FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Clemson for the lone time in 2019-20.
- The Cavaliers (6-4) are fourth in the ACC, while Clemson (5-6) is tied for sixth.
- Virginia has a nine-game winning streak against Clemson.
- Kihei Clark ranks third in the ACC and is 21st nationally in free throw percentage (88.7).

ALL-TIME AGAINST CLEMSON

- Virginia is 77-52 all-time vs. Clemson, including a 44-16 home mark, in a series that dates back to 1935-36.
- UVA defeated the Tigers 63-43 in the lone meeting last season.
- UVA has a nine-game winning streak in the series, limiting the Tigers to 43 or fewer points in four of the wins.
- The Cavaliers have a nine-game winning streak against the Tigers in Charlottesville, including a 61-36 win in the last meeting at JPJ.
- The Cavaliers are 11-2 in their last 13 meetings against the Tigers.
- Head coach Tony Bennett is 11-3 all-time vs. Clemson.

LAST TIME VS. THE TIGERS

- Kyle Guy scored 13 points to lead then-No. 4 Virginia to a 63-43 win at Clemson on Jan. 12, 2019.
- De'Andre Hunter added 12 points and reserve Jay Huff chipped in 11 points and seven rebounds in the second half.
- UVA held Clemson to two points in the first 10:57 of the game.
- UVA went 10 of 23 from 3-point range, while Clemson was 3 of 19.
- The Cavaliers out-rebounded the Tigers 46-36, led by Braxton Key and Jack Salt with eight rebounds apiece.
- UVA held Clemson to 25.9 percent shooting as the Tigers were just 14 of 54 from the field.

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- UVA is 9-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 50 points.
- UVA is 96-2 when achieving the mark in the Tony Bennett era.
- Bennett-coached teams are 121-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA is 4-0 when limiting opponents to fewer than 40 points (27-0 all-time under Bennett).
- UVA has three wins when scoring fewer than 50 points for the first time since 1981-82 (Maryland and NC State twice).

CLARK, DIAKITE, HUFF AND KEY AMONG ACC LEADERS

- Kihei Clark ranks second in the ACC in minutes (37.0), third in free throw percentage (88.7), fourth in assists (5.9) and 11th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7).
- Braxton Key ranks eighth in steals (1.65) and 11th in rebounding (7.35).
- Mamadi Diakite ranks eighth in blocked shots (1.25) and 16th in scoring (13.5), free throw percentage (74.4) and rebounding (6.9).
- Jay Huff ranks sixth in blocked shots (1.55).

LAST TIME OUT

- Mamadi Diakite scored 19 points and Kihei Clark added 15 as Virginia upset then-No. 5 Florida State 61-56 on Jan. 28 at JPJ.
- Braxton Key added 13 points and nine rebounds as Virginia (14-6, 6-4 ACC) improved to 2-1 against ranked foes this season.
- Florida State started the game on an 8-0 run and led 28-27 at halftime.
- Virginia limited the Seminoles to 38.9 percent field goal shooting and owned a 24-20 advantage on points in the paint.
- Virginia converted a season-high 20 free throws in the win.

UVA IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

- As of Feb. 4, Virginia ranks first in the nation in scoring defense (50.7) and field goal percentage defense (35.8), third in fewest fouls (268), fourth in personal fouls per game (13.4) and 26th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (29.4).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 190-45 (.809), including a 9-3 mark in 2019-20, in 14 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- South Carolina ended UVA's 22-game home nonconference winning streak, while Syracuse ended the Cavaliers' six-game home ACC winning streak.
- UVA was 15-1 at JPJ last season and is 151-29 (.839), including a 117-14 (.893) mark the past eight seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 60-8 (.882) in league home games over the past seven seasons. Duke is second at 59-9 (.868).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 10 straight seasons.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 268-95 (.738) mark in 11 seasons at Virginia and 337-128 (.725) career mark in 14 seasons.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett has guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins for the fifth time in the past six seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record seven straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best eight straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16 and 2017-19).
- Bennett has led UVA to seven consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 141-38 (.788) in non-conference action (79-7 at JPI), 127-57 (.690) in ACC play and 152-29 (.840) at home under Tony Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .690, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited nine opponents to fewer than 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points.
- UVA held Virginia Tech to 39 points, marking its largest home win against the Hokies since a 48-point win on Feb. 18, 1955.
- The Cavaliers held Maine to 26 points, matching the fewest Virginia has allowed in the shot clock era (since 1985-86).
- UVA held both Syracuse and JMU to 34 points, marking the first time UVA has limited its first two opponents to fewer than 40 points in the shot clock era and since 1943-44.
- Syracuse's 34 points in the season-opener on Nov. 6, marked UVA's fewest points allowed to an ACC foe since holding Wake Forest to 34 on Feb. 25, 2015.
- The 34 points by Syracuse and JMU are tied for the fifth fewest for UVA in the shot clock era.
- UVA limited Maine to 18.6 percent shooting, second lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- UVA limited JMU to 22.6 percent shooting, tied for fifth lowest for a Cavalier opponent.
- The Cavaliers have limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia, Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.
- UVA has held 16 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers have forced 16 shot clock violations in 2019-20.
- UVA has outrebounded 16 opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense six times and finished in the top-five nationally in 10 of 13 seasons.

ON THE ROAD

- Virginia is 3-3 in true road games in 2019-20, defeating Syracuse (48-34), Georgia Tech (63-58) and Wake Forest (65-63 OT).
- UVA went 8-1 in ACC road action last season and 10-1 overall.

UVA RECEIVES VOTES IN NATIONAL POLLS

- UVA received votes in the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' polls on Feb. 3.
- UVA, which has been unranked in four straight polls, was unranked in the Jan. 13 AP poll for the first time since Nov. 20, 2017, ending its

streak at 46 straight weeks in the national polls.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- The quartet of Mamadi Diakite, Kihei Clark, Braxton Key and Jay Huff lead Virginia into action this season.
- Diakite leads UVA in scoring (13.5 ppg) and is second in rebounding (6.9), while Clark is averaging 10.3 points, 4.5 rebounds and a team-high 5.9 assists.
- Diakite needs 11 rebounds to reach 500 career rebounds.
- Key is averaging 10.2 points and a team-high 7.4 rebounds.
- Key needs 23 points to reach 1,000 career points (589 at Alabama and 388 at Virginia).
- Huff has tallied 8.4 points and 6.0 rebounds and a team-high 31 blocks. Huff recorded career highs in points (17) and blocks (6) at Georgia Tech.
- Tomas Woldentensae, Casey Morsell and Kody Statmann have replaced Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy and De'Andre Hunter on the perimeter.
- Woldentensae has started the past four games and has made 29 3-pointers, including seven at Wake Forest en route to a career-high 21 points.
- Morsell scored a career-high 19 points against Arizona State en route to all-tournament honors at the Air Force Reserve Tip-Off Tournament.
- Statmann is averaging 4.6 points, including career highs in points (11) at Boston College and rebounds (8) against Virginia Tech.
- Francisco Caffaro contributed 10 points and seven rebounds against North Carolina, and six points vs. NC State.
- Justin McKoy chipped in six points on 3 of 3 shooting off the bench at Purdue and four points and five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
- Walk-on Chase Coleman has averaged 5.5 minutes backing up point guard Kihei Clark, while Jayden Nixon has played in five games.
- Forward Kadin Shedrick is redshirting this season, while Sam Hauser will sit out the season after transferring from Marquette.

WATCH ME NOW

- Mamadi Diakite was named to the Oscar Robertson Trophy Player of the Year watch list from the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.
- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award) and Diakite (Karl Malone Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame pre-season award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Malone Award honors the top power forward.
- Diakite was also one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy Player of the Year watch list and one of 20 players named to the NABC Division I Player of the Year pre-season watch list.
- Diakite was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List.

UVA VS. THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

- UVA is 70-15 against teams from Virginia since 1999-00.
- UVA has won 23 of its last 26 games against teams from Virginia, including a pair of wins (JMU and Virginia Tech) this season.

- Diakite needs six blocks to pass Chris Alexander (148 blocks from 1993-96) for second on the list.
- Ralph Sampson is UVA's career blocked shots leader with 462.
- Diakite's 63 blocked shots in 2018-19 rank sixth on UVA's single-season list.

VIRGINIA PICKED FOURTH IN THE ACC

- Virginia was picked to finish fourth in the ACC preseason poll.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- Duke is the preseason favorite, followed by North Carolina, Louisville, Virginia, Florida State, NC State, Notre Dame, Syracuse, Miami, Pitt, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Boston College, Virginia Tech and Wake Forest.

ABOUT THE 2019-20 SCHEDULE

- Three of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the latest AP Top-25 poll (Louisville, Duke and Florida State).
- The Cavaliers will play 13 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against Duke, Florida State, Louisville, North Carolina, Syracuse, Vermont and Virginia Tech; road contests at FSU, Louisville, North Carolina, Purdue, Syracuse and Virginia Tech.

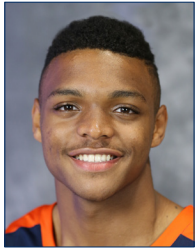

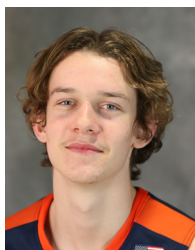
