# **GAME OVERVIEW**

The Virginia Cavaliers (5-0) are ranked No. 1 this week in both the USILA coaches and Nike/Inside Lacrosse media polls after topping then-No. 3 Syracuse on Sunday afternoon. UVa hosts its final midweek contest Tuesday night when the Vermont Catamounts (0-3), out of the America East Conference, invade Klöckner Stadium. Faceoff is slated for 7 p.m.

The Cavaliers will be looking to start the season at 6-0. UVa has started four of the last five seasons with a 5-0 record. In 2008 UVa started 9-0, in 2009 they started 12-0 and in 2010 the Cavaliers posted an 11-0 record before suffering a loss.

# THE SERIES VS. THE CATAMOUNTS

Tuesday night marks the fifth-straight season the Cavaliers have hosted the Catamounts in a series where UVa holds the all-time 4-0 advantage. Vermont is coached by former UVa All-American Ryan Curtis. A four-year letterwinner under Virginia head coach Dom Starsia, Curtis won the Schmeisser Cup as the nation's outstanding defenseman in 1999 when the Cavaliers won their first national championship in 27 years.

# FOLLOWING UP AN NCAA TITLE

• Virginia has won five NCAA titles and the Cavaliers are 3-2 all-time in their season-opening games after winning a title. The wins came following the 1972, 2003 and 2011 seasons. The losses came after the 1999 and 2006 titles. UVa is 2-1 when facing Drexel in a season-opening game in a year following a title

• Since the NCAA started holding a men's lacrosse tournament in 1971, only seven times has a school repeated as champions - three of those efforts were part of a three-peat

- UVa has never repeated as champions following an NCAA title season
