### FOR OPENERS

- No. 18 Virginia is tied for first in the ACC at 3-0, while Boston College is tied fourth at 2-1.
- Virginia has a six-game winning streak vs. Boston College.
- The Cavaliers have held a Division I leading nine opponents to fewer than 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA has started 3-0 in the ACC for third straight season.

### ALL-TIME VS. BOSTON COLLEGE

- Virginia is 15-7 all-time vs. Boston College, including an 11-7 ACC mark, in the series that dates back to 1971-72.
- The Cavaliers have a six-game winning streak against the Eagles and have won eight of the last nine games in the series.
- UVA is 4-4 against Boston College in Chestnut Hill, including an 83-56 win in its last visit to Chestnut Hill in 2018-19.
- UVA has limited BC to 58 or fewer points in each of the last five meetings.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 9-4 all-time against Boston College.

### LAST TIME VS. THE EAGLES

- Mamadi Diakite and De'Andre Hunter scored 18 points apiece to guide then-No. 4 UVA to an 83-56 win at Boston College on Jan. 9, 2019.
- Ty Jerome added 13 points and Kyle Guy chipped in 10.
- UVA shot 60 percent and out-rebounded the Eagles 41-21.
- The Cavaliers went on a 16-0 run and held Boston College scoreless for 7:21 of the second half.

### UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Jan. 6, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (46.7), field goal percentage defense (34.0) and fewest fouls (156), third in personal fouls per game (12.0) and 13th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (26.6).

### HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 9-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 96-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 121-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 4-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).

### LAST TIME OUT

- Braxton Key collected 18 points and 10 rebounds for his second career double-double as No. 19 Virginia routed Virginia Tech 65-39 on Jan. 7 at John Paul Jones Arena.
- Kihei Clark added a career-high 18 points and game-high six assists, and Mamadi Diakite chipped in six points and 10 rebounds.
- UVA held the Hokies to 27.1 percent shooting (13 of 48) and owned a 38-25 rebounding advantage.
- UVA outscored Virginia Tech 34-16 in the paint and forced 13 turnovers.
- Landers Nolley II led the Hokies with 18 points.

### UVA RANKED NO. 18 IN LATEST POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 18 in the latest Associated Press poll and USA Today Coaches' polls.
- UVA has been ranked in the AP poll for 44 straight weeks and has been ranked in the top 10 in 37 of the last 41 polls.

### OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited nine opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 11 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 14 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has out-rebounded 11 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 265-91 (.744) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 334-124 (.729) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett has guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPI), 124-53 (.700) in ACC play and 151-27 (.848) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .700, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

**HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.2 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.8), while Clark is averaging 9.8 points, 4.4 rebounds and a team-high 5.9 assists.
- Key is averaging 10.3 points and a team-high 7.3 rebounds.
- Huff has tallied 8.6 points and 6.1 rebounds and a team-high 18 blocks.
- Kody Statmann and newcomers Casey Morsell and Tomas Wolde-tensae have absorbed the minutes left by Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Morsell, who scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors, is averaging 5.4 points.
- Statmann is averaging 5.3 points, including career highs in points (10) and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Wolde-tensae has started eight games and has made 12 of 39 3-pointers, including three against North Carolina.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Francisco Caffaro started two contests after contributing 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 6.0 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.

**WATCH ME NOW**

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List.

**THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

- Virginia is 189-43 (.815), including an 8-1 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina recently ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPI last season and is 151-27 (.848), including a 116-12 (.906) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 59-6 (.908) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 56-8 (.875).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.

**UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA**

- UVA is 70-15 against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 23 of its last 26 games against teams from Virginia.
- UVA defeated JMU (65-34) and Virginia Tech (65-39) earlier this season and finished 4-0 against teams from the Commonwealth in 2018-19.

**RECORDS WATCH**

- Mamadi Diakite ranks fourth on UVA's career blocks list with 132.
- Diakite needs 10 blocks to pass Isaiah Wilkins (141 blocks from 2015-18) for third on the list.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's single-season list.

**UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS**

- UVA is 43-34 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era, including a 1-0 mark in 2019-20.
- UVA went 11-3 vs. ranked foes and the 11 ranked wins marked a school record.
- The Cavaliers posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time in poll history since 1948-49.
- UVA posted back-to-back wins vs. ranked opponents two times (Wisconsin and Maryland and Virginia Tech and Louisville) for the first time in the regular season since 1982.
- The Cavaliers are 157-329 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-30 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

**ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE**

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 poll (Duke, Florida State and Louisville), while Purdue received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA defeated First Four NCAA Tournament team Arizona State in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament championship on Nov. 24.
- Two opponents (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 National Invitation Tournament.

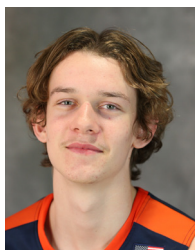
