- The Cavaliers captured the Corpus Christi championship in 2013 and Barclays Center Classic title in 2014.
- Virginia has scored 80 or more points in each of its two wins this season after reaching the 80-point barrier in two contests in 2014-15.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett sports a 138-65 mark in seven seasons at Virginia and 207-98 career mark in 10 seasons.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time in school history.

VIRGINIA'S RANKED NO. 6 AP IN BOTH POLLS

- UVA is ranked No. 6 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' preseason polls.
- The Cavaliers' No. 6 preseason ranking was UVA's best since a No. 1 ranking to start the 1982-83 season.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 10 in 25 consecutive AP polls since March 3, 2014, its longest span since 49 consecutive polls from 1980-83.

ABOUT THE 'HOOS

- The Cavaliers are averaging 78.7 points per game and allowing 59.3 ppg.
- Senior All-America candidate Malcolm Brogdon and Anthony Gill lead the Cavaliers into action at the Charleston Classic.
- Brogdon tallied a career-high 28 points at George Washington and leads UVA in scoring at 15.3 points per game.
- Gil had a team-high 16 points vs. Bradley and is averaging 13.0 points and 6.3 rebounds. Gill, who has reached double figures in scoring in all three games, is 28 points shy of reaching 1,000 career points in three seasons at UVA and one at South Carolina.
- Marial Shayok made his second career start last night vs. Bradley and had a career-high 10 points. Shayok matched a career-best with six rebounds.

LAST TIME OUT

- No. 6 Virginia closed the first half with an 18-3 run en route to an 82-57 win over Bradley in the first round of the Charleston Classic.
- Anthony Gill had 16 points to lead four UVA players in double figures. Gill added a team-high seven rebounds.
- Malcolm Brogdon added 13 points and moved into 34th on UVA's career scoring list with 1,180 points.
- London Perrantes had season highs in points (12) and assists (8).
- Marial Shayok started his first game of the season and responded with a career-best 10 points.
- UVA shot a season-best 56.6 percent (30-53) from the field and 94.1 percent (16-17) from the charity stripe.
