Game Notes

- With the start, NT Jordan Redmond became the first true freshman to start a season opener on the defensive line for UVA since 2002 when DE Kwakou Robinson started against Colorado State. He was only the fourth UVA freshman (true or redshirt) since 1986 to start a season opener on the defensive line. The others were DE Matt Conrath (RS-Fr., 2008 vs. USC) and NT Tim O'Conner (RS-Fr., 1986 vs. South Carolina).
- Bryce Perkins' 36-yard rushing touchdown in the first quarter was the longest rush by a UVA quarterback since Matt Johns' 42-yard rush against Kent State in 2014.
- With two rushing touchdowns, Bryce Perkins became the first UVA quarterback to rush for two touchdowns in a game since Jameel Sewell at Southern Miss in 2009.
- Perkins finished with 108 rushing yards, becoming the first UVA quarterback to rush for at least 100 yards in a game since Jameel Sewell (104) did so against Virginia Tech in 2009.
- Perkins became only the 13th Cavalier quarterback to rush for at least 100 yards in a game.
- Perkins finished with 185 passing yards, giving him the xx most by a UVA quarterback starting his first game.
- With a career-high 146 rushing yards, Jordan Ellis became the 43rd player in program history to reach 1,000 career rushing yards.
- Ellis rushed for at least 100 yards for the second time in his career. He rushed for 136 yards at North Carolina in 2017.
- With both Perkins (108) and Ellis (146) rushing for over 100 yards, the duo becomes the 29th Cavaliers to do so in the same game. The last UVA to each rush for at least 100 yards in a game was Daniel Hamm (136) and Kevin Parks (135) in 2013 against VMI.
- With six catches, Olamide Zaccheaus has now recorded a reception in 30-straight games.
- Zaccheaus finished with 101 receiving yards, his fourth career game over 100 receiving yards.
- With 101 receiving yards, Zaccheaus passed Heath Miller (1,703) and Patrick Jeffers (1,785) into seventh on UVA's all-time receiving yards list.
- With six receptions, Zaccheaus passed Kris Burd (162) for No. 3 all-time at UVA in career receptions.
- With Ryan Nelson's start at left tackle, UVA has now started a redshirt freshman at left tackle in a season opener two years in a row. In 2017, Dillon Reinkensmeyer started at left tackle against William & Mary.
- DE Mandy Alonso's sack in the second quarter is the first solo sack of his career. He shared a sack at Miami in 2017.
- In the second quarter, WR Chuck Davis returned the first punt of his career (-1).

Game Notes

- UVA blocked two kicks in a game for the first time since the 2008 Richmond game when Matt Conrath and Nick Jenkins each blocked field goals.

- The 28-0 win is UVA's first bowl shutout.
