# KEVIN SAUER

#### 28th Season at Virginia 20 Seasons with Varsity Team 7 Seasons with Club Team



Kevin Sauer finished his 19th year as the head coach of the varsity Virginia rowing program in 2014 and has led the Cavaliers to 10 top-four finishes in his career and eight consecutive top-six finishes at the NCAA Championships.

A two-time Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association (CRCA) National Coach of the Year (2010 and 2012), Sauer has elevated Virginia to the most elite level of rowing programs around the country and has guided the Cavaliers to a pair of NCAA Championships. in 2010 and 2012.

Cavalier boats have been crowned national champions eight times, including four times in the Varsity Four (2004, 2005, 2007 and 2010) and three times in the Second Varsity Eight (1998, 1999 and 2005). Sauer's program hit another high in 2012 as the UVa Varsity Eight won the NCAA title for the first time and clinched the team title in the process.

The Cavaliers' top crew, the Varsity Eight, has had a stellar record under Sauer, going 54-5 in 2013 and 32-9 in 2014. Overall, the V8 is 784-174 (.818 winning percentage) in the Sauer era.

Under Sauer's tutelage, 33 student-athletes have earned 44 CRCA All-America citations and he has had 66 All-ACC selections. Virginia has had multiple All-Americans 14 years in a row and had a member on the first team 16 consecutive seasons. Additionally, 17 Virginia rowers were named to the ACC's 50th Anniversary Rowing Team. In 2006, a league-high 16 Cavaliers were named to the inaugural Academic All-ACC Team.

The Cavaliers have also excelled in the ACC under Sauer, winning 14 of the 15 ACC regattas to be held, including the last five years. Virginia has won 54 of the 60 events to be held at ACC regattas, had 12 crews be named ACC Crew of the Year and Sauer himself has been honored as the ACC Coach of the Year 10 times, including the last five seasons.

Sauer came to Charlottesville in the fall of 1988, when he was hired as the Virginia Rowing Club's second full-time professional coach. He oversaw the direction of both the men's and women's club teams until the women's team was upgraded to varsity status and began competition in the fall of 1995. Both teams thrived under Sauer, including the women's Varsity Four winning the club national championship in 1995.

Once at varsity level, it did not take long for Sauer to build Virginia into a national powerhouse. The Cavaliers finished fourth at the inaugural NCAA regatta in 1997 and have finished as the runner-up on three occasions (1999, 2005 and 2007). Virginia is one of just seven schools to claim the NCAA Championship (Brown, California, Harvard, Ohio State, Stanford and Washington are the others) and one of four schools to compete in at least 16 NCAA Women's Rowing Championships. At each of those 16 appearances, the Cavaliers have not finished any lower than seventh.

In addition to NCAA success, the Cavaliers' Varsity Eight has been the top collegiate crew in the Championship Eights at the Head of the Charles three consecutive years and was the top overall crew at the 2012 regatta. Since being at Virginia, Sauer has helped coached several USRowing teams, including three times as the head coach of the US Under-23 National Team. Under the guidance of Sauer at the national level, the American quad won gold at the 2007 World U-23 Championships, while Kelsie Chaudoin was in the American eight that captured gold in 2008. UVa standout Jennifer Cromwell was in the 2- in that same squad in 2007 andwon gold with the eight in 2010.

Also in the summer of 2008, former UVa rowers tasted the ultimate success as Lindsay Shoop (Class of 2004) and Melanie Kok (Class of 2007) earned medals at the Olympics in Beijing, China. Shoop won gold with the U.S. women's eight, while Kok was a bronze medalist with the Canadian lightweight double.

Overall at Virginia, Sauer has coached 17 rowers that have competed at the World Championships and six Olympians, including one at each of the last three Olympiads.

Before coaching at Virginia, Sauer served two stints as head coach at Purdue, his alma mater, from 1979 to 1982 and from 1986 to 1987. Under his direction, Purdue crews won the 1981-82 Midwest Championship and placed third in the 1986 Dad Vail. From 1983 to 1985, Sauer served as freshman coach at Yale, where his crews posted a 22-5 record.

A native of Indianapolis, Ind., Sauer received his bachelor's degree in marketing and finance from Purdue in 1976 and was a member of the U.S. National Rowing Team in 1975 and 1977. While at Purdue, he rowed for the United States in the 1975 Pan American Games. He also competed in the 1977 World Rowing Championships.

Sauer continued his involvement in international competition as the rowing, canoe and kayak course contractor for the 1984 Olympics, the 1987 Pan American Games, the 1990 Goodwill Games and the 1996 Olympics. He also coached the U.S. Rowing Development Camp in 1997 and served as a technical advisor for U.S. Rowing during the 1988 Olympic year before coming to Charlottesville that fall.

From 1997-2000, Sauer was a member of the High Performance Committee for U.S. Rowing, which makes plans for the coaching, selection and training of the national and Olympic rowing teams. In 2001, he was elected to serve as the South representative for the Collegiate Rowing Coaches Association, a position he held until 2008.

Sauer and his wife, Barb, reside in Charlottesville. The Sauers have two children, Nick and Kelly, who also live in Charlottesville. Nick and wife, Lindsay, have two sons, Kevin and Nate, while Kelly and husband, Mark, have a daughter Colbie. Coach Sauer is the only one that does not have a University of Virginia degree.

# COACHING STAFF BRETT GORMAN



### Assistant Coach Third Season

Brett Gorman completed her second season as assistant coach of the Virginia rowing program in 2014. Gorman assists the Cavalier recruiting efforts and works with the varsity crews, including the Varsity Four that finished third at the 2014 NCAA Championships and fourth at the 2013 national regatta.

Gorman served as the lead assistant for her alma mater, Michigan, from 2010-12 and helped guide the Wolverines to a second-place finish at the NCAA Championships and their first Big Ten title in eight years in 2012. She oversaw the recruiting efforts for the Wolverines and led the novice program.

Gorman is a four-time member of the USRowing senior national team and won gold medals with the women's eight at the 2006 and 2007 World Rowing Championships. She also finished 12th in the women's double sculls at the 2006 world regatta and was a Team USA alternate for the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games.

A 2005 graduate of Michigan, Gorman helped the varsity eight earn a secondplace finish at the 2003 NCAA Championships and a bronze medal at the 2004 national regatta.

Gorman and her husband, Sean, reside in Charlottesville.



### **JOSH GAUTREAU**

#### Assistant Coach Third Season

Joshua Gautreau finished his third season with the Cavaliers in 2014, second as assistant coach after being promoted from graduate assistant. Gautreau oversees the novice and development squads as well as work directly with varsity crews, and is the primary recruiter for international athletes as well as the Mid-Atlantic, Southern,

and Pacific Northwest regions.

Last year, Gautreau acted as boat coach for the Second Varsity Eight in the lead up to the NCAA Championships, helping the Cavaliers to a third-place finish. During the regular season, Gautreau mentored the Third Varsity Eight to an ACC Championship to cap off an undefeated season. In 2013, Gautreau guided the Novice Eight to the ACC Championship and had novices challenging for


NCAA positions by the end of the spring season.

In his first season at Virginia as graduate assistant coach, Gautreau helped lead the Novice Eight to an undefeated spring season, spanning 10 races. The Novice Eight captured its race at the ACC Championships to secure crucial points towards the Cavaliers' team title.

After rowing for Syracuse from 2002-06, Gautreau won the lightweight fours at the Head of the Charles, the Canadian Henley and is a two-time US Rowing National Champion. He competed for the US National Team at the 2011 Pan American Games, where he finished seventh with the lightweight fours.

Gautreau graduated from Syracuse with a bachelor's degree in physics in December 2005 and is currently pursuing a master's degree from UVa in exercise physiology.

Gautreau resides in Charlottesville with his wife, Catherine, and their son, Boden, who was born in January 2015.



### ROGER PAYNE

#### Boatman 10th Season

Roger Payne completed his 10th season as boatman for UVa in 2014. Before coming to UVa, he worked as the boatman for Wisconsin for 14 years.

In 2012, Payne helped construct one of the Cavaliers' newest boat, the Craig K. Littlepage, dedicated in honor of Virginia's

Director of Athletics. The boat was used by the Varsity Eight that won the NCAA Championship less than two months after its dedication.

A 1976 graduate of the University of Washington, Payne rowed lightweight crew for the Huskies and was a four-time Canadian Henley lightweight doubles champion. Payne was also the head women's rowing coach at Oregon State, and worked for Pocock Racing Shells and Owen Racing Shells.

In 1996, Payne was the boatman and assistant coach for the U.S. team at the Nation's Cup (U-23 World Championships). Payne served as boatman for the United States at the 1997 and 1998 Nations Cups. In 1999, Payne was the boatman for the U.S. team at the Pan Am Games. He also worked as the U.S. women's doubles coach at the Midwest Olympic Development Camps (1999-2003).

Payne is an active oarsman and competes in master's events. He and his wife, Kathie, have a son and daughter, Collin and Eva, who both rowed for Wisconsin.



#### TERESA A. SULLIVAN President, University of Virginia

Teresa A. Sullivan is the eighth president of the University. Before coming to U.Va., she was the Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs at the University of Michigan. She was also Professor of Sociology in the College of Literature, Science, and the Arts.

Prior to her work at the University of Michigan, Ms. Sullivan was Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs for the University of Texas System, a position she held from 2002 until May 2006. In that role, she was the chief academic officer for the nine academic campuses within the University of Texas System. Ms. Sullivan first joined the University of Texas at Austin in 1975 as an instructor and then assistant professor in the Department of Sociology. From 1977-81, she was a faculty member at the University of

Chicago. Ms. Sullivan returned to Texas in 1981 as a faculty member in Sociology. In 1986 she was named to the Law School faculty as well. Ms. Sullivan also held several administrative positions at Texas including: Vice President and Graduate Dean (1995-2002), Vice Provost (1994-95), Chair of the Department of Sociology (1990-92), and Director of Women's Studies (1985-87).

Ms. Sullivan's research focuses on labor force demography, with emphasis on economic marginality and consumer debt. The author or co-author of six books and more than 50 scholarly articles, her most recent work explores the question of who files for bankruptcy and why.

Ms. Sullivan is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. She serves as chair of the National Research Council Panel on Measuring Higher Education Productivity, and as a member of the following committees and councils: National Research Council Committee on Research Universities; Council of Presidents for the Association of Governing Boards of Universities and Colleges; National Security Higher Education Council; and the Northern Virginia Technology Council, the trade association of the technology industry in Northern Virginia. She serves as the AAU representative on the ACE Board of Directors, and as a member of the Higher Education Advisory Committee that provides guidance for implementation of the Virginia Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2011.

A graduate of James Madison College at Michigan State University, Ms. Sullivan received her doctoral degree in sociology from the University of Chicago.



### CRAIG LITTLEPAGE Athletics Director

Committed to preserving and building on UVa's longstanding tradition of academic and athletic excellence, Craig Littlepage is in his 11th year as Virginia's Athletics Director. Littlepage's appointment as athletics director was announced in August of 2001.

Littlepage served as Virginia's interim athletics director from June 1, 2001, until his appointment to the position. He had also served as the University's interim athletics director from December of 1994 until July of 1995.

The first African-American athletics director in Atlantic Coast Conference history, Littlepage was named the Black Coaches Association's "Athletics Administrator of the Year" in 2003 and 2006. He was also listed on Sports Illustrated's list of the 101 most influential minorities in sports in 2003 and 2004. In March 2005, Littlepage was named one of Black Enterprise magazine's "Most Powerful African-Americans in Sports."

Littlepage has been a member of UVa's athletics administration since 1990 when he was appointed an assistant athletics director, a position he held from 1990-1991. He then spent four years as the associate director of athletics for programs and six years (1995-2001) as senior associate director of athletics, managing all aspects of the athletics department's day-to-day operations.

Littlepage leads a comprehensive 25-sport athletics program that routinely competes for championships and national rankings in many sports. At the same time, Cavalier student-athletes who exhaust their eligibility at Virginia graduate at a rate comparable to the student body as a whole. Annually, UVa student-athletes rank among the top Division I-A public universities in the country in graduation rates.

Nine years ago, Littlepage outlined a number of ambitious 10-year goals for the department to achieve by 2012: graduate 100 percent of its student-athletes; win 12 national championships and 70 conference titles; fully endow all scholarships and provide the operational support required to meet all other stated goals; build and maintain high-quality facilities; annually recruit the best student-athletes in the country (based on how coaches rate their top prospects); and fully comply with Title IX

Such goals reflect Littlepage's vision of "uncompromised excellence in intercollegiate athletics" as well as the department's overall mission to "enhance and support the intellectual purpose of the University and its exemplary academic standards and traditions."

The 2010-11 athletics year proved to be another very successful one as 21 of Virginia's 25 athletics programs advanced to postseason competition. UVa finished seventh in the Learfield Sports Directors' Cup standings, the second highest finish in school history and the third consecutive year the Cavaliers finished in the Top 10.

The men's lacrosse team won the NCAA Championship, the men's tennis team won its fourth consecutive ITA National Team Indoor Championship and UVa won two individual NCAA championships. Other top finishes in NCAA postseason competition by UVa athletics teams in 2010-11 included program-best finishes of second by the men's tennis team, a tie for third by the baseball team, fourth by the women's golf team and eighth by the men's swimming and diving team. The field hockey team reached the NCAA Tournament's semifinals for the second consecutive year and the women's rowing team finished sixth at the NCAA Championships. The baseball team earned the No. 1 national seed in the NCAA Baseball Championship and participated in the College World Series for the second time in three years.

Virginia has won six team NCAA Championships and 12 individual NCAA Championships in the last nine years. The Cavaliers have also won 47 ACC Championships in that time frame, more than any other conference school. UVa won five ACC championships in 2010-11, tying for the most of any league member. It's the fourth-consecutive athletics season UVa led the ACC in league titles.

Great progress has also been made in the area of athletics facility improvements during Littlepage's watch, including the addition of John Paul Jones Arena. The basketball arena/special events center opened in the summer of 2006 to rave reviews.

Littlepage has held many leadership roles within the NCAA, ACC, the University-at-large and professional organizations. He is currently a member of the John McLendon Foundation Steering Committee and served on the Executive Committee of the National Association of Collegiate Athletics Directors (NACDA) from 2006-10.

In February 2002, he was appointed to the 10-member Division I Men's Basketball Committee by the NCAA Championship/Competition Cabinet and served a five-year term which was completed Aug. 31, 2007. In 2005-06, Littlepage served as the chair of the Men's Division I Basketball Committee and administered its selection process.

Littlepage is currently the chairman of the ACC Women's Basketball Committee and the ACC Committee on Awards. He previously chaired the ACC Student-Athlete Welfare Committee, the ACC Men's and Women's Swimming/Diving Committees, and the ACC Men's Soccer Committee.

He is a member of the Associate Faculty for the University's Center for Alcohol and Substance Education, and participates in various alcohol and drug prevention/education conferences. Littlepage also has been active in the local community, having served on the Board of Directors for the Charlottesville Ronald McDonald House and serving as a Trustee with the Mount Zion Baptist Church.



#### JON OLIVER **Executive Associate Director of Athletics**

Jon Oliver is in his 11th year at Virginia. His primary responsibility is oversight of the dayto-day operations of the athletics department. Oliver is the administrative liaison for football and men's basketball and he has senior staff administra-

tive oversight responsibilities for Academic Affairs, Equipment Room Operations, Human Resources, Facilities and Game Operations, Lifeskills, Marketing and Promotions, Sports Medicine, Sports Nutrition, Sports Psychology, Strength and Conditioning and Video Services. Oliver also serves as the Department's representative on all major facility projects.

Before coming to UVa, Oliver spent the previous six years involved in various aspects of athletic administration at Washington State University. Oliver ended his tenure at WSU as the associate athletics director for external affairs and prior to that served as the associate athletics director for finance and facilities development, the assistant athletics director for business and compliance and the director

Oliver earned a bachelor's degree in communications from Boise State in 1994 and his law degree from the Idaho School of Law in 1997.

Oliver is a former member of the University of Idaho Law School Advisory Board and served on the NCAA's Minority Opportunities and Interests Committee. He is a member of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and the Black Coaches & Administrators (BCA).

He and his wife, November, have a son, Dante, and two daughters, Ariana and Mia.



#### JANE MILLER **Senior Associate Director of Athletics** for Programs

A 26-year veteran of the Virginia athletics department, Jane Miller has served as the senior associate director of athletics for programs since 2001. Previously, Miller was the asso-

ciate athletics director for programs/senior women's administrator.

Miller serves on the University Calendar Committee and Judicial Review Board. Miller is a member of the NCAA Division I Championships/Competition Cabinet, the Chair of the ACC Men's and Women's Lacrosse Committees, and is a member of the ACC Women's Basketball Committee and the Equity Committee.

She has been a member of the University's Women's Leadership Council since 2000.

Head coach of the UVa women's lacrosse team for 12 seasons, Miller resigned her coaching duties in 1995 for a full-time administrative role. She retired as the winningest coach in UVa women's lacrosse history, compiling a record of 145-44, including two national championships and four Final Four appearnaces. She was elected to the Virginia chapter of the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 1996, the New England chapter of the Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 2000 and the U.S. Lacrosse National Hall of Fame and Oliver Ames High School Hall of Fame in 2003.

A native of Easton, Mass., Miller graduated from Northeastern University in 1973 and was elected to her alma mater's Hall of Fame in 1983. She was a three-sport standout at Northeastern in basketball, field hockey and

Miller is a member of the National Association of Collegiate Women Athletic Administrators and the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics. In May of 1999, she received the Woman of Achievement Award from the UVa Women's Faculty and Professional Association.



#### **DIRK KATSTRA Executive Director of** the Virginia Athletics Foundation/Associate **Athletics Director for External Affairs**

Dirk Katstra is in his 17th year as executive director of the Virginia Athletics Foundation and his ninth year as associate athletics

director for external affairs with the athletics department.

In June 2004, Katstra was named Fundraiser of the Year by the National Association of Athletic Development Directors (NAADD) in recognition of his outstanding leadership and success in fundraising on behalf of Virginia athletics.

The annual campaign supports student athletes in all 25 sports programs in the form of scholarships, summer school, academic affairs and operational costs. The foundation is also responsible for all fund raising efforts for endowments for scholarships and operating costs. In addition, the foundation is responsible for supporting all fund raising efforts in the area of capital projects, including the new track and field facility, the recent \$4 million expansion to Davenport Field and the John Paul Jones Arena, UVa's \$129 million basketball arena and special events center, which opened in July 2006.

As associate director for external affairs, Katstra oversees the long-range planning and daily operations for media relations, sports publications, and the ticket office. From 1992 to 1996, Katstra served as director of annual giving for the Foundation.

A native of Stilwell, Kan., Katstra is a 1991 graduate of UVa with a degree in sport management. A member of the Cavalier basketball team from 1987 to 1991, Katstra played on three NCAA Tournament teams and was a senior captain on the 1990-91 squad.

Before joining the Virginia Athletics Foundation staff in 1992, Katstra served an internship with the athletics department's promotions and marketing office, and had administrative responsibilities with the men's basketball

Katstra is married to the former Michelle Massie of Charlottesville. The couple has two sons, Austin and Ryan, and daughter, Ryleigh. Katstra's father, the late Richard Katstra, lettered as a member of the UVa basketball team in 1963 and 1964.



#### **KEITH VANDERBEEK Associate Director of Athletics for Business Operations**

Keith VanDerbeek is in his 25th year as an associate athletics director.

The scope of his duties encompasses planning, organizing, directing and evaluating the business operations of all UVa athletics department activities. His responsibilities include the supervision of the business operations staff and the manager of information systems, acting as financial adviser to the athletics director, and coordinating the implementation and management of the department's operating budget. He serves as the department's liaison to the University's audit, budget, financial administration, and procurement offices.

A native of Spring Valley, N.Y., VanDerbeek received a B.S. degree in economics and business from Lafayette College in Easton, Pa., in 1972 and an M.S. degree in accounting from UVa in 1977.

From 1972 to 1975, he served as credit analyst and auditor for the Chemical Bank of New York, investigating market and industry studies and compiling portfolio analyses. During his enrollment in graduate school at UVa, he taught introductory and cost accounting classes at the McIntire School of Commerce. In 1977, he was recruited as budget officer for the College of Arts and Sciences at UVa before becoming Virginia's athletics business manager in the fall of 1978.

He is a member of the National Association of College and University Business Officers, the College Athletic Business Management Association, and the National Association of Accountants.

VanDerbeek has served on numerous Universitywide committees, including: Air Travel Service Committee, Capital Project Planning Committee, Centralized Accounts Payable Project, Committee on Safety and Security, Committee on Women's Concerns, Computer Resource Allocation Committee, Dining Services RFP Selection Committee, Outstanding Awards Committee, Integrated Systems Project Advisory Committee, Administration Technology Council, and the University's Strategic Task Force for Athletics.

She worked as a media relations assistant at Washington State, and spent one year each as a championships intern with the NCAA and Director of Marketing for MAAC Properties. She is a member of the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics and the National Association of Collegiate Women Athletics Administrators.
