### BY THE NUMBERS

Virginia has won six consecutive games following its annual break for finals in the month of December.

### FOR OPENERS

- Virginia has a seven-game winning streak and is 7-1 at home this season.
- The Cavaliers rank second nationally in scoring defense (50 ppg) and fifth in opponent field goal percentage (34.1%) as of Dec. 17.
- UVa juniors Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell and sophomore Darion Atkins are each averaging career highs in scoring.
- Virginia has held its last two opponents under 40 points.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Virginia beat Mississippi Valley State, 67-39, on Dec. 8 for its seventh consecutive win.
- Cavalier junior forward Akil Mitchell had 20 points and five rebounds to lead the Cavaliers.
- Virginia freshman forward Justin Anderson added a season-high 15 points and nine rebounds.
- Junior guard Joe Harris was held without a field goal for just the second time in his UVa career.
- UVa allowed 17 points in the second half and held Mississippi Valley State to 19 percent shooting from the field, including a 3-23 (13%) mark from three-point land.

### ALL-TIME VS. MORGAN STATE

- Virginia meets Morgan State of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference for the second time.
- The Cavaliers defeated the Bears, 85-66, in the first meeting and second game at John Paul Jones Arena on Nov. 19, 2006, in Charlottesville.

### ALL-TIME VS. MID-EASTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

- Virginia is 18-0 all-time vs. the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (6-0 vs. Hampton, 4-0 vs. Howard, 2-0 vs. Maryland Eastern Shore and 1-0 vs. Bethune-Cookman, Coppin State, Morgan State, Norfolk State, North Carolina A&T and South Carolina State, respectively).

### EMBRACE THE PACE

- The Cavaliers have held five opponents under 50 points this season.
- UVa has held its opponent under 43 percent shooting from the field in nine consecutive games.

### 2012-13 Opponents in Bold

- The Cavaliers have held an opponent under 20 points in a half five times this season (15 vs. Fairfield, 13 vs. Seattle, 18 vs. Lamar, 16 vs. Tennessee and 17 vs. Mississippi Valley State).
- Opponents are shooting just 34.1 percent from the field and 27.8 percent from three-point range vs. Virginia this season.
- UVa ranks second nationally in opponents assists per game (8.0) and fifth nationally in opponent possessions per 40 minutes (60.7).

### INSIDE THE SEVEN-GAME WINNING STREAK

- UVa's seven-game winning streak is its best since last year's 11-game winning streak from Nov. 19, 2011-Jan. 7, 2012.
- UVa is shooting 48.3 percent from the floor, 40.2 percent from the three-point line and 78.4 percent from the free-throw line during the streak.
- UVa is averaging 66.6 points per game and allowing 47.6 points per game during the streak.
- The Cavaliers are limiting opponents to 30.4 percent shooting from the floor and 24 percent from the three-point line during the streak.

### NONCONFERENCE NOT A PROBLEM

- UVa is 8-2 in nonconference action this season and 40-16 in nonconference play in four years under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVa has posted nonconference wins vs. Fairfield (54-45), Seattle (83-43), Lamar (63-44), North Texas (80-64), Wisconsin (60-54), Green Bay (67-51), Tennessee (46-38) and Mississippi Valley State (67-39).

### HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has posted a 61-43 mark in four seasons at UVa.
- Bennett has a 130-76 career record, including a 69-33 record at Washington State, in seven seasons of collegiate coaching.
- Bennett guided the Cavaliers to their first NCAA Tournament since 2007 last season with a 22-10 record, and UVa's 22 wins were the most since 25 in 1994-95.
- UVa's nine ACC wins in 2011-12 were its most since 11 in 2006-07.
- Bennett is one of 18 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

### NO ORDINARY JOE

- Joe Harris is averaging a career-high 14.8 points, 4.3 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.
- Harris led UVa with 19 points at George Mason, 15 points vs. Fairfield, 20 vs. Delaware, 17 vs. Lamar, a season-high 22 at Wisconsin, 20 vs. Green Bay and 13 vs. Tennessee.
- Harris has led the team in scoring 19 times and scored in double figures 45 times in 74 career games at Virginia.
- Harris is also shooting a career-high 43.5 percent (20-46) from three-point range.
- He ranks fifth in the ACC in three-point shooting accuracy (43.5%), sixth in three-point field goals made per game (2.0) and eighth in scoring (14.8 ppg) through games of Dec. 16.

### AKIL HAS A FEEL

- Akil Mitchell is averaging career highs in points (13.4) and rebounds (9.2).
- Mitchell has four double-doubles this season (15-13 vs. Delaware, 14-16 vs. Seattle, 11-10 at Wisconsin and 13-12 vs. Tennessee).
- Mitchell has scored in double figures in nine of 10 games.
- Mitchell has scored a career-high 20 points two times.
- Mitchell has led UVa in rebounds in six games.
- Mitchell is also shooting a career-best 73.9 percent (34-46) from the free-throw line.
- He ranks fifth in the ACC in rebounding (9.2 rpg) and seventh in field goal percentage (54.3%) through games of Dec. 16.

### CARRY ON DARION

- Darion Atkins has started the past five games and is averaging a career-best 8.4 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.8 blocked shots per game.

- He scored a career-best 14 points at Wisconsin (11/28/12) and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds vs. Green Bay (12/1/12).
- UVA is 6-0 with Atkins in the starting lineup.
- Atkins leads the team in field goal percentage (54.3%) and blocked shots (18).
- Atkins ranks sixth in the ACC in blocked shots per game (1.8 bpg).

#### **FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

- Five Virginia freshmen (Justin Anderson, Taylor Barnette, Teven Jones, Evan Nolte and Mike Tobey) have started at least one game this season.
- Anderson leads the newcomers in scoring at 6.4 points per game, followed by Nolte (5.9), Tobey (4.9), Jones (4.1) and Barnette (2.6).
- Nolte leads the team in steals (12) and three-point field goal percentage (47.8%).
- UVA started three freshmen (Anderson, Tobey and Barnette) in its season-opening game vs. George Mason for the first time in school history.

#### **CLEANING THE GLASS**

- Virginia, who is averaging 34.4 rebounds per game, has outrebounded its opponent in nine of 10 games.
- The Cavaliers have grabbed eight or more offensive rebounds in seven games.
- Akil Mitchell leads Virginia in offensive rebounds (30), defensive rebounds (62) and total rebounds (92).

#### **HOLDING FOES UNDER 50**

- Virginia is 5-0 this season when holding opponents under 50 points.
- Virginia is 22-1 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era.
- Last season, Virginia set an ACC record during the shot clock era by holding 11 opponents under 50 points last season.
- The 11 games of holding opponents under 50 points were the most for the Cavaliers in a season since holding 16 opponents under 50 points in 1945-46.

#### **THE ELECTRIC 70s**

- Virginia is 27-2 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett.
- The Cavaliers are 34-41 over the past four seasons when scoring under 70 points.

#### **60 IS THE NEW 70**

- UVA is 6-0 when scoring at least 60 points and 2-2 when scoring under 60 points.
- Last season, Virginia was 18-2 when scoring at least 60 points and 4-8 when scoring under 60 points.

#### **RECORDS WATCH**

- Jontel Evans needs 14 assists and 20 steals to rank 10th on the UVA career lists. Joe Harris needs 21 three-pointers to rank 10th on the all-time career list.

#### **THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME AT JPJ**

- Virginia is 79-32 (.712) in seven seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavs are 7-1 this season at JPJ after posting a 13-3 record last season.
- Virginia is 42-16 (.724) at home under head coach Tony Bennett.

#### **NOTE WORTHY**

- UVA has used six starting lineups this season.
- Joe Harris and Akil Mitchell have started every game.
- UVA is 7-0 when shooting 70 percent or better from the free throw line.
- The Cavs are 8-1 when limiting opponents to less than 50 percent shooting from the field.
- The 84 combined points in the Virginia-Tennessee game tied for the lowest total in UVA history during the shot-clock era.
- UVA has allowed under 40 points for two straight games, marking the first time the Cavaliers have allowed under 40 in consecutive games since 1948-49 (38 by Langley Field, 39 by Rich-

### **PRESS CREDENTIALS**

Please allow ample time for credentials to be mailed to you. We would like to receive credential requests no later than 10 days prior to the game if at all possible. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

### **PHOTO CREDENTIALS**

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

### **PRESS PARKING**

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVA athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

### **INTERVIEWS**

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day, preferably longer, to arrange an interview.

### **POSTGAME INTERVIEWS**

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. The first coach will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the second coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after home games.

### **RADIO**

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

### **GAME SERVICES**

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

### **TELEPHONES/WIRELESS**

The Virginia athletics media relations office will have a limited number of telephones available for postgame reporting. Should you require your own telephone for game coverage, please contact Darlene Craig or Jim Daves in the Virginia athletics media relations office. **LONG RANGE BOMBERS**

- The Cavaliers set a John Paul Jones Arena team record for three-point shooting percentage in a game by drilling 8-of-11 (72.7%) shots beyond the arc vs. North Texas (11/20/12).
- Virginia has made six or more three-pointers in five games.
- Joe Harris ranks fifth in the ACC in three-point field goal percentage (43.5%) and sixth in three-point field goals made per game (2.0) through games of Dec. 16.

**BROGDON TO REDSHIRT THIS SEASON**

- Sophomore guard Malcolm Brogdon will redshirt the 2012-13 season while recovering from successful foot surgery performed on March 7.
- Brogdon averaged 6.7 points and 2.8 rebounds per game in 28 games last season.

**PERRANTES AND HALL SIGN WITH VIRGINIA**

- Virginia signed standout guards London Perrantes (Woodland Hills, Calif.) and Devon Hall (Virginia Beach, Va.) to National Letters of Intent on Nov. 14.
- Perrantes is ranked No. 86 on ESPN's Top 100 recruiting list for 2013, while Hall is ranked No. 77 on Rivals.com's Prospect Ranking list.

**VIRGINIA PICKED 7TH IN THE ACC**

- Virginia was selected seventh in the preseason poll at ACC Operation Basketball.
- The Cavaliers, who were picked fourth and finished fourth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in each of the last four seasons.
- NC State is the preseason favorite, followed by Duke, North Carolina, Florida State, Miami, Maryland, Virginia, Clemson, Georgia Tech, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest and Boston College.

**ABOUT THE 2012-13 SCHEDULE**

- Five of Virginia's opponents were ranked in the preseason polls (NC State, Duke, North Carolina, Wisconsin and Florida State), while another two received votes (Tennessee and Miami, Fla.).
- Six opponents earned 2012 NCAA Tournament berths, while three participated in the College Basketball Invitational and two in the National Invitation Tournament.

**EUROPEAN TOUR RECAP**

- The Cavaliers posted a 2-3 mark during their five-game European Tour this past August.
- UVa competed against teams from the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Joe Harris led Virginia in scoring in Europe, averaging 15.6 points per game, while Akil Mitchell averaged 13.4 ppg, Mike Tobey 11.2 ppg and Jontel Evans 9.6 ppg.
- Evans averaged 7.8 assists per games, while Mitchell was UVa's top rebounder, pulling down 50 boards in the five games.

**SCOTT WILL BE TOUGH TO REPLACE**

- UVa will miss the 2011-12 third-team All-American Mike Scott, who is now a member of the NBA's Atlanta Hawks.
- Scott, who led Virginia in scoring and rebounding last season, was the first Cavalier to earn All-America honors since Ralph Sampson in 1983.
- Scott totaled 1,538 points and 944 rebounds in 130 career games at UVa.

**ON THE AIR THIS SEASON**

- Most all of Virginia's games this season will be broadcast either on television or online this season. The only games that will not be broadcast are the NIT Season Tip-Off consolation games on Nov. 19-20.
- All games will be broadcast on the Virginia Sports Radio Network with David Koehn (play-by-play) and Ted Jeffries (analyst) calling the action.


