jan. 15 and 80-73 loss at then-No. 5 Louisville Feb. 8.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record.
- UVA posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time since 1948-49.
- The Cavaliers are 159-331 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-30 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

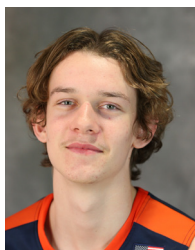
