- UVa leads the nation in scoring defense at 46.2 points per game, while Davidson leads the nation in scoring at 87.7 points per game.
- The Cavaliers have shot 50 percent or better for four consecutive games, their longest streak since five games in 1990-91.

### UVA RANKED IN TOP 10 FOR NINE STRAIGHT WEEKS

- UVa is ranked No. 3 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today coaches polls.
- The Cavaliers have been ranked in the top 10 for the first nine weeks of the season for the first time since 1982-83.
- The No. 9 AP preseason ranking was UVa's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.

### SERIES HISTORY

- UVa sports an 11-4 mark, including a 6-2 mark in Charlottesville, against Davidson in the series that dates back to 1920-21.

**VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT**

- Sixth-year head coach Tony Bennett sports a 117-60 mark at Virginia and 186-93 mark in nine seasons overall.
- Bennett was named 2014 ACC Coach of the Year after guiding the Cavaliers to their first ACC Tournament championship since 1976.
- In 2013-14, he guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship in the same season for the first time in school history.
- Bennett has guided the Cavaliers to three consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012 and 2014 and NIT in 2013).
- Bennett has increased UVA's win total in each of the last five seasons (15 in 2009-10, 16 in 2010-11, 22 in 2011-12, 23 in 2013-13 and 30 in 2013-14).
- Bennett-coached teams are 66-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his nine-year coaching career.
- Bennett-coached teams have finished in the top five nationally in scoring defense in five of eight seasons (first in 2008-09 and 2013-14, second in 2007-08 and 2011-12, and fifth in 2012-13).
- Bennett is one of 24 Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.

**EMBRACE THE PACE**

- Virginia is averaging 69.5 points and allowing a nation-leading 46.2 points, marking its best averages under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA has shot 49.8 percent from the field (14th nationally) and 39.2 percent from 3-point range, while limiting its opponents to 31.2 percent from the field (2nd nationally) and 27.8 percent from 3-point range.
- As of Dec. 29, the Cavaliers rank in the top five nationally in 11 defensive categories: rebounds per game (1st), points per game (1st), defensive rebounds per game (1st), assists per game (2nd), field goal percentage (2nd), effective shooting percentage (2nd), true shooting percentage (2nd), points per possession (3rd), possessions per 40 minutes (4th), rebound percentage (4th) and offensive rebound percentage (5th).
- The Cavaliers limited Rutgers to eight points in the second half and Harvard to eight points in the first half.
- Virginia is the first NCAA Division I team to hold two Division I opponents under 30 points (Rutgers and Harvard) in a season since Bucknell in 2004.
- UVA set a school and ACC record by limiting Harvard to just 16 percent (8-50) field goal shooting.
- Harvard's one first-half field goal tied the NCAA record for fewest made field goals in a half in the shot clock era (Savannah State, one second-half field goal at Kansas State on Jan. 7, 2008).
- The Cavaliers have held 35 straight opponents and 37 straight ACC opponents under 50 percent shooting from the field.
- UVA has limited its opponents to 18 fast break points.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- The Cavaliers have held their opponents scoreless for five or more minutes 11 times this season.
- Virginia held Tennessee State scoreless for 10:23 and Cleveland State scoreless for 10:03 during the non-conference season.
- Virginia has also limited its opponents without a field goal for eight or more minutes seven times, highlighted by Harvard for 19:53 on Dec. 21.

**BROGDON LEADS CAVALIERS INTO ACTION**

- Preseason All-ACC performer Malcolm Brogdon leads UVA into action this season.
- Brogdon ranks second on the team at 13.1 points per game and had a season-high 20 points against La Salle and added 18 at Maryland.
- He ranks seventh in the ACC in free throw percentage (77.3%), 11th in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0) and 24th in scoring.
- Brogdon has 10 or more points in eight games.
- In 2013-14, Brogdon averaged a career-high 12.7 points and 5.4 rebounds en route to All-ACC honors.
- Brogdon scored a career-best 23 points in the 2014 ACC Tournament final win against Duke.

**SIXTH MAN NO MORE**

- 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year Justin Anderson has started and led the team in scoring in nine games this season.
- He was named the USBWA's Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week and ACC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 9 after averaging 18.5 points and seven rebounds in wins at Maryland and VCU.
- Anderson tallied a season-high 21 points at VCU and had 20 against Tennessee State.
- He is averaging career highs in points (15.1), rebounds (4.8), field goal percentage (56.3%), 3-point percentage (60%) and free-throw percentage (81.3%).
- He ranks first in the ACC in 3-point percentage, eighth in 3-pointers per game (2.2) and field goal percentage and 10th in scoring.
- Anderson tied a career high with five 3-pointers on 5-5 shooting from distance against Tennessee State.
- Anderson was named 2014 ACC Sixth Man of the Year after averaging 7.8 points and 3.2 rebounds off the bench.
- In 2013-14, Anderson led the team in scoring in five games and had several game-changing defensive plays to ignite UVA.

- Anthony Gill, a High Point, N.C., native, is averaging career highs in points (12.1) and rebounds (6.6) this season.
- Gill tallied his first career double-double with 16 points and a career-high 10 rebounds en route to MVP honors at the Barclays Center Classic.

- Perrantes averaged 5.5 points and 3.8 assists and ranked sixth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.5) to earn All-ACC Freshman Team honors last season.

- Junior forward Evan Nolte, who is one of Virginia's top 3-point shooting threats, has averaged 8.5 points in his last two games.
- Nolte tallied a season-high nine points vs. Harvard and added eight points against Cleveland State.
- Nolte, who keyed UVa's rally with a pair of 3-pointers against Coastal Carolina in the 2014 NCAA Tournament, has shot 35.3 percent from 3-point range during his career.

## ROOKIES ARE FINDING THEIR WAY ON GROUNDS

- Redshirt freshman Devon Hall and true freshmen Isaiah Wilkins and Marial Shayok have made solid contributions in 2014-15.
- Shayok had nine points, five rebounds and four assists at Maryland.
- Hall had five points and five steals in a starting role in place of London Perrantes at James Madison.
- Wilkins chipped in eight points, five rebounds, three assists, two steals and two blocks at James Madison.

- Virginia is averaging 34 points in the paint, while limiting its opponents to 16.9 points per game in the paint.
- Frontcourt players Anthony Gill, Mike Tobey and Darion Atkins have combined to shoot 58.2 percent (113-194) from the field and are averaging 19.2 rebounds as a unit.
- UVa has outrebounded its opponent in every game and has a +14.2 rebounding margin.
- Gill, Tobey, Atkins and Isaiah Wilkins have combined for 40 blocked shots.

### PRESS CREDENTIALS

Media members interested in obtaining season or game credentials should contact Erich Bacher via email at bacher@virginia.edu, office phone (434) 982-5530 or cell phone (720) 318-5538. We would like to receive credential requests no later than seven (7) days prior to the game. Credentials that can't be mailed will be held for pickup at the will call window at John Paul Jones Arena. You must have a press pass to be admitted to the media area and the press room.

### PHOTO CREDENTIALS

All photographers and camera operators must wear a visible credential issued by the Virginia athletics media relations office. Photographers work from the baselines at both ends of the court at John Paul Jones Arena. Live television is given top priority for courtside space.

### PRESS PARKING

Press parking passes are provided upon request on a limited basis. If you need a parking pass, please be sure to inform the UVa athletics media relations office when making your press or photo credential request.

### INTERVIEWS

All requests for interviews with Virginia basketball coaches and players should be made through Erich Bacher in the athletics media relations office. It is requested you allow the athletics media relations staff at least one day to arrange an interview.

### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Virginia head coach Tony Bennett and the visiting head coach will meet with media representatives in the press room after each game at John Paul Jones Arena. Coach Bennett will be available in the press room approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game and the visiting coach will be in the press room approximately 20 minutes after the game. Virginia players will be available in the team meeting room adjacent to the men's basketball locker room after Coach Bennett is done with his postgame press conference.

### RADIO

Each visiting school is allowed one free radio broadcast from John Paul Jones Arena. The Virginia athletics media relations office provides two ISDN lines and three business touchtone lines for use by the visiting broadcast crew. Radio network crews work from a courtside location at the scorer's table. Three seats are available at the table and one seat behind the visitor's broadcast location.

### GAME SERVICES

Information packets are available before each game at John Paul Jones Arena, and a full statistical summary and play-by-play sheets are distributed at halftime and after the game. Quotes from both coaches and two or three players from each team will be available at the conclusion of the game. A pregame meal is served for working members of the media in the press room on the event level of John Paul Jones Arena.

The Virginia athletics media relations office will have a limited number of telephones available for postgame reporting. Should you require your own telephone for game coverage, please contact Darlene Craig or Erich Bacher in the Virginia athletics media relations office.
