FOR OPENERS

- Virginia meets Lehigh for the third time.
- UVA has started 7-0 for the second straight season and third time in nine seasons under head coach Tony Bennett.
- UVA is ranked first nationally in scoring defense (50.1 ppg), fourth in free throw percentage (81.4%), sixth in field goal percentage defense (34.5%), seventh in turnovers per game (9.3), tied for 11th in 3-point field goal percentage defense (25%) and 20th in scoring margin (19.7).

AGAINST THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

- Virginia has a 35-34 all-time record vs. current Patriot League members (14-31 vs. Navy, 7-0 vs. Loyola (Md.), 5-1 vs. American, 3-0 vs. Army, 2-1 vs. Lafayette, 2-1 vs. Bucknell and 2-0 vs. Lehigh).
- The Cavaliers are 2-0 vs. Patriot League opponents under head coach Tony Bennett, defeating Navy (67-42) and Lehigh (80-54).

UVA RANKED NO. 18 IN AP POLL

- UVA is ranked No. 18 in the latest AP poll and No. 15 in the USA Today Coaches' poll.
- The Cavaliers received votes in the first three AP polls, snapping a streak of 64 consecutive weeks in the AP rankings since Feb. 3, 2014.
- UVA was ranked in the top 10 in the preseason rankings in each of the past three seasons (2014-16).

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- UVA has limited its opponents to a school-record 50.1 points per game and has held four of its 2017-18 foes to fewer than 50 points (UNCG, Austin Peay, Vanderbilt and Wisconsin).
- The Cavaliers are 68-2 when limiting their opponents to fewer than 50 points under head coach Tony Bennett.
- In 2016-17, Virginia led the nation in scoring defense (56.4 ppg) for the third time under Bennett.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense four times (2008-09, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2016-17) and finished in the top-five nationally in eight of 11 seasons.
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points during his 12-year coaching career.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 154-40 (.794), including a 4-0 mark in 2017-18, in 12 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- The Cavaliers have a six-game home winning streak dating back to Feb. 27, 2017.
- The Cavaliers finished undefeated at home (15-0) in 2015-16.
- UVA is 116-24 (.829), including an 81-9 (.900) mark the past six seasons, at home under head coach Tony Bennett.
- Virginia is 41-4 in ACC home games over the past five seasons.
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for eight straight seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. LEHIGH

- UVA is 2-0 all-time vs. Lehigh in a series that dates back to 1973-74.
- The Cavaliers meet the Mountain Hawks for the first time since posting an 80-54 win in the last meeting between the teams in 2015-16.
- UVA topped Lehigh 87-60 in the first meeting at University Hall on Dec. 11, 1973.
- Former Cavalier great and ABA standout Gus Gerard had 22 points and nine rebounds to lead UVA, which out-rebounded Lehigh 48-30 in the contest.

LAST TIME VS. THE MOUNTAIN HAWKS

- Malcolm Brogdon tallied 23 points to lead then-No. 12 Virginia to an 80-54 win over Lehigh in non-conference action on Nov. 25, 2015.
- Darius Thompson (12 points), Marial Shayok (11 points) and Anthony Gill (10 points) also reached double figures as UVA reached 80 points for the fourth straight game.
- London Perrantes dished out a game-high eight assists and UVA out-rebounded the Mountain Hawks 37-29.
- UVA shot 50 percent or better from the field for the fourth straight game, hitting 34 of 65 attempts for 52.3 percent.

UVA IN KEN POM EFFICIENCY RATINGS

- As of Nov. 30, UVA ranks Nos. 1, 3 and 39 in the KenPom.com adjusted defense, overall and adjusted offense efficiency ratings.
- UVA is shooting 48.8 percent from the field, 37.6 percent from 3-point range and school-best 81.4 percent from the free throw line.
- UVA has shot 50 percent or better in four games.
- UVA has held each of its seven foes to less than 50 percent shooting.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Head coach Tony Bennett has a 195-83 (.701) mark in nine seasons at Virginia and 264-116 (.695) career mark in 12 seasons overall.
- Bennett has guided UVA to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances and has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 23 or more wins.
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-record five straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons from 2014-16, eclipsing 88 wins from 1981-83.
- Bennett has led the Cavaliers to six consecutive postseason tournaments (NCAA in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and NIT in 2013).
- In 2015-16, Bennett led UVA to its third consecutive NCAA Tournament and first NCAA Elite Eight appearance since 1995 with 29 wins.
- Bennett was named 2015 USBWA National Coach of the Year and ACC Coach of the Year after leading Virginia to a school-record tying 30 wins and its second consecutive ACC regular-season title.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons (2014-2015) for the first time in school history.
- In 2013-14, Bennett guided UVA to its first ACC regular season and tournament championship (first since 1976) in the same season.
- Bennett is one of 28 current Division I head coaches who played in the NBA.
- UVA is 107-33 (.764) in non-conference action, 88-50 (.638) in ACC play and 116-24 (.829) at home under Tony Bennett.

LAST TIME OUT

- Kyle Guy scored 17 points and Devon Hall added 16 as Virginia shut down Wisconsin 49-37 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge on Nov. 27.
- The Cavaliers held the Badgers scoreless for 7:37 of the second half and held Wisconsin to 31.3 percent shooting (15 of 48).
- UVA out-rebounded Wisconsin 39-30 behind Isaiah Wilkins' game-high 10 rebounds.
- UVA did not attempt a free throw for the first time in school history, breaking the previous low of one free throw attempt vs. Clemson (2012) and North Carolina (1982).
- UVA is one of nine DI teams since 1996-97 to win a game without attempting a free throw - Bucknell, Dayton, Illinois State, Miami (OH), Michigan State, Portland, Princeton, Stony Brook.

ABOUT THE CAVALIERS

- UVA is led by tri-captains Devon Hall, Isaiah Wilkins and Jack Salt.
- The announcement of Hall, Wilkins and Salt marked the first time in Bennett's 12-year head coaching career where he officially named team captains.
- UVA has averaged 69.9 points per game (second most under Bennett) on offense, while yielding a nation-leading 50.1 ppg (lowest in school history) on defense.
- UVA has started Ty Jerome, Kyle Guy, Hall, Wilkins and Salt in each of its first seven games.
- Guy leads the team in scoring at 16 points per game and has scored 13 or more points in six of seven games, including a career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17).
- Hall has averaged 11.9 points on 54 percent shooting and a team-leading 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the charity stripe.
- Wilkins, who has averaged 7.9 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds, leads UVA in field goal percentage (64.7%) and has a team-high eight blocked shots.
- Jerome is averaging 7.7 points and is tied for the team lead in assists (17).
- Salt is averaging 3.0 points and career-best 5.4 rebounds, while graduate transfer Nigel Johnson is averaging 6.3 points after averaging 11.3 points for Rutgers last season.
- Mamadi Diakite (6.3 ppg & 3.9 rpg) and redshirt freshmen De'Andre Hunter (6.3 ppg) and Jay Huff (5.0 ppg) are contributors off the bench.
- Marco Anthony provides depth and fellow rookie Francesco Badocchi is expected to redshirt the 2017-18 season.

ZAY PAVES THE WAY

- Senior forward Isaiah Wilkins is one of the top utility players in college basketball.
- Wilkins has averaged 7.9 points, 6.9 rebounds, 1.9 assists, 1.1 blocked shots and 1.1 steals in 2017-18.

- Wilkins was named the MVP of the NIT Season Tip-Off after scoring a career-high 19 points against Rhode Island (11/24/17) and blocking four shots and scoring eight points against Vanderbilt (11/23/17).
- He tallied eight points, eight rebounds, two assists, one steal and took a team-high three charges at VCU (11/17/17).
- In 2016-17, the All-ACC Defensive team honoree led the team in rebounding (6.0 rpg), blocked shots (43) and steals (33), becoming the first Cavalier since Travis Watson in 2002-03 to lead the team in those three categories.
- Wilkins recorded a pair of double-doubles in 2016-17 (13 points, 11 rebounds and career-high tying five blocks vs. Louisville and 10 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Miami).

HALL OF A PLAYER

- Redshirt senior Devon Hall is averaging 11.9 points, 3.9 rebounds and 2.2 assists in 25.9 minutes per game.
- Hall is shooting 54 percent from the floor, 50 percent from 3-point range and 95.2 percent (20 of 21) from the free throw line.
- He scored a career-high 19 points against UNCG (11/10/17) and added 18 against Rhode Island (11/24/17).
- In 2016-17, Hall averaged career highs in points (8.4), rebounds (4.4), 3-point percentage (37.2%), free throw percentage (77.6%) and minutes (27.4).
- Hall, who has started 61 consecutive games dating back to last season, has scored in double figures in 24 career games including four games this season.
- He was named to the 2016-17 All-ACC Academic Team after earning his degree in media studies and is currently enrolled in the Professional Development Program at the Curry School of Education.

THIS GUY GETS BUCKETS

- Sophomore Kyle Guy is having a breakout season for Virginia.
- Guy leads Virginia in scoring (16 ppg), steals (1.4 spg) and is tied for team lead in assists (2.4 apg), and is second in 3-point percentage (42.9%) and free throw percentage (88.2%).
- Guy's career-high 29 points at VCU (11/17/17) were the most for a Virginia player since Joe Harris' 36 points vs. Duke in 2012-13.
- Guy has led the Cavaliers in scoring in four contests and has scored 13 or more points in six games this season.
- Guy is shooting 47.8 percent (66 of 138) from 3-point range during his two-year career and has made five 3-pointers in four games.
- Guy's 7.5 points per game average in his rookie season under head coach Tony Bennett ranked higher than former UVA standouts Malcolm Brogdon (6.7 ppg) and London Perrantes (5.5 ppg).
- Guy has scored 10+ points in 17 games, including a pair of 20-point efforts last season against Pitt (3/8/17) and Grambling State (11/22/16).

HOLDING FOES UNDER 50

- Virginia is 68-2 when holding opponents under 50 points in the Tony Bennett era (4-0 in 2017-18).
- Bennett-coached teams are 93-3 when holding opponents to fewer than 50 points (25-1 in three years at Washington State).
- UVA held Wisconsin under 40 points and is 19-0 under Bennett when limiting foes to 40 or fewer points.

• Virginia has scored 70 or more points in four games and is 99-6 when scoring at least 70 points under Tony Bennett. UVA is 96-77 when scoring under 70 points under Bennett.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 SCHEDULE

• Six of Virginia's opponents are ranked in the AP Top-25 preseason poll (Duke, Notre Dame, Miami, North Carolina, Louisville and West Virginia), while Rhode Island received votes.
 • The Cavaliers will play 17 games against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams: home games against North Carolina, Notre Dame, Louisville, Virginia Tech and Wisconsin; road contests at Duke, North Carolina, West Virginia, Louisville, Florida State, Wake Forest and VCU; and neutral-site tilts against Vanderbilt and either Seton Hall or Rhode Island in the NIT Season Tip-Off in Brooklyn, N.Y.
 • Four opponents (Clemson, Georgia Tech, Monmouth, UNC Greensboro and Syracuse) participated in the 2017 National Invitation Tournament.

VIRGINIA PICKED 6TH IN THE ACC

• Virginia was picked to finish sixth in the ACC preseason poll.
 • The Cavaliers, who were picked third and finished tied for fifth last season, have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in eight of the last nine seasons.
