FOR OPENERS

- UVA (8-5) is fourth in the ACC, while North Carolina (3-10) is 15th.
- Virginia has a five-game winning streak against the Tar Heels and seeks its first two-game regular season sweep of UNC since 2001-02.
- UVA's 50-49 overtime win vs. Notre Dame marked the lowest scoring overtime win in ACC history in the shot clock era (since 1986).
- UVA and UNC meet as unranked teams for the first time since Jan. 20, 2014.
- Mamadi Diakite, Cincinnati's Trevon Scott and Michigan's Jon Teske are Division I college basketball's active career wins leaders with 104.

ALL-TIME AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

- UVA is 58-131 all-time vs. UNC in the series that began in 1910-11.
- UVA is 8-66 all-time against the Tar Heels in Chapel Hill, including a 5-24 mark at Smith Center.
- The Cavaliers have won seven of the last eight regular-season meetings between the teams, including a 56-47 decision on Dec. 8, 2019.
- UVA has won two of the last three meetings at Smith Center, including a 69-61 win last season.
- UVA is 7-3 against UNC in its last 10 games against North Carolina.
- Tony Bennett is 10-8 all-time vs. North Carolina, including a loss as head coach of Washington State in the 2008 NCAA Sweet 16.

LAST TIME VS. THE TAR HEELS

- Francisco Caffaro had 10 points and seven rebounds off the bench to lead then-No. 5 Virginia to a 56-47 win over then-No. 7 North Carolina on Dec. 8.
- Mamadi Diakite added 12 points and Tomas Woldetensae chipped in 11 as UVA held its seven opponent to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA outrebounded the Tar Heels 37-32.
- The Cavaliers held North Carolina to 37 percent shooting, including a 1 of 14 effort from 3-point range.
- UVA owned a 25-10 advantage in bench points.

CLARK, DIAKITE, HUFF AND KEY AMONG ACC LEADERS

- Kihei Clark ranks first in the ACC in minutes (37.5), second in free throw percentage (85.5), fourth in assists (6.0) and eighth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7).
- Braxton Key ranks fifth in defensive rebounds (5.7), and ninth in steals (1.6) and rebounding (7.5).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks eighth in blocked shots (1.3), 12th in defensive rebounds (5.0), 15th in scoring (13.6) and 16th in rebounding (6.7).
- Jay Huff ranks fifth in blocked shots (1.7), 16th in offensive rebounds (2.2) and tied for 17th in rebounding (6.3).

LAST TIME OUT

- Mamadi Diakite scored a game-high 20 points to lead Virginia to a 50-49 overtime win against Notre Dame on Tuesday, Feb. 11.
- Diakite buried a game-tying jump shot with 25.3 seconds to tie the game at 47-47, and UVA outscored Notre Dame 3-2 in overtime to gain its four win when scoring 50 or fewer points.
- Jay Huff chipped in eight points and nine rebounds, and Kihei Clark scored nine points.
- Braxton Key snared a career-high 13 rebounds.
- Prentiss Hubb led three Fighting Irish in double figures with 12 points.
- UVA shot 37.3 percent from the field, outrebounded the Irish 42-34 and scored 24 of its 50 points in the paint.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Feb. 13, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (51.6) and field goal percentage defense (36.1), fifth in fewest fouls (311) and personal fouls per game (13.5) and 20th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.1).

ON THE ROAD

- Virginia is 3-4 in true road games in 2019-20, defeating Syracuse (48-34), Georgia Tech (63-58) and Wake Forest (65-63 OT).
- The Cavaliers are 5-4 away from home, including a pair of neutral site wins at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament.
- UVA went 8-1 in ACC road action last season and 10-1 overall.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 11-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 98-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 123-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 4-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).
- The Cavaliers have held the Tar Heels to fewer than 50 points in three of the last five meetings between the teams.

UVA RECEIVES VOTES IN NATIONAL POLLS

- UVA received votes in the latest AP poll.
- UVA, which has been unranked in five straight polls, was unranked in the Jan. 13 AP poll for the first time since Nov. 20, 2017, ending its streak at 46 straight weeks in the national polls.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 270-96 (.738) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 339-129 (.724) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 129-58 (.690) in ACC play, 154-29 (.842) at home and 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPY) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .690, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 192-45 (.810), including an 11-3 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak, while Syracuse ended the Cavaliers' six-game home ACC winning streak.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPY last season and is 153-29 (.841), including a 119-14 (.895) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 62-8 (.886) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 60-9 (.870).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited 11 opponents to fewer than 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 18 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 17 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has outrebounded 18 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.6 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.7), while Clark is averaging 10.3 points, 4.4 rebounds and a team-high 6.0 assists.
- Diakite has 504 career rebounds at Virginia.
- Key is averaging 10.1 points and a team-high 7.5 rebounds.
- Key has totaled 1,006 career points (589 at Alabama and 417 at Virginia) and 680 career rebounds (331 at Alabama and 349 at Virginia).
- Huff has tallied 8.3 points and 6.3 rebounds and a team-high 40 blocks. Huff recorded career highs in points (17) and blocks (6) at Georgia Tech.
- Tomas Woldetensae has started the past seven games and has made a team-high 38 3-pointers, including seven at Wake Forest and seven at Louisville en route to a career-high 27 points.
- Woldetensae is the 3rd Virginia player in the last 20 seasons to have multiple games with at least 7 made 3-pt FG, joining Curtis Staples (8 such games) and Kyle Guy (3).
- Casey Morsell scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament.
- Kody Stattmann is averaging 4.1 points, including career highs in points (11) at Boston College and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Francisco Caffaro contributed 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina, and six points vs. NC State.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 5.4 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser is sitting out the season after transferring from Marquette.

WATCH ME NOW

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year preseason watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50.

DIAKITE EARNS PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- Mamadi Diakite was named the preseason All-ACC first team.
- Diakite was joined on the All-ACC first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Jordan Nwora (Louisville), Tre Jones (Duke), Cole Anthony (North Carolina) and John Mooney (Notre Dame).

RECORDS WATCH

- Mamadi Diakite ranks third on UVA's career blocks list with 147.
- Diakite leads all active ACC players in career blocked shots.
- Diakite needs two blocks to pass Chris Alexander (148 blocks from 1993-96) for second on the list.
- Ralph Sampson is UVA's career blocked shots leader with 462.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by UNC, Louisville, UVA, FSU, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 poll (Louisville, Duke and Florida State), while Purdue received votes.
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at FSU, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.
- UVA defeated First Four NCAA Tournament team Arizona State in the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament championship on Nov. 24.
- Two foes (Clemson and NC State) participated in the 2019 NIT.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 2-2 against ranked opponents in 2019-20 (1-2 vs top-5 foes and all four are top-10 foes).
- UVA is 44-36 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- Virginia's 61-56 win over No. 5 Florida State marked its first top-five win since a 65-63 win at then-No. 4 Duke on Jan. 27, 2018
- The top-5 win was also UVA's first as an unranked team since a 73-68 win over then-No. 3 Duke on Feb. 28, 2013.
- The Cavaliers posted a 56-47 win over then-No. 7 North Carolina Dec. 8 at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA dropped a 54-50 decision at then-No. 9 Florida State Jan. 15 and 80-73 loss at then-No. 5 Louisville Feb. 8.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record.
- UVA posted an ACC-record five ranked wins on the road in 2018-19, which tied UConn (1998-99) for the most all-time since 1948-49.
- The Cavaliers are 158-331 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-30 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

- In addition, Dallas head coach Rick Carlisle is a Virginia alum who helped the Cavaliers to their last NCAA Final Four in 1984.

MORE THAN MANAGERS

- Virginia men's basketball managers and Charlottesville natives Grant Kersey and Matt Palumbo saw two minutes of action vs. JMU.
- Palumbo made his collegiate debut, while Kersey saw action in 10 games in a similar role last season.
- Coach Tony Bennett calls his team managers the "ultimate servants."

- The 6-3, 173-pound McCorkle tallied 15.9 points per game en route to AP and NCISAA 4A All-State honors at Greensboro Day School.

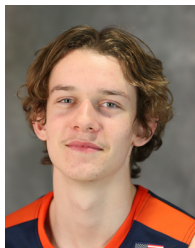
